THE GAME - The #23 Sun Devil Football program enters the second weekend of the 2021 season this Saturday, Sept. 11 against the UNLV Rebels at Sun Devil Stadium in Tempe, Ariz. The game is slated for a 7:30 p.m. AZT kickoff on ESPN2 (Beth Mowins, Kirk Morrison, Dawn Davenport on the call) and will be carried over the airwaves on Arizona Sports 620 AM (Tim Healey, Jeff Van Raaphorst, Jordan Simone).

THE REBELS - Despite the relatively close proximity between the two schools, this will be just the second meeting in history between Arizona State and UNLV. The Rebels won the lone contest, 23-20, back in 2008. UNLV dropped its season opener to Eastern Washington in double overtime, 35-33.

KICKING OFF

- » ASU's secondary has combined for 127 career starts, a total that is second in the nation behind only Indiana. The group is led by Chase Lucas' 40 career starts, who needs nine starts this season to break the Sun Devil school record currently held by Dexter Davis (47).
- ASU has 19 rushing touchdowns in that span, which is tied for the second-most by any FBS program over a three-game stretch since at least 1996 (Nebraska, 22 in 1997).
- » ASU has scored 157 points over this three-game stretch since a streak of three straight 50-plus games and 162 points in 2013 (54 vs. Colorado, 53 vs. #20 Washington and 55 at Washington State).
- » ASU has forced 38 turnovers in its last 12 games dating back to 2019, good for the most in the nation over a 12-game span. In fact, the next closest team (lowa) has just 29 in that span. ASU has multiple takeaways in 10 of those (and three or more in six of them).
- » ASU has 38 takeaways since October 2019, and only Clemson (47), Baylor (45), Alabama (42) and Cincinatti (42) have more in that span. However, ASU's takeaways have come in just 13 total games, compared to 23, 20, 22 and 21, respectively by the previously mentioned teams.
- » ASU's offensive line has allowed just 214 combined quarterback pressures by opponents since 2019 - the sixth-fewest among Power Five programs.
- » Darien Butler became the first Sun Devil linebacker with two interceptions in a game since Carlos Mendoza in 2012.
- Southern Utah only managed 78 yards rushing, the seventh opponent not to reach the century mark on the ground in the Edwards' era.

The Sun Devils allowed just 25.5 points per game in 2018, good for 53rd nationally. These totals are notable as ASU was 103rd nationally at 32.8 points per game allowed in 2017 and had finished 99th or worse in three consecutive seasons prior.

Arizona State has played in 11 total games decided by four points or less in the Herm Edwards era (since 2018), which is tied for fourth in the FBS in that time behind Kansas State (13), Iowa State (12) and North Carolina (12). ASU has seven wins in games decided by four points or less (7-4 record), tied for second behind Nevada (8) for the most wins by four points or fewer since 2018. The Sun Devils have played in 19 games decided by a touchdown or less since 2018, going 9-10 in that time. The 19 games are third behind Texas (21) and North Carolina (20) for the most in the country in that span.

ASU has allowed just seven plays over 50 yards to opponents since the 2018 season over 30 games. The .23 50+ yard plays per game allowed are second-fewest in the FBS in that time behind only Washington (.09 percent on 3 plays over 32 games). ASU ranked in the bottom 10 nationally in 50+ yards played allowed each year from 2014-17. ASU is one of just seven teams in the country to rank in the Top-35 in fewest plays over 30 yards allowed in EACH of the last three seasons (Cal, Washington, Utah, Iowa, Michigar State, Northwestern). ASU has allowed just 43 in that time (1.4 per game/31 games)).

Jayden Daniels has committed just five turnovers on 657 plays in his career, the fewest among FBS quarterbacks since 2019 (0.8 percent of plays). Daniels is one of just seven FBS quarterbacks since 2019 to not throw an interception on third down (min. 50 attempts). Since 2019, Daniels is fifth among FBS quarterbacks in yards per attempt on third down at 9.3 (1,000 yards on 107 attempts). Among Power Five quarterbacks with at least 100 third-down attempts since 2019, Daniels is 13th with an NFL quarterback rating of 101.8.

DANNNGGGGG DANIELS

- Entering this season, Jayden Daniels had thrown for 877 passing yards in the fourth quarter of games in his career, 14th among Power Five quarterbacks since 2019.
- His nine fourth quarter passing touchdowns entering the year were 11th among Power Five QBs since 2019. His fourth quarter NFL passer rating is 111.4 in the fourth quarter, ninth among Power Five QBs since 2019.
- » He leads the nation since 2019 in yards per pass completion with 11+ yards to go at 18.7 ypc (765 yards on 41 completions). His NFL passer rating with over 11+ yards to go since 2019 is 130.5, second in the nation behind Texas Tech's Tyler Shough (131.3).

