PAC-12 PLAYS BEGINS: The Sun Devil men's hoops team (11-2) tips Pac-12 play on Wednesday, Jan. 2, against Utah in an 8 p.m. tip on the Pac-12 Network. ASU matched its win total from last year with a 77-62 road win over Texas Tech on Dec. 22 behind Jahii Carson and Jon Gilling's 18 points (third-highest in Gilling's career), which included a career-high six three-pointers from Gilling and 16 of Carson's points coming in the second half. Jahii outscored Texas Tech 12-4 in a key 5:50 stretch late in the second half to seal the deal as a seven-point lead lead went to a 15-point win. ASU then took care of Coppin State on Dec. 29 68-52, improving its home record to 9-1, one year after going 7-10 on Ned Wulk Court. ASU will open its Pac-12 season at home for the first time since the 2007-08 season (five years) and for just the 14th time in 35 Pac-10/12 seasons. Most teams win when you shoot well, but with ASU it seems to be a given as it is 52-8 (.867) under Coach Sendek when it shoots 50 percent.

JORDAN BLOCK-SHYNSKI: ASU is fourth in the nation in blocks per game at 7.9 per game, trailing only St. John's (9.3) and Kansas (8.1), led by junior Jordan Bachynski's 59 (4.54 per game) as he also ranks third. Jordan has seven more blocks than the Utah team (52) and as many as 288 other D-I schools...in the first six seasons (197 games) of Coach Sendek's ASU tenure, ASU had nine blocks in a game four times. It has had at least nine blocks seven times this season..an overlooked block statistic for Jordan is keeping it in play. Of his 59 blocks, more than 60 percent (37) have resulted in direct possessions for ASU, and only six have gone out of bounds. He has now 120 career blocks, seventh in Sun Devil history. The Sun Devil career record is 191 (Mario Bennett from 1991-95). Next up is Jeff Pendergraph, who had 131 from 2005-09. Also, in the first 41 games of his ASU career Jordan shot 42-of-88 (.478) from the field, but in the past 26 games he is 94-147 (.640).

PAC LIDLIFTERS: The last time the Sun Devils hosted its Pac-12 (then Pac-1) opener, James Harden was in a Sun Devil uniform and hardly had any facial hair. This year is the first time the Sun Devils have hosted a league opener since a 62-54 win over Oregon on Jan. 3, 2008 (first time in five seasons). That victory was ASU's first in a Pac-10 opener since 2002-03...ASU has opened at home just 13 times since joining the league (it is 5-8)...ASU is 9-25 in Pac-10/12 openers, 3-11 in its past 14 and 5-18 in past 23...it is 2-4 under Coach Sendek...ASU won openers in 1978-79, 1979-80, 1982-83, 1987-88, 1994-95, 1997-98, 2002-03, 2007-08 and 2008-09...Bill Frieder and Rob Evans both went 1-7 in Pac-10 openers at ASU.

MAKING/SHOOTING THREES: ASU had 14 three-pointers at Texas Tech on Dec. 22, just the 12th time in school history it had hit 14 and it tied for the second-most in a road game. ASU hit 16 at Brigham Young on Dec. 1, 1992, and also had 14 at Oregon on Jan. 30, 1993. Eight of the top 12 games have happened under Coach Sendek's watch. It then made 10-of-30 against Coppin State on Dec. 2, as the 30 three-point attempts is the most since ASU had 40 vs. Oregon on March 5, 2011.

CARRICK UPDATE: Senior **Carrick Felix** (B.S., Communications 2012) is averaging 9.1 rebounds per game in the past seven games and in the past 10 games he is averaging 16.0 points, 7.9 rebounds, has 17 blocks and is shooting 62-of-103 (.602) from the field and 13-of-33 (.394) from the three-point stripe...Cal State Northridge game marked sixth time he played turnover free-game (minimum 15 minutes)...Pac-12 Player of the Week for his efforts from Nov. 26-Dec. 2...after not having a double-double in the first 65 career games he posted them in back-to-back games with 11 points and 11 boards vs. Hartford (Dec. 5) and 21 points/12 boards vs. Sacramento St. (Dec. 1) and now has three in his career...nine field goals and five assists vs. Sacramento St. were career-bests, as was 14 rebounds and five blocks vs. Dartmouth on Dec. 15...eight 20-point games and three this year (24 vs. Arkansas, 21 vs. Sacramento St. and vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff).

TURNOVERS BACK TO NORMAL: ASU has had less turnovers than its opponent in five of the past six games and in the past seven games is averaging just 12.0 turnovers per tilt. In the first six games they were at 15.5 turnovers per game.

JAHII UPDATE: Freshman Jahii Carson is averaging 17.7 points and 5.7 assists per game. According to ESPN Stats, no freshman has averaged 17 points and five assists in a season since Shaheen Holloway of Seton Hall in 1996-97 (17.3/6.3). Jahii has led or shared the team lead in scoring in nine of 12 games this season. He has 74 assists through 12 games, just about halfway to 150 which has been done by just 11 freshmen at current Pac-12 schools.

