## #BYTHENUMBERS

The Sun Devil pitching staff has inherited 66 baserunners through 14 games and allowed just 20 to score (30.3 percent), continuing a trend that began last season in which ASU inherited 205 baserunners for the year and allowed just 58 to score (28.3 percent). That total was the second-lowest of any season since 1998 (28.1 percent in 2010). Christian Bodlovich has led this charge in his time at ASU, inherited 34 baserunners and allowing just six to score (17.6 percent) - 1/12 this year. Will Levine has inherited 25 and allowed only 6 to score (6 and 0 this season).

The Sun Devils are playing 11 games over a 14 day span that began with the Oklahoma State series last week. The two games against the Cowboys marked the first of five games over a six days, seven games over nine and 11 games over the 14. All told, ASU will play 18 non-conference games over a span of 25 days to start the year. The team will finally get a four day break following its four-game San Francisco series at Phoenix Muni next weekend before then heading on the road to open Pac-12 play at Oregon State the weekend of March 18.

ASU has gotten exceptional efforts from its starting pitching with the starters combining posting a 3.74 ERA - and that includes a horrific finale against BYU. . Even with that last BYU game included, ASU still has a sub-four ERA (3.60) amongst its 12 starts this year. ASU has gotten five quality starts on the season with two from Friday-night ace Adam Tulloch and one each from Kyle Luckham, Tyler Meyer and Jacob Walker. The starters have 66 strikeouts in 65.0 innings and are holding opponents to just a paltry .218 average.

> Deuces have wild for the Sun Devils this season with ASU excelling in two categories on the year: doubles by the offense and double plays turned by the defense. ASU has turned 13 double plays on the year - good for 8th among all Division 1 programs. Additionally, asy has 35 doubles on offense so far this year - good for 10th in Division 1 baseball. ASU has doubled as least once in all but one game this season and has multiple doubles in 9 of 14 games. Will Rogers' six doubles are third in the Pac-12

### GAME NOTES/ROSTERS

NUMERICAL DUICK BOSTER

**PHOENIX** -- Sun Devil Baseball returns home after a five-game road trip and will host four games in the next three days over the course of the weekend, taking on San Francisco thrice and Missouri once before setting its eyes on Pac-12 play beginning next week in Corvallis against a Top-10 Oregon State team.

Originally planned for a four-game series against USF this weekend, the two teams welcomed Mizzou after the Tigers had to cancel their previously scheduled home series due to inclement weather conditions in Columbia. As such, both ASU and USF witll still play four games, just doing so with a regular three-game series against each other while each adding a double header day against Missouri. ASU kicks off the weekend against the Dons on Friday, March 11 at 6:30 p.m. AZT. The two teams will continue on Saturday at 6 p.m. AZT after USF plays the Tigers earlier in the day. ASU will conclude Sunday with a doubleheader, starting with USF at 12 p.m. AZT followed by Missouri shortly after the conclusion of the first game.

### On the Dons/Tigers

- ASU is 6-0 alltime in the series against San Francisco but have not played since 2010 an ASU sweep
  of two midweek games.
- The Dons are off to a 10-4 start and have won five straight, including a four-game series against St.
  John's last weekend and a walkoff midweek win over Fresno State on Wednesday.
- Like the Sun Devils, the Dons have shown plenty of gap power and are currently 13th nationally with 34 doubles. The team also leads the WCC and is in the Top-50 nationally with 15 homers.
- USF batters have been hit by 15 pitches this season, 10th in the nation.
- ASU holds a 4-3 all-time series advantage over Missouri though the teams have not played since 2009 where ASU took 2-of-3 in the DeMarini Invitational.

#### The Long Con-or

- Sun Devil super senior Conor Davis might be among the oldest players in college baseball, but there is not denying his impact on the Sun Devil program early on.
- After his senior season at Auburn was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Davis came to ASU as a graduate transfer expecting to fill some of the void left at first base with the departure of 2020 MLB No. 1 overall pick Spencer Torkelson. In ASU's very last fall scrimmage prior to the 2021 campaign, Davis blew out his knee and was forced to sit out the season with ACL surgery.
- Davis' appearance in the lineup on Opening Night was special regardless of the outcome but the "grandpa" - as his teammates call him - made it a night to remember as he launched a 1-2 offering to left field in his very first plate appearance in nearly two seasons - a solo shot that set the pace for ASU in a 3-1 victory.
- Davis has started the year with a team-best .370 average 11th in the Pac-12 to go with a .469 OBP and a .611 slugging percentage
- His four homers are tied for fourth in the Pac-12 and 55th in the nation while his .696 slugging percentage is ninth in the conference.
- Davis has drawn a team-best 10 walks including a four walk game against BYU that was tied for fifth in ASU single game history - which is good for fourth in the Pac-12 and has struck out just six times in 54
- While ASU as a whole has struggled advancing runners, Davis has exceeded and done so a team-best 20 times on 34 chances (.588) as he and teammate Sean McLain are the only ones to be successful over 50 percent of the time.

