UP NEXT

The Sun Devil women's basketball team (7-7, 1-1 Big 12) will play its third game in six days when it goes on the road to face Houston (4-9, 0-2 Big 12) on Saturday (5 p.m. MST).

Prior to Monday's game vs. Penn, the Sun Devils had not played a game since their Big 12 Conference opener at Utah on Dec. 21. The Sun Devils have won both of their games since resuming play after the holiday break. They defeated Penn (73-67) on Monday and followed that with a win in their first Big 12 Conference home game, defeating Texas Tech (79-61) on New Year's Day.

Saturday's game at Houston can be seen on ESPN+ (Chelsea Reber/play by play, Austyn Iven/analyst, Brooke Kirchhofer/reporter). The game can also be heard on KDUS AM 1060. Veteran broadcaster and the state of Arizona's 2010 & 2019 Broadcaster of the Year Jeff Munn is in his 21st season as the voice of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.

SERIES NOTES

- This will be the third meeting – series started in 2021 – between the Sun Devils and Cougars. Houston prevailed in both games.
- Houston claimed a 50-48 win in the consolation final of the Postseason WNIT's Fort Worth Regional played in March 2021. The two teams crossed paths a little more than eight months later at the Cancun Challenge. In that contest, the Cougars came out on top 68-60.

RANKINGS OF NOTE

- Through games played Jan. 2, ASU is ranked among the top 60 teams in the nation in free throw pct. (30th/77.1/3rd in Big 12), blocks per game (40th/4.5/5th in Big 12) and defensive rebounds per game (53rd/27.9/3rd in Big 12).
- ASU is also ranked in the top half of the Big 12 in rebounds per game (6th/39.2), free throws made per game (7th/13.0) and scoring offense (8th/73.1 ppg).
- Individually, **Kennedy Basham** is 12th in the nation in blocks per game (2.4/2nd in Big 12) and **Tyi Skinner** is 35th in minutes per game (35.2/2nd in Big 12).
- ASU also has several players ranked among the Top 20 in the Big 12: **Skinner** is 4th in FT pct. (83.6), 7th in scoring (17.2 ppg/has scored in double figures in all but two games this season) and 9th in 3-pointers per game (2.4); **Jalyn Brown** is 11th in scoring (16.8 ppg) and blocks per game (1.1), 12th in FT pct. (79.1) and 19th in FG pct. (43.4); and **Kennedy Fauntleroy** is 10th in steals per game (2.1) and 13th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.65). Fauntleroy has 16 steals in ASU's last four games (4.0 steals per game), more than twice as many as the 1.3 steals per game she averaged in ASU's first 10 games.

