SUN DEVIL LACROSSE PREVIEW

Four-seeded Sun Devil lacrosse (9-9) dominated with 12 goals in the first half of game one in the Pac-12 Tournament, eventually downing the fifth-seed Oregon Ducks (8-7) 19-12 on Wednesday. ASU will face one-seeded and No. 19 Stanford tomorrow, May 2 at 4 p.m. MST in the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum. The game is set to be broadcast on the Pac-12 Network.

The 19 goals allowed by the Ducks was the second most they've allowed this season, their season-high 20 goals allowed came to No. 20 Colorado last weekend. ASU's 19 goals scored were the most by the team in their Pac-12 postseason history.

Program History:

The two teams have faced off 14 times in program history, with Stanford holding the 13-1 edge. The most recent loss to the Cardinal came just one month ago in Stanford when the home team took down ASU 20-8. The Cardinal won a fter a 10-goal third quarter proved to be the difference in the match.

Sun Devil Notes:

The No. 19 Cardinal are the eighth ranked team that the Sun Devils will have faced this season. ASU is 0-7 in their seven ranked matchups this season, and have not beaten a ranked team since May 5, 2022 when the team upset then-No. 16 USC 13-12 in the 2022 Pac-12 Tournament.

Scouting the Opponent:

Stanford rank in the top-10 nationally in a variety of statistical categories: Caused turnovers per game - 7th, Ground balls per game - 4th, Scoring margin - 9th, Save percentage - 10th, Scoring defense - 10th, Shots per game - 1st, and Shots on goal per game - 5th, 26.07. They had five players named to the Pac-12 All-Conference first team and one to the second team. They also had the Defensive, Draw Specialist, Freshman, Goalkeeper, and Coach of the year.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS:

- Senior attacker Mina Scott is 4th all-time in program history with 94 goals. She is 6th all-time with 120 points in the program's career recordbooks behind Kaylon Buckner's 138.
- Sophomore attacker Lydia Oldknow is also on the list with Scott sitting at 61 career goals, which is 7th place in the career recordbooks. Oldknow is 7th in all-time points with 86. Her 25 career assists is also 7th all time.
- Zoe Mazur's 149 draw controls have her on the single-season leaderboard, sitting at first all-time passing Maura Cissel's 111 draw controls which came in 2021.
- Mazur also holds the program's career draw control record with 312, almost 90 more than the next closest player.

PLAYER NOTABLES:

- Zoe Mazur's 8.40 draw controls per game are the ninth-best individual mark in the NCAA and second best in the Pac-12.
- Mina Scott now holds the team lead for goals scored with 46. Oldknow is a close second with 44.
- in the Pac-12 opener against SDSU, junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle hit the 400 career save mark and was the second active goalie in the Pac-12 with 400 career saves.
- Oldknow has nine hat tricks this season, which leads the team.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

- Katie Vahle earned the first weekly award for ASU this season after being named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the week on 3/19.
- Zoe Mazur was named Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week on 4/8/24 after recording 24 draw controls in two games. It was the first career Pac-12 honor for the graduate defender.
- On Monday 4/29, the Pac-12 Conference announced that Arizona State Seniors, Mina Scott and Zoe Mazur, were named the Pac-12 Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week, respectively, in the final awards of the regular season.
- The weekly award sweep for the Sun Devils is the first for ASU this season and is the fifth time in the Pac-12 that one team has claimed both awards. Arizona State has now been the recipient of four weekly awards this season, three defensive and one offensive award joining Zoe Mazur and Katie Vahle.

Sun Devil Athletics hired Taryn VanThof as the new Lacrosse Head Coach, Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson announced on July 5, 2022

VanThof comes to Arizona State after an extremely successful six-year stint as the Assistant Coach at national power Florida. There she served as the Offensive Coordinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator for the Gators.

“Thank you to Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson and Senior Associate AD/SWA Christina Wombacher for this opportunity to lead the Sun Devil Lacrosse program,” VanThof remarked. “I could not be more thrilled to coach at this extraordinary university.”

Under the direction of VanThof and Head Coach Amanda O’Leary, Florida has emerged as one of the nation’s premiere programs over the past six years. In 2022, the Gators made their fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament, earning a bid every year of VanThof’s tenure. She arrives in Tempe coming off two straight appearances in the NCAA Quarterfinal Round (Elite Eight) with Florida.

“Taryn VanThof is a tremendous addition to the Sun Devil Family.” Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson stated. “We identified her as the right person to lead this program on the rise because of her energy, passion, and desire to be at Arizona State.”

Prior to launching a budding career in coaching, VanThof was a standout All-American midfielder at Loyola Maryland from 2011-15. She competed at the professional level as recently as the 2021 season in the Athletes Unlimited League.

While she was an assistant coach at Florida, the Gators combined to go an incredible 85-24 (78%) from 2017-22. That stretch included five NCAA Tournament appearances, six NCAA Tournament victories, all five possible Conference Tournament titles, and two of the three Elite Eight appearances in program history.

As the Offensive Coordinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator, VanThof had an impact on all aspects of the program for the last six years. The Gators finished the season ranked in the Top-10 all but one of those seasons, proving to be one of the most consistent and well-coached teams in the country.

She began her coaching career at Rutgers in 2016, getting a taste of Big Ten action immediately following the completion of her collegiate career. During her only season in New Brunswick, she helped orchestrate a four-win improvement, with two Scarlet Knights named to the Big Ten All-Conference Team.
