THE GAME - The Arizona State Sun Devils will face the No. 21 Fresno State Bulldogs in the 27th edition of Mitsubishi Motors Las Vegas Bowl on Saturday, Dec. 15 at Sam Boyd Stadium in Las Vegas, Nev.

ASU will play in its 31st bowl game overall and the team's seventh bowl appearance in the last eight seasons. It will be the Sun Devils' second appearance in the Las Vegas Bowl, joining its 2011 appearance. ASU is 14-15-1 all-time in Bowl Games.

The 27th Mitsubishi Motors Las Vegas Bowl will be played Saturday, Dec. 15, at 12:30 p.m. PT (3:30 p.m. ET) at Sam Boyd Stadium. The game will be televised nationally on ABC, featuring the top choice from the Mountain West against the sixth pick from the Pac-12 Conference. Fresno State will serve as the home team in the contest.

This will be the fourth matchup between ASU and Fresno State in history, though it will be the first one in the modern era of college football. The two teams played in 1931, 1933 and 1941 - all Sun Devil victories.

Fresno State has recorded 11 wins for the sixth time in program history and have never recorded 12 wins in a year. The Bulldogs have won 20 of their last 24 games and have a nation-leading streak of 24 straight games holding opponents under 30 points.

Held every December since 1992, the Las Vegas Bowl has boasted sold-out attendance for eight of the last 13 years at Sam Boyd Stadium, including the second-largest team sporting event crowd in state history of 42,213 people in 2015.

This will mark the sixth consecutive year and seventh time overall that the Mitsubishi Motors Las Vegas Bowl will appear on ABC. It will be the seventh consecutive Saturday kickoff and 12th in the event's history. It will also be the bowl's 12th day game. The Las Vegas Bowl will be heard throughout the country and overseas by Sports USA and along the American Forces Radio Network. The Mitsubishi Motors Las Vegas Bowl is one of 14 bowl games owned and operated by ESPN Events, a division of ESPN.

AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- Be just the fourth time in the Pac-12 era (since 1978) that ASU beat Arizona and won a Bowl Game in the same season (1978, 2005, 2012).
- Be the first time EVER that ASU defeated both UCLA and USC as well as Arizona and won a Bowl Game.
- Mark Herm Edwards as just the 5th Sun Devil head coach ever to win 8 games in his first season at the helm (Dan Devine, John Cooper, Dennis Erickson, Todd Graham).
- Give ASU 8 wins in a season for the first time since 2014.
- Be just the seventh time in program history that ASU won three games over ranked teams in the same season and just the fourth time in the past 32 seasons (2014 (4), 2013, 1997)
- End ASU's streak of two straight bowl losses and move ASU back to .500 all-time in bowl games (currently at 14-15-1).

No ASU running back has LOST a fumble in 875 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 31 games. That includes 300 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions). Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,214 carries over 44 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.

Only three Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 650 defensive snaps this season and all of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson/749, Aashari Crosswell/722, Darien Butler/690). Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have combined for 3,302 play snaps on defense this season with the bowl game left to play. Comparatively, freshmen combined for just 918 total defensive snaps played in 2017 and 1,035 in 2016. Robertson's 749 snaps are the 5th-most among any Power Five true freshman in the country.

Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 133 straight games. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 75 of those games (56.4 percent). The Sun Devils scored at least 30 points in each of their victories during its three-game winning streak. ASU is 6-0 this year when scoring 30 or more points. Conversely, it only allowed opponents to score more than 30 three times, going 2-1 in those games.

Eno Benjamin needs just 42 rushing yards to set ASU's all-time single season school record. Benjamin is currently third in the nation with 1,524 rushing yards as he eyes Woody Green's 1972 school record of 1,565. He tied for third nationally in total rushing yards and his 15 rushing touchdowns are seventh in the country. Both totals lead the Pac-12 Conference. Benjamin ranks 3rd among Power-Five running backs with that 81.5 score, though he only had 23 career rushes prior to this season. He and Oregon State freshman Jermar Jefferson are the only Top-25 highest graded Power Five running backs that did not have at least 100 career carries prior to this season.

