### **UP NEXT**

The Sun Devil women's basketball team (12-13, 4-9 Pac-12/#9 seed) opens postseason play on Wednesday when it faces Oregon State (13-12, 6-9 Pac-12/#8 seed) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament taking place at Michelob ULTRA Arena (Mandalay Bay Events Center) in Las Vegas.

For the second straight season, ASU's ability to consistently compete in conference play was impacted by the starts and stops caused by COVID-19. ASU was the last team to start league played after having its first six Pac-12 contests postponed due to COVID-19 protocols. The Sun Devils would go on to play the second-fewest number of conference games (12) of any team in the league.

As any team in the Pac-12 can attest to, navigating the path to a successful season can be a complicated endeavor when playing in the strongest conference – from top to bottom – in the country. Part and parcel of this for any team is being able to manage all the ups and downs that are inevitable for just about every team.

ASU's 'ups' have included a 57-52 overtime upset of then-No. 22 Colorado in the Sun Devils' Pac-12 'opener' on Jan. 21 and a three game-winning streak in early February that proved the Sun Devils were capable of competing with the nation's best: a 67-57 win over an underrated and talented Oregon State squad (Feb. 4), a 55-49 win over then-No. 19 Oregon (Feb. 6) and an 81-77 upset of then-No. 6 Arizona on Feb. 11.

What followed ASU's brilliant winning streak only reinforced how blurry the line can be when trying to separate teams in the conference as the Sun Devils would go on to lose their last five games of the season.

The slide started with what most would have considered – if there is such a thing – as an encouraging loss at Arizona, 62-58. The Sun Devils nearly swept the defending national finalist as they were tied with the Wildcats at 57-57 with 1:33 remaining.

ASU would be credited with three losses the following week, two of them decided on the court as ASU had to take a forfeit for a game it did not play at Cal (Feb. 16). ASU was snakebitten in the two games it did play on its road trip to Washington. At co-Pac-12 runner-up WSU (Feb. 20), ASU dropped a 65-58 decision in a game it trailed by two with 2:35 remaining and by three with 52 seconds remaining. Two days later at Washington – the same Washington team that nearly upset Pac-12 champion Stanford on the last day of the regular season – ASU was within a single point with 36 seconds remaining, only to come up short, 74-69.

The season would conclude with home losses to USC (60-58 on Feb. 24) and UCLA (59-52 on Feb. 26). Against USC, ASU was done in by a buzzer-beater. Down by five to UCLA with 4:09 remaining, ASU was unable to muster any additional offense as it missed its final eight shots and was not able to get to the free throw line.

Two important factors that played into ASU's last four losses were the loss of veteran post Jayde Van Hyfte (injured in final minutes in loss at WSU) and an injury to top reserve guard Gabriela Bosquez, who was having her best game of the season at Washington before being bitten by the injury bug late in the game. She would go on to miss ASU's game at USC.

### **SERIES NOTES VERSUS OSU**

- ASU's 67-57 win last month in Tempe was the first meeting between the two squads since February, 2020, as both contests in 2021 were canceled due to Covid-19.
- ASU has won 27 of the last 37 meetings, but the Beavers have gotten the better of it in recent years with wins in eight of the last 13 games.
- On the back end of the home-sand-home matchups in 2020, OSU's basket at the buzzer gave the Beavers a 64-62 win in Corvallis and snapped ASU's four-game winning streak in the series. The game that extended ASU's winning streak to four was the second of its consecutive wins over Top 5 teams as, two days after defeating No. 2 Oregon, ASU knocked off No. 3 OSU 55-47. ASU's win prevented the Beavers from becoming the No. 1 team in the poll the following day.
- ASU's 57-51 win in the 2018 Pac-12 Tournament quarterfinals snapped OSU's streak of seven straight wins. In 2018-19, ASU swept Oregon State for the first time since 2011 and became the first Pac-12 team to accomplish the feat since 2013.

### **LOVILLE, GILLES EARN PAC-12 HONORS**

Sun Devil women's basketball players Jade Loville and Mael Gilles were recognized by the Pac-12 on Tuesday as the conference announced its annual awards for the 2021-22 season as voted on by the league's head coaches.

