**THE GAME** - Sun Devil Football returns home this weekend after a two-game road stretch to take on Oregon State on Saturday, Sept. 29. The game, scheduled for a 7: p.m. PT kickoff, will be broadcast live on the Pac-12 Network with Roxy Bernstein, Anthony Herron and Lewis Johnson on the call. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on ESPN 620 AM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, joined by Jeff Van Raaphorst and Jordan Simone.

**PAC-12 HOME OPENERS AND THE BEAVERS** - ASU is 28-13-1 all-time in its series against Oregon State with an impressive 20-4 record in games played at Sun Devil Stadium. The Sun Devils will be taking the field in the team's Pac-12 home opener this weekend, where ASU posts a 24-15-1 all-time record.

**HALL OF FAME GAME** - Sun Devil Athletics will welcome seven new members to the Sun Devil Athletics Hall of Fame during ASU's football game on September 29 against Oregon State.

Seven former student-athletes from six different sports will make up the 2018 class. Derrick Rodgers (football), Katie Burkhart (softball), Ashley Kelly (gymnastics), Jackie Johnson (track), Desiree Davila-Linden (track & field/cross country), Cain Velasquez (wrestling) and Francisco Sanchez (swimming) will be honored at halftime of the Sun Devils-Beavers game at Sun Devil Stadium.

The Hall of Fame Luncheon will take place on Friday, Sept. 28 at The Pera Club (1 E. Continental Dr., Tempe, AZ 85281) from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. The luncheon will include a formal ceremony into the SDA Hall of Fame by the ASU Athletic Heritage Committee.

The Hall of Fame was established in 1975 to honor the school's most distinguished student-athletes in all sports. The ASU Athletics Hall of Distinction, inaugurated in 1982, recognizes outstanding contributions from coaches and administrators. Student-athletes become eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame 10 years after their senior class has graduated.

No ASU running back has **lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 633 consecutive carries**, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 23 consecutive games. That includes 58 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only RBs on rushing plays and does not include RBs on receptions). The fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back. If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 972 carries over 35 games (since 2015).

Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of **125 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points**. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. ASU is 12th in the country among teams that have played at least four games with just 8 touchdowns allowed this season. ASU has allowed just 75 total points through the first four games of the season, it's best total through the first four games since 2012 (51 points).

N'Keal Harry **has a reception in all 29 games of his career** at Arizona State, tied for the seventh-longest active streak among all current FBS players. Harry is now in 5th place in program history with 166 receptions. He needs just two to tie Chris McGaha for fourth in program history. At 5.72 receptions per game in his career, Harry is currently the NCAA's active career leader in the category. His 73.7 career receiving yards per game are second among all active players. With 17 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 10th in ASU school history in that category as well and needs just one more to move him into ninth.

Eno Benjamin has forced **21 missed tackles this season (13 rushing, 8 receiving)** - leading the Pac-12 running backs and tied for 8th nationally. He has posted a for a 63.6 elusive rating according to Pro Football Focus, good for 14th nationally. Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 24.1 percent of the time - 11th nationally. 28.6 percent of Benjamin's rushing attempts this season have resulted in a first down or touchdown - a total good for 22nd nationally. Benjamin has been equally impressive in the passing game, currently fourth among the nation's running backs with 17 catches this season and his 23 total targets are fourth.

Kobe Williams has allowed just **six yards after the catch this season** - leading Pac-12 corners with at least 75+ coverage snaps and the 11th-lowest total nationally. Williams has been targeted only once every 11.4 coverage snaps this season (9 targets on 103 snaps), tied for the 5th-lowest percentage among FBS corners. He has allowed just 64 yards total when targeted, the 19th-lowest total nationally. Terin Adams **has been targeted just six times this season**, second among Pac-12 corners that have played at least 75 pass snaps and tied for third nationally among all cornerbacks with at least 75 pass snaps in coverage.

