The 2016-17 Sun Devil men's basketball team (4-2) hits the road for another Eastern Time Zone game as it travels to the Bahamas to face top-ranked Kentucky on Monday, Nov. 28, at 7 p.m. ET on ESPN2. All five ASU starters (Sam Williams, Paul Williams, Alton Lister, Byron Scott and Fat Lever) in that game were future NBA first- or second-round draft picks. ASU 96, CAL POLY 74 (11/13/16): ASU led just 39-38 at the half as Cal Poly hit seven threes in the first half, but ASU's guards became hard to guard as the Sun Devils scored 57 in the second half and raced to a 96-74 win. Tra Holder posted 24 points, while Shannon Evans II added 20 and Torian Graham had 18 off the bench. Evans II became the first Sun Devil since Ike Diogu (Jan. 17, 2004 vs. USC) to go perfect in at least 12 free throw attempts, while ASU's 57 second-half points was the most in a half since it scored 58 vs. San Francisco on Nov. 20, 2009.

ASU 88, PORTLAND STATE 70 (11/11/16): Tra Holder (9-of-11 free throws) and Torian Graham (9-of-11 FGs off the bench) led ASU with 23 points, while Shannon Evans added 19 in the 88-70 win over Portland State to open the season. ASU hit nine threes, and Obi Oleka added 13 rebounds. PSU led for most of the first six minutes, but ASU pulled away to lead 44-30 at the half. ASU beat the Vikings 47-32 on the boards and got 30 points from its bench. Graham's 23 points marked the most by a Sun Devil in a career debut since Jerren Shipp had 23 on Nov. 13, 2006.

Sierra Canyon, will join the Sun Devil program in 2017-18. A four-star signee according to Scout, Martin averaged 14.5 points as a junior. Lawrence, a four-star small forward from The New Hampton School in New Hampton, N.H., is the nation's 54th overall prospect according to ESPN, while Scout.com lists him as the nation's No. 11 small forward. ASU had signed five ESPN top-100 players in the previous nine years, but now has signed five in its 2016 and 2017 classes. In the 1995 Sweet Sixteen in Birmingham the second-ranked Wildcats beat No. 16 ASU 98-73 in Birmingham and then on Nov. 25, 2002, the 15th-ranked Wildcats beat ASU 82-64 in Maui. Last year ASU fell 72-58 after trailing 32-31 at hte half.

KENTUCKY: ASU went to Lexington on Dec. 12, 2015, and was down just 32-31 at the half, 44-40 at the 13:34 mark and 49-43 at 12:12 but #5 Kentucky banked in a three-pointer to start a 19-5 over next seven minutes and won 72-58. Tra Holder led ASU with 15 points while Kodi Justice added 12 off the bench. ASU shot an uncharacteristic 3-of-9 from the free throw line in the second half (8-of-15 for the game).
