SCOUTING THE SERIES

The Sun Devils of the Wild West are suiting up for a showdown against the Mavericks at Mullett Arena as Arizona State ice hockey (11-12-0) hosts No. 17 Minnesota State (12-9-1) on January 13-14. Both matchups commence at 7 p.m. MST and air on Fox Sports 910. Friday will air on the ASU Live Stream and Saturday is shown on Pac-12 Arizona.

The Sun Devils and the Mavericks have met five times in the last five years and ASU has yet to defeat the Mavericks. ASU and MSU clashed in Mankato for a two-game series this time last year. The eventual championship runner-ups swept ASU in a duo of two-goal differential games. Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan each enjoyed two-goal games.

The 2022-23 season is the first time in program history that ASU plays against four CCHA teams in a single season. The Sun Devils faced off against Bemidji State (1-1-0) and Michigan Tech (0-1-0) and will host St. Thomas two weeks after the series against MSU.

SHUTOUT SEMPTIMPHELTER

After shutting out Air Force, 2-0, in the third place game of the Desert Hockey Classic last weekend, Semptimphelter boasts a career record of four shutouts this season and stied for first in shutouts in the NCAA. Joey Daccord currently holds the ASU record for most shutouts in a single season with seven in the 2018-19 season. Semptimphelter stopped 32 shots against the Falcons, his secondmost saves in a shutout behind his 40 saves against Bemidji State on October 7, 2022. Semptimphelter is also ranked fourth in the country for save percentage (.921) amongst goalies with at least 20 games.

MASTRO MAGIC

Senior forward Robert Mastrosimone leads the team in shots, points, goals, and assists. Within the 23 games that Mastrosimone has played in, he has 88 shots, 25 points, eight goals, and 17 assists. On top of these leads, Mastrosimone also leads in shots per game with 3.8. The Boston University transfer is revelling in the best statistical season of his career. Through only 23 games he outpaces all other seasons in goals and assists and ties his career high of 25 points in a single season from 2021-22. With two game-winning goals this season (at No. 6 North Dakota and vs. No. 2 Minnesota), he ties junior forward Ryan O'Reilly for the team lead in GWG. Mastrosimone is tied for the team lead in power play scoring with Lukas Sillinger. Each boasts three goals and six assists on the power play for a total of nine points on the man-advantage.

SENIOR D-MEN

Good things happen when senior defensemen Jacob Semik and Jack Judson are on the ice. The pair lead the team in plus/minus with Semik tallying a +9 and Judson shortly behind with a +8. Judson is having the best season of his season, slowly easing into the offensive defenseman role with four goals and ten assists in 22 games. Semik is the only skater on the team who has not been assessed a single penalty this season (Schoen did not record a penalty in his nine games before filing a medical redshirt for 2022-23).

SUN DEVIL NOTES

PENALTY KILL SUCCESS

ASU's penalty kill has found success as of late, landing in the top-10 in all NCAA penalty kill units with a 85.7 percentage (ranked 9th). The Sun Devils jumped up two percentage points after holding Boston College's power play unit silent last weekend. Heading into the New Year's Eve series, the Eagles boasted the sixth-ranked power play unit in the country, but were unable to muster a power play goal at Mullett Arena. On Saturday night of both the Minnesota and Denver series, the penalty kill unit held the top teams in the country without a successful man-advantage opportunity. On Saturday at No. 1 Denver, ASU survived seven DU power play opportunities. The group went on a 14-kill streak from October 29 against No. 6 North Dakota to November 18 at Clarkson and is currently on a 14-kill streak dating back to BC on Dec. 30.

MULLETT MANIACS

The Sun Devils have found the same home success famous at Oceanside Ice Arena at their new digs in Mullett Arena. The team is 8-4-0 at home with one loss coming at the hands of No. 2 Minnesota (who was ranked No. 1 in the Pairwise at the time). Both games against No. 2 Minnesota over the Thanksgiving holiday weekend were marked as sellouts. Saturday's game against the Golden Gophers was the highest attendance for Mullett Arena thus far at 5,153 fans. The Sun Devils have never been swept by an opponent on home ice in the Mullett Arena era.

OH, OH, OH, O'REILLY

Junior forward Ryan O'Reilly continues to make a scoring impact on this Sun Devil hockey team. Two weekends ago, O'Reilly racked reeled in goals in back-to-backB2B goals in their two games against Boston College. O'Reilly has also knocked home two game- winning goals this year. One against Colorado College on October 22, 2022 and another against Boston College on December 31, 2022. These two game winning goals also put him in second among all of Sun Devil hockey players with six game winning goals in his career.

ACADEMIC WEAPONS

Five hockey players recorded a 4.00 GPA or above at the conclusion of the Fall 2022

semester: Jacob Semik, TJ Semptimphelter, Tanner Hickey, Gibson Homer and Cade Stibbe. Twenty-four of 28 players are scholar athletes, which requires a 3.00 or above. This fall, the team tallied a 3.46 GPA, the highest met by the team in the post-Covid era. TJ Semptimphelter finished the semester with a 4.13 GPA and awarded the ASU Student-Athlete of the Semester for Fall 2022.

TIME IN THE BOX

A chink in the armour for ASU during the first half of the schedule has been penalties, and ultimately, penalty minutes assessed to Sun Devil skaters. ASU has sat in the box more than any other NCAA team, a massive 353 minutes so far this season. ASU's opponents have spent 239 minutes in the penalty box and averaged 4.48 penalties per game. ASU averages 5.00 penalties per game and 15.35 penalty minutes per game to the opponents 10.39 per game.

FACEOFF LEADER

Demetrios Koumontzis leads the pack at the dot amongst those with 169 attempts or more with a .514 success rate. He's won 89 faceoffs to 84 faceoff losses. He's followed by Robert Mastrosimone at .508 (67-65). Josh Doan has taken the most faceoffs for the Sun Devils at 363 attemps for a .499 percent (181-182). Ryan Alexander has taken the second-most faceoffs for 202 attempts for a .489 percentage (108-113).

POWER PLAY KING

Matthew Kopperud is encroaching on the program record for power play goals in only his junior season of college play. Through 76 career games, Kopperud scored 24 power play goals, just one shy of tying Johnny Walker's record at 25. The Denver native racked up 13 PPG in his sophomore year (2021-22) and seven in his rookie campaign. He's tallied four in 2022-23. He finished the 2021-22 season as the NCAA Division I leader for power play goals (13).

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his eighth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2022-23, and his 15th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year. as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Powers led ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents in 2021-22 for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their firstever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the commencement
 of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun Devil men's ice
 hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado Parkway on the
 east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and recieved its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena.
 Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- · A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.






