Sun Devils Left Inspired After Pac-12 Educational Trip to Alabama

SELMA, Ala. – Sun Devil gymnasts Izzy Redmond and Juliette Boyer, along with Office of Student-Development Coach Markisha Farrier, joined other student-athletes and personnel from the Pac-12, ACC, and Big Ten in a three-day trip to Alabama for an educational event that will prepare them to make an impact after their athletic careers.

The event started in Montgomery where they heard from keynote speaker Sheyann Webb-Christburg who is an author and in-person witness of the original Bloody Sunday Attack. They then took a visit across Montgomery and Selma, visiting key locations of the Civil Rights Movement such as the Edmund Pettus Bridge and the First Baptist Church. There they heard from Lydia Blackman Lowery, who shared her story of marching with the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. during the Selma Voting Rights March.

They also went to the Interpretative Center at Alabama State University, the Civil Rights Memorial Center, the Alabama Department of Archives and History, and the Equal Justice Initiative (EJI) Legacy Museum, where they heard from social justice lawyer Bryan Stevenson and they discussed their experience visiting the locations.

As President and Vice President of the Black Student-Athlete Association, Redmond and Boyer left feeling they were bringing back valuable information to help make an impact in the world. They each felt they had the necessary tools to help educate other student-athletes that it doesn't matter how young you are, you can make a difference.

"It shows that students everywhere have the power to make a change," Redmond said. "The idea that this is recent history, and when you hear about it, it's almost like this faraway distant thing but it's important for people to realize how recent it is."

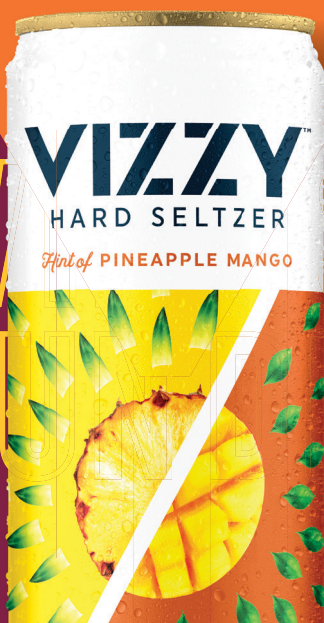

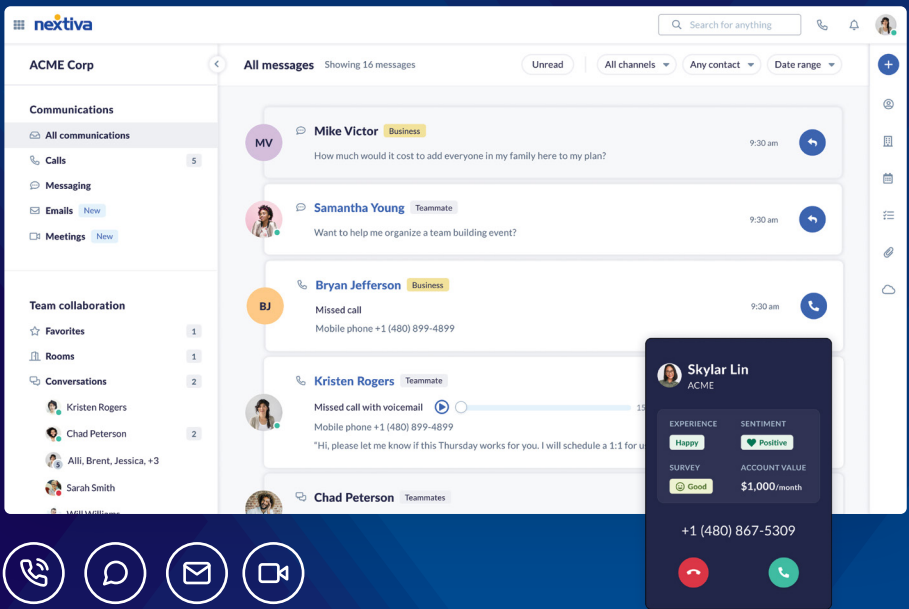
ASU's model for the New American University

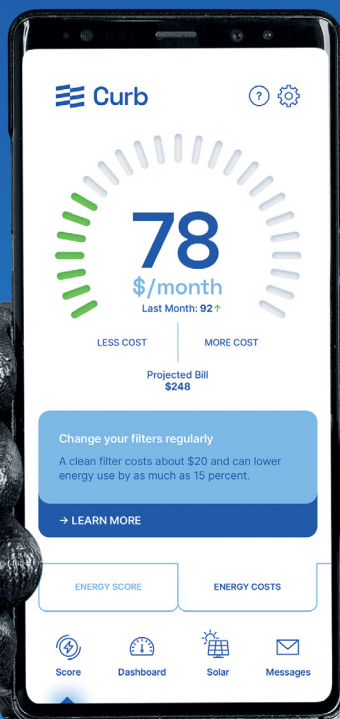

Sun Devil Stadium

Automatic Teller Machines (ATM)

Sun Devil Stadium has Automatic Teller Machines (ATM) for your convenience:

- **Main concourse** and the upper deck levels
- **Southeast Gate:** Located next to Carson Student Athlete Center

Banners/Signs

Banners and signs cannot be hung over any existing signage, block the view of another guest, or contain any advertisements or profanities. Poles of any kind or size are not allowed in Sun Devil Stadium.