Loville, who transferred to ASU last year from Boise State where she was an All-Mountain West selection last season, was named to the 15-member All-Pac-12 Team in her first year as a Sun Devil. Gilles, a graduate transfer from Rutgers, earned Pac-12 All-Defense honorable mention recognition.

In conference games, Loville led the Pac-12 in scoring (18.64 ppg) and finished third in the league in scoring for all games (16.92). Loville's 34 points at San Diego (Dec. 18) represented the highest single-game total by a player in the Pac-12 this season. Her 33 points vs. Oregon State (Feb. 4) tied for the highest single-game point total in Pac-12 competition. Loville finished fourth in the Pac-12 (all games) in 3-point FG percentage (43.7) and 10th (all games) in free throw percentage (75.9). Loville, who produced nine efforts in which she scored 20 or more points, scored in double figures in 17 of 23 games, including 13 times in the last 15 games.

Gilles played a major role in helping ASU allow 55 or fewer points 10 times this season. Gilles' tremendous versatility enabled her to finish among the top 10 in the Pac-12 in rebounding (fourth/7.67 rpg), steals (fifth/1.83 spg), offensive rebounds (fifth/2.54 rpg), defensive rebounds (sixth/5.13 rpg) and blocks (eighth/1.21 bpg). She posted five double-doubles and just missed the feat three other times. In ASU's three wins over ranked teams – No. 22 Colorado, No. 19 Oregon, No. 6 Arizona – Gilles nearly averaged a double-double (10.3 ppg/9.0 rpg). Gilles, who scored in double figures 10 times grabbed 10 or more rebounds 7 times, scored career-high 19 points and pulled down 10 rebounds in ASU's upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11). Followed that with 15-point performance (6-10 FGs) in the rematch in in Tucson (Feb. 13).

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- Through games played Feb. 28, ASU has an NCAA Net ranking of 45, one of seven Pac-12 teams in the Top 50 (Stanford 3, Oregon 12, Arizona 17, Utah 27, Colorado 29, UCLA 41). Of those teams, ASU has wins over Colorado, Oregon State, Oregon and Arizona.
- ASU has advanced to the championship game of the Pac-12 Tournament three times (2002, 2005 and 2007). It won the inaugural Pac-10 Tournament title in 2002, upsetting No. 2 Stanford 70-63 in the championship game.
- ASU also played in the championship game in 2005 (Stanford won 56-42) and again in 2007 (Stanford won 62-55).
- As of Mar. 1, ASU is ranked among the top third in the Pac-12 in offensive rebounds (3rd/13.12– rpg) and and scoring defense (4th/59.92 ppg).
- During the Fall 2021 semester, ASU had a team GPA of 3.73.
- In its last four games, ASU has averaged only 12.0 turnovers.
- In ASU's 3 wins over ranked teams No. 22 Colorado, No. 19 Oregon, No. 6 Arizona Taya Hanson averaged 15.5 ppg while shooting 43 pct from long range (6-14). In those same games, Mael Gilles nearly averaged a double-double (10.3 ppg/9.0 rpg).
- The team's active career leader in 3-pointers (139/3rd place on ASU's all-time list), Hanson needs 22 triples to tie Kylan Loney (161/2001-05) for 2nd place. The top spot is held by Katie Hempen (185/2014-16).
- Four players have led or tied for the team lead in scoring this season Loville (12x), Simmons (6x), Hanson (4x), Gilles (4x), Levings (1x).
- Defensively, ASU has given up 55 or fewer points 10x. In its 57-52 OT win over Colorado (Jan. 21), ASU held CU nearly 18 points below its scoring average. CU's 52 points tied its lowest point total of the season. It needed the 5 additional minutes in OT to reach that as the Buffaloes had 46 points in regulation. ASU held Oregon more than 24 points below its average in 55-49 upset of the No. 19 Ducks (Feb. 6).
- ASU has allowed 13 or fewer points in a quarter 42x this season.
- Two Sun Devils have started every game: Jaddan Simmons and Taya Hanson both returning starters from last season's squad.
- Transfers Jade Loville (Boise State) and Mael Gilles (graduate transfer from Rutgers) have started all 24 games they have played in.
- Maggie Besselink started first 7 games before getting injured. Jayde Van Hyfte, returning from surgery last year, started the next 15 games before sustaining an injury late in the game at WSU (Feb. 18).