NOTES FROM LAST GAME - @ASU 79, Texas Tech 61

- The Sun Devil women's basketball team celebrated New Year's Day by defeating Texas Tech 79-61 to claim its first Big 12 win in its first Big 12 home game.
- The Sun Devils had six players post double-digit scoring totals on Wednesday: Kennedy Fauntleroy (17 points), Tyi Skinner (16 points), Jyah LoVett (13 points), Nevaeh Parkinson (12 points), Maggie Besselink (11 points) and Jazion Jackson (10 points).
- For the third time this season, ASU connected on higher than 50 pct of its shots (50.8), including 54.8 pct (17-31) in the second half.
- Parkinson and Kennedy Basham each grabbed eight boards helping ASU finish plus-seven for the game (39-32). Five of Parkinson's rebounds came on the offensive end. Although each team had 13 offensive rebounds, it was the Sun Devils who took advantage of the extra opportunities outscoring the Lady Raiders 17-10 in second chance points.
- Fauntleroy and Jackson each had six helpers to account for 12 of ASU's 18 assists. It was the fifth time this season Fauntleroy dished out six or more assists in a game. Defensively, Jackson made her presence known with a game-high five steals, the third time this season she has collected four or more steals in a game.
- Texas Tech's 61 points represented the second fewest total ASU has allowed this season. In addition, it was the fifth time in the last six games the Sun Devils have allowed 67 or fewer points.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- A win at Houston would lift the Sun Devils above the .500 mark both overall and in conference play. It would also be ASU's first three-game winning streak of the season.
- Prior to its 102-82 loss at Utah, the Sun Devils were starting to make strides on the defensive end of the floor. After giving up an average of 76.0 points in their first eight games, the Sun Devils gave up 16.0 fewer points per game (60.0) in their contests vs. UMES, at UC Davis and at San Francisco. In the contests vs. UMES and UC Davis, the Sun Devils allowed a season-low 57 points in back-to-back games. Including this week's wins over Penn and Texas Tech, ASU has given up 67 or fewer points in five of its last six games. Penn's 26 points in the last 20 minutes matched the fewest points ASU has given up in the second half this season.
- Tyi Skinner (6x) and Jalyn Brown (5x) have combined to lead or tie for the team lead in scoring 11x this season. Also among the single-game scoring leaders have been Nevaeh Parkinson (2x), Jyah LoVett (1x) and Kennedy Fauntleroy (1x).
- Skinner (12 of 14 games) and Brown (9 of 11 games) have combined to score in double figures 21 times this season. Skinner has scored 20 or more points 5x, including a career-high 30 points in ASU's season opening win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). Brown has scored 20 or more points 4x.
- In ASU's last four games, LoVett has averaged 14.8 points and connected on half of her 48 shot attempts. Compared to her first 10 games, LoVett has averaged +5.7 more points per game and shot +8.8 percentage points higher.
- In ASU's last three games, Parkinson has averaged 16.0 points and 8.3 rebounds. During that stretch she is shooting 72 percent (21-29).
- After playing seven consecutive game away from Tempe between Nov. 26 - Dec. 21, ASU will play no more than two straight games on the road the remainder of the season.
- Kennedy Basham has had multiple blocks in seven games this season, including a career-high seven rejections at San Francisco (Dec. 17).

PROGRESS NOT ALWAYS MEASURED IN WINS AND LOSSES

The Sun Devils, who have eight new players on this season's roster, have experienced the ups and downs that can sometimes go with combining the talents of several outstanding players early in the season. That factor alone could account for the Sun Devils' current 6-7 record. Some of the near misses...

- Against Arkansas State, the Sun Devils trailed by 13 with 6:15 remaining. After a 19-5 run, ASU was suddenly up by one with 1:01 remaining. Arkansas State scored the last five points of the game to claim the win.
- After going into the half with a 42-33 win vs. Grand Canyon, the Sun Devils were outscored 37-17 in the second half.
- At Coppin State, ASU was unable to score in the final 53 seconds to break a 61-61 tie. The Eagles would go on to win in OT.
- Despite a stout defensive effort and a plus-12 advantage on the boards, the Sun Devils came up on the short end of a 57-50 decision at UC Davis. For the second straight game the Sun Devils held the opposition to the fewest points they have given up this season and allowed the Aggies to shoot only 37 percent. Unfortunately for ASU, it struggled to put the ball in the basket as it made just 28 percent of its shots and knocked down one of its 14 attempts from long range. Down by eight entering the fourth quarter, the Sun Devils did not show any letup, methodically trimming the Aggies' advantage. Besselink's layup got the Sun Devils within two points, 44-42, with 5:36 remaining. ASU was within one possession three more times but did not come away with points in each instance. After Besselink's earlier field goal got ASU within two, the Sun Devils were only able to connect on three of their 14 shot attempts in the final five minutes of the game.
- At San Francisco, the Sun Devils were unable to take advantage of a 27-point performance from Skinner and a career-high and a tremendous all-around performance from Basham, who scored 12 points, grabbed seven rebounds and had a career-high seven blocks. The difference in the game was at the free throw line, not in accuracy – ASU made 82 percent of its attempts and San Francisco made 83 percent – but in the number of opportunities. By game's end, the Dons had more than three times as many attempts (29-35) as the Sun Devils (9-11). Still the Sun Devils were tied at 57-57 with 1:09 remaining. After the Dons took a six-point lead, Skinner knocked down a pair of 3-pointers and missed on a third that would have tied the game and sent it to overtime.