RUSH HOUR

- Starting with 1996 season, ASU's 19 rushing touchdowns in its past three games is topped only by Nebraska's 22 in November of 1997. Kansas State (2002) and Nebraska (2000) also had 19 in a three-game span. ASU had seven rushing touchdowns at Arizona and six at Oregon State to close 2020, and then had six in the Southern Utah opening-game win on Sept. 2.
- » ASU has gone over the 200-yard mark on the ground in five of its last seven games dating back to 2019.
- » ASU led the Pac-12 and was seventh nationally in averaging 264.2 rushing yards per game last season. It was the highest single-season tally at ASU since the 1981 team posted 266.6 yards per game on the ground.
- » Arizona State running backs averaged 7.2 yards from scrimmage per touch (505 yards / 70 touches) on first down last season.
- » Rachaad White had just three yards for loss on the season and DeaMontre Trayanum had just four as PFF credited the duo with a 0.0 percent stuff rate, marking them the only running backs in the Pac-12 with such a claim and two of just five running backs nationally to do so. Neither player lost a yard in the opener.

THE PRICE IS WHITE

- Rachaad White was the leading rusher for the Sun Devils in the opener, registering his third consecutive multi-rushing touchdown game dating back to last year.
- A credit to his smooth cuts and the big men in front of him, 58.0 percent of White's rushing yards came before contact last season. He averaged 5.8 yards per rush without being touched on the year - tops in the nation and 3.0 more yards than any other player in the league
- White led the nation in averaging 10.0 yards per rush (420 yards on 42 attempts) while he was 14th nationally in all-purpose yards per game (151.0). He was second among Pac-12 running backs with 151 receiving yards and caught all eight of his targets.

GOING OFF THE RAILS ON A CRAZY TRAYANUM

- » DeaMonte Trayanum was the highest-graded running back in the Pac-12 in Week One, posting an overall offensive score of 86.1.
- Trayanum was the highest-graded running back in the Pac-12 last season by PFF with a score of 87.6 4.4 points higher than any other back in the league. White was fourth in the Pac-12 with a score of 82.5.
- » Against UCLA, Chip Trayanum became the first true freshman to rush for 100 yards in a game since Demario Richard in 2014 (14 for 116 vs. Utah - the 8th game of the year). In doing so in just his second game as a Sun Devil, he became the fastest freshman to have a 100-yard game since Keegan Herring

- rushed for 134 yards on 12 carries in his debut in the season opener for $\ensuremath{\mathsf{ASU}}$
- » Trayanum averaged a first down or touchdown on 36.7 percent of his carries last season, tops in the league just ahead of his teammate, White (35.7).

A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- The Devils were tops in the country in turnover margin last season at 2.00. ASU was 6th nationally in turnover margin in 2019 (1.08).
- » ASU (11th in 2018) is one of just two teams nationally to rank in the Top-25 in turnover margin in each of the last three seasons (Georgia Southern) and only ASU was in the top-15 in each of those seasons.

THRILL OF THE CHASE

- » Chase Lucas was the highest-graded corner in the Pac-12 in coverage last season with a grade of 84.7 and the 16th-highest graded corner in the nation.
- » He allowed just 109 yards in coverage, seventh-fewest in the Pac-12 while his 7.8 yards allowed per catch were third in the league and only allowed five first downs, fourth-fewest in the league and forced five incompletions - good for third in the league.
- » Lucas allowed a first down or touchdown just 31.8 percent of the time, seventh-lowest in the Pac-12, and allowed just one player over 15 yards, second-lowest in the league.
- Among players with at least 250 defensive snaps, Lucas was the fifth-highest graded defensive player in the Pac-12, regardless of position, with a score of 81.4 from Pro Football Focus. He was the highest-rated cornerback in the league.
- » Lucas recorded a score of 84.8 in pass coverage for the season, the highest for a cornerback in the league and the second-highest of any defensive player.
- » He was the sixth-highest graded cornerback in the nation in pass coverage and the 12th-highest graded cornerback in the country overall.
- » Lucas forced an incompletion on 27.3 percent of the passes thrown his way, the ninth-best tally among corners nationally.
- » He was targeted just 22 times on the season despite playing over 90 percent of the team's defensive snaps, allowing just 14 catches.

IN THE TRENCHES

- » ASU's offensive line has allowed just 214 combined quarterback pressures by opponents since 2019 - 6th-fewest among Power Five schools.
- » Dohnovan West was named a 2021 PFF Preseason All-America pick by Pro Football Focus, a 2021 Athlon Sports Preseason All-Pac-12 First Team Selection and is ranked as the 2021 No. 5 Lindy's Preseason Center.
- » West was the 7th-highest graded guard in the Power Five last season, according to PFF (76.7) and tops among Pac-12 guards
- » He was credited with just two QB pressures allowed, tied for third among P5 guards nationally and did not allow a sack on the season.
- » Kellen Diesch was the 18th highest-graded tackle in among Power Five schools last year, according to PFF and second in the Pac-12 with a score of 81.3 (just behind the 14th overall selection in the 2021 NFL Draft, Alijah Vera-Tucker of USC (81.8). He is the highest graded returning tackle in the league.
- » Diesch had the 22nd-best pass blocking grade in the Power Five (78.9), second in the league behind Vera-Tucker.
- Diesch was credited with just four QB pressures allowed on the year, fourthlowest in the P5. Paved the way for a rushing offense that was seventh

nationally in 264.2 yards per game - 30 more than any other team in the Pac-12.