The Sun Devil have also closed games strongly, holding opponents to just 3.5 points per fourth quarter - the 5th lowest total nationally and lowest in the Pac-12. That allowed ASU to outscore opponents 119-42 in the frame this season. **ASU was 4-1 in games decided by three points or less**, the most wins by any team in the nation in the category. ASU was 6-14 in tilts of 3 points or less in the previous 10 seasons. The tough scoring defense has kept ASU in every game this season, with nine games this year being decide by one possession - tied with Texas for the most in the FBS this year. Unfortunately, all 5 of ASU's losses came in one-possession games.

Cohl Cabral was one of just 15 Power Five centers to not allow a sack this season. He was the third-highest graded center in the Pac-12 as a run blocker (63.3) Cabral had a positive run impact on 9.8 percent of plays this season, the 20th-best total among all FBS centers. The Devils have 6 games this season not allowing a sack (UTSA, UW, OSU, USC, UTAH, ARIZ). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack. ASU's 15 sacks allowed this season are 19th nationally. A year ago, ASU finished 124th in the nation with 41 sacks allowed and 119th in 2016 with 41 sacks allowed as well.

#10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

- ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 12 of its last 17 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard with 4 and Eno Benjamin with 8).
- Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have combined for 3,302 play snaps on defense this season with two games left to play. Comparatively, freshmen combined for just 918 total defensive snaps played in 2017 and 1,035 in 2016.
- Only three Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 650 defensive snaps this season and all of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson/749, Darien Butler/690, Aashari Crosswell/722).
- Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 133 straight games.
- No ASU running back has lost a fumble in 875 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 31 consecutive games.
- Tyler Johnson had 18 QB pressures over the final six weeks of the season, the second-most in the Pac-12 Conference among outside linebackers and tied for 11th-most nationally in that time span.
- ASU has held opponents to just 3.5 points per 4th quarter - the 5th lowest total in FBS as ASU's outscored opponents 119-42 in the frame. ASU was 112th last season (8.9 points per 4th), 124th (10.7 points) in '16, 121st (11.1 point) in '15 and 101st (8.6 points) in '14.
- ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently tied for 19th in the FBS with 1.25.
- Merlon Robertson is the first freshman to lead the team in tackles since Jason Shivers in 2001 and the first freshman to lead the team in tackles for loss and sacks since Junior Onyeali in 2010.
- Aashari Crosswell led the team in interceptions with three (t-6th among FBS freshmen) while recording 121 yards in interception returns - the latter good for the ninth-most nationally and the most for a freshman in the country

HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is the 19th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 (77.2) by Pro Football Focus, regardless of position and the fourth-highest quarterback in the league.
- » Wilkins currently sits at 8,495 career passing yards, good for fifth in Sun Devil football history - within striking distance of moving into the Top 3 in ASU history (8,827 yards by Jake Plummer) with the bowl game remaining
- » His 685 career completions are good for fourth in program lore while his 51 career touchdown passes are 6th in program history.
- » Wilkins has 20 rushing touchdowns in his career, good for second among all ASU quarterbacks in school history behind only Mark Malone (21). He has 8 rushing touchdowns this season, tied for 16th nationally, and needs one more touchdown pass to join what is currently a list of eight quarterbacks this season with 20+ passing touchdowns and 8+ rushing touchdowns.
- » Wilkins has accounted for 71 career touchdowns (51 passing and 20 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 100.8 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 21st-best total in the FBS.
- » Wilkins has a 118.5 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the 11th-best total in the country.
- » Wilkins has just a 12.4 sack percentage (percentage of time sacked when under pressure) that sits as the 20th-lowest total in the nation.
- » Wilkins is 33rd nationally in adjusted completion percentage (73.1 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.
- » He joins Jake Plummer (1996) and Taylor Kelly (2013) as the only other Sun Devil quarterbacks to beat both SoCal schools and Arizona in the same season.

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin is 9th nationally and 2nd in the Pac-12 conference in averaging 147.6 All-Purpose Yards per game.
- » Is tied for third nationally with 1,524 rushing yards and his 15 rushing touchdowns are seventh in the country. Both totals lead the Pac-12 Conference.
- » He has rushed for 70 first downs this season, second nationally and 6 behind the national leader
- » At 1,524 yards this season, he is 42 yards away from the ASU all-time single season school rushing record (1,565 yards by Woody Green in 1972)
- » Set the ASU school record with 277 carries this season.
- » Mario Bates (1993) and J.R. Redmond (1999) are the only other running backs since 1978 to average over 100 yards per game in a single season. Benjamin is currently at 127.0 yards per game.
- » In the Pac-12 era, no ASU running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently 3rd nationally at 1,524 yards. Darryl Clack (1984) and Mario Bates (1993) both finished 18th nationally - the highest for a Sun Devil running back in the Pac-12 era.

