NOTES ON THE SCHEDULE THUS FAR

- The Sun Devils did not have to leave the Grand Canyon State for their first five games of the season. Four contests were played at their usual home venue Desert Financial Arena and one was played at Footprint Center (officially a neutral site) when they faced Grand Canyon in the Hall of Fame Series Phoenix event on Nov. 14.
- This will be the third time this season ASU will be coming into a game in which it did not play a game for at least eight days. Its most recent contest was Dec. 21 (nine days ago) at Utah in the Big 12 Conference opener for both teams... After defeating Oregon State in its most recent home game on Nov. 17, ASU did not compete for nine days leading up to its first road trip of the season: the Coast2Coast Music City Classic in Nashville where it met then-No. 14 Kentucky (Nov. 26) and South Dakota (Nov. 27). After returning from a road trip to the DMV, the Sun Devils were off for eight days for final exams prior to traveling to Northern California for games at UC Davis (Dec. 15) and at San Francisco (Dec. 17).
- ASU will now transition from a period of relative inactivity when it came to playing games to a stretch in which it will play three contests in six days. After it faces Penn on Monday, ASU will host Texas Tech in its first ever Big 12 home game on New Year's Day. It will then pack its bags once again for a game at Houston on Jan. 4.

WELCOME HOME

What has ASU been up in the 43 games since it last played a home game?

- After wins over SMU (80-73 on Nov. 16) and former Pac-12 foe Oregon State (79-60 on Nov. 17) in the annual Briann January Classic, the Sun Devils split their contests at the Music City Classic in Nashville, Tenn., falling to then-No. 14 Kentucky 77-61 (Nov. 26) and beating South Dakota 95-88 (Nov. 27) . Nevaeh Parkinson was named to the Music City Classic All-Tournament Team. Against South Dakota, Parkinson scored a teamand career-high 26 points. Parkinson's single-game field goal percentage of 92.3 percent on 12 of 13 shooting vs. South Dakota, was the best individual performance for a Sun Devil attempting 10 or more shots in a game since Betsy Boardman made all 10 of her shots (1.000) vs. UCLA on February 17, 2001. Parkinson was also ASU's top rebounder in the two contests (6.5 rebounds per game).
- Next it was off to the DMV where the Sun Devils once split their two contests, falling at Coppin State 74-68 in OT (Dec. 5) before coming back to defeat UMES 64-57 (Dec. 7) in the Coaches vs. Racism Roundball Classic played in Washington DC. The game at Coppin State was ASU's first true 'road game' of the season. Brown (14.5 ppg) and Skinner (13.5 ppg) both averaged double figures in the two games. At Coppin State, ASU came back from nine points down to take a 59-55 lead with 3:33 remaining. The Sun Devils led 68-67 with 1:28 remaining in OT before the Eagles closed the game with a 9-0 run to claim the win. Against UMES, ASU was phenomenal on the defensive end where it allowed the fewest points in a game this season and had season bests in steals (15) and blocked shots (9) and forced 32 turnovers, 13 more than the previous opponent high of 19 by Oregon State in last month's Briann January Classic.
- After time off for final exams, ASU was back on a plane, this time to Northern California for games at UC Davis (Dec. 15) and at San Francisco (Dec. 17). Despite a stout defensive effort and a plus-12 advantage on the boards, ASU came up on the short end of a 57-50 decision at UC Davis. For the second straight game ASU held the opposition to the fewest points its given up this season (57). It also allowed the Aggies to shoot only 37 percent. Unfortunately for ASU, it struggled to put the ball in the basket as it made just 28 percent of its shots and knocked down one of its 14 attempts from long range. Brown led all scorers with 21 points to go with three steals. Leading ASU's effort on the boards was Maggie Besselink, who had game highs in rebounds (12) and offensive rebounds (7). For Besselink, who also scored four points, her 12 boards were one short of matching her career high of 13 vs. USC on Mar. 3, 2021.
- Despite a game-high 27 points from Skinner, ASU lost at San Francisco, 67-64. For the second time this season, Skinner came within one triple of tying the single-game school record after knocking down six vs. the Dons. The difference in the game was at the free throw line, not in accuracy ASU made 82 pct of its attempts and San Francisco made 83 pct but in the number of opportunities. By game's end, the Dons had more than three times as many attempts (29-35) ASU (9-11).
- In the Big 12 conference opener at Utah, the Sun Devils posted their highest point total and best field goal percentage since Nov. 27. Despite its strong offensive performance, ASU was not able to come through with the win, falling at Utah 102-82. The Sun Devils scored more than 80 points for the fourth time this season and had their highest final point total since a 95-88 win vs. South Dakota at the Music City Classic on Nov. 27. ASU's shooting percentage of 48.4 percent was also its highest since the win over South Dakota (52.2 percent).



