#5 ASU (1-0) vs #3 Missouri (1-0)

Date: November 17
Time: 7:00 p.m. AZ
Location: Mullett Arena

The stars will be out Thursday night in Tempe when No. 5 ASU hosts No. 3 Missouri in the Sun Devils' home opener at Mullett Arena. There will be 10 All-Americans, including a national champion and two runners-up, in the building, making this one of the biggest duals of the season.

The marquee match will be at 149 lbs where ASU's 2x All-American No. 3 Kyle Parco is set to face Missouri's 3x All-American No. 8 Brock Mauller.

Fresh off an undefeated weekend, No. 19 Tony Negron will take the mat against '22 NCAA defending national champion and current No. 1 Keegan O'Toole at 165 lbs.

The heavyweight bout will see Colton Schultz, the 2022 NCAA heavyweight runner-up and current No. 1, take on Missouri's No. 7 Zach Elam.

At 197 there's the potential of seeing All-Americans Kordell Norfleet and Rocky Elam faceoff too.

Sun Devil Notables

Arizona State is currently ranked No. 4 according to FloWrestling and No. 5 according to InterMat. The program is looking to build on its back-to-back fourth place finishes at the NCAA National Championships.

McGee's 114 collegiate wins lead the Sun Devils' active roster. Brandon Courtney is right behind him with 93. This will be the sixth matchup between Arizona State and Missouri. ASU leads the series 3-2.

Arizona State started its season off 1-0 with a 25-16 victory over No. 21 Rutgers, claiming victories at 125, 133, 149, 165, 174, and 197. ASU then won seven titles the next day at the Journeymen Collegiate Classic. Richard Figueroa, Michael McGee, Jesse Vasquez, and Tony Negron all won Hammer Awards.

After transferring from Penn State, Tony Negron entered this season unranked. In his first match with Arizona State, Negron pinned Rutgers '22 All-American Connor O'Neill in 1:40 and went on to beat Penn's No. 19 Lucas Ravno by decision at the Journeyman Collegiate Classic. Negron is now ranked No. 19 in the nation by FloWrestling.

Richie Figueroa (125 lbs) claimed two ranked victories this weekend. The first came against Rutgers' No. 20 Dylan Shawver, and the second came in the Journeyman Collegiate Classic against Penn's No. 18 Ryan Miller.

The Sun Devils have seven All-Americans on the roster in Brandon Courtney (125 lbs, 3x), Michael McGee (133 lbs, 2x), Kyle Parco (149 lbs, 2x), Jacori Teemer (157 lbs, 3x), Anthony Montalvo (184), Kordell Norfleet (197) Colhton Schultz (HWT, 2x).

Courtney and Schultz are chasing NCAA individual titles after finishing as runners-up in their respective weight classes. Courtney earned silver in 2021, and Schultz earned silver in 2022.

This ASU squad has historically been successful in the first battles of the year. The Sun Devils claimed a 22-12 win over No. 17 Oklahoma last fall and had 13 titles across the first two tournaments. In fall 2021, ASU picked up a pair of dual victories over Little Rock (39-3) and No. 20 Oklahoma (20-12).

Zeke Jones (ASU)

3x Pac-12 Coach of the Year; part of the 1988 national championship team; directly responsible for 5 Pac-12 team titles, 32 individual conference champions, 25 All-Americans, and back-to-back NCAA team trophies.

Missouri Notables

Missouri is beginning the season ranked No. 3 in the country, according to FloWrestling. The Tigers placed ninth in last year's NCAA Championships and had two wrestlers finish with All-American honors.

Sophomore Keegan O'Toole is the 165 lb defending national champion, and currently sits at No. 1 on FloWrestling's rankings. O'Toole is 44-1 over his collegiate career, and wrapped up last season with a flawless 25-0 record.

Sophomore Rocky Elam was Missouri's second '22 All-American, finishing fourth place at 197 lbs. FloWrestling's No. 4 wrestler at 197 lbs, Elam is coming off two top-5 NCAA finishes, as he left the 2021 NCAA Championships with a 5th place tally, and his first All-American honors.

Redshirt Junior Brock Mauller (149 lbs) finished his true junior season with All-American honors and a fifth place finish at the '21 NCAA Championships. He took last season to wrestle unattached and competed for the United States at the U23 World Championships in Belgrade, Serbia, and is now back in Missouri's lineup as the No. 8 wrestler in the country.

Redshirt Sophomore No. 14 Noah Surtin was a '22 NCAA qualifier at 125 lbs and placed seventh at the '22 Big-12 Championships. He started last season off 7-1, beating three ranked opponents in four matches.

A 3x NCAA qualifier, Redshirt Senior Allan Hart (141 lbs) is coming off a year that found him runner-up at the Big-12 Championships with a 16-7 season record. Hart is currently ranked No. 6 by FloWrestling.

A MAC champion and 4x NCAA qualifier, No. 15 Jarrett Jacques (157 lbs) is entering his senior season after an 18-14 junior season that saw him place fifth at the Big-12 Championships.

'22 Big-12 Championships runner-up (174 lbs), Redshirt Junior Peyton Mocco is a 3x NCAA qualifier and ranked No. 9 heading into this matchup.

Redshirt Junior Zach Elam, brother to Rocky, is FloWrestling's No. 7 heavyweight in the nation. Zach is a 3x NCAA qualifier, and finished last season with an 18-7 record, finishing third at the Big-12 Championships.

