ASU TAKES ON KSU IN MEN'S BASKETBALL MATCHUP Sun Devil Men's Basketball hosts Kansas State on Tuesday at 8 PM MST

Sun Devil Men's Basketball hosts their second straight home game when Kansas State comes to Desert Financial Arena for a Tuesday night contest. Arizona State (12-9, 3-7) is coming off playing in an incredible home atmosphere, as 13,544 fans packed DFA for the rivalry showdown with Arizona. Sun Devil fans have another opportunity to watch the Maroon and Gold take on a Wildcat foe, with this one coming from Manhattan. This represents a critical contest for Head Coach Bobby Hurley's team in the crowded and competitive Big 12 Conference standings.

THE MATCHUP

One of the five teams that Arizona State plays twice is Kansas State. The first of the two matchups will take place in Tempe, with the Wildcats making their first trip to Tempe since 1980. ASU leads the all-time series 5-4, with the last meeting going in favor of the Sun Devils in a thrilling 92-90 win at the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational. This is the first of

two meetings between the two sides, with Arizona State returning the trip to Manhattan a few weeks later.

HOW TO FOLLOW

Arizona State returns to ESPN+ on Tuesday, February 4 at 8 PM MST when they host Kansas State. Pete Sousa (playby-play) and Scott Williams (analyst) are on the call. Make sure to listen to Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM (KMVP).

Freshman forward Jayden Quaintance has proven to be one of the nation's most unique and versatile athletes. He is currently the ONLY PLAYER IN THE NATION averaging at least 9.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 2.9 blocks. He produces at that high of a level while playing 31.4 minutes per game. Quaintance is averaging exactly 10.1 points, 8.5 rebounds, and 2.95 blocks with room to spare on two of the three qualifiers.

BUYING "STOCKS"

Quaintance has combined for 80 'stocks' (59 blocks + 21 steals) in 20 games so far this season. He is one of only two players in the nation (only high major conference player) to boast these numbers (55+ blocks and 20+ steals) despite missing a game. The next closest Power 4 + Big East player is Creighton senior center Ryan Kalkbrenner with 72 stocks (58 blocks + 14 steals). For comparison, National Defensive Player of the Year candidate Johni Broome from Auburn has 66 stocks in 19 games (52 blocks + 14 steals).

BLOCK PARTY

Freshman Jayden Quaintance has recorded 59 blocks thus far in the 2024-2025 season and averages the fourth-most blocks per game (3.0) of any player in the nation. He broke the program freshman record and did so in only 18 games. He has two or more blocks in 17 of 20 games this year, including eight 4+ block performances.

WE WILL BLOCK YOU

Arizona State is second in the Big 12 and 22nd nationally averaging 5.1 blocks per game. Freshman Jayden Quaintance is a big reason why, contributing a league-best 3.0. Basheer Jihad, Shawn Phillips Jr., and BJ Freeman each have nine or more blocks this season.

GETTING ACQUAINTED

Jayden Quaintance continues to show improvement throughout the season. Take a closer look at a comparison between his first four and last 16 games.

Last 16 Games: 11.3 pts, 9.3 reb, 55..5% FG First 4 Games: 5.5 pts, 5.0 reb, 38.9% FG

ACE WOLF

Senior guard Adam Miller has been hot offensively throughout his last four games, averaging 14.3 points while shooting 50%

(20-of-40) from the field and 54% from three (12-of-22).

80-POINT MARK

The Sun Devils have scored 80 points or more nine times through 21 games this season after doing it only six times in 32 games last year. ASU is 7-2 when reaching the 80-point mark.

COMFORTABLE WHEN ITS CLOSE

Sun Devils is 20-10 in two-possession games over the past three seasons. Arizona State is 62-44 (58.5%) in close games in the Bobby Hurley era and 4-2 this season. ASU is 44-23 (.656) in two-possession games in the past six seasons (since 2019-20). The 44 wins are tied for the most among power five teams.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Arizona State boasts one of the nation's best three-point defenses. They are holding opponents to just 30% from distance this year, the 36th-best total in the country. In the second half of games, the Sun Devils are holding foes to a putrid 29.2% from behind the arc. The metrics look favorably upon ASU's defense as well. KenPom has the Maroon & Gold with the 39th-best defensive rating despite playing the 8th-toughest offensive schedule according to KenPom.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 167 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark. He is now the second-winningest coach in program history.

- So far in 2024-25, Arizona State has wins over Santa Clara, Grand Canyon, New Mexico, Saint Mary's, UMass, West Virginia, and Colorado away from home
- ASU has had the 5th toughest Strength of Schedule according to ESPN with an average NET opponent ranking of 4
- The Sun Devils will eventually play six teams in the AP Top-25 at some point during the 2024-25 campaign
- Big 12 play features single contests against No. 5 Houston, No. 8 Iowa State, No. 16 Kansas, and two against No. 13 Texas Tech and No. 20 Arizona
- Both Florida and Gonzaga were in the Top-10 when Arizona State faced them in significant non-conference challenges away from home.

One of the most recognizable names in college basketball history became the 14th men's head coach of the Sun Devil Men's Basketball program, as Arizona State named 1992 NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player Bobby Hurley as the head coach on April 9, 2015. What has followed is aggressive scheduling, lots of fast-paced hoops, playing hard, several big-time wins both home and away and back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for Arizona State for the first time since Byron Scott, Fat Lever and Alton Lister were starring in Tempe (1980-81 to be exact).

In his ten seasons as head coach, Sun Devil Men's Basketball has matched its highest ranking in school history (third in the Associated Press Poll in December of 2017), notched its best two average attendances in history (10,603 in 2017-18 is the ASU record), reached the NCAA Tournament three times, notched its best two non-conference wins in school history (vs. No. 1 Kansas on Dec. 22, 2018 and at No. 2 Kansas on Dec. 10, 2017) and defeated two eventual 2018 No. 1 seeds in a span of a few weeks (Kansas and Xavier).

Following a three-year drought without a First or Second Team Pac-12 All-Conference selection, ASU had at least one in six straight seasons under Hurley (2018-23) and Frankie Collins received Honorable Mention distinction in 2024. Hurley has

coached two Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year winners in addition to the 2019 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year (Lu Dort). Three Sun Devils have been selected to the Pac-12 All-Tournament team and three received All-Defensive Team distinction during Hurley's tenure.

A signature of Hurley's teams have been their successs in close games and ability to erase deficits. Arizona State is 40-20 (.666) in close games (two possesions or less) over the past five seasons. The 40 wins are a Top-10 total in the nation during that span. To take it a step further, ASU is 25-17 in two point or less games under Bobby Hurley. Arizona State has come back to win a game when trailing at halftime 44 times during the Bobby Hurley era. The 44 comeback wins place Arizona State in the Top-15 nationally since 2015-16.
