SERIES NOTES

- ASU has won 30 of the last 44 encounters, however Arizona has claimed victories in 10 of the last 13 contests including the last six meetings.
- ASU's 81-77 win at home vs. No. 6/7 Arizona in the first meeting of 2022 (Feb. 11, 2022) its last win over Arizona was the second straight upset of a Top 10 Arizona squad. ASU knocked off the No. 9 Wildcats 66-64 (OT) in the 2020-21 rematch in Tempe (Feb. 28, 2021).
- Arizona's 58-53 win on Dec. 29, 2019 was its first in Tempe since 2000. ASU swept the season series in 2015, 2016 & 2018 and split with the Wildcats in 2017, 2019, 2021 and 2022.

SKINNER EARNS BIG 12 WEEKLY HONOR

Tyi Skinner was one of two players who shared the Big 12's weekly player of the week honor, the league announced on Monday.

- Last week, Skinner extended her streak of scoring 20 or more points to three games after putting up a game-high 25 points vs. then-No. 10 TCU before dropping 22 points in an 85-73 overtime win at BYU.
- The graduate student scored 13 of her 22 points against BYU in the second half and led the team in assists (6) and steals (4). Skinner also went over 1,000 points as a Sun Devil and moved into second place on the program's list for most 3-pointers in a season.
- The first Sun Devil women's basketball player to earn a Big 12 weekly honor, Skinner went 8-of-9 from the FT line against BYU, including a pair of makes with 12 seconds remaining to send the game to overtime.
- Four games prior to Wednesday's contest at CU: Averaged 20.3 ppg, shot 44 percent 3FGs (11-25) and 91 percent (20-22) from the foul line.
- Coming into Saturday's game, Skinner needs six 3-pointers to tie **Katie Hempen's** single-season school record of 76 in 2014-15.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- Jalyn Brown (14x) & Tyi Skinner (12x) have combined to lead/tie for the team lead in scoring 26x. Other single-game scoring leaders: Nevaeh Parkinson (3x), Jyah LoVett (1x) and Kennedy Fauntleroy (1x).
- **Skinner** (25/29 games) and **Brown** (22/26 games) have combined to score in double figures 47x. The duo has also teamed up to score 20 or more points 20x: **Brown** 11x and **Skinner** 9x.
- **Brown** (959 points as a Sun Devil) needs 41 points to join ASU's 1,000 point club.
- Kennedy Basham has had multiple blocks in a game 19x this season, including a career-high seven rejections at San Francisco (Dec. 17). She has also had six blocks 2x, most recently at Oklahoma St. (Jan. 29). Currently with 74 blocks, Basham is No. 2 on ASU's list for most blocks in a season. Kali Bennett tops the list with 91 rejections in 2011-12.
- Basham has led ASU in rebounds in each of its last 6 games (averaging team highs of 9.0 rpg and 2.5 offensive rpg). That stretch includes 10 boards at Arizona (Feb. 8) and 11 at UCF (Feb. 12). Basham also scored 10 points at Arizona to notch her 3rd double-double of the season. In ASU's overtime win at BYU (Feb. 22), Basham scored 7 points to go with 9 rebounds and 5 blocks. She nearly had her fourth double-double (11 points, 8 rebounds) in ASU's game at Colorado on Wednesday.
- Makayla Moore was such a tremendous contributor coming off the bench, she has earned starts in each of ASU's last 4 games. In ASU's last 7 games, Moore leads the team in 3-point FG pct. (42.3/11-26), is 2nd on the team in 3-point FGs (11), rebounds (6.0 rpg) and offensive rebounds (2.8 O-rpg) and has averaged only 1.3 turnovers, the fewest of any players who have played the last seven games and have averaged 20 or more minutes during that stretch.
- Currently shooting 76.3 percent from the free throw line (368-of-482), ASU has a chance to lead a conference for the first time since 2006-07, when its school record mark 75.1 percent (571-of-768) led the Pac-10. That was the only time ASU led the Pac-10/12 in its 38 seasons (1986-87 to 2023-24).

