UP NEXT

The Sun Devil women's basketball team (3-2) begins what figures to be its most challenging stretch of the season when it travels to Nashville, Tenn., for the Coast 2 Coast Music City Classic where it will face No. 14 and unbeaten Kentucky (5-0) on Tuesday (3:30 p.m. CST/2:30 p.m. MST) and South Dakota on Wednesday (11 a.m. CST/10 a.m. MST).

For the Sun Devils, the game vs. Kentucky will be the first of seven consecutive in which it will be on the road for either a neutral site contest (three games) or as the away team in a true road game (four games). Eight days after Wednesday's game, the Sun Devils will be in Baltimore to take on Coppin State (Dec. 5) followed by a third neutral site game vs. Maryland Eastern Shore in the Coaches vs Racism Classic in Washington D.C. (Dec. 7).

After visits to Music City, Baltimore, Md., and the nation's capital, ASU will take an extended break for final exams before once again leaving the state of Arizona for road games at UC Davis (Dec. 15), at San Francisco (Dec. 17) and at Utah (Dec. 21). The contest at Utah will be ASU's first ever Big 12 Conference game.

The Sun Devils return to play in Tempe on Dec. 30 when they host Penn at Mullett Arena, Sun Devil Women's Basketball's inaugural appearance in SDA's newest on-campus Multi-Purpose Arena. Two days later, ASU will take on Texas Tech in its first ever home game as a member of the Big 12 Conference.

ASU is coming off consecutive wins over SMU (80-73 on Nov. 16) and former Pac-12 foe Oregon State (79-60 on Nov. 17) in the annual Briann January Classic.

STATE OF PLAY

The Sun Devils (3-2), who have eight new players on this season's roster, have experienced the ups and downs that can sometimes go with combining the talents of several outstanding players in the early stages of the season.

ASU opened the 2024-25 campaign with a 74-66 win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Tyi Skinner, who missed the entire 2023-24 season due to injury, scored a career-high 30 points to go with a team-high five assists. Jalyn Brown just missed scoring in double figures with 9 points to go with 6 boards. Two of the newest members of the team – local product Kennedy Basham (8 points, game-high 10 rebounds, 4 blocks) and Nevaeh Parkinson (8 points) - combined for 16 points.

Despite scoring 96 points – the most scored by ASU during head coach Natasha Adair's time at ASU - the Sun Devils were edged in a 100-96 decision to Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Five players scored in double figure against the Red Wolves: Brown (24 points), Parkinson (18 points), Skinner (16 points), Basham (14 points) and Kennedy Fauntleroy (13 points).

The Sun Devils played three games in four days between Nov. 14-17. The stretch started with a 70-59 loss against Grand Canyon in the Hall of Fame Series played at Footprint Center in downtown Phoenix. ASU led by as many as 12 in the first half and went to the locker room with a nine-point advantage, 42-33. Unfortunately for ASU, it experienced a 180-degree turnaround on both ends of the floor as it was outscored 37-17 over the final 20 minutes.

The Sun Devils bounced back with consecutive wins over SMU (80-73 on Nov. 16) and former Pac-12 foe Oregon State (79-60 on Nov. 17). Against SMU, Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) both came through with marquee performances as the duo combined for 51 points. In its win over Oregon State the following day, ASU recorded opponent season lows for points (60), field goals (19), 3-point field goals (3) and 3-point field goal percentage (13.4) and had season highs in shot blocks (eight), turnovers forced (19) and points scored off turnovers (26) in what added up to ASU's largest margin of victory this season. Skinner scored 20 or more points for the third time this season (21 points/8-11 FGs, 4-4 FTs), Brown had 12 points (5-8 FGs) and Basham and Jazion Jackson had identical double-doubles (10 points, 10 rebounds) in the win.

DYNAMIC DUO DEBUT

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were dealt a serious blow when it was announced a month before the start of the season that superstar guard Tyi Skinner would miss the entire season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who played her first two seasons at Delaware, joined Natasha Adair in Tempe after Adair was named ASU's head coach. In 2022-23, Skinner (2023 All-Pac-12 honorable mention) scored 20 or more points 15 times, including a career-high 29 points twice. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner averaged 19.3 ppg, the most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89 season. She concluded her first campaign in the Maroon and Gold among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), FTss made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG percentage (34.7/6th) and FT percentage (78.1/8th).

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were left pondering, 'what might have been,' had Skinner been able to share the court with Louisville transfer Jalyn Brown. Much like Skinner did in 2022-23, Brown would emerge as one of



the top performers in the Pac-12. In league games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56). She scored in double figures 26 times (12 20-point games) including a pair of outings in which she had the two highest-scoring games by a Sun Devil since 2000: 35 vs. Colorado (Jan. 7, 2024) and 34 points at Washington (Jan. 21).

Brown, who earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, went on to lead the team in scoring (17.3 ppg) and 3-pointers per game (1.4), was 2nd in FT pct. (76.9), 3-pointers (1.3 per game), minutes (35.54 mpg) and FTs made (103) and attempted (134), 3rd in assists (1.6 apg), tied for 3rd in steals (0.9 spg) and 4th in O-rebounds (1.1 rpg).