### Adam's Family

- Junior Adam Tulloch has been about as exceptional of a Friday night starter through three weeks as
  anyone could have expected when just a couple of months ago, it was unclear just who that pitcher
  might be.
- Tulloch has two quality starts in his three Friday night starts this year.
- In three STARTS this year, Tulloch has a 1.50 ERA over 18.0 innings pitched. He has 23 strikeouts while allowing just seven total hits and is holding opponents to a .117 average.
- Tulloch is currently 19th in the nation and third in the Pac-12 in allowing just just 3.50 hits per nine
  innings on the year.
- His 23 strikeouts are fifth in the Pac-12 and near the Top-50 in the nation and he has a 11.5 K/9 average.
- Opponents are batting a paltry .115 against Tulloch this season, the second-lowest tally among eligible Pac-12 pitchers and within the Top-25 of all pitchers in the nation.
- Tulloch has given ASU 6.2 and 7.0 innings of work in his last two starts, notable as he never eclipsed 5.2 innings in any game at West Virginia last year.
- At West Virginia last year, the 17th Round pick of the Dodgers struck out 52 in 37.1 innings pitched, including a 10-strikeout effort against Coastal Carolina.
- Tuolloch had a solid outing in Cape Cod this past summer where he was 10th among all players with at least five starts with a 4.03 ERA, finishing third in the league with 43 strikeouts over 31.0 innings.

### **GAME NOTES**

#### Big Sean

- Sean McLain became a staple in the Sun Devil infield and batting order last season en route to being named a freshman All-American, Pac-12 All-Conference selection and ABCA All-West Region pick. McLain enters the season as the No. 33 overall collegiate prospect in the 2022 class, according
- McLain's bat came alive during ASU'sf five-game road stretch as he went .455 with three RBI, a triple and two doubles to go with a .538 OBP.
- McLain, despite missing two games, has drawn nine walks second on the team - and has been hit by team-high three pitches as his OBP sits at .492 above his .362 overall average. The OBP is good for seventh in the Pac-12.
- McLain has been a part of seven of ASU's Pac-12 leading 13 double plays this season and leadss the Pac-12 with 46 defensive assists despite missing two games one the year.
- McLain recorded a 23-game hitting streak as a freshman last season tied for the third-longest at ASU since 1998 with Andre Ethier's 2003 23-game hitting
- McLain was a Collegiate Baseball News freshman All-American, an ABCA All-West Region first team selection at second base and an honorable All-Pac-12
- He was second on the team with a .322 average on the year, just outside ASU's all-time freshman top-10 in the category. McLain led the team in multi-hit games last year with 23. His 10 multi-RBI games were second on the team
- McLain had 17 doubles in the regular season, good for sixth in the Pac-12 and finished with 18 on the year - tied for third in ASU freshman history.
- He led the team with 24 hits with two outs on 66 chances (.364)
- McLain successfully advanced runners 50.5 percent of the time (54-of-107 chances) - second on the year.
- He turned 48 double plays last season, two more than any other player in the league even including those with runs to the College World Series and 13 more than any other second baseman.

