SOFTBALL VISITS UCF IN FIRST BIG 12 ROAD SERIES Sun Devils making first trip to Orlando in program history

Sun Devil Softball continues its trip to Florida this weekend with a three-game Big 12 series at UCF. The series begins on Friday at 6 p.m. ET / 3 p.m. AZT and continues on Saturday at 2 p.m. / 11 a.m. Sunday's series finale is scheduled to begin at 11 a.m. / 8 a.m.

Every game of the series will be played at the UCF Softball Complex.

How to Follow

All three games will be live on ESPN+ with Eric Lopez (play-by-play) and Alex Powers (analyst) calling the action. Live scoring will be available for every game of the series.

Sun Devil Notes

Arizona State starts its second Big 12 series with a 19-7 overall record. They are one of the five conference teams that started conference play at 2-1. The team has gone 2-1 in road games this season.

ASU begins conference play second in the Big 12 and 30th in the NCAA with a .331 batting average. They also rank 33rd in the country in slugging at .539 and 35th with a .406 on base percentage. The team scores 5.92 runs per game, and they have hit 32 home runs to place 22nd nationally.

ASU maintains a 3.11 ERA in the circle while ranking 36th in the NCAA with a 1.25 WHIP. Sun Devil pitchers

Looking Back

ASU began its five-game trip to Florida by sweeping a doubleheader against Stetson on Wednesday at Patrica Wilson Stadium. Arizona State took the first game 5-2 before claiming the nightcap 14-5 in five innings.

Last week, the Sun Devils won its inaugural Big 12 series against BYU. They took the opener 1-0 and the finale 5-4 in eight innings. The Cougars won game two 6-5.

About UCF

UCF welcomes the Sun Devils to Orlando with a 19-9-1 overall record and at 2-1 in Big 12 action. The Knights started conference play by taking two of three at Arizona last weekend.

UCF is batting .287 as a team and they lead the Big 12 with 42 doubles. They are scoring 4.00 runs per game while sitting third in the conference by stealing 1.29 bases per contest. Sierra Humphreys leads the team with 34 hits.

The Knights are third in the Big 12 with a 2.60 ERA and their 1.26 WHIP is fifth in the league. Kaitlyn Felton leads the conference and is third in the NCAA with a 0.53 ERA. She is also tied for the conference lead in wins while throwing three shutouts.

Strike First, Finish Strong

ASU has been jumping on teams early in games this season, outscoring the opposition 31-11 in the first inning. They are 9-1 when scoring in the first inning and 11-3 when scoring first overall. In a weird twist, the Sun Devils are also 5-1 when the opponent scores in the first inning.

And while scoring in the first has been key, ASU has put teams away late. The Sun Devils have outscored their opponents 28-6 in the fifth and 19-6 in the sixth. That 47-12 advantage in the later innings has helped the team go 10-1 when leading after five and 13-0 when leading after six.

Long Ball

ASU has used the long ball to its advantage, with 32 home runs on the year. The team ranks second in the Big 12 and 27th nationally in total homers while hitting 1.25 home runs per game, ranking

second in the Big 12 and 28th nationally.

The Sun Devils have homered in 20 games with multiple home runs in a game 10 times. They have gone 16-4 in games they hit a homer and 9-1 when hitting multiple.

Youth Movement

One of the youngest teams in the country, ASU has had eight freshmen make at least one appearance so far this season. Those freshmen have combined to make 103 starts, accounting for 43 percent of all starts for the year.

The freshman class is batting .300 with a .933 OPS. They have combined to hit 15 home runs – half of the team's total – and drive in 53 while also going 5-3 with 48 strikeouts in the circle.

Approaching 1,900

ASU enters the weekend series needing two wins to reach 1,900 in the program's history. One of the most successful programs in the country, the team currently holds a record of 1,898-961-2 (.664) since it began in 1967.

200 and Counting

ASU head coach Megan Bartlett recorded her 200th career victory in the win over BYU last Saturday. Now in her eighth season as a collegiate head coach and third at ASU, Bartlett has a career record of 202-172 (.540).

Hall Pass

Kelsey Hall opened the season in the starting lineup just 277 days after tearing her ACL. Having started all 26 games, Hall leads the team with a .430 batting average, eight home runs, and 32 RBIs. She has recorded a hit in 21 games with 12 multi-hit games.

This is her sixth season of collegiate softball, Hall is 18th among active players with 138 runs scored, 21st with 330 total bases, 24th with 137 RBIs and 37 home runs.

Tanya Time

Tanya Windle has taken over as the starter in center field and she leads the team lead with 36 hits while batting .404. She had hits in both games at Stetson to extend her hitting streak to 11 games. During the streak, Windle is 21-for-38 with seven multi-hit games.

Windle ranks 17th among active NCAA players with 10 triples in her career. Her .397 career batting average is ninth among active players with at least 375 career at-bats.

Brown is Back

After sitting out last season with an injury, Kenzie Brown has been solid in her return to the circle. The senior struck out the first five batters she faced this season and now has 96 strikeouts in 56.2 inning pitched.

Brown had 18 strikeouts against BYU last Thursday to tie the ASU record for strikeouts in a 7-inning game. She has three games this season with doubledigit strikeouts, becoming the first Sun Devil to do so since 2018. Brown is second in the NCAA by averaging 11.9 strikeouts per seven innings.