VS. UTAH: ASU records have the Utes on top of the Sun Devil series 26-18 in an old Border Conference and Western Athletic Conference rivalry that dates to the early 1960s...prior to the teams split last year with each team winning on its home floor. Utah and ASU had not met since the 2002-03 season prior to last year, with ASU winning an 83-79 double overtime game in the Maui Invitational on Nov. 27, 2002 and then the Utes beating ASU in Salt Lake City 79-55 on Dec. 7 (yes, they played twice that year)...ASU also beat NCAA Tournament bound Utah 71-62 at America West Arena in Phoenix on Dec. 4, 2001...current ASU radio analyst Kyle Dodd played in all three of those games...ASU has lost six straight at Salt Lake City...Coach Sendek had never coached against the Utes prior to last season...in the 57-52 Feb. 9 win in Tempe last year over the Utes, ASU led Utah 23-18 at the half. It was the fewest points allowed by ASU in the first half since a Feb. 11, 2010, game with Oregon State when it led 26-18...ASU held Utah to .304 from the field (17-of-56), the fourth-best defensive effort in a Pac-10/12 game under Coach Sendek...Jordan Bachynski notched his first career double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds in 30 minutes...Utah's 52 points, 17 field goals made and .304 shooting percentage (17-of-56) all were ASU opponent 2011-12 lows...Utah won 64-43 on Jan. 21, 2012 in the first meeting last year, the fourth-fewest points under Coach Sendek, as ASU had 20 turnovers, tied for the fourth-most under Coach Sendek...Carrick Felix averaged 14 points in the two games vs. the Utes last year, shooting 11-of-17 (.647) from the floor...Bachynski was 8-of-13 (.615) from the floor and averaged 10.5 points and 9.5 rebounds against the Utes...ASU was just 6-of-25 (.240) against Utah last year from the three-point stripe...last year Jonathan Giling was 3-of-10 from the floor against Utah and each field goal attempt was a three-pointer.

DEVELOPING BIG MAN: After not playing his senior year in high school (2007-08) due to an injury and then taking two years off from hoops for LDS Mission to Miami (2008-10), Jordan Bachynski (ba-CHIN-ski) is developing into a solid post presence. One thing to keep in mind about his development is how two of ASU's past big men developed, as in his senior year (2008-09) Jeff Pendergraph led the nation in field goal percentage (.660) en route to become the first pick of the second round in the 2009 NBA Draft, while Eric Boateng, who played for the 2012 Great Britain Olympic team, led the Pac-10 in field goal percentage in 2009-10 (.665)...has three double-doubles on the year and four in his career including a the first triple-double in ASU history on Dec. 8 with 13 points, 12 rebounds and 12 blocks vs. Cal State Northridge.

GILLING AND ABLE: Sophomore Jonathan Gilling has 93 rebounds (7.2 per game) after posting 54 all of last season. He also is 10-of-21 (.476) from the three-point stripe in the past two games. His past two games are his best scoring games of the season, as he had 18 at Texas Tech on Dec. 22 and 14 vs. Coppin State on Dec. 29.

CARRICK IS KEY: How big of a key is Carrick Felix to Sun Devil success in 2012-13? Consider this: he averaged 14.4 points in Sun Devil wins last year and 8.8 losses. How important are those 5.6 points per game? ASU's scoring margin in 31 games last year was -5.3 ppg.

COACH SENDEK NOTES...

FREE THOWS: NC State under Herb Sendek led the nation and set an ACC record for free throw shooting (.799) in 2003-2004. <u>That mark</u> is tied for tenth-best mark in NCAA history.

POINTS: NC State's 74.5 ppg. in 2005-2006, Coach Sendek's final team in Raleigh, would have been third-highest in Pac-12 last year.

NBA READY: Herb Sendek was one of just three coaches who had a NBA first-round draft pick in 2005 and 2006. Julius Hodge was the No. 20 (Denver Nuggets) in 2005. Cedric Simmons was No. 15 (New Orleans) in 2006.

HISTORY: Herb Sendek was the first coach to knock off the No. 1 seed in the ACC Tournament in consecutive years. NC State beat Maryland (2002) and Wake Forest (2003). Maryland was ranked second while Wake Forest was ninth.

DEFENSE: In Herb Sendek's 10 seasons, NC State led the ACC in scoring defense four times and held opponents to just 54.7 points per game in 1996-97, an ACC record.

FINAL FOURS: Herb Sendek has coached in two Final Fours (1987 Providence and 1993 Kentucky).

THREE: NC State averaged nine threes in 2005-06, best in the ACC and ninth in nation.

YOUNG TALENT: NC State placed seven players on the All-ACC freshman team under Coach Sendek, and James Harden (2007-08) and Trent Lockett (2009-10) have continued the trend in Tempe.

OT: ASU is 6-4 in OT under Coach Sendek, including 4-0 in 2007-08. Its last OT game was 73-72 loss to UCLA in Tempe (Jan. 29, 2011).