### **PLAYER NOTES**

- <u>Jade Loville</u>: Has scored 20 or more points 9x this year and currently leads ASU in scoring (16.9 ppg/3rd in Pac-12), 3-pointers (38), FG pct (43.3) and 3-point FG pct. (43.7/4th in Pac-12) and is 2nd in FTs made (66) and attempted (87). On Dec. 18, Loville became the fourth Sun Devil to score 30 or more points since 2000, as the 2021 All-Mountain West honoree dropped 34 points (most in the Pac-12 as of Feb. 25) in ASU's win over San Diego (Dec. 18). She repeated the feat by accounting for 19 of her game-high 33 points (tied for 2nd-highest total in the Pac-12 this season) in the second half of ASU's win over Oregon State (Feb. 4). Loville scored an opponent game-high 27 points in ASU's upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11). DNP for precautionary reasons in ASU's contest vs. Colorado (Jan. 21).
- <u>Jaddan Simmons:</u> Leads ASU in FTs made (73) and attempted (101) and is 2nd in assists (2.8 apg/13th in Pac-12) and steals (1.6 spg/11th in the Pac-12) and 4th in rebounds (3.4\5). Averaged 11.5 ppg in two games vs. Arizona including team-high 16 points at Arizona (Feb. 13). Simmons averaged 17.0 points while shooting 59 percent (16-27) from the floor, including 62.5 percent (5-8) 3FGs, in consecutive contests at Arizona, at Washington and at Washington State.
- <u>Taya Hanson:</u> Is 2nd on the team in 3FGs (28), tied 2nd in blocks (0.6 bpg), is 3rd in assists (2.2 apg) & steals (1.2 spg) and 5th in rebounds (3.4 rpg). Hanson scored 17 points in ASU's win over No. 22 Colorado (Jan. 21) and in its win over OSU (Feb. 4). She tied her career high in rebounds (7) in the win over Colorado and again in ASU's upset of No. 19 Oregon (Feb. 6). *Hanson, who has made all 30 of her FTs in Pac-12 play, scored a season-high 19 points in upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11).*
- Mael Gilles: Currently paces the team in assists (2.92 apg/11th in Pac-12), rebs (7.67 rpg/4th in the Pac-12), offensive rebs (2.6 rpg/5th in Pac-12), steals (1.83 spg/5th in Pac-12) and blocks (1.2 bpg/8th in Pac-12) and is 2nd in scoring (9.8 ppg). Gilles has five double-doubles and has just missed the feat three other times. She has scored in double figures 10x including career-high 19 points (10-of-10 FTs) in upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11) and has grabbed 10 or more rebs 7x. Followed that with 15-point performance (6-10 FGs) in the rematch in in Tucson (Feb. 13). DNP for precautionary reasons in ASU's contest vs. Lipscomb (Dec. 30).
- <u>Jayde Van Hyfte:</u> The only Sun Devil on last season's roster to start every game in 2019-20, made her 2021-22 debut in the season's eighth game after not having played since the 2020-21 season opener. She had started 15 straight games before getting injured late in ASU's game at WSU (Feb. 18)... Was shooting 64 percent for the season (21-33)... With ASU up by one point, took a charge in the final seconds of ASU's 81-77 win upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11).
- Maggie Besselink: After starting the first seven games, missed ASU's next six games due to injury. She returned to action vs. Colorado (Jan. 21) and played until missing ASU's contest vs. Oregon State (Feb. 4). Returned for ASU's rematch vs. Oregon (Feb. 6) but has not played since. In per-game averages, Besselink is 2nd on the team in rebounds (5.3 rpg) and offensive rebounds (2.3 rpg). Her career-high 15 rebounds vs. Minnesota (Nov. 12) are the most by a Sun Devil this season. Besselink started 14/18 games last season and led ASU in rebounds (5.7 rpg/16th in the Pac-12).