Around the Horn

DV MONTH

Tiare Ho-Ching is batting .350 with 28 hits and 16 RBIs while settling in as the team's lead off hitter. The freshman homered to lead-off game one at Stetson on Wednesday.

Samantha Swan has started every game behind the plate and is fourth on the team with her .333 batting average. She has recorded six multi-hit games

AJ Murphy is batting .347 with three home runs and 13 RBIs. She enters the weekend on a four-game hitting streak.

Lillian Holtje has taken over at first base and has hit five home runs while leading the team with 14 walks.

Takyla Davis has posted a hit on 12 of the team's last 15 games to raise her season average to .321.

Meika Lauppe leads the team with 11 starts in the circle while working 53.0 innings. She has a 5-3 record with 38 strikeouts.

Looking Ahead

ALBERTA B. FARRINGTON SOFTBALL STADIUM



Arizona State University will celebrate the 25th anniversary of Alberta B. Farrington Softball Stadium this season, which was unveiled in 2000 as the home of Sun Devil Softball. During its time as one of the premier softball facilities in the country, Farrington Stadium has welcomed over 800,000 spectators to witness ASU

win nearly 700 games, hosting 11 Regionals and nine Super Regionals. Those large crowds have created an amazing home environment known across the country as Club Farrington.

Farrington Stadium features individual seats in the lower section between the dugouts and chair-back bleachers in the upper sections, with a capacity for 1,535 fans. The new Lapan Sunshine Devil Deck will open in 2025 above the clubhouse down the third baseline, and a grass berm located just beyond the first base dugout provides an additional spectator area.

The stadium has several amenities that make it one of the premier softball stadiums in the country. Sunken dugouts are lighted for night games and have recessed, individual bat slots and locker room access. The playing surface and outfield grass were completely replaced during the offseason. In addition, there is a built-in concession stand, a team shop, restrooms and locker rooms for the visiting team and officials.

Upgrades to the Sun Devil clubhouse were completed last spring to give the team a modern locker room and team area. The redesigned space also added new coaches' offices, locker areas, and a new training room.

The Betsy and Kent Bro Softball Hitting Facility, located down the left field line, opened in 2020 and

provides the Sun Devils year-round access to batting cages and the latest technology.

After adding a press box and extending the outfield fences before the 2013 season, Farrington was again upgraded before the beginning of the 2014 season. Solar panels were added above the stands, providing shade to most in the upper deck seats. The facility has also received two major awards for design and excellence in architecture.

Megan Bartlett took over as head coach of the Arizona State softball program in the summer of 2022, becoming the eighth head coach in the program's

With the start of a new season, Bartlett has a 183-165 (.526) career record that includes a 42-57 mark in her two seasons leading the Sun Devils.

With Bartlett at the helm, ASU saw Yanni Acuña be named NFCA All-American, NFCA All-Region, All-Pac-12 Conference, CSC Academic All-American and CSC Academic All-District. Jordan VanHook was also named All-Region, and Kylee Magee was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team.

Bartlett guided the Sun Devils through a roster overhaul to finish 2023 with a 22-26 overall record. That included a series win over Women's College World Series participant Washington and an eightgame winning streak early in the season.

Prior to taking the Sun Devils, Bartlett spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Texas. That followed five seasons in Indiana as a head coach building the Ball State softball program.

As the head coach at Ball State for five seasons (2016-20), Bartlett led the program to a 141-108 overall record (.567) while registering three consecutive 30-win seasons from 2017-19. Over that stretch, she helped guide the Cardinals to the 2018 Mid-American Conference (MAC) West Division title with that season's 37 victories marking the fourth-most wins in a single season in program history.

Bartlett began her coaching career as a graduate assistant coach at Loyola University Chicago (2005-07), where she was part of the 2007 Horizon League Coaching Staff of the Year while helping her squad to the league's regular season title.

From there, she moved on to become an assistant coach at Northern Illinois (2007-12), working with infielders and outfielders while also serving as the recruiting coordinator, offensive coordinator and camp coordinator

After spending a single campaign at DePaul as a volunteer assistant coach for the 2014 Big East regular season and tournament champions (44-11), Bartlett moved on to become an assistant coach at Purdue (2014-15).

Bartlett was a four-year letter winner at Notre Dame (2002-05) under her maiden name Megan Ciolli, helping power the Irish to four NCAA Regional appearances, four Big East regular season championships and two Big East Tournament titles. A two-time NFCA All-American (2004, 2005), she captained the 2005 squad to a 46-15 mark while helping secure the program's first-ever NCAA Regional home contests.

The 2004 Big East Player of the Year, Bartlett completed her playing career at Notre Dame as the program's leader in hits (284) and stolen bases (76) while finishing in the top five in batting average (second .368) and runs scored (second – 161). She also finished ranked in the UND career top 10 in doubles (ninth - 37), triples (seventh - 9), HRs (ninth - 13) and RBIs (10th - 101).

Bartlett graduated from the University of Notre Dame with a bachelor's degree of business administration in managerial consulting in 2005. She completed her master's of business administration in healthcare administration at Loyola University Chicago in 2007 and went on to earn a juris doctor from Northern Illinois in 2012.

A licensed attorney in the state of Illinois, she is married to Mike Bartlett, a former professional hockey player, and they have two daughters, Vivian and Maren.
