MEN'S BASKETBALL BATTLES GCU AT FOOTPRINT CENTER

ASU takes on Grand Canyon at the home of the Phoenix Suns as part of the Hall of Fame Series

Sun Devil Men's Basketball will compete at the Footprint Center for the second consecutive year, this time taking on Grand Canyon on Thursday at 7 PM. Arizona State (2-1) will compete in the Phoenix edition of the Hall of Fame Series, which features highly-anticipated neutral site events throughout the country. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's team matches up with an in-state rival when they take on 2024 NCAA Tournament participant Grand Canyon.

THE MATCHUP

A Valley basketball battle will take place at the Footprint Center, home of the Phoenix Suns, as part of the Hall of Fame Series. It is the fourth all-time matchup between the two schools, two of which have come since GCU made the jump to the Division I level. Arizona State owns a 3-0 advantage in the series (not counting an exhibition victory), including sweeping a home-and-home set in 2020-21.

"We are excited for the opportunity to play GCU at the Footprint Center," Coach Hurley remarked. "It will be an outstanding matchup for basketball fans in the Valley. I've got a ton of respect for the program that GCU has built. We are always looking to challenge ourselves with these type of games in the non-conference to get ready for conference play."

this time featured on ESPN2 when they take on Grand Canyon at Footprint Center, scheduled for a 7 PM MST tip-off with Roxy Bernstein and Sean Farnham on the call. Make sure to listen to Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM (KMVP).

LAST TIME OUT

Head Coach Bobby Hurley's team went toe-to-toe with Top-10 opponent Gonzaga on the road. In one of college basketball's most hostile environments, Arizona State had a late second half lead and provided a scare into the No. 4-ranked Bulldogs. Senior forward Basheer Jihad recorded his 10th career double-double, finishing with 22 points and 10 rebounds. Senior guard Alston Mason was productive offensively, accounting for 19 points. Freshman forward Jayden Quaintance recorded two blocks to put his NCAA-leading total at 12.

DIALED IN FROM DEEP

ASU made 15 three-point field goals in the win over Santa Clara earlier in the year, tied for the third-most three pointers made in a single-game in the Bobby Hurley era. The last time they made 15 three-pointers was at the Pac-12 Tournament against Stanford back on March 9, 2022).

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Arizona State have been extremely effective on the defensive end, allowing teams to shoot 38.5% overall against them. In the first half of games, ASU's opponents are shooting a putrid 36.9%. The Sun Devils held Idaho State to 48 points in tonight's home-opener, tied for third-lowest points scored by an opponent since 2000.

BLOCK PARTY

Jayden Quaintance leads the NCAA in total blocks (12) and the Big 12 in blocks per game (4.0). He was credited with six blocks in his collegiate debut, the most in a single game by a Sun Devil since De'Quon Lake had seven against Pacific on December 22, 2017. ASU finished with nine blocks, more than they had in any game last year and the most since recording nine blocks in a road win over Oregon State back on Jan. 14, 2022.

PHENOMENAL FRESHMAN

Head Coach Bobby Hurley put together a Top-10 recruiting class, the highest in program history. It was ranked No. 9 by 247 Sports and No. 8 by Rivals and features a five-star recruit (Jayden Quaintance) alongside two high four-star prospects (Joson Sanon, Amier Ali).

IMPACT TRANSFERS

A five-man transfer class immediately bolstered the Sun Devil Men's Basketball roster. It is one of the premier transfer classes in program history. BJ Freeman, Alston Mason, and Basheer Jihad join the fold after leading their teams in scoring a season ago. Brandon Gardner and Austin Nunez return to Arizona State after making strong connections with the connections in their previous recruitment process.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Arizona State freshman forward Jayden Quaintance enters the 2024-25 season as the youngest player in college basketball. He is over six months younger than the second-youngest on the list, which is Duke's Cooper Flagg. Sunday's matchup features three of the five youngest players in college basketball.

FAMILY TIES

The Sun Devil Men's Basketball roster features several connections through bloodline. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's son, Bobby Hurley, is a senior guard on the team. Senior guard Alston Mason's father, Alton Mason, played at Arizona State from 1998-2001. Senior guard Jordan Williams cousin is legendary Sun Devil guard James Harden.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 157 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark.