Freshman post Meg Newman – one of the nation's most sought after players and ranked No. 6 at her position by ESPN.com – was lost for the season after suffering a knee injury during preseason practices. In addition, Isadora Sousa, another exciting newcomer, missed most of preseason workouts due to injury.

• ASU opened the 2021-22 season splitting its first two contests, defeating Northern Colorado 71-41 (Nov. 9) before falling to Minnesota 66-59 in OT (Nov. 12). Loville (16.5 ppg) & Hanson (12.0 ppg) both averaged double figures in scoring in the two games. Gilles averaged 7.0 ppg, 5.0 rebs, 4.0 blocks and 3.0 steals. Besselink had a career-high 15 rebounds vs. Minnesota.

- Despite a strong defensive effort, ASU was not able to overcome shooting 30 percent in a 55-44 loss at BYU (Nov. 17).
- Coming off a 13 pct (3-24) outing from long range at BYU, ASU came within one 3-pointer of tying the single-game school record after hitting 13 in an 82-53 win over Marist (Nov. 21). Ten of its triples came during a first half in which it shot a blistering 59 pct from beyond the arc.
- ASU went 1-2 at the Cancun Challenge played on Thanksgiving weekend. ASU started the tourney with setbacks against Houston (68-60) & No. 6 Baylor 62-52. In both contests, the Sun Devils fought back to get within single digits after trailing by double-figures. In the final of the three games it played in three days, ASU defeated Fordham 58-43. The Sun Devils entered the game with a record of 2-4. The win over the Rams started a sequence in which the Sun Devils went 7-1 over their next eight games.
- ASU swept its home tournament, the ASU Classic, defeating UTSA (68-44) & Harvard (91-54) to extend its winning streak to three games. Loville (13.0 ppg), Gilles (11.0 ppg, 8.5 rpg, 4.0 apg, 2.5 spg) and Basallo (10.0 ppg, 3.0 apg) were ASU's top contributors. Gabriela Bosquez (career-high nine points) and Imogen Greenslade (career-high 11 rebounds) both had strong outings against Harvard.
- Despite a (then) career-high 18 points from Gilles, ASU had its three-game winning streak snapped at Creighton, 69-62 (Dec. 12). ASU shot 47 pct for the game, its third straight contest shooting 45 pct or higher. ASU doubled up Creighton in scoring (24-12) in the third quarter to take a five-point lead going the final frame. Creighton outscored ASU 28-16 over the last 10 minutes the most points scored by an ASU opponent in a quarter this season to come back and claim the win.
- On Dec. 18, Loville became the 4th Sun Devil WBB player to score 30 or more points since 2000, as the 2021 All-Mountain West honoree dropped 34 points (most in the Pac-12 as of Feb. 19) in ASU's 79-60 win over San Diego.
- ASU was originally scheduled to open Pac-12 play with contests at UCLA (Dec. 31) & at USC (Jan. 2). On Dec. 24, it was announced the first half of ASU's road trip to Los Angeles had been postponed. ASU announced on Dec. 28 it reached an agreement to play Lipscomb on Dec. 30 in Tempe (ASU won 70-54). On Dec. 29, it was announced the second half of ASU's trip to the City of Angles would not be happening, either. ASU also had its next four contests vs. UW and WSU, at UO and OSU postponed.
- Coming off an unplanned period of just over three weeks without playing a game, ASU started Pac-12 play the final Pac-12 team to start league play with a 57-52 overtime upset of No. 22 Colorado (Jan. 21). It followed that with a 72-63 loss at home to Utah, a game in which ASU nearly came up with what would have been the second-largest comeback in NCAA Division I history. Trailing by 29 points with two minutes remaining in the second quarter, ASU fought back to get within six points with just over two minutes remaining.
- Playing for only the fourth time in 37 days, the Sun Devils fell at No. 2 and defending national champion Stanford 78-40 on Jan. 28. ASU was not able to play the second game it had scheduled while in the Bay Area after its game at Cal (Jan. 30) had to be postponed.
- In its first opportunity to make up one of its seven postponements, ASU came up on the wrong end of a 72-58 decision at No. 19 Oregon (Feb. 1). Gilles came through with one of her best all-around games of the season with team highs in points (15), rebounds (7) and assists (career high-tying 5 assists). Trailing by three points entering the fourth quarter, ASU was outscored 23-12 in the final 10 minutes.
- ASU entered its contest vs. third-place Oregon State (Feb. 4) having lost its last three games. The Sun Devils would respond to the challenge as Loville scored 19 of her game-high 33 points in the second half and Hanson knocked down 6 consecutive free throws with 17 seconds remaining to help ASU defeat the Beavers 67-57. ASU then evened the score with Oregon, upsetting the No. 19 Ducks 55-49 (Feb. 6). Loville scored 12 of her 16 points in the 2nd half and Basallo chipped in 7 of her 10 points in the 3rd quarter.
- ASU split its two games vs. No. 6 Arizona, winning 81-77 in Tempe (Feb. 11) and coming just short of pulling off the sweep, falling 62-58 in Tucson (Feb. 13). Loville (27 points, season high 8 rebounds), Hanson (season-high 19 points) and Gilles (career-high 19 points/10 rebounds) combined for 65 points in ASU's win in Tempe (Feb. 11). With the scored tied at 57-57 in the second game, Arizona scored five of the game's last six points to escape with an 62-58 win. Loville (17.5 ppg), Gilles (17.0 ppg) and Simmons (11.5 ppg), who led ASU with 16 points in the rematch, all averaged double figures in the two games.
- ASU's makeup game at Cal (scheduled for Feb. 16) was supposed to be the second game of a sequence in which ASU would have been playing 4 road games