Cameras/Photography

Fans are welcome to bring personal cameras less than 6" and do not have a detachable lens into Sun Devil Stadium. However, flash photography, monopods, tripods, and selfie sticks are not permitted in the stadium. Professional photography/cameras are not allowed in the stadium without a media credential.

Concessions

Multiple concession stands are located on all levels throughout Sun Devil Stadium. All stands offer a variety of food and beverage items. Some of the specialty concessions offered for the 2022 season include Chick-fil-A, Cold Beers & Cheeseburgers, Kona Ice, Someburros and Venezia's Pizza.

Elevators

Elevator access is limited throughout Sun Devil Stadium. Individuals with specific needs for elevator access to seating areas should contact Guest Relations for more information at (480) 965-3933.

First Aid

The AMR First Aid Stations are staffed by registered nurses and physicians and are located behind the south end zone, the northwest corner of the main concourse (behind section 12), the southwest end of the upper deck (behind section 201), and on the east side. Paramedics are available during all football games and regularly patrol the stadium.

Guest Assistance Center

There are Guest Assistance Centers located inside Sun Devil Stadium. They are located just inside the Southwest Gate and on the main concourse level and upper deck on the west and east sides. Guest relations representatives are available to assist with directions, seating issues, and any other questions or comments you may have.

Lost Children

Parents of lost children should contact the nearest game management staff member, including ushers and security, regarding their lost child. They may also go to the Sun Devil Stadium Police Station

located behind Section 12 on the concourse level for assistance or text SPARKY 69050. Please include your location (seat/section number) and issue (lost child).

Lost and Found

Sun Devil Stadium provides lost and found services for its guests located at the Police Station behind Section 12 on the concourse. Found items should be taken to this location or given to a game day staff member. Lost and found items will be logged and kept for two weeks. Unclaimed items will be donated to charity after the two-week holding period. To check on or claim a lost and found item following football games, please call (480) 965-3933.

Police

The Sun Devil Stadium Police Station is located on the concourse behind Section 12.

Prohibited Items

For the safety and security of our guests, all prohibited items must be returned to the owner's vehicle or discarded prior to entry. The following items are prohibited inside Sun Devil Stadium and are causes for removal. No refunds:

- Soft or hard sided coolers, ice chests
- Glass or metal containers
- Outside beverages
- Tortillas
- Balloons
- Use of tobacco products,

- Cameras with detachable lenses greater than 6" or video cameras
- Tripods, monopods, or selfie sticks for cameras/phones
- Full size strollers
- Backpacks, diaper bags, and other similar bags
- Bikes, skateboards, scooters, hoverboards, longboards
- Long golf umbrellas
- Pitchforks (metal, wood, plastic)
- Sticks, poles, or similar objects that can be used as a weapon
- Weapons of any kind
- Fireworks, drones, or laser pointers
- Artificial noisemakers (air horns, thunderstix, musical instruments, cans filled with contents, whistles, cow bells, or any other item used to make artificial noise)
- Pets/animals

Please note this list is not inclusive, as other items may not be allowed

Re-entry

Re-entry will no longer be allowed at Sun Devil Stadium as the safety of our fans are the number one priority of Sun Devil Athletics, a policy commonly enforced throughout the collegiate and professional sports and entertainment landscape.

Restrooms

There are restrooms located throughout Sun Devil Stadium. Baby changing tables are available in men's and women's restrooms throughout the stadium. There are family restrooms located throughout the stadium on the main concourse and behind sections 5, 9, and 17.

Seat Backs

Seat backs are available for season and single game rental at various locations throughout Sun Devil Stadium. Please note there are a limited number of seatbacks for single games available on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you would like to reserve your seat back, you can log on to www.sundevilseats.com or call (800) 510-5614.

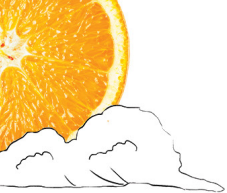

Super Bowl Sun Devils

The Sun Devils have had some great history with the Super Bowl.

Arizona State All-American Terrell Suggs was a part of the Kansas City Chiefs Super Bowl LIV in February of 2020, giving him a pair of NFL titles after previously earning a Super Bowl ring with the Baltimore Ravens back in 2013.