NUMERO ENO

- » Benjamin is the highest-graded running back in the Pac-12 and 10th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12, regardless of position (81.5).
- » Benjamin ranks 3rd among Power-Five running backs with that 81.5 score, though he only had 23 career rushes prior to this season. He and Oregon State freshman Jermar Jefferson are the only Top-25 highest graded Power Five running backs that did not have at least 100 career carries prior to this season.
- » His 87.5 score from PFF on rushing plays only is 3rd among all Power Five backs and 13th among all FBS running backs.
- » Benjamin has forced 83 missed tackles this season (70 rushing, 13 receiving) - second among all FBS players in the category.
- » Benjamin has just one fumble on 277 carries - one of just 14 running backs that have played 400+ snaps with 200+ carries that have 1 or fewer fumbles.
- » 35.8 percent of Benjamin's rushes this season have resulted in a "win" for the Sun Devil offense according to Pro Football Focus, the 8th-highest total among FBS running backs with at least 200 carries. Averaged a first down or touchdown on 30.5 percent of his carries this season - 8th-most among FBS running backs with at least 200 carries this year.
- » Benjamin's 29 explosive runs this season (runs for over 15 yards) are second nationally
- » Benjamin set a single-game school rushing record with 312 yards against Oregon State, placing him eighth all-time on the Pac-12 conference single-game rushing list and the highest single-game performance in the FBS this season.

DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU is currently 27th nationally and second in the Pac-12 in averaging 7.2 tackles for loss per game this season. ASU was 50th a year ago in the category, averaging just over 6 tackles for loss per game.
- » The Sun Devils are 43rd in the nation and fourth in the Pac-12 in sacks per game, averaging 2.42 per game.
- » 22 players have logged a tackle for loss this season for ASU, making the Sun Devils one of just one of 14 teams nationally to lay such a claim. 12 different players have scored a sack.
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.

DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » The Sun Devils have allowed just 25.1 points per game this season, good for 49th nationally. A year ago, ASU was 103rd nationally at 32.8 points per game and had finished 99th or worse in three consecutive seasons prior to the marked improvement this year.
- » ASU did not allow more than 30 points in the first 7 games of the season, one of just 11 teams in the nation to do so in 2018. ASU has held opponents to 30 or less points in 9 of 12 games this season.
- » This was just the fifth season in the Pac-12 era that ASU has opened the year with seven consecutive games not allowing 30 points, joining the 1982, 1986, 1991 and 1997 campaigns
- » The Sun Devil defense did not allow a single point in the first quarter of games against non-conference opponents and haven't allowed one in six of 12 games this year. ASU has allowed just 4.9 points per first quarter this season, good for 36th nationally. Last season, ASU allowed 6.7 first quarter points per game - the 82nd worst tally nationally.
- » The Sun Devil have also closed games strongly, holding opponents to just 3.5 points per fourth quarter - the 5th lowest total nationally and lowest in the Pac-12. That allowed ASU to outscore opponents 119-42 in the frame this season.
- » ASU struggled to close teams out last year, allowing 8.9 points per fourth quarter (112th nationally). The Sun Devils were outscored by opponents 116-102 in the fourth quarter of games on the year. ASU was 124th (10.7 points per fourth) in 2016, 121st (11.1 point per fourth) in 2015 and 101st (8.6 points per fourth) in 2014.

DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » The tough scoring defense has kept ASU in every game this season, with nine games this year being decide by one possession - tied with Texas for the most in the FBS this year.
- » ASU was 4-1 in games decided by three points or less, the most wins by any team in the nation in the category. ASU was 6-14 in tilts of 3 points or less in the previous 10 seasons.
- » Only three other teams even had three such wins by three points or less (Cal, NIU and Charlotte).
- » Unfortunately, ASU was also on the wrong end of five of those one-possession games - tied for the most losses by a touchdown or less of any team in the nation.

HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has LOST a fumble in 875 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 31 consecutive games. That includes 300 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions).
- » Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a failed play-action exchange on a direct snap play to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,214 carries over 44 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.
- » ASU ranks tied for third nationally with only 9 turnovers this season and the only Power Five conference with fewer than 10 turnovers on the year. ASU is outscoring opponents 59-20 in points off turnovers this season.



- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.

MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 655-348 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 67.9 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (110 of 162) while finding the end zone 83 times in that span (51.2 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 51.8 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (59 of 114) with 45 touchdowns (39.5 percent).

KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » Posted a positive run impact score on 19.2 percent of rushing plays this season, the 6th-best total among all Pac-12 Front Seven players. It was the 23rd-best percentage among all defensive interior players in the FBS
- » Wren was the 8th-highest graded defensive interior player in the Pac-12 on running plays this season with an 81.1 score.
- » Also the 15th-highest graded defensive lineman in the FBS when dropping back in coverage and his 23 defensive "stops" this season were tied for fourth among all Pac-12 interior defenders.
- » Jalen Harvey made 40 tackles on rushing plays within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage is the third-most among all safeties in the Pac-12 and within the Top 25 of safeties in the FBS despite the games missed.
- » Harvey's 70 tackles on the season are the third most among safeties in the Pac-12 while his 20 defensive "stops" are tied for fourth among Pac-12 safeties. Harvey had a 5.3 positive run impact percentage led all safeties in the Pac-12 and 30th among all safeties in the FBS.

LOCKING IT DOWN

- » ASU is tied for 14th nationally in allowing just 7 plays over 40 yards this season, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). ASU is also tied for 8th nationally in allowing just 2 plays of over 50 yards on the year.
- » The Devils have given up just 19 plays over 30 yards, tied for 30th-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.
- » ASU is tied for 20th nationally for fewest passing plays over 40 yards allowed this season, allowing just five. ASU was 90th in the category a year ago with 12 such plays allowed and 127th in 2016 with 22 passing plays over 40 yards allowed.
- » The Sun Devils are 60th in allowing 5.63 yards per play this year, an improvement of 50 positions from the team's 111th place finish in the category last year (6.33 yards per play). ASU had finished 109th or worse in the category in three consecutive seasons prior to the current campaign.

ON THE DEFENSE

- » The Sun Devils are forcing opponents into the 5th-worst starting field position nationally, with teams starting on average at their own 25.8 yard line.
- » On passing downs, opponents are averaging a marginal explosive tally of -0.13, according to Bill Connelly's advanced metrics, the 12th-best score nationally.
- » A testament to ASU's ability to crack down on the big play, the Sun Devils are 23rd nationally with a -0.03 defensive marginal explosiveness rating.
- » The defense has been exceptional in limiting scoring, logging in a 1.09 IsoPPP (points per play) score based on Connelly's metrics, the 29th-best total among FBS defenses. A year ago, ASU was 111th (1.17).
- » ASU's .341 points allowed per play (minus fancy calculations) is 40th nationally after finishing 98th last season (.445) and 125th in 2016 (.552)
- » The Sun Devil defense causes havoc (tackles for loss, fumbles forced or passed defended/intercepted) 17.7 percent of the time - good for 38th nationally. ASU had just a 14.1% havoc rate last season (94th nationally).
- » ASU's defense has held opponents to just 2.89 points per possession on "short" field drives (drives that start with 60 or fewer yards to go to the end zone). That's the 28th-lowest total nationally. ASU was 64th a year ago in the category (3.35).
- » ASU is surrendering just 4.46 points per scoring opportunity (points per trip inside the 40), 64th nationally and an improvement over its 96th-place ranking last season.
- » The Sun Devil defense has bent but not broke this year, allowing an opponent touchdown

on drives where a first down was allowed only 33.0 percent of the time this season (36th nationally) after sitting 91st (42.4 percent) in the country last season.