#### I Love Lamp

- Joe Lampe has been a spark plug for the Sun Devils since he stepped foot on campus last year and that has continued this season.
- The sophomore showed off his toughness against #4 Oklahoma State, dislocating his shoulder in the first inning while attempting to steal a base. He popped it back in in the clubhouse, returned to the game and later recorded a single, stolen base and run scored.
- Lampe is batting .305 early on with a team-best 12 runs scored.
- He is tied with Conor Davis for the team lead with four homers also tied for fourth in the Pac-12. He has added four doubles as well to give him a .694 slugging percentage that is fifth in the league.
- He is also errorless in centerfield on 27 chances, already recording two assists to go with 25 put outs.
- Lampe was one of three Sun Devils selected to the Pac-12 All-Defensive Team after not posting an error in center field in conference games all year. He finished the season with just one error and a .993 fielding percentage and was also named a ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove Finalist as an outfielder
- In the opener against USC, Lampe recorded nine putouts the most by an ASU center fielder since at least 1998. Hunter Bishop had eight in 2019 and no other player had more than seven.
- Lampe did a solid job turning the order around in the nine-hole with a .383 OBP compared to a .294 average
- Lampe successfully advanced runners 53 times on 102 chances (.520) the highest percentage in the team. He was absurd at productive outs, recording 23 runners advanced with an out this year - five more than any other player on the roster. He was ASU's best player with a runner on third and less than two outs with 13 RBI - tops on the team - and a .684 average on 19 chances.

#### We Want EZ

- Ethan Long is tabbed as the No. 37 overall collegiate prospect in the 2022 MLB Draft class by Baseball America.
- The big bat was a little slow getting going this year, but Long bumped his average over 150 points during last week's road trip and now sits at .319 after he went 10-for-17 (.588) in the four games he played.
- Long made the transition to third base this season and so far has been largely efficient there with just one error on 25 chances (.960).
- Long became the 129th Sun Devil to be named an All-American last seson, becoming a consensus selection after being named to teams by Collegiate Baseball News, NCBWA, and Baseball America
- Also earned two freshman All-America nods (CBN/NCBWA) and was a First Team All-Pac-12 pick as well as an ACBA All-West Region second team selec-

- tion and Pac-12 All-Conference first team pick
- Long Finished the 2021 regular season 22nd nationally and second in the Pac-12 with 16 home runs while finishing 13th nationally and leading the league with a .725 slugging percentage on .340 hitting. He was sixth in the league with 53 RBI. His .340 average remained the same through the postseason, giving him the ninth-highest freshman average in Sun Devil history
- Finished with a team-best 54 RBI, tied with Barry Bonds for fourth in ASU freshman history while his 16 homers on the year surpassed Bonds for second in ASU freshman history behind only Spencer Torkelson (25) and good for Top-
- Behind Long's bat, ASU won five straight weekend series in the last half of the year. He began getting hot with his go-ahead two-RBI eighth inning double off potential Stanford All-American closer Zach Grech on April 16. In the 19-game stretch that started that night and lasted until his hitless weekend against USC in the penultimate series, Long bat .444 with 40 RBI, 15 home runs, eight doubles, a 1.181 slugging percentage, a .500 OBP and an absurd 1.681 OPS. Of his 32 hits in that span, 23 were for extra bases.
- Long was the only player in the Pac-12 to earn multiple Pac-12 Player of the Week nods this season, let alone three. He was the first Pac-12 player to win the honor three times in a season since Hunter Bishop in 2019. Andrew Vaughn of Cal was the last non-Sun Devil to accomplish the feat thrice in one season in 2018 when he was eventually named the Pac-12 Player of the Year.

#### Nate the Great

- Nate Baez earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention accolades as a catcher, despite only playing behind the dish for only the last month and a half of the
- Baez has shown plenty of poise as the the team's Opening Day starter behind the dish, recording seven assists, throwing out four runners.
- At the plate, Baez had the game-sealing grand slam in the rubber match against Dixie State and is batting .292 through the early going of the season - and tied for second on the team with eight RBIs
- Baez bat a team-best .362 over the final 14 games of the 2021 season with team highs in homers (8) and RBI (20) in that stretch while slugging a gaudy .915. All eight of his home runs came in those 14 games
- Finished the year with a .276 average with 26 starts and 41 games played
- All these numbers are notable as he didn't become a fixture in the starting lineup until the Cal series as he has fully taken on his role as the team's backstop, showing off his utility after coming to ASU as an infielder and spending much of his early career there prior to this current stretch.

### Welcome to the Jam

- The Sun Devils have made a recent habit of having its relief pitchers inherit baserunners and getting out of games with minimal damage done. Last season, ASU inherited 205 baserunners for the year and allowed just 58 to score (28.3) percent). That total was the second-lowest of any season since 1998 (28.1 percent in 2010).
- ASU's staff has inherited 66 baserunners this season and only 20 have scored (30.3 percent).
- Christian Bodlovich has inherited 34 runners in his career at ASU, with only six scoring (17.6 percent), including an 1-for-12 count this season.
- Will Levine has been impressive in the category through his career as well with only 6-of-25 scoring and none on six chances this year.