WELCOME HOME

After home wins over SMU (80-73 on Nov. 16) and former Pac-12 foe Oregon State (79-60 on Nov. 17) in the annual Briann January Classic, the Sun Devils started a stretch in which it did not play a home game for 43 days. A summary of what happened while they were away from Tempe:

- The Sun Devils split their contests at the Music City Classic in Nashville, Tenn., falling to then-No. 14 Kentucky 77-61 (Nov. 26) and beating South Dakota 95-88 (Nov. 27). Nevaeh Parkinson was named to the Music City Classic All-Tournament Team. Against South Dakota, Parkinson scored a team- and career-high 26 points. Parkinson's single-game field goal percentage of 92.3 percent on 12 of 13 shooting vs. South Dakota, was the best individual performance for a Sun Devil attempting 10 or more shots in a game since Betsy Boardman made all 10 of her shots (1.000) vs. UCLA on February 17, 2001. Parkinson was also ASU's top rebounder in the two contests

- Next it was off to the DMV where the Sun Devils once again split their two contests, falling at Coppin State 74-68 in OT (Dec. 5) before coming back to defeat UMES 64-57 (Dec. 7) in the Coaches vs. Racism Roundball Classic played in Washington DC. The game at Coppin State was ASU's first true 'road game' of the season. Brown (14.5 ppg) and Skinner (13.5 ppg) both averaged double figures in the two games. At Coppin State, ASU came back from nine points down to take a 59-55 lead with 3:33 remaining. The Sun Devils led 68-67 with 1:28 remaining in OT before the Eagles closed the game with a 9-0 run to claim the win. Against UMES, ASU was phenomenal on the defensive end where it allowed the fewest points in a game this season and had season bests in steals (15) and blocked shots (9) and forced 32 turnovers, 13 more than the previous opponent high of 19 by Oregon State in last month's Briann January Classic.
- After time off for final exams, ASU was back on a plane, this time to Northern California for games at UC Davis (Dec. 15) and at San Francisco (Dec. 17). Despite a stout defensive effort and a plus-12 advantage on the boards, ASU came up on the short end of a 57-50 decision at UC Davis. For the second straight game ASU held the opposition to the fewest points its given up this season (57). It also allowed the Aggies to shoot only 37 percent. Unfortunately for ASU,

it struggled to put the ball in the basket as it made just 28 percent of its shots and knocked down one of its 14 attempts from long range. Brown led all scorers with 21 points to go with three steals. Leading ASU's effort on the boards was Maggie Besselink, who had game highs in rebounds (12) and offensive rebounds (7). For Besselink, who also scored four points, her 12 boards were one short of matching her career high of 13 vs. USC on Mar. 3, 2021.

- Despite a game-high 27 points from Skinner, ASU lost at San Francisco, 67-64. For the second time this season, Skinner came within one triple of tying the single-game school record after knocking down six vs. the Dons. The difference in the game was at the free throw line, not in accuracy – ASU made 82 pct of its attempts and San Francisco made 83 pct – but in the number of opportunities. By game's end, the Dons had more than three times as many attempts (29-35) ASU (9-11).

- In the Big 12 conference opener at Utah, the Sun Devils posted their highest point total and best field goal percentage since Nov. 27. Despite its strong offensive performance, ASU was not able to come through with the win, falling at Utah 102-82. The Sun Devils scored more than 80 points for the fourth time this season and had their highest final point total since a 95-88 win vs. South Dakota at the Music City Classic on Nov. 27. ASU's shooting percentage of 48.4 percent was also its highest since the win over South Dakota (52.2 percent).

DYNAMIC DUO DEBUT

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were dealt a serious blow when it was announced before the season that superstar guard Tyi Skinner would miss the entire season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who played her first two seasons at Delaware, joined Natasha Adair in Tempe after Adair was named ASU's head coach. In 2022-23, Skinner (2023 All-Pac-12 honorable mention) scored 20 or more points 15 times, including 29 points twice. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner averaged 19.3 ppg, (most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89). She concluded her first campaign as a Sun Devil among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), FTs made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG pct (34.7/6th) and FT percentage (78.1/8th).