TAKING OFFENSE

- » ASU is 30th nationally in Offensive Ball Control Rate (drives that last 4 plays or more) - doing so 70.8 percent of the time.
- » The Devils are 40th nationally if Offensive First Down rate (drives that result in at least a single first down) with 75.4 percent of its drives resulting in at least one first down.
- » ASU has capitalized on short field position, scoring 4.17 points per drive when the possession STARTS within 60 yards of the opponent end zone - 22nd nationally.
- » ASU is also 33rd nationally in total points per drive, sitting at 2.57.
- » ASU gets itself into manageable third-and-short situations 15.4 percent of the time (10th nationally).
- » ASU only finds itself in third-and-long situations 43.8 percent of the time this season, good for the 21st-lowest total national. It's average third-down distance is 6.9 yards - the 26th-best total in the country.
- » ASU is 16th nationally in fourth quarter points per game (9.9) - second in the Pac-12 behind WSU - and have outscored opponents 119-42 in the fourth quarter of games this year.
- » The Sun Devil offense ran a successful play, according to Bill Connelly's metrics, 44.4 percent of the time - good for 41st nationally. Last season, ASU was 65th with a successful play rate of just 41.8 percent.
- » ASU's offensive efficiency score of 2.68 is good for 28th nationally. A team's OE is a value generated per drive by a team's offense adjusted by its starting field position.

THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

- » Only three Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 650 defensive snaps this season and all of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson/749, Aashari Crosswell/722, Darien Butler/690).
- » Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have combined for 3,302 play snaps on defense this season with the bowl game left to play. Comparatively, freshmen combined for just 918 total defensive snaps played in 2017 and 1,035 in 2016.
- » Robertson's 749 snaps are the 5th-most among any Power Five true freshman in the country.
- » Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have accounted for 34.4 percent of all of ASU's tackles this season (248 of 720) and 43.8 percent of the team's total tackles for loss (35 of 80).
- » Among all true or redshirt freshmen playing for Power Five teams in the country, none have more defensive stops (as graded by Pro Football Focus) than Robertson (35) and Butler (31). The duo ranks 13th and 21st overall in the Pac-12, regardless of year in school.
- » Robertson is third among all Pac-12 linebackers with 22 QB pressures this season while Butler sits ninth among the league's linebackers.
- » Both are tied for the 8th-fewest missed tackles among Pac-12 linebackers this season, both logging just seven over the course of the season - just 14 total on their combined 1,439 defensive snaps this season (0.9 percent).

MAGNIFICENT MERLIN

- » Freshman Merlin Robertson was named the Pac-12 Freshman Defensive Player of the Year.
- » Robertson becomes the fifth Sun Devil to earn a Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honor and the third to be named the Pac-12 Defensive Freshman of the Year. He joins Vontaze Burfict (2009) and Junior Onyeali (2010) as the third person to be distinguished as the Pac-12 Defensive Freshman of the Year.
- » Robertson led the team in tackles (77), tackles for loss (8.5) and sacks (5.0). Added an interception, two breakups, a fumble forced and a fumble recovered.
- » He was the first freshman to lead the team in tackles since Jason Shivers in 2001 and the first freshman to lead the team in tackles for loss and sacks since Junior Onyeali in 2010.
- » Led all FBS freshmen (true or redshirt) with 35 defensive "stops" this season - tied for 13th among all Pac-12 defensive players.
- » Led Pac-12 freshmen (true or redshirt) with 25 total QB pressures this season - second most among all freshmen in a Power Five conference. It was the 12th-most for any player in the Pac-12, regardless of year and second-most among all linebackers in the Pac-12.
- » Played more snaps than any true freshman in the Pac-12 (749) and was one of just 7 true freshmen nationally to accomplish the feat (5th nationally)



DON'T BE CROSS

- » Freshman Aashari Crosswell led the team in interceptions with three (t-6th among FBS freshmen) while recording 121 yards in interception returns – the latter good for the ninth-most nationally and the most for a freshman in the country
- » Led the team with 9 pass breakups on the season – more than any Sun Devil recorded last season and tied for third among freshmen in the FBS this season
- » His 10 forced incompletions are tied for 10th among all Pac-12 secondary players.
- » One of just two Pac-12 true freshman to play at least 700 snaps (722), one of just 7 freshmen to do so nationally in a Power Five conference

NOT SO FRESH ANYMORE

- » Redshirt freshman Tyler Johnson had 18 QB pressures over the final six weeks of the season, the second-most in the Pac-12 Conference among outside linebackers and tied for 11th-most nationally in that time span.
- » Johnson four sacks over the final 6 weeks were the most among Pac-12 outside linebackers and tied for 10th most among FBS outside linebackers. He is tied for 15th among all Pac-12 linebackers and edge defenders with 23 quarterback pressures this season
- » Freshman Jermaine Lole had four pass breakups on the season despite being a lineman – tied for third overall on the team and tied for the fourth among Pac-12 freshmen this season.
- » Lole's 13 QB pressures are ninth among all freshmen (true or redshirt) in the Pac-12.