REBOUND: ASU is 10-0 this year and 83-21 under Coach Sendek when it outrebounds its opponent.

ASU: After posting just three 20-win seasons in the previous 25 seasons, ASU has posted three 20-win seasons under Herb Sendek in his first six years.

HEAD COACH: Herb Sendek, 109-98 (.527) at ASU, is in his 20th season as a head coach in 2011-2012 and has averaged 18.6 wins per season. He led the NC State Wolfpack to five straight NCAA appearances from 2002-06 and is now 363-256 (.586) and was 191-132 (.591) at NC State. The 49-year-old (born Feb. 22, 1963) Pittsburgh, Pa., native is the fourth-youngest coach in the Pac-12. Only Duke posted more ACC wins (regular season and ACC Tournament) than NC State's 53 from 2002-2006. Here is an overlooked note is his 10-year stay at NC State. To compare it to the Pac-10, since league expanded to 10 teams in 1978-79, only seven coaches have coached at their schools for at least 10 years: Lute Olson (24/UA), Ralph Miller (19/OSU), Mike Montgomery (18/Stanford), Ernie Kent (13/UO), Ben Braun (12/Cal), Lorenzo Romar (11th at UW) and Ben Howland (10th at UCLA).

EVAN HEATING UP: Evan Gordon started the year 7-of-34 (.205) from the three-point stripe, but he is 21-of-46 (.457) in his past seven games from long distance. His 29-point effort vs. Sacramento State on Dec. 1 is a career high including his two years at Liberty. He then came back with 20 vs. Cal State Northridge on Dec. 12 as he has 10 20-point games. He averaged 14.4 points as a sophomore at Liberty in 2010-11 and made 112 three-pointers in his two-year career. Evan led Liberty in scoring (14.4 ppg., eighth in Big South) in his sophomore year (2010-11) before transferring to ASU. He has 980 career points.

SOME NOTES ON HERB'S SCORING: It is early in the year, but in looking at the numbers easy to see that ASU is averaging 75.2 points per game. In Coach Sendek's final five seasons at NC State (2001-2006), his team's averaged 73.7 points per game (192 games) including 75.4 points per game in 2001-02. His final team at NC State averaged 74.5 points per game. How does that 74.5 points per game from 2005-06 compare to the current Pac-12? It would have been the third-highest scoring team in the Pac-12 in each of the past two seasons.

TOUGH TO SCORE: In his 619-game head coaching career, only three teams have scored 100 points against Herb Sendek The last team to do it was top-ranked Duke on Feb. 14, 2002 (108-71 at Cameron).

THE FIRST: Junior Jordan Bachynski's 13 points, 12 boards and 12 blocks vs. Cal State Northridge on Dec. 8 is the only triple-double in Sun Devil history. He set the school record with 12 blocks, topping his own mark of nine set in the opener on Nov. 10 vs. Central Arkansas. It marked the first triple-double by a Pac-10/12 player since Daniel Hackett had 22 points, 10 rebounds and 10 dimes vs. South Carolina on Nov. 17, 2007. The 12 blocks is tied for the second-most by a Pac-10/12 player along with Stanford's Brook Lopez, who had a dozen vs. USC on Jan. 25, 2007.

A 1985 graduate of Carnegie-Mellon (Pa.), Herb Sendek is 363-256 (.586) in his 20 seasons as a head coach and has an 109-98 (.527) record in seven seasons at Arizona State. Heading into the 2012-13 season, Sendek's 606 games as a head coach ranked third in the Pac-12 and his 352 Division I wins were fourth-best in the conference. He is a three-time Coach-of-the-Year recipient and has made seven NCAA Tournament appearances.




Sendek led ASU to three straight 20-win seasons in 2007-08 (21-13), 2008-09 (25-10) and 2009-10 (22-11), which had not happened since 1961-63. Prior to those three 20-win seasons, ASU had just three 20-win seasons in the previous 25 years.

Between 2007-10, Sendek led ASU to 68 total wins, a school record 15 home wins in 2007-08, seven wins over ranked teams, five straight wins against Arizona and six-of-seven overall, including three consecutive in Tucson, and a sweep of UCLA in 2008-09.

He was 191-132 (.591) at North Carolina State in 10 seasons. He earned Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year in 2003-04 and has taken 15 teams to the postseason. He posted five 20-win seasons, including his final three, while competing in one of the nation's most intense conferences.

After eight years as an assistant, including Final Four appearances in



championship. His three-year record at Miami was 63-26, giving him the highest winning percentage (.708) in school history.

Sendek has collected 36 wins over teams ranked in the top 25, including 16 over top-10 teams. He has had nine former assistant coaches (eight current) earn D-I head coaching positions.

He was one of only three coaches who had NBA first-round picks in both the 2005 and 2006 drafts, and then followed that up in 2009 with a top-three pick (James Harden at No. 3) and the first pick of the second round (Jeff Pendergraph).