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were left pondering, 'what might have been,' had Skinner been able to share the court with Louisville transfer Jalyn Brown. Much like Skinner did in 2022-23, Brown would emerge as one of the top performers in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. In league games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56). She scored in double figures 26 times (12 20-point games) including a pair of outings in which she had the two highest-scoring games by a Sun Devil since 2000: 35 vs. Colorado (Jan. 7, 2024) and 34 points at Washington (Jan. 21).

Brown, who earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, went on to lead the team in scoring (17.3 ppg) and 3-pointers per game (1.4), was 2nd in FT pct. (76.9), 3-pointers (1.3 per game), minutes (35.54 mpg) and FTs made (103) and attempted (134), 3rd in assists (1.6 apg), tied for 3rd in steals (0.9 spg) and 4th in O-rebounds (1.1 rpg).

In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Skinner

scored a career-high 30 points – the 17th time she scored 20 or more points in a Sun Devil uniform – in ASU's 74-66 win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). Brown led ASU in scoring (24 points) vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Combined with Skinner's 16 points, the duo combined for 40 points in the game.

In ASU's 80-73 win over SMU (Nov. 16), Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) combined for 51 points. In addition both Skinner (8-16 FGs, 5-10 3FGs) and Brown (10-18 FGs, 3-7 3FGs) were efficient with their opportunities as they teamed up to shoot 53 percent (18-34 FGs) from the field, including 47 percent (8-17) from long range. Both have scored in double figures in all but two of the games they have played this season. Out of the 14 games ASU has played thus far, Skinner has led or tied ASU in scoring 6 times and Brown 5 times.

NOTES ON ASU’S FIRST SEASON IN THE BIG 12

Big 12 Transfers: Three Sun Devil newcomers were on a Big 12 campus in the past year. Heavenly Greer played the past two years at Kansas State, Dallas native Jazion Jackson was at Texas Tech last year and Kennedy Fauntleroy was at Oklahoma State last year after earning 2022-23 Big East Freshman of the Year at Georgetown.

The Big 12 format: Teams will play three opponents home and away while facing six teams only at home and six opponents only on the road for a total of 18 Conference games. Opponents were selected based on a combination of geography, historical results and a poll of the coaches to best balance the schedule in terms of travel and competitiveness.

ASU’s Big 12 opponent breakdown: Home: Baylor (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Cincinnati (2024 WNIT Team), Iowa State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), TCU (2024 WBIT Team), Texas Tech, West Virginia (2024 NCAA Tournament Team). Away: Central Florida, Colorado (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Houston, Kansas (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Kansas State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Oklahoma State. HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR



- On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils

overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points).

- ASU was once again hampered by injuries in 2023-24 as it lost leading scorer Tyi Skinner before the season started. Despite the injury issues, the Sun Devils still increased their overall win total and conference win total from the season before. Individually, Jalyn Brown flourished in her first season as a Sun Devil. The transfer from Louisville earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention recognition from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 notice from media who covered the league. In conference games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56).
- In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All-Conference honors.
- In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished 2016-17 with 17 wins, the most for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 – the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 – and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All-Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the

program to consecutive postseason appearances.

- In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

- In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.

- While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.

- Adair previously spent 14 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with eight years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor five WNBA draft picks and several players who went on to play professionally overseas.

- A founding member of the Black Coaches United, Adair has been recognized by the organization, as well as Advancement of Blacks in Sports (ABIS), as one of the top women's basketball coaches in the country. Adair prides herself on being known as a game-changer as it

relates to social justice and creating a safe space for athletes to find and use their voice; where she was a guest on ESPNW's "Around the Rim" with LaChina Robinson and Delaware's UD Winning Women in Athletics: Trailblazers and Changemakers Webinar Series.

- Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990- 92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994.

- Coach Adair has two children, a son Aaron M. Adair (27), graduated magna cum laude from Johnson C. Smith University. A four-year member of the university's President's Council for his academic achievement, he also earned four letters playing for the men's basketball team. Daughter Allyssa M. Adair (19) is a sophomore at Texas State University and a middle blocker on the volleyball team.