in 8 days. ASU's flight to Oakland on Feb. 15 was aborted (mechanical issues with its aircraft.) While alternatives were explored to travel to the Bay Area and play the game, none were deemed to be in the best interest of the health and welfare of the student-athletes. Because ASU did not travel to California and play the game, the Pac-12 ruled ASU had to forfeit the game and take a loss in the conference standings.

• Despite a pair of stellar offensive performances from Jade Loville (13 of 21 points in the 1st half) and Jaddan Simmons (career-high 22 points/19 in the 2nd half), ASU lost at Washington State 65-58 (Feb. 18). Missed opportunities prevented ASU from capturing the win as it spent much of the 4th quarter either tied or within one possession of the Cougars. Two days later at Washington, ASU, similar to its loss at WSU, was within a single possession for most of the last five minutes. It even managed to pull even with after Taya Hanson's 3-pointer knotted the score at 62-62 with 2:17 remaining. The outcome was in doubt until the final seconds when the Sun Devils were not able to hit a 3-pointer to force overtime.

ASU continued to be without Maggie Besselink (has not played since Feb. 6 vs. Oregon) for both games and veteran post Jayde Van Hyfte did not play at UW after getting injured late in the game at WSU. In addition, Gabriela Bosquez, who was having one of the best games of her career vs. Washington, was forced to leave the game in the second half due to injury.

• The season would conclude with home losses to USC (60-58 on Feb. 24) and UCLA (59-52 on Feb. 26). Against USC, ASU was done in by a buzzer-beater. Down by five to UCLA with 4:09 remaining, ASU was unable to muster any additional offense as it missed its final eight shots and was not able to get to the free throw line

### **WELCOME TO TEMPE**

ASU added a quartet of talented and experienced transfers in the offseason who head coach Charli Turner Thorne feels has the potential to have a major impact this season. Three of the four transferred in April with 2020 Mountain West Conference Newcomer of the Year Ayzhiana Basallo being the first to officially join the program. Basallo, a 5-5 guard who will have two years of eligibility, arrived at ASU from San Jose State where she earned her degree in communication earlier this year. In her only full season at San Jose State – did not play in 2018-19 due to NCAA transfer rules and SJSU's 2020-21 season was canceled after only four games due to COVID-19 – Basallo earned the Mountain West Conference's Newcomer of the Year award for a season in which she averaged a teamhigh 18.5 points per game while shooting 44.7 pct from the field, 45.4 pct from beyond the arc (school single-season record) and 92.5 pct at the free throw line (school single-season record).