With Suggs helping lead Kansas City to a victory on the biggest stage in professional sports, the Chiefs became the 32nd Super Bowl-winning team to feature a Sun Devil. An incredible 34 Super Bowl rings have been earned by Sun Devils, two of them on the hand of Terrell Suggs. Suggs becomes just the sixth Sun Devil in history to win two or more Super Bowls, joining elite company: Darren Woodson (1993, 1994, & 1995 Cowboys), Mike Richardson (1986 Bears, 1990 49ers), Jim Jeffcoat (1993 & 1994 Cowboys), Grey Ruegamer (2002 Patriots, 2008 Giants), and Marvel Smith (2006 & 2009 Steelers).

HISTORY and TRADITIONS

Territorial Cup

Thanks to a historic find in a church basement several years ago, Arizona State University and the University of Arizona can now claim the oldest intercollegiate rivalry trophy in the nation. The Territorial Championship Cup®, which has been registered with the NCAA, was first presented to Tempe Normal School (now ASU) on Nov. 30, 1899, following an 11-2 victory over the University of Arizona at Tucson's Carillo Gardens Field. The Territorial Cup® was lost for a time and was discovered years ago in the basement of a church that was being demolished. According to the NCAA, the previous oldest trophy was the Michigan/Minnesota Little Brown Jug which dates back to 1909.

The Mascot

On Nov. 8, 1946, the students of Arizona State College voted 816 to 196 in favor of changing the school's nickname from the Bulldogs

to the Sun Devils. Phoenix attorney Walter E. Craig contacted a former classmate, Berk Anthony, who was an artist employed by Walt Disney Studios. Anthony designed the Sun Devil free of charge.

The Gear

Beginning in July 2015, Sun Devil Athletics embarked on its new, eight-year partnership with adidas with a goal of advancing the brand, including the use of iconic logos like the Pitchfork as well as historic logos like Sparky and the interlocking AS. The partnership with adidas set the standard for apparel contracts by creating provisions to adapt for the addition of sports and dollars allocated towards marketing and facility upgrades. The company has also shown its investment in Sun Devil student-athletes, giving them the opportunity to test and provide feedback on its latest performance gear prior to release.

of the school has changed. In 1952, a bomb destroyed the letter, but in 1955, the present "A", which stands 60 feet tall, was built using reinforced steel and poured concrete.

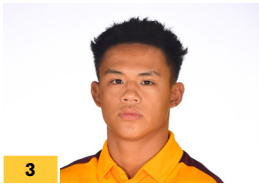

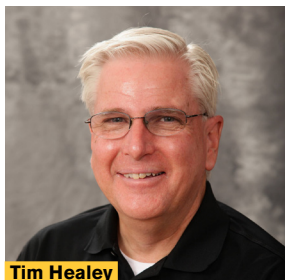

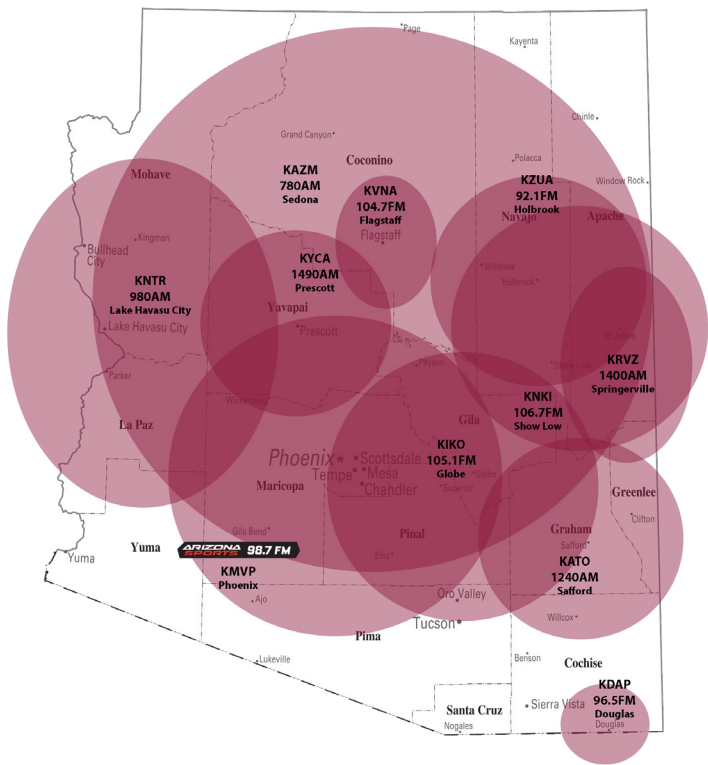

Multi-Purpose Arena

The new premier 5,000-seat multi-purpose arena on Arizona State University's Tempe Campus is home to Sun Devil Hockey, Gymnastics, and Wrestling as well as a temporary facility for the National Hockey League's Arizona Coyotes. The arena includes two NHL-size ice sheets, including the Mountain America Credit Union Community Iceplex which houses adult and youth hockey and figure skating leagues, games, and learn-to-skates.

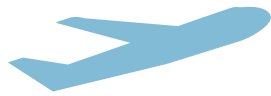