With Skinner recovered from her injury, Adair is excited to see what the Sun Devils are capable of with both Skinner and Brown on the court.

"It's poetry in motion; those two have known each other even prior to coming here from the Washington, DC area so they know each other's game, and more importantly it's about every other piece in addition to them," Adair said. I'm excited for our fans to see our size inside, it's going be hard to guard (us because) who are you going to sag off on and who are you going to double?

"Watching us work on that every day you can see it coming together. I'm excited about every piece because as much as they are talented there are so many other players and parts. I want to know how opponents are going to stop us."

In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Skinner scored a career-high 30 points – the 17th time she scored 20 or more points in a Sun Devil uniform – in ASU's 74-66 win over Jacksonville State on Nov. 4. Brown led ASU in scoring (24 points) in vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Combined with Skinner's 16 points, the duo combines for 40 points in the game. Skinner had a team-high 15 points in ASU's contest vs. Grand Canyon (Nov. 14).

In ASU's 80-73 win over SMU (Nov. 16), Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) both came combined for 51 points. In addition to their high point totals, both Skinner (8-16 FGs, 5-10 3FGs) and Brown (10-18 FGs, 3-7 3FGs) were efficient with their opportunities as they teamed up to shoot 53 percent (18-34 FGs) from the field, including 47 percent (8-17) from long range. Brown also led the team with five assists.

DEVILS BRINGING THE 'D'

Although it is the first month of the season, ASU has already proven an ability to adjust and improve. After giving up an average of 83.0 points in its first two games, ASU has only allowed 67.7 points in its last three games.

But for an atypical offensive performance in the final 20 minutes against Grand Canyon – scored 17 points in the second half after accounting for 42 in the first half – the Sun Devils could easily be 4-1 and riding a three-game winning streak coming into Tuesday's game.

NOTES ON ASU'S FIRST SEASON IN THE BIG 12

Big 12 Transfers: Three Sun Devil newcomers were on a Big 12 campus in the past year. Heavenly Greer played the past two years at Kansas State, Dallas native Jazion Jackson was at Texas Tech last year and Kennedy Fauntleroy was at Oklahoma State last year after earning 2022-23 Big East Freshman of the Year at Georgetown.

The Big 12 format: Teams will play three opponents home and away while facing six teams only at home and six opponents only on the road for a total of 18 Conference games. Opponents were selected based on a combination of geography, historical results and a poll of the coaches to best balance the schedule in terms of travel and competitiveness.

ASU's Big 12 opponent breakdown: Home: Baylor (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Cincinnati (2024 WNIT Team), Iowa State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), TCU (2024 WBIT Team), Texas Tech, West Virginia (2024 NCAA Tournament Team). Away: Central Florida, Colorado (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Houston, Kansas (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Kansas State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Oklahoma State. Home and Away: Arizona (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), BYU (2024 WBIT Team), Utah (2024 NCAA Tournament Team)

When it starts/ends: League play begins Saturday, Dec. 21 with six games and concludes Sunday, March 2. The regular season will be followed by the 2025 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship, which will take place in Kansas City's T-Mobile Center for the second consecutive season.

About the league: The current league members combined to go 8-0 in their first game of the 2024 NCAA Tournament while 15 of the 16 teams finished the 2023-24 season in the top 101 of the NET rankings. Four Big 12 teams are ranked in the top 16 of ESPN's Women's Basketball Way-Too-Early Top 25, tied for the most of any league.



HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR



- •On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- •Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- •In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- •In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils

overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points).

- ASU was once again hampered by injuries in 2023-24 as it lost leading scorer Tyi Skinner before the season started. Despite the injury issues, the Sun Devils still increased their overall win total and conference win total from the season before. Individually, Jalyn Brown flourished in her first season as a Sun Devil. The transfer from Louisville earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention recognition from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 notice from media who covered the league. In conference games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56).
- •In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- •Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All- Conference honors.
- •In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- •Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished 2016-17 with 17 wins, the most for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- •In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- •While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All- Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- •Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the

program to consecutive postseason appearances.

- •In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.
- •In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.
- •While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.
- •Adair previously spent 14 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with eight years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor five WNBA draft picks and several players who went on to play professionally overseas.
- A founding member of the Black Coaches United, Adair has been recognized by the organization, as well as Advancement of Blacks in Sports (ABIS), as one of the top women's basketball coaches in the country. Adair prides herself on being known as a game-changer as it



relates to social justice and creating a safe space for athletes to find and use their voice; where she was a guest on ESPNW's "Around the Rim" with LaChina Robinson and Delaware's UD Winning Women in Athletics: Trailblazers and Changemakers Webinar Series.

- •Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990- 92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994.
- •Coach Adair has two children, a son Aaron M. Adair (27), graduated magna cum laude from Johnson C. Smith University. A four-year member of the university's President's Council for his academic achievement, he also earned four letters playing for the men's basketball team. Daughter Allyssa M. Adair (19) is a sophomore at Texas State University and a middle blocker on the volleyball team.