Jade Loville, a 5-10 wing who earned All-Mountain West honors last season, joined ASU from Boise State. In 2020-21, Loville, who has two years of eligibility, scored in double figures 19 times last season, setting the school's single-game scoring record with 40 points at UNLV on Feb. 10, 2021. She scored 20 or more points nine times and was named the Mountain West Player of the Week after averaging 26.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game in a two-game sweep of San Jose State (Dec. 31 and Jan. 2).

A 6-1 forward who originally came up through Canada's youth national teams Mael Gilles is using her fifth year of eligibility to play for ASU after spending the last four seasons with Rutgers (started 55 of 101 career games). Last season, Gilles averaged 8.1 points and 4.3 rebounds in helping Rutgers earn its highest seed in the NCAA Tournament since 2012. A starter in all 18 games she played in last season, Gilles notched six double-figure scoring efforts, including a season-high 16 points on two occasions.

In early June, ASU welcomed Isadora Sousa, a six-foot guard who played the last two seasons at Chipola College in Marianna, Fla. A native of Sao Paulo, Brazil, Sousa has twice been named an NJCCA All-American – third team in 2020 and second team in 2021 – by World Exposure Report. She is coming off a campaign in which she earned FCSAA/NJCAA VIII All-State, All-Panhandle Conference first-team and FCSAA/NJCAA VIII All-Tournament Team honors in helping lead Chipola to its seventh FCSAA Championship and an appearance in the NJCAA Tournament semifinals.

One of the biggest challenges ASU faced last season was overcoming its youth/inexperience as out of 120 possible starts, 95 were made by freshmen (62) or upperclassmen who were first-year starters (33). In addition to the talent they brought, just as important is the experience as Gilles (56/104), Loville (87/23) and Basallo (60/33) brought a combined 224 games of NCAA D1 playing experience, including 139 starts.



## **HEAD COACH CHARLI TURNER THORNE**



- The winningest coach in ASU women's basketball history and No. 2 in the Pac-12 in career wins (488), Charli Turner Thorne is at the helm of an Arizona State program that has qualified for postseason all but one year since 2001, including a school record six consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (2014-19), two Elite Eight appearances and three Sweet 16 finishes. ASU's 14 NCAA Tournament appearances under Turner Thorne are 11 more than what ASU had in the 15 years prior to her arrival in Tempe. Has also earned a pair of gold medals with USA Basketball.
- The 2021-22 season will be the 25th at ASU for Turner Thorne who has 528 career in 28 seasons as a head coach (includes 40 wins in three seasons at Northern Arizona).
- In 2020-21, Turner Thorne led the Sun Devils to a berth in the Postseason WNIT, their 20th postseason trip in the last 21 seasons in which a postseason competition has been held. It was also the program's seventh consecutive postseason appearance in which a postseason competition was held (six consecutive NCAA Tournaments 2014-19, 2021 WNIT). With its 66-64 OT win over No. 9 Arizona on Feb. 28, ASU has five wins over Top 10 teams over the last three seasons.
- After finishing with a 20-11 record in 2019-20, ASU extended its school record for consecutive 20-win seasons (seven) and finished No. 25 in the AP poll. The Sun Devils were preparing to make their school record seventh straight trip to the NCAA Tournament before the cancellation of the season was announced on March 12, 2020 due to the coronavirus pandemic. ASU became the first unranked team to defeat consecutive Top-5 opponents when it knocked off then-No. 2 Oregon (72-66 on Jan. 10) and then-No. 3 Oregon State (54-47 on Jan. 12).
- In 2018-19, Turner Thorne led ASU to a school record sixth consecutive NCAA appearance and 20-win season. The Sun Devils captured a pair of wins in the 2019 NCAA Tournament and advanced to the Sweet 16.

• In 2017-18, ASU matched the school record for consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (five) and consecutive 20-win seasons (five). ASU won 22 games and made it to the second round of the NCAA Tournament while posting four Top 25 wins, including a 57-51 upset of No. 10 Oregon State in the quarterfinals of the Pac-12 Tournament.