#### Playing the Field

- The Sun Devils feature a moderately new look infield this year with only Sean McLain starting the season at the position he started last year - second base. Hunter Haas made the shift from third to shortstop to start the year while ASU has "new" faces on the corner infield positions with Ethan Long and Conor Davis while catcher Nate Baez only played the position the final month of the year last season.
- Despite this, the Sun Devils are fielding .976 to start the year good for third in the Pac-12 and Top-50 nationally
- ASU has turned 13 double plays on the year a tally good for 8th in Division I.
- ASU has had one or fewer errors in 10 of 14 games this year.
- It's the same tale for ASU as last year, the Sun Devils were likely one of the few teams in the country that did not returning a single position player to their 2020 positions in 2021. ASU's only veteran starter was Drew Swift - who shifted over to shortstop this season after spending the majority of his career at second base.. All other positions on the diamond were replaced by newcomers.
- Despite that, ASU had one or fewer errors in 40 games last year during the regular season, going 29-11 in those.
- In 2021, ASU fielded at a very respectable .976 fielding percentage in the

- regular season good for 47th nationally. ASU was first in the nation with 60 double plays turned last season, which is especially impressive since the team had just six in the first 14 games of the season.
- Sean McLain (48), Drew Swift (32) and Hunteer Haas (12) all led their respective
  positions in the Pac-12 in double plays turned in the regular season. McLain and
  Swift were first and third in the league in the category, regardless of position
  incredibly notable as first basemen tend to lead the way in the area.

#### A Little Luck-ham On Our Side

- While Adam Tulloch has excelled as the Friday night ace for the Devils, Kyle
  Luckham has been no slouch either as he has locked down the Saturday starting
  role and given ASU a solid 1-2 weekend punch after losing four weekend arms to
  the MLB Draft this last offsason and waiting from Boyd Vander Kooi to return fully
  from Tommy John surgery.
- Luckham has given ASU 17.0 innings in three starts, posting a 3.18 ERA and a 1-0 record.
- He ha s struck out 15 to just four walks while holding opponents to a .220 average.
- His 7.2 inning effort against SDSU was the longest by a Sun Devil this season.

#### Tyler The Negator

- Transfer pitcher Tyler Meyer has been among the most pleasant surprises of the early 2022 campaign, showing off some midweek prowess that ASU has found lacking in recent years.
- In his three midweek starts against 2021 NCAA competitor Nevada, then fourthranked Oklahoma State and Preseason Top-25 UC Irvine - Meyer has a 2.45 ERA in 14.2 innings pitched with 16 strikeouts.
- He earned the win against Nevada and followed it up with only ASU's second quality start of the season against the Cowboys.
- It has been an especially notable effort as Meyer didn't pitch last season after his
  previous school, Stanislaus State, cancelled its season.

#### Mr. Rogers' Neighborhood

- Will Rogers came to ASU as a highly touted catching prospect and was drafted by the Brewers this offseason. In the offseason, Rogers did plenty to show his bat needed to be in the lineup, leading to him becoming ASU's day to day starter in left field.
  - The freshman bat got off to a slow start but he has rallied in recent weeks and is now sitting at a .269 average on the season.
- Rogers leads the team with nine extra base hits with his six doubles sitting
  Top-50 nationally and third in the Pac-12 and his three homers tied for 8th in the
  Pac-12 and giving him a .559 slugging percentage.

#### **Boom Goes the Dynamite**

- The Sun Devils are current second in the Pac-12 and Top-15 nationally with 15 home runs this season. Conor Davis and Joe Lampe lead the way with four, tied for fourth in the Pac-12 and 55th nationally
- The team has added 35 doubles on the year as well, good for 10th in the nation and first in the Pac-12. Will Rogers paces the team with six - good for third in the league.
- ASU has at least one double in all but one game so far this season and multiple doubles in nine of 14 games.
- The team is slugging at a .451 clip that is good for fifth in the conference and Top-50 nationally.
- ASU hit two grand slams (Will Rogers and Nate Baez) in consecutive innings (6th and 7th) in its 17-8 series clinching win against Dixie State on opening weekend. That was notable as prior to that, the Sun Devils had recorded just one single grand slam at Phoenix Municipal Stadium since moving there in 2015.
- It was the first time ASU had two grand slams in a single game since 2003 when
  the Sun Devils did so against San Diego State on Jan. 26 (also in consecutive
  innings in the 3rd and 4th). ASU is one of just three teams with two grand slams
  in a single game this season.
- ASU had just two grand slams total as a team between 2015-2021.
- It was the first time ASU had two grand slams in a season, period, since having two in 2014.
- Should ASU hit another grand slam this year, it would mark the first time since 2009 it has had three in one season and would tie the most since ASU had 4 in 2004