NOTES FROM LAST MEETING @ARIZONA 66, ASU 59 FEB. 8, 2025

- Despite only having eight players available and playing in the kind of hostile environment reserved only for rivalry games, ASU showed tremendous grit in battling back from an 11-point deficit to tie the game after **Jyah LoVett's** 3-pointer early in the 4th quarter. In the end, its gallant effort was not enough. Due in large part to a 9-0 run that started after LoVett tied the game, Arizona was able to come away with a 66-59 win.
- The short-handed Sun Devils came into the game missing usual starters **Jazion Jackson** and **Kennedy Fauntleroy**.
- Tyi Skinner (19 points/10 in the second half), Jalyn Brown (18 points/12 in the second half), and LoVett (10 points/eight in the second half) carried much of the scoring load while helping keep ASU in the game as the trio scored 30 of ASU's 35 points in the second half.
- Kennedy Basham led ASU's rebounding effort notching her fourth double-digit outing with 10 rebounds to go with 6 points and 2 blocks. ASU also received solid production on the glass from LoVett and Makayla Moore, who had six rebounds each. LoVett came a rebound short of tying her career-high set earlier this season vs. Penn on Dec. 30.
- After making just one of their first nine 3FGs, the Sun Devils made seven of their last nine attempts (78 percent) from long range. What nullified ASU's tremendous performance from downtown over the last quarter-plus of the game was its inability to make shots inside the arc where they were successful on only one of their last 12 attempts.

WHAT IFS AND MIGHT HAVE BEENS

The Sun Devils entered the 2024-25 season with eight new players on the roster. With that have come the ups and downs that can sometimes go with combining the talents of several outstanding players who have not had a lot of time to gel. That factor alone could account for ASU's current record. With several near misses, ASU is much closer to being in the top half of the Big 12 than its current record indicates.

- Against Arkansas State, ASU trailed by 13 with 6:15 remaining. After a 19-5 run, ASU was up by one with 1:01 remaining. Arkansas State scored the last five points of the game to claim the win.
- After going into the half with a 42-33 win vs. Grand Canyon, the Sun Devils were outscored 37-17 in the second half.
- At Coppin State, ASU was unable to score in the final 53 seconds to break a 61-61 tie. The Eagles would go on to win in OT.
- Despite a stout defensive effort and a plus-12 advantage on the boards, the Sun Devils came up on the short end of a 57-50 decision at UC Davis. For the second straight game the Sun Devils held the opposition to the fewest points they had given up this season and allowed the Aggies to shoot only 37 pct. ASU made only 28 pct of its shots and knocked down one of its 14 attempts from long range. Down by eight entering the fourth quarter, ASU got within one possession three times late in the game but did not come away with points in each instance. After Maggie Besselink's earlier field goal got ASU within two,

the Sun Devils were only able to connect on three of their 14 shot attempts in the final five minutes of the game.

- At San Francisco, ASU was unable to take advantage of a 27-point performance from **Skinner** and a career-high and a tremendous all-around performance from **Basham**, who had 12 points, seven rebounds and a career-high seven blocks. The difference in the game was at the FT line where the Dons had more than 3x as many attempts (29-35) as ASU (9-11). Still, ASU was tied at 57-57 with 1:09 remaining. After the Dons took a six-point lead, **Skinner** hit two triples and missed a third that would have sent the game to OT.
- ASU came up short in what would have been the biggest comeback in program history in a 90-83 loss to Iowa St. (Jan. 8). Down by as many as 20, ASU was within three points with 13 seconds remaining. A win would have eclipsed the biggest comeback in program history: 18 points vs. Utah on Feb. 17, 2019, a game in which ASU scored the last 20 points of the game to edge Utah 60-58.
- At then-No. 11 Kansas State (Jan. 19), ASU trailed by two after one quarter, by six at the half and were able get back within seven three times in the fourth quarter after falling behind by as many as 17.
- Led Cincinnati (Jan. 25) by nine points in the fourth quarter. Unfortunately for ASU, a 23-7 Cincinnati down the stretch prevented the Sun Devils from coming away with the win.
- Despite only having eight players available and playing in the kind



of hostile environment reserved only for rivalry games, ASU showed tremendous grit in battling back from an 11-point deficit to tie the game after **Jyah LoVett's** 3-pointer early in the fourth quarter. In the end, ASU's gallant effort was not enough. Due in large part to a 9-0 run that started after LoVett tied the game, the Wildcats were able to come away with a 66-59 win on Feb. 8.