- In 2018 the Sun Devils also matched the school record with eight student-athletes named to the Pac-12's All-Academic Teams. ASU's No. 5 finish (3.672) on the WBCA's 2017 Academic Honor Roll represented the second time in three seasons the Sun Devils were among the top 10 programs in the country after placing seventh (3.558) for the 2014-15 academic year.
- Between 1996-97 (Turner Thorne's first season at ASU) and 2018-19, the Sun Devils led the Pac-12 in the number of first-team All-Academic conference awards (22) and the combined number of first- and second-team All-Academic conference awards (46). Note: As of 2019-20 the Pac-12 no longer distinguishes first- and second-team honorees in academics.
- Despite injuries to key personnel and a young backcourt, Turner Thorne led ASU to its fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance (12th during ASU tenure) and fourth-consecutive 20-win season (12th during ASU tenure) in 2017. The Sun Devils made it to the second round of NCAAs where they came up just short of upsetting eventual national champion South Carolina as the Sun Devils took a lead going into the final minute of the game.
- Was named the 2016 Pac-12 Coach of the Year (coaches and media), the second time she has been recognized with the honor (2001), after leading the Sun Devils to their second regular season Pac-12 championship. ASU would go on to earn its highest NCAA Tournament seed (No. 2) in program history. In 2016 ASU also tied the program records for most conference wins (16) and consecutive wins (15) and set the program record for most road wins (11).
- In 2014-15 Turner Thorne led ASU to 29 wins (second-highest total in school history), a second-place finish in the Pac-12 and a berth in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The 2014-15 Sun Devils posted the best overall start (18-1) and conference start (7-0) in school history and reached 20 wins faster than any other squad (22 games).
- In 2013-14, ASU recorded its 10th 20-win season (23) and its ninth NCAA Tournament berth since 2000-01. The Sun Devils advanced to the second round of the Tournament, the seventh time under Turner Thorne the Sun Devils have been among the final 32 teams or better.
- In 2011 led ASU to its sixth NCAA Tournament appearance in seven years and a third-place finish in the Pac-10, ASU's ninth top-3 conference finish in 11 seasons.
- In 2009 guided ASU to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament for the second time in three seasons. ASU's final 26-9 record in 2008-09 included a school record 15-game winning streak (tied by 2016-17 team).
- In 2006-07 guided the Sun Devils to a school record 31 wins,

including a school record 16 Pac-10 wins, and led them to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history. ASU concluded the 2006-07 season ranked No. 8 in the final USA Today/ESPN coaches poll and No. 10 in the final Associated Press poll, their highest FINAL rankings in each of the respective polls in school history.

- In 2005-06 led ASU to a 25-7 record. During the season led ASU to its first Top 10 ranking in 22 years.
- In 2004-05 directed ASU to a 24-10 overall record and its first NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearance in 22 years.
- Led her 2001-02 team to a 25-9 record, which at the time had tied the single-season school record for most wins.
- Guided ASU to a share of the Pac-10 title in 2001 and the inaugural Pac-10 Tournament title in 2002, the first league championships in school history.
- Started her head coaching career at Northern Arizona where she spent three seasons (40-40 record from 1992/93 1995/96) and led NAU to consecutive winning seasons in 1994-95 and 1995-96, the first coach in school history to accomplish the feat.
- · As a player, lettered four years at Stanford where she played three years under Tara VanDerveer.
- During the summer of 2009 Turner Thorne served as the head coach of the USA Women's World University Games Team which went undefeated (7-0) and captured the gold medal at the 2009 World University Games in Belgrade, Serbia. It was Turner Thorne's second time working with USA Basketball. In the summer of 2007 Turner Thorne served as an assistant coach on USA Basketball's U21 World Championship Team which won the gold medal at the FIBA U21 World Championship in Moscow, Russia.
- Is a past president of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) Executive Committee.
- · Graduated from Stanford in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and later earned her master's degree in education from Washington in 1990.
- Turner Thorne and her husband, Will, have three sons Conor (23), Liam (20) and Quinn (18).
