MEN'S HOOPS TAKES ON SANTA CLARA IN LAS VEGAS

Arizona State will face Santa Clara at Lee's Family Forum on Friday at 6 PM

Sun Devil Men's Basketball heads to familiar territory when they face off with Santa Clara on Friday at 6 PM MST.

Arizona State (1-0) returns to Las Vegas where they will take on the Santa Clara Broncos in a neutral site contest. The showdown is part of a doubleheader at Lee's Family Forum, with the nightcap featuring UCLA and New Mexico. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's team looks to build off an impressive defensive effort in the season opener, as the Sun Devils held Idaho State to just 25.4% shooting, the lowest by an opponent in the Hurley era.

THE MATCHUP

A neutral site matchup with plenty of intrigue as the Sun Devils take on one of the nation's best mid majors, Santa Clara, in their first test away from home. Santa Clara is led by former ASU Head Coach Herb Sendek, who will take on his former team for the first time. This is the first meeting between the two sides since 2004, with Arizona State holding a 5-2 advantage in the series. The contest will take place in Las Vegas, a location familiar to the Sun Devils. The program has had several significant wins under Bobby Hurley in Las Vegas.

LAST TIME OUT

Arizona State pulled out a hard fought 55-48 win over Idaho State to kick off the 2024-2025 regular season on Tuesday. Guard Joson Sanon and forward Jayden Quaintance made their highly-anticipated collegiate debut in front of the home crowd, becoming the first freshman duo to start the first game of the year since 2020.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

The Sun Devils held Idaho State to 48 points in tonight's home-opener, tied for third-lowest points scored by an opponent since 2000. Arizona State also held Idaho State to a 25.4 FG%, marking the lowest FG% by ISU since Montana held them to 24.6 FG% on Feb. 6, 2012. The Bengals finished with the lowest FG% by an ASU opponent since Oregon State (24.6%) on Feb. 11, 2010. It is the lowest an opponent has shot against a Bobby Hurley-coached ASU team. The 14.3% shooting from beyond the arc by the Bengals was the lowest percentage by a Sun Devil opponent since Grambling shot 7.7% from deep on Nov. 22, 2022.

BLOCK PARTY

Jayden Quaintance was credited with six blocks in his collegiate debut, the most in a single game by a Sun Devil since De'Quon Lake had seven against Pacific on December 22, 2017. ASU finished with nine blocks, more than they had in any game last year and the most since recording nine blocks in a road win over Oregon State back on Jan. 14, 2022.

SEASON OPENING NOTES

Arizona State moved to 8-2 in season openers against non-conference opponents in the Bobby Hurley era, having won eight of their last nine. Overall since 2000, the Maroon & Gold are 21-6 in season openers dating back to the 1998-99 season.

HOME OPENER NOTES

The Sun Devils have now won their past nine home openers under Bobby Hurley. They are averaging 79.3 points in home-opener games while giving up only 64.9. ASU is 11-1 in their last 12 home openers.

PHENOMENAL FRESHMAN

Head Coach Bobby Hurley put together a Top-10 recruiting class, the highest in program history. It was ranked No. 9 by 247 Sports and No. 8 by Rivals and features a five-star recruit (Jayden Quaintance) alongside two high four-star prospects (Joson Sanon, Amier Ali).

IMPACT TRANSFERS

A five-man transfer class immediately bolstered the Sun Devil Men's Basketball roster. It is one of the premier transfer classes in program history. BJ Freeman, Alston Mason, and Basheer Jihad join the fold after leading their teams in scoring a season ago. Brandon Gardner and Austin Nunez return to Arizona State after making strong connections with the connections in their previous recruitment process.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Arizona State freshman forward Jayden Quaintance enters the 2024-25 season as the youngest player in college basketball. He is over six months younger than the second-youngest on the list, which is Duke's Cooper Flagg. Sunday's matchup features three of the five youngest players in college basketball.

FAMILY TIES

The Sun Devil Men's Basketball roster features several connections through bloodline. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's son, Bobby Hurley, is a senior guard on the team. Senior guard Alston Mason's father, Alton Mason, played at Arizona State from 1998-2001. Senior guard Jordan Williams cousin is legendary Sun Devil guard James Harden.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 156 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark.

- The Big 12 is 15-1 after every team's first game, including a ranked win by UCF over No. 13 Texas A&M.

- The Big 12 is the first conference to have at least five teams in the preseason top 10 in the history of the AP Poll, which began releasing a preseason poll in 1961-62.

- Six Big 12 teams are in the preseason AP Poll, including No. 1 Kansas, No. 4 Houston, No. 5 Iowa State, No. 8 Baylor, No. 10 Arizona and No. 20 Cincinnati.

- The Big 12 has led all conferences in average NET ranking in four consecutive seasons and has been the top ranked Conference in NET/ RPI (prior to 2019) in nine of the past 11 seasons.

- The Big 12 has led the nation in non-conference winning percentage in each of the past three seasons. The Conference was 147-34 (.812) in regular season non-league games in 2023-24.