HOLD THE LINE

- » Despite playing the fewest games in the league, ASU's defensive line last season recorded 23 tackles for loss or tackles for no gain - third in the Pac-12.
- » The group tallied 70 total quarterback pressures, sixth in the league but a 17.5 pressure per game average along the line that was easily tops in the league.
- » Tyler Johnson is ASU's active leader in tackles for loss (21) and sacks (11.5). Last year, he led the team with 5.0 sacks and 7.5 tackles for loss, good for fourth in the Pac-12, respectively
- » Johnson was the ninth-highest graded edge defender in the Pac-12 last season as a pass rusher (70.3).
- » Johnson's 19 quarterback hurries were fourth in the league among edge defenders. He generated pressure on 21.3 percent of his pass snaps, second most in the league and sixth-most nationally.

SAFETY VALVE

- » Evan Fields Was the fifth-highest graded safety in coverage in the Pac-12 last season (73.4). He was also the fifth-highest graded safety in the Pac-12 in run defense (73.1).
- » He was targeted just 4.2 percent of the time, second-lowest among league safeties and 15th among FBS safeties.
- » He allowed just 51 yards in coverage, third-lowest in the league while his two first downs allowed were tied with teammate Deandre Pierce for first in the Pac-12
- » Fields Led the Sun Devils with 28 tackles eight more than any other player and his 9.5 tackles per game were sixth in the Pac-12.
- » Deandre Pierce held opponents to a 64.0 NFL QBR when targeting him last year.
- » Pierce was fourth in the league in allowing a first down or touchdown just 28.6 percent of the time in primary coverage and was not credited with a touchdown allowed on the year.
- » He had a negative grade in run defense just 3.3 percent of the time on the season.

GO DJ, THAT'S MY DJ

- » Redshirt freshman defensive back D.J. Taylor picked up right where he left off last season. Not only did he collect 55 kick return yards, he added 87 punt return yards, the highest total by anyone player in the nation during week one. He only needed three attempts to collect those 87 yards, averaging 29 yards per return. Taylor's 47-yard punt return is the longest of any player in the conference this season.
- » His efforts garnered him Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week accolades.
- » He went over 100 all-purpose yards for the third time in five games as a Sun Devil.
- » Taylor by himself finished with more punt return yards than any other team at the FBS level.
- » Taylor was the highest-graded player in the entire country on punt plays this week (83.6) according to PFF. The 83.6 rating was actually 10 points higher than any other player nationally. His elusiveness was on full display, as he forced three missed tackles despite only touching the ball five times.
- » Taylor teamed up with Rachaad White to form a dynamic punt return duo, with the two combining for 123 punt return yards, the 53 more yards than any other team in the nation after week one.
- D.J. Taylor was the highest-graded kick returner in the Pac-12 with a grade of 81.1 from Pro Football Focus last season – good for 12th nationally. Despite his knack for success on returns, he was actually the fourth-highest graded player on kickoff coverage in the Pac-12 as well – with a score of 77.7.
- » Taylor averaged 36.9 total yards per kick return attempt (including yardage on kicks taken out of the end zone), which was seven yards per return more than any other player in the Pac-12 and fourth among any player in the FBS with at least five kickoff returns.
- » His 107 total yards on his touchdown against Arizona was the longest of any player in the FBS last season, according to PFF. Taylor took the opening kickoff



- back for a touchdown in the Territorial Cup, the first Sun Devil to accomplish the feat against Arizona.
- » He was credited with at least one tackle in three of the four games last season on the return coverage unit.

HEY MR. D.J.

- » Senior defensive lineman D.J. Davidson was a disruptive force in the middle of the Sun Devil defense. He was a big reason why Southern Utah only managed 78 yards rushing, making six stops (three solo) from his nose tackle position leading the team in tackles for the game.
- » His efforts garnered him Pac-12 Defensive Lineman of the Week accolades.
- » Despite seeing double teams for a majority of the game, it did not stop Davidson from being extremely productive. He finished with two tackles for loss, batted down a pass, and recovered a fumble during an excellent season debut
- » According to Pro Football Focus, he was the Pac-12's highest-graded defensive lineman in run defense this week (90.5) and had the second-best overall run defense grade in the conference behind Oregon's Noah Sewell.
- Davidson was the 8th-highest graded player nationally on run plays and second in the country among defensive interior players.
- He finished as the sixth-highest graded overall defender in the Pac-12 for week one. Davidson was part of 5 defensive stops, the second-most in pac-12.
- » He was involved in 27 snaps, with 15 of those regarded as "key plays" by PFF.

NO IFS, ANDS OR BUTLERS

- » Linebacker and senior captain Darien Butler picked off a pair of passes, his first multi-interception game of his career.
- » He became the first Sun Devil to pick off two passes since Jack Jones did so in a victory over Arizona on Nov. 30, 2019 and the first linebacker to record the feat since Carlos Mendoza back in 2012.
- » The two picks represent the first two interceptions of his career.
- » He added five tackles and one tackle for loss in an all around productive season debut.
- » Butler was the highest-graded linebacker in the Pac-12 in Week One (85.0) good for eighth among all FBS linebackers.