Sun Devil Coaching Staff

Head Coach: Zeke Jones, Year 9

Three-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year and 1988 Sun Devil national champion Zeke Jones was hired to lead his alma mater in April 2014 and immediately turned the program into a national powerhouse while continuing the Sun Devils' tradition of success in the conference. Jones is directly responsible for bringing five Pac-12 Championships to Tempe since his arrival - bringing ASU's total conference title count to 23. He developed a two-time national champion in Zahid Valencia, a 125 national runner-up in Brandon Courtney (2021), and in 2022 led heavyweight Cohlton Schultz to national runner-up honors too. ASU has celebrated 25 All-America honors since Jones' hiring. 2022 marked the second-consecutive season ASU finished fourth at the NCAA Championships - that's the first time the Sun Devils have earned back-to-back team trophies since the 1989 and 1990 seasons when ASU earned back-to-back silver medals. Jones is directly responsible for 32 individual Pac-12 titles, four NCAA top-10 finishes, four Pac-12 Most Outstanding Wrestlers, five Pac-12 Wrestlers of the Year, and three Pac-12 Freshmen/Newcomers of the year.



Jones took the helm with a resume that features accomplishments at the collegiate and international level. The Ann Arbor, Michigan, native was a three-time All-American, three-time Pac-10 champion, and national runner-up at 118 lbs with the Sun Devils from 1987-1990 before going on to earn the 1991 52kg World Champion title. He followed his world title with a silver medal-finish (52kg freestyle) while representing the U.S at Barcelona 1992. He finished his professional career with four World-Cup titles before shifting over to coaching, guiding U.S. Olympians at the 1996, 2000, 2004 and 2012 Games. His accomplishments earned him an induction into the Arizona State Athletics Hall of Fame in 2004.

The 2020-21 season was one for the record books, despite the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. No. 6 ASU earned five titles at the conference championships to post 138 total points en route to earning its 20th title in the Pac-10/12 era. Brandon Courtney (125), Jacori Teemer (157), Anthony Valencia (165), Kordell Norfleet (197) and Cohlton Schultz (HWT) brought home gold, and nine total trophies were earned in Corvallis, Oregon. Jones' athletes went on to collect five All-America nods at the NCAA Championships, with No. 3 Courtney taking silver in 125. The year was capped off with Cohlton Schultz earning a spot on Team USA with his second-place finish at the Olympic Trials, Anthony Valencia earning CoSIDA Academic All-America status, and Cade Belshay earning a Pac-12 Postgraduate Scholarship.

Jones earned his third Pac-12 Coach of the Year honor in four years in 2020 after leading the Sun Devils to their highest conference tournament point total (141.5) since 1993 while winning the program's 19th Pac-10/12 title. He became the first ASU wrestling head coach to win the conference award three times since Thom Ortiz did so in 2003, 2005 and 2006.

As an Olympic head coach, Jones' athletes earned two gold medals and one bronze at the London Games in 2012. His athletes in the 2004 Athens Games, where he was the freestyle coach, earned a gold and two silvers.

Lee Pritts, Assistant Coach

Year: 10

Lee Pritts was named assistant coach on September 4, 2012. Pritts, considered one of the top recruiters in the country, previously worked at North Carolina State, Old Dominion, and Missouri. He was a two-time team captain and made three appearances in the NCAA Championships, earning All-America honors in 1996 for Eastern Michigan and qualified for the 2000 Olympic trials. In 2017 and 2018, he was a coach for USA Wrestling at the Cadet Freestyle World Championships. Pritts mainly works with the lighter weights and also helps oversee the academics of Sun Devil Wrestling student-athletes.



Frank Molinaro, Assistant Coach

Year: 3

Frank Molinaro was named assistant coach on April 9, 2020. Molinaro was training to prepare himself for Team USA's roster for the Olympics before the Olympic Committee announced postponement of the games to 2021. Previously he won the 2016 Pan American games (70kg) and placed second at the 2017 World Team Trials. Molinaro comes to ASU after previously working as an assistant coach with Virginia Tech in 2017-2018. Before coaching at Virginia Tech, Molinaro was also an assistant coach with Rutgers and Penn State, where he helped win the National Championship in 2016. During Molinaro's collegiate career he was named NCAA champion with Penn State, a four-time NCAA All-American, and a two-time Big Ten champion. Molinaro primarily works with the middle weights and focuses heavily on the mental health and readiness of the team.



Eric Thompson, Assistant Coach

Year: 2

Thompson joined the Sun Devil Wrestling staff in August 2021 as a volunteer assistant coach. Thompson coached at the Nittany Lion Wrestling Club prior to coming to Tempe where he trained Kyle Snyder and David Taylor, five world-team members, and four Olympians. Before joining the coaching staff, Thompson wrestled at NLWC, where he trained to make the 2016 Olympic Team. He took fifth place in the 2016 Olympic trials. During his collegiate career at Grand View University, Thompson was a three-time NAIA National Champion at 285 pounds and was named NAIA Wrestler of the Year in 2012. Other stops for Thompson include a three-year stint with M2 Training Center where he worked with over 100 athletes and a one-year position with Lock Haven University as an assistant coach. Thompson focuses on the upper weights.