IN THE TRENCHES

- » ASU has now twice gone consecutive games without allowing a sack (Washington/Oregon State and USC/Utah) The last time ASU had consecutive games doing so even once in a season was 2005 (LSU and Northwestern).
- » The Devils now have 6 such games this year (UTSA, UW, OSU, USC, UTAH, ARIZ). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack.
- » ASU's 15 sacks allowed this season are 19th nationally. A year ago, ASU finished 124th in the nation with 41 sacks allowed and 119th in 2016 with 41 sacks allowed as well.
- » ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently tied for 19th in the FBS with 1.25 allowed per game.
- » Cohl Cabral was one of just 15 Power Five centers to not allow a sack this season.
- » He was the third-highest graded center in the Pac-12 as a run blocker (63.3).
- » Cabral had a positive run impact on 9.8 percent of plays this season, the 20th-best total among all FBS centers.
- » Quinn Bailey is for 20th among all offensive tackles in the FBS with just one sack allowed this season. His 12 total pressures allowed are 7th among all Pac-12 offensive tackles and tied for 36th among all FBS tackles nationally.
- » Bailey is the 34th-highest graded offensive tackle as a pass blocker this season, according to Pro Football Focus (84.2)
- » Following the non-conference slate, ASU's run game efficiency from PFF was ranked 85th nationally (8th in Pac-12) with a play success rate of 32.9. During the Pac-12 slate, ASU is ranked 42nd nationally (4th in Pac-12) with a success rate of 36.3

GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 12 of its last 17 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard with 4 and Eno Benjamin with 8).
- » Benjamin's 8 100+ yard performances this season put him in rare company. He is now one of just five Sun Devils have had 7 or more in a season and tied for the school record with Freddie Williams and Art Malone (8). Woody Green (7, twice) and Demario Richard (7) are the only others to reach the 7-game milestone
- » ASU has 25 rushing TDs this year as reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fifth time in the last seven seasons. Those five times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards seven times in the last eight seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.

- » ASU currently has the 15th-highest graded rushing attack of 2018, according to Pro Football Focus.

KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 133 straight games. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 75 of those games (56.4 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won as least seven games in five of the last seven seasons.
- » ASU is bowl eligible for the 8th time in the last 9 seasons.

DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry had a reception in all 37 games of his career at Arizona State - tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players and joins school record holder D.J. Foster (53 straight games with a catch) as the only other Sun Devil to log a reception in every game of their career.
- » Harry is third in program history with 213 career receptions and third in program history with 2,889 career receiving yards. That tally was within 50 yards of second in program history, despite the fact that seven of ASU's 10 all-time leading receivers did so in four seasons while Harry still has at least two games left in his junior campaign.
- » At 5.76 receptions per game in his career, Harry is third among the NCAA's active career leaders in the category. His 78.7 career receiving yards per game are fifth among all active players.
- » His 209 career receptions are 7th among all active players but first among players that are not seniors. All six players ahead of him in the category are seniors. Similarly, Harry's 22 career touchdown receptions are 10th among active players but third among players that are not seniors.
- » With 22 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 5th in ASU school history and needs just two more to move into fourth.

