## QUICK HITS

### Winning Streak

ASU is currently on a five-match winning streak. Three of those five wins are against ranked opponents, making this season the first since 2018 that Sun Devils has defeated three ranked opponents in one season. The Sun Devils' winning streak is the longest since the beginning of 2018.

### Iman Isanovic

Junior outside hitter Iman Isanovic continues to remain in the top of the Pac-12 with kills this season as she has 364 this season, good for second. In Sunday's upset over Stanford, Isanovic had a team-high 19 kills and has now reached double figures in kills in 22 matches this season.

### She's A Freshman

Continuing to produce on offense and defense, freshman outside hitter Geli Cyr has five matches in a row reaching double figures in kills as she had a career-high 14 kills in Friday's sweep over Cal. Cyr had her third career double-double on Sunday as she had 12 kills and 10 digs against the Cardinal.

### No Sophomore Slump Here

Sophomore setter Ella Snyder has set the Sun Devils for success throughout the winning streak as she's had 11 double-doubles this season and had 46 assists in Sunday's win over Stanford.

### She Can Dig It

Junior libero Annika Larson is second in the Pac-12 in digs this season with 352. She had 18 digs on Sunday against Stanford and now has 16 matches this season with double digits in digs.

## Scouting the Opposition

### No. 8 Washington (16-4, 9-3 Pac-12)

- Over the weekend, UW was on the road and defeated USC in four sets on Friday, but they were swept against No. 16 UCLA on Sunday in Los Angeles. Sunday's loss snapped a nine-match winning streak for the Huskies.
- Last year, Washington made it to the NCAA tournament where the Huskies made it to the semifinals. UW finished first in the Pac-12 with a 17-3 record throughout the regular season of conference-only competition.
- This is the second time this season ASU will play Washington. The Sun Devils played the Huskies on Oct. 10 in Tempe where they came up short in five sets. Sophomore setter Ella Snyder finished with a career-high 51 assists and surpassed 1,000 career assists in that match.

### No. 22 Washington State (14-8, 8-4 Pac-12)

- The Cougars traveled to the LA schools last weekend where they split their two matches. They took down USC in straight sets on Sunday in Pasadena but came up short to No. 16 UCLA on Sunday in Los Angeles in five sets on Friday.
- Last season WSU finished fourth in the Pac-12 with an 11-4 record. The Cougars made it to the NCAA tournament and lost in the first round to Western Kentucky.
- ASU is playing its second match of the season against the Cougars after facing them on Oct. 7 in Tempe. The Sun Devils were swept by the Cougars, one of just two three-set losses ASU has had this fall. The all-time record between ASU and WSU is tied at 35-35.

## Weekly Awards

Junior outside hitter Iman Isanovic was named Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 25, and on Oct. 26 she was the Sports Imports/AVCA Player of the Week. It was the first offensive player of the week nod for ASU since 2018 and the first national weekly award since 2015.

## New Kids On The Block

There are eight new faces on the roster: five freshmen and three transfers. Of the five freshmen, one is a libero, two are outside hitters, one is a setter and one is a middle blockers. The transfers include two middle blockers and one libero.

## National Team Experience

Over the summer, Sun Devil Volleyball pin hitters Iman Isanovic and Marta Levinska played for their national teams in their home countries of Bosnia-Herzegovina and Latvia, respectively. Isanovic

helped her team earn a bid for the European Women's Volleyball Championship for the first time ever.

## Worldwide Sun Devils

The Sun Devils continued to be represented by countries all around the world. On the coaching staff, head coach Sanja Tomasevic is from Serbia and associate head coach Carlos Moreno is from Brazil.

On the roster, there are six international student-athletes. Jinna Zeng is from Canada, Ayyuce Altintas is from Turkey, Iman Isanovic is from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Marta Levinska is from Latvia, Roberta Rabelo is from Brazil and Beatrice Badini is from Italy.

## 2020-21 Recap

In the fourth season under head coach Sanja Tomasevic, the Sun Devils competed in 20 matches, all against Pac-12 opponents. The team went 6-14 on the year and finished in ninth place in the conference. The roster was made up of primarily underclassmen (82 percent), eight student-athletes making their Division I NCAA volleyball debut.

Arizona State earned two wins over ranked opponents in the 2020-21 season, beating Sweet Sixteen teams Washington and Oregon. The Sun Devils made history at Stanford this season, winning there for the first time since 1982.

## Pac-12 Honors in 2020-21

A few Sun Devils made a splash in conference play in the spring. Iman Isanovic was named to the All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention list last season. Marta Levinska made the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team after being named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week twice.

## Career Leaders

On this young squad, junior Iman Isanovic has the highest career numbers in multiple categories. She has 481 kills and 35 aces. Junior Annika Larson has 387 career digs and junior Shannon Shields has 558 career assists.

## Tried and True

The roster features 12 returning letterwinners, including the kill leaders (Isanovic and Levinska), digs leader (Annika Larson) and assists leader (Ella Snyder). Seven Sun Devils who started in a match last season are returning.

## Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 11th in the Pac-12 preseason poll. ASU finished the 2020-21 season in 9th place. Washington was picked to win the conference.

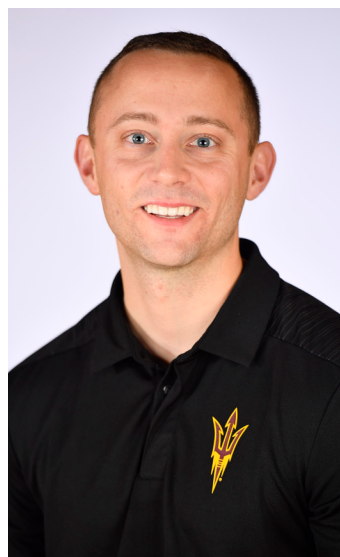

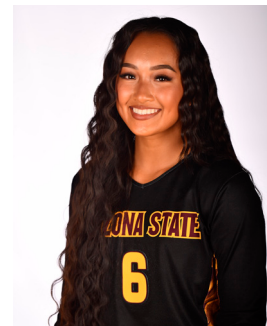