#### The Good News...And the Bad News..

- ASU has gotten exceptional efforts from its starting pitching with the starters combining posting a 3.74 ERA - and that includes a horrific finale against BYU.
- The starters have 66 strikeouts in 65.0 innings and are holding opponents to just a paltry .218 average.

- Unfortunately, while ASU's starters have consistently kept the team in games, the back end of the pen has struggled to bring things home. ASU has been leading tied or leading after 7 innings in 10 games this season but has lost five of those.
- The vast majority of damage done to the Devils this year has come prior to the
  pitchers getting two outs as the staff is limiting opponents to just 26-of-122
  hitting (.216) once it gets the second out of any inning.
- Offensively, ASU has gotten its leadoff runner on 42.5 percent of the time this season and sits 23rd in the country with 140 hits and has 10 or more hits in 5 of the last 7 games
- That being said, ASU is batting just .238 as a team with runners on the base path and just .239 (38-of-159) with runners in scoring position this year while advancing runners less than 50 percent of the time.
- ASU did have the two grand slams in one game against Dixie State which
  unfortunately are just two of ASU's three total hits with the bases loaded this
  year, going 3-for-17 (.176) in the scenario.
- The Devils have stranded 122 base runners this year (8.7 per game).

#### Big Willie Style

- One of the best players in the program's record books will start a new era of Sun Devil Baseball as Willie Bloomquist looks forward to his first season at the helm of the Devils.
- A 14-year Major League Baseball veteran and with over 20 years of experience in professional baseball, Bloomquist returns to the Sun Devils as one of the most accomplished alumni in program history and has remained deeply entrenched in all levels of baseball.
- Bloomquist spent five years as a Special Assistant to Arizona Diamondbacks
  President & CEO Derrick Hall after joining the front office in May 2016. In this
  role, Bloomquist assisted Hall and other departments throughout the baseball
  and business side of the organization, including working on-field with players at
  all levels of the organization, attending community events, meeting with corporate
  partners, interacting with season ticket holders and visiting D-backs Minor
  League affiliates.
- The Port Orchard, Wash., native joined USA Baseball's Board of Directors in 2016, a post he has retained since then. Bloomquist is a two-time alum of Team USA, having played for the Collegiate National Team in 1998 and for the 2013 World Baseball Classic.
- Bloomquist became the first Arizona State Sun Devil to play for the Diamondbacks and spent three seasons with the franchise from 2011-13, serving a key role on the 2011 National League West Championship team. In 225 games for the D-backs, he hit .289 with 36 doubles, 8 triples, 4 homers, 63 RBI, 43 walks and 27 stolen bases. In the 2011 NL Division Series vs. Brewers, he hit .318 (7-for-22) with an RBI and three stolen bases in five games. In 2012, he set career highs with a .302 average and 21 doubles.
- During his 14-year Major League career, which included time with the Mariners (2002-08, '14-15), Royals (2009-10) and Reds (2010), Bloomquist hit .269 with 778 hits, 110 doubles, 23 triples, 18 home runs, 225 RBI and 133 stolen bases in 1,055 career games. He compiled a .977 fielding percentage playing outfield (339 games), shortstop (305 games), third base (142), second base (141) and first base (47). Of the 111 Sun Devils to play in MLB, only seven earned more service time than Bloomquist.
- Bloomquist played three seasons at ASU (1997-99) and earned 1999 Pac-10 Player of the Year honors as a junior. In 1998, he tied a College World Series single-game record with 5 hits in a game while leading a team that competed for the National Championship. Bloomquist was an All-American in both the 1998 and 1999 campaigns. He finished his college career with a .394 average before being drafted by the Mariners in the third round of the 1999 draft.
- To this day, Bloomquist still holds the fourth-highest career batting average in school history (.394) while he remains fifth in ASU history in runs (216), fourth in triples (22) and fourth in stolen bases (72) and was named to the All-Packard Team in 2014.