RANKINGS OF NOTE

- Through games played Dec. 28, ASU is ranked among the top 60 teams in the nation in blocks per game (22nd/5.1/5th in Big 12), free throw percentage (34th/76.3/3rd in Big 12) and defensive rebounds per game (3rd/28.0/68th in Big 12).
- ASU is also ranked in the top half of the Big 12 in rebounds per game(6th/39.3) and free throws made per game (8th/13.2).
- Individually, Kennedy Basham is 8th the in the nation in blocks per game (2.8/2nd in Big 12), **Tyi Skinner** is 46th in 3-pointers per game (2.58/8th in the Big 12) and 57th in minutes per game (34.6/2nd in Big 12).
- ASU also has several players ranked among the Top 20 in the Big 12: **Skinner** is 6th in scoring (17.8 ppg), 7th in FT pct. (82.6), 10th in 3-point pct. (38.3), 18th in assists per game (3.3) and 19th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.18); Jalyn Brown is 11th in scoring (16.8 ppg) and blocks per game (1.1), 12th in FT pct. (79.1) and 19th in FG pct. (43.4), Basham is 13th in rebounds per game (6.8) and Kennedy Fauntleroy is 15th in steals per game (1.9). Fauntleroy has had more than twice as many steals in her last six games (16) as she had in her first six games (7).

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- Prior to its loss at Utah, the Sun Devils were starting to make strides on the defensive end of the floor. After giving up an average of 76.0 points in their first eight games, the Sun Devils gave up 16.0 fewer points per game (60.0) in their contests vs. UMES, at UC Davis and at San Francisco. In the contests vs. UMES and UC Davis, the Sun Devils allowed a season-low 57 points in back-to-back games. •Skinner (six times) and Brown (five times) have combined to lead or tie for the team lead in scoring in 11 of 12 games this season. Also among the single-game scoring leaders have been Nevaeh Parkinson (career-high 26 points vs. South Dakota (Nov. 27) and Jyah LoVett who tied Skinner for the team lead with 13 points in ASU's win at UMES.
- Skinner (10 of 12 games) and Brown (nine of 11 games) have combined to score in double figures 19 times this season. Skinner has scored 20 or more points five times, including a career-high 30 points in ASU's season opening win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). Brown has scored 20 or more points four times.
- Despite dealing with a number of injuries during her time at ASU, Maggie Besselink has persevered to become a regular contributor for the Sun Devils. She is currently tied for the team lead in offensive rebounds per game (1.8) and is fourth on the team in overall rebounds per game (3.6).
- Seven Sun Devils have started at least 3 games this season. Skinner is the only player on ASU's roster who has played and started all 12 games this season. Brown, who did not play in ASU's loss at San Francisco, has started all 11 games she has played in and Jazion Jackson has started all 8 games she has played in. Kennedy Basham has played in every game (8 starts) and Nevaeh Parkinson has started 8 of the 10 games she has played in. Other players who have started this season include Maggie Besselink (4 of 10 games), Jyah LoVett (3 of 12 games) and Kennedy Fauntleroy (3 of 12 games).
- Kennedy Basham has had multiple blocks in seven games this season, including a career-high seven rejections at San Francisco (Dec. 17).

PROGRESS NOT ALWAYS MEASURED IN WINS AND LOSSES

The Sun Devils, who have eight new players on this season's roster, have experienced the ups and downs that can sometimes go with combining the talents of several outstanding players early in the season. That factor alone could account for the Sun Devils' current 5-7 record. The fact of the matter is, the Sun Devils could just as easily be 10-2 right now...

- Against Arkansas State, the Sun Devils trailed by 13 with 6:15 remaining. After a 19-5 run, ASU was suddenly up be one with 1:01 remaining. Arkansas State scored the last five points of the game to
- After going into the half with a 42-33 win vs. Grand Canyon, the Sun Devils were outscored 37-17 in the second half.
- At Coppin State, the Sun Devils were unable to score in the final 53 seconds to break a 61-61 tie. The Eagles would go on to win in
- Despite a stout defensive effort and a plus-12 advantage on the boards, the Sun Devils came up on the short end of a 57-50 decision at UC Davis. For the second straight game the Sun Devils held the opposition to the fewest points they have given up this season and



allowed the Aggies to shoot only 37 percent. Unfortunately for ASU, it struggled to put the ball in the basket as it made just 28 percent of its shots and knocked down one of its 14 attempts from long range. Down by eight entering the fourth quarter, the Sun Devils did not show any letup, methodically trimming the Aggies' advantage. Besselink's layup got the Sun Devils within two points, 44-42, with 5:36 remaining. ASU was within one possession three more times but did not come away with points in each instance. After Besselink's earlier field goal got ASU within two, the Sun Devils were only able to connect on three of their 14 shot attempts in the final five minutes of the game.