DYNAMIC DUO

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were dealt a serious blow when it was announced before the season that superstar guard **Tyi Skinner** would miss the entire season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who played her first two seasons at Delaware, joined Natasha Adair in Tempe after Adair was named ASU's head coach. In 2022-23, Skinner (2023 All-Pac-12 honorable mention) scored 20 or more points 15 times, including 29 points twice. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner averaged 19.3 ppg, (most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89). She concluded her first campaign as a Sun Devil among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), FTs made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG pct (34.7/6th) and FT percentage (78.1/8th).

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were left pondering, 'what might have been,' had Skinner been able to share the court with Louisville transfer **Jalyn Brown**. Much like Skinner in 2022-23, Brown emerged as one of the top performers in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. In league games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56). She scored in double figures 26x (12 20-point games) including the two highest-scoring games by a Sun Devil since 2000: 35 vs. Colorado (Jan. 7, 2024) and 34 points at Washington (Jan. 21).

Brown, who earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, went on to lead the team in scoring (17.3 ppg) and was 2nd in FT pct. (76.9), 3-pointers (1.3 per game), minutes (35.54 mpg) and FTs made (103) and attempted (134), 3rd in assists (1.6 apg), tied for 3rd in steals (0.9 spg) and 4th in O-rebounds (1.1 rpg).

In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Skinner scored a career-high 30 points — at the time the 17th instance she scored 20 or more points in a Sun Devil uniform — in ASU's 74-66 win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). Brown led ASU in scoring (24 points) vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Combined with Skinner's 16 points, the duo combined for 40 points in the game.

In ASU's 80-73 win over SMU (Nov. 16), Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) combined for 51 points. In addition both Skinner (8-16 FGs, 5-10 3FGs) and Brown (10-18 FGs, 3-7 3FGs) were efficient with their opportunities as they teamed up to shoot 53 percent (18-34 FGs) from the field, including 47 percent (8-17) from long range.

Skinner (25/29 games) and Brown (22/26 games) have combined to score in double figures 47x. The two have also combined to score 20 or more points 20x: Brown 11x and Skinner 9x. Brown's seasonhigh 32 points at K-State (Jan. 19) represents the highest single-game total by a Sun Devil this season.

HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR



- •On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- •Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- •In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- •In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils

overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points).

- ASU was once again hampered by injuries in 2023-24 as it lost leading scorer Tyi Skinner before the season started. Despite the injury issues, the Sun Devils still increased their overall win total and conference win total from the season before. Individually, Jalyn Brown flourished in her first season as a Sun Devil. The transfer from Louisville earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention recognition from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 notice from media who covered the league. In conference games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56).
- •In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- •Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All- Conference honors.
- •In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- •Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished 2016-17 with 17 wins, the most for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- •In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- •While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All- Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- •Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the

program to consecutive postseason appearances.

- •In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.
- •In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.
- •While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.
- •Adair previously spent 14 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with eight years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor five WNBA draft picks and several players who went on to play professionally overseas.
- A founding member of the Black Coaches United, Adair has been recognized by the organization, as well as Advancement of Blacks in Sports (ABIS), as one of the top women's basketball coaches in the country. Adair prides herself on being known as a game-changer as it



relates to social justice and creating a safe space for athletes to find and use their voice; where she was a guest on ESPNW's "Around the Rim" with LaChina Robinson and Delaware's UD Winning Women in Athletics: Trailblazers and Changemakers Webinar Series.

- •Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990- 92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994.
- •Coach Adair has two children, a son Aaron M. Adair (27), graduated magna cum laude from Johnson C. Smith University. A four-year member of the university's President's Council for his academic achievement, he also earned four letters playing for the men's basketball team. Daughter Allyssa M. Adair (19) is a sophomore at Texas State University and a middle blocker on the volleyball team.