REAL DEAL N'KEAL

- » Harry posted an 84.0 overall grade from Pro Football Focus, among the Top-15 highest graded wide receivers nationally and the 7th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 – regardless of position. The junior ranked in the Top-30 nationally in receiving touchdowns (9/21st), receiving yards (1,088/15th), receiving yards per game (90.7/18th) and receptions per game (6.1/24th) following the regulat season.
- » Harry had a 119.0 Pro Football Focus QB rating when targeted this season, good for 13th nationally among receivers that logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.
- » He forced 17 missed tackles this season, which was good for 9th-most among Power Five receivers.
- » Harry's ability to make plays pivotal situations has been a staple of his career. In 2018, he was 5th among all FBS receivers in receiving yards in the fourth quarter of games (325) and tied for 6th with four fourth quarter touchdown receptions. His 12 first down grabs in the fourth quarter of games were 8th nationally.
- » That ability kept ASU in striking distance of games as well as Harry was 10th in the nation with 318 receiving yards when the Sun Devils were trailing by a touchdown or less with 16 first-down grabs (third nationally).
- » The junior out of Chandler, Ariz., demonstrated his versatility throughout the season, scoring touchdowns receiving, rushing and on punt return this season and being responsible for numerous game-changing plays all across the football field. Harry averaged 104.2 all-purpose yards per game (top-10 in the Pac-12 and Top-75 nationally) and has played 753 snaps this season - 9th-most among all Power Five receivers - and at times handled direct snap-taking duties in the team's Sparky formation.

HERM EDWARDS

**HEAD COACH
7-5 (1ST SEASON)**



Former NFL head coach and ESPN Analyst Herm Edwards was named the 24th head coach of Sun Devil Football, as announced by Arizona State University and Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson on December 3, 2017.

Edwards arrives in Tempe with a football legacy that has impacted thousands, whether as a player, coach, analyst, motivational speaker and author, or community advocate and philanthropist.

At ASU, Edwards has taken proactive approach to developing coordinators and assistant coaches, drawing on his nearly three decades of NFL experience in a variety of capacities and wide range of leadership positions within both the sport of football and in other endeavors. That experience will also be utilized in an effort to develop players to prepare for the next stage of their careers after college.

Edwards was tabbed by Anderson as someone who will be a “central leader with a collaborative staff around him that will elevate the performance of players and coaches on the field, in the classroom and in our community. Equally important, (Edwards) will be a dynamic and tireless recruiter.”

Edwards spent eight years as an NFL head coach with the New York Jets (2001-05) and Kansas City Chiefs (2006-08). He led his teams to four playoff appearances, including 2004 when his Jets squad finished with a 10-6 regular season record and advanced to the AFC Divisional Playoffs. Edwards, who also guided the Chiefs to a Wild Card berth in 2006, is one of only four NFL coaches to lead two different teams to the playoffs in his first season as head coach with those teams.

Among the numerous players that Edwards coached in his career include Pro Football Hall of Famers Curtis Martin, Warren Sapp and Derrick Brooks and numerous All-Pro players such as Larry Johnson, Ronde Barber, John Lynch, Jared Allen, Kevin Mawae, Santana Moss, Tony Gonzalez, Tamba Hali, Derrick Johnson in addition to players like Donnie Abraham, Chad

Pennington and Brandon Carr.

Edwards most recently served as a coach for the past six years at the Under Armour All-American game, which features the top high school football recruits in the country, and as an NFL analyst for ESPN since 2009 where he appeared primarily on NFL Live, SportsCenter, ESPN Radio, and the network’s coverage of Super Bowl week. He spent 10 seasons in the NFL as a cornerback between the Philadelphia Eagles, Atlanta Falcons and Los Angeles Rams, followed by another 18 years as a scout, position coach, assistant and head coach between the Kansas City Chiefs, Tampa Bay Buccaneers and New York Jets. He made the playoffs four times as an NFL head coach.

Edwards played cornerback for the University of California in 1972 and 1974 before he ended his collegiate career at San Diego State in 1975. An undrafted free agent who went on to have a 10-year NFL career, he never missed a game in his nine seasons with the Philadelphia Eagles from 1977 to 1985 and started all 16 games in seven of his nine seasons with the team. Over the course of his nine years in Philadelphia, Edwards totaled 38 interceptions -- with seven during his sophomore NFL season -- which is just one short of the franchise record. He earned second-team All-NFC honors in 1980 to help lead the Eagles to Super Bowl XV.

It is said the victory formation, which was implemented by the Eagles, came in part to a play made by Edwards late in the 1978 season. Trailing 17-12 to the New York Giants with seconds remaining, Giants’ quarterback Joe Pisarcik fumbled the handoff and Edwards picked it up for the scoop and score and the 19-17 victory. The play became known in Philadelphia as “The Miracle at the Meadowlands”.

Edwards had 33 career interceptions, plus five more picks in playoff games.