• At San Francisco, the Sun Devils were unable to take advantage of a 27-point performance from Skinner and a career-high and a tremendous all-around performance from Basham, who scored 12 points, grabbed seven rebounds and had a career-high seven blocks. The difference in the game was at the free throw line, not in accuracy – ASU made 82 percent of its attempts and San Francisco made 83 percent – but in the number of opportunities. By game's end, the Dons had more than three times as many attempts (29-35) as the Sun Devils (9-11). Still the Sun Devils were tied at 57-57 with 1:09 remaining. After the Dons took a six-point lead, Skinner knocked down a pair of 3-pointers and missed on a third that would have tied the game and sent it to overtime.

DYNAMIC DUO DEBUT

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were dealt a serious blow when it was announced before the season that superstar guard Tyi Skinner would miss the entire season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who played her first two seasons at Delaware, joined Natasha Adair in Tempe after Adair was named ASU's head coach. In 2022-23, Skinner (2023 All-Pac-12 honorable mention) scored 20 or more points 15 times, including 29 points twice. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner averaged 19.3 ppg, (most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89). She concluded her first campaign as a Sun Devil among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), FTs made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG pct (34.7/6th) and FT percentage (78.1/8th).

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were left pondering, 'what might have been,' had Skinner been able to share the court with Louisville transfer Jalyn Brown. Much like Skinner did in 2022-23, Brown would emerge as one of the top performers in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. In league games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56). She scored in double figures 26 times (12 20-point games) including a pair of outings in which she had the two highest-scoring games by a Sun Devil since 2000: 35 vs. Colorado (Jan. 7, 2024) and 34 points at Washington (Jan. 21).

Brown, who earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, went on to lead the team in scoring (17.3 ppg) and 3-pointers per game (1.4), was 2nd in FT pct. (76.9), 3-pointers (1.3 per game), minutes (35.54 mpg) and FTs made (103) and attempted (134), 3rd in assists (1.6 apg), tied for 3rd in steals (0.9 spg) and 4th in O-rebounds (1.1 rpg).

In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Skinner scored a career-high 30 points – the 17th time she scored 20 or

more points in a Sun Devil uniform – in ASU's 74-66 win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). Brown led ASU in scoring (24 points) vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Combined with Skinner's 16 points, the duo combined for 40 points in the game.

In ASU's 80-73 win over SMU (Nov. 16), Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) combined for 51 points. In addition both Skinner (8-16 FGs, 5-10 3FGs) and Brown (10-18 FGs, 3-7 3FGs) were efficient with their opportunities as they teamed up to shoot 53 percent (18-34 FGs) from the field, including 47 percent (8-17) from long range. Both have scored in double figures in all but two games his season. Out of the 12 games ASU has played thus far, Skinner has led or tied ASU in scoring 6 times and Brown 5 times.

- Scored a season-high 15 points at UW (Feb. 23) and followed that up with 14 points at WSU (Feb. 25) for her first career games in double figures.

NOTES ON ASU'S FIRST SEASON IN THE BIG 12

Big 12 Transfers: Three Sun Devil newcomers were on a Big 12 campus in the past year. Heavenly Greer played the past two years at Kansas State, Dallas native Jazion Jackson was at Texas Tech last year and Kennedy Fauntleroy was at Oklahoma State last year after earning 2022-23 Big East Freshman of the Year at Georgetown.

The Big 12 format: Teams will play three opponents home and away while facing six teams only at home and six opponents only on the road for a total of 18 Conference games. Opponents were selected based on a combination of geography, historical results and a poll of the coaches to best balance the schedule in terms of travel and competitiveness.

ASU's Big 12 opponent breakdown: Home: Baylor (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Cincinnati (2024 WNIT Team), Iowa State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), TCU (2024 WBIT Team), Texas Tech, West Virginia (2024 NCAA Tournament Team). Away: Central Florida, Colorado (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Houston, Kansas (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Kansas State (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), Oklahoma State. Home and Away: Arizona (2024 NCAA Tournament Team), BYU (2024 WBIT Team), Utah (2024 NCAA Tournament Team).

When it starts/ends: League play begins Saturday, Dec. 21 with six games and concludes Sunday, March 2. The regular season will be followed by the 2025 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship, which will take place in Kansas City's T-Mobile Center for the second consecutive season.

About the league: The current league members combined to go 8-0 in their first game of the 2024 NCAA Tournament while 15 of the 16 teams finished the 2023-24 season in the top 101 of the NET rankings. Four Big 12 teams are ranked in the top 16 of ESPN's Women's Basketball Way-Too-Early Top 25, tied for the most of any league.



HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR



- •On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- •Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- •In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- •In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils

overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points).

- ASU was once again hampered by injuries in 2023-24 as it lost leading scorer Tyi Skinner before the season started. Despite the injury issues, the Sun Devils still increased their overall win total and conference win total from the season before. Individually, Jalyn Brown flourished in her first season as a Sun Devil. The transfer from Louisville earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention recognition from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 notice from media who covered the league. In conference games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56).
- •In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- •Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All- Conference honors.
- •In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- •Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished 2016-17 with 17 wins, the most for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- •In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- •While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All- Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- •Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the

program to consecutive postseason appearances.

- •In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.
- •In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.
- •While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.