Edwards retired from the NFL following the 1986 season, and as the first graduate of the league’s Minority Coaching Fellowship, he immediately went into coaching as a defensive assistant at San Jose State University from 1987 to 1989.



In 1990, Edwards transitioned back into the NFL as a scout and defensive backs coach with the Chiefs from 1990 to 1995 under legendary head coach Marty Schottenheimer. He then served under Tony Dungy with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers from 1996-2000 before being hired as the head coach for the New York Jets in January 2001.

Over the course of five seasons Edwards led the Jets to three playoff berths, five postseason contests and a pair of 10-win seasons. His 35 victories with the team from 2001-04 is tied with Joe Walton (1983-86) for the most regular season wins by a coach in his first four years with the team.

He started his second tour with the Kansas City Chiefs in 2006 and became the first coach in franchise history to lead the team to the playoffs in his initial season.

Edwards joined ESPN in March 2009 as an NFL studio analyst. He appeared primarily on NFL Live and SportsCenter, while also contributing to ESPN Radio and the company's annual Super Bowl coverage. He also worked local broadcasts of Eagles preseason games in 2009.

Among Edwards' other responsibilities, he called weekly SEC prime time college football games alongside Clay Matvick on ESPNU in 2010, and he worked alongside Rece Davis and Chris Spielman in August 2009 to call the Dike-New Hartford at Aplington-Parkersburg (Iowa) high school football game on ESPN. The game marked the emotional return to the field for Aplington-Parkersburg, which lost its legendary football coach Ed Thomas in a tragic school shooting two months earlier. Edwards also participated in the 2011 SportsCenter series "Back to School," where he returned to his hometown of Monterey, Calif., to coach his former high school team, the Monterey H.S. Toreadores.

Before officially joining ESPN, Edwards worked a brief stint in Bristol during the 2008 NFL offseason as a guest analyst.

A native of Seaside, Calif., Edwards graduated from Monterey High School, attended the University of California, Berkeley for two years, with a stint at Monterey Peninsula College, before graduating from San Diego State University with a degree in Criminal Justice. Herm was inducted into the California Community College Sports Hall of Fame in 2017.

He was appointed a charter member of the Fritz Pollard Alliance, named a member of the Positive Coaching Alliance's National Advisory Committee in 2003 and sits on the Santa Catalina School Board of

Trustees. Edwards also remains active in numerous charitable and philanthropic endeavors, including the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF) along with his wife, Lia, who lives with Type I diabetes. He also created the Herman L. Edwards Family Youth Foundation in 1985 with the goal of making a direct impact on the lives of children on the Monterey Peninsula.

Edwards has been recognized by multiple organizations for his work in the community. He received the 2012 Walter Camp Foundation Man of the Year Award for his longtime contributions to the game of football; he was honored with Team ESPN's Commentator of the Year Award in 2013; and in 2015 he received the prestigious Shell Legacy Award from the Shell Oil Company. Edwards was the recipient of the inaugural Voices Leadership Award in 2017. Voices is an organization that provides a wide range of support services for 9/11 families, responders and survivors.

Known for his dynamic motivational speaking, Edwards regularly addresses football players of all ages, as well as corporate groups. He spoke to incoming players at the NFL Players Association's Rookie Premier in 2011, and coached teams at both the Under Armour All-America High School Football game (Head Coach 2011-16) and has also coached the NFLPA Collegiate Bowl college all-star game.

Edwards was 5-1 in the Under Armour All-America game, where he worked with such players as Jameis Winston, Amari Cooper, Deshaun Watson, Leonard Fournette and Dalvin Cook.

Edwards co-authored the book *You Play to Win the Game – Leadership Lessons for Success On and Off the Field* with ESPN's Shelley Smith, and he was involved in longtime NFL referee Jim Tunney's book, *It's the Will, Not the Skill – Principles and Philosophies of Success as Seen Through the Eyes, Mind and Heart of Herm Edwards*.

A passionate golfer, Edwards appeared in Golf Channel's original series "The Haney Project" with professional instructor Hank Haney in December 2011. Edwards has also played a number of high-profile celebrity tournaments in the past, including the Pebble Beach National Pro-Am and the American Century Celebrity Golf Championship in Lake Tahoe, the latter of which he takes part in every year.

Edwards and his wife Lia are the proud parents of three children: Marcus, Gabrielle and Vivian.