ASU is one of just 3 teams this season **to not give up a play of over 40 yards**, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). The Devils have given up just three plays over 30 yards, tied for eighth-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th. ASU is currently 29th nationally in averaging 7.50 tackles for loss per game (30 total) this season while the team's 144 yards lost on tackles for loss are good for seventh nationally. The Sun Devils are 12th in the nation in sacks per game, averaging 3.25 per game thus far (13 total).

- Terin Adams was the 2nd-highest graded defensive back in the Pac-12 during week four by Pro Football Focus, receiving a 70.7 overall rating for his performance against Washington. His 74.9 pass coverage grade was the highest in the league for the week.
- ASU has just two turnovers this season - tied for third nationally. ASU has outscored opponents 21-0 on points off turnovers on the year.
- Cohl Cabral is the nation's 12th-highest graded center as a pass blocker and the highest rated center in the Pac-12 with a score of 83.6.
- Kobe Williams has allowed just six yards after the catch this season - leading Pac-12 corners with at least 75+ coverage snaps and good for the 11th-lowest total nationally.

- ASU is one of just 3 teams this season to not give up a play of over 40 yards, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively).
- N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 29 games of his career at Arizona State, the seventh-longest active streak of games for any returning player in the NCAA.
- Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 125 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points.



## FOCUSING ON FOOTBALL

- » Terin Adams was the 2nd-highest graded defensive back in the Pac-12 during Week Four by Pro Football Focus, receiving a 70.7 overall rating for his performance against Washington. His 74.9 pass coverage grade was the highest in the league for the week.
- » Demonte King was ASU's highest-graded player on either side of the ball, with a 72.9 overall score that was fourth among all Pac-12 safeties for the week. His 79.8 score in run defense was the highest among Pac-12 safeties for the week and four points higher than any other safety in the league.
- » During Week 4 against Washington, Eno Benjamin posted the 9th-highest rushing/receiving score out of all Power Five running backs that played at least 25 snaps according to Pro Football Focus (67.5).
- » Khaylan Kearsse-Thomas was the Pac-12 highest graded inside linebacker on run defense during Week 4 against Washington, finishing with a 86.1 overall score. His 75.2 overall score was third-highest among Pac-12 inside linebackers for the week.
- » Cohl Cabral is the nation's 12th-highest graded center as a pass blocker and the highest rated center in the Pac-12 with a score of 83.6.

## GOLD ZONE

- » ASU had its streak of 64 consecutive successful red zone scoring drives (excluding game-ending kneel-downs) come to a end during the second quarter against San Diego State - a streak that dated back to the first half of the team's contest at Washington in 2016.
- » However, ASU has scored on 91.7 percent of its red zone trips (11-of-12) this season, good for 32nd nationally.
- » ASU finished fifth nationally in converting on 96.23 percent of its red zone appearances last season (51-of-53). HOWEVER, the Devils took a knee in the red zone in the final seconds of the team's victories over fifth-ranked Washington and in the Territorial Cup contest against Arizona.
- » The Sun Devils scored on 43-of-47 trips to the red zone in 2016 (91.5 percent), a total that ranked 10th in the nation.
- » ASU is the only team in the country to be ranked in the Top 10 in red zone scoring in each of the past two seasons.

## DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.
- » ASU is currently 29th nationally in averaging 7.50 tackles for loss per game (30 total) this season while the team's 144 yards lost on tackles for loss are good for seventh nationally.
- » The Sun Devils are 12th in the nation in sacks per game, averaging 3.25 per game thus far (13 total).
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.

## DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » Among team's that have played at least four games, ASU is 23rd nationally in scoring defense (18.8 points per game).
- » The Sun Devils did not allow a single point in the first quarter of games against non-conference opponents.
- » ASU is 12th in the country among teams that have played at least four games with just 8 touchdowns allowed this season.
- » ASU has allowed just 75 total points through the first four games of the season, it's best total through the first four games since 2012 (51 points).

## HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 633 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 23 consecutive games. That includes 58 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions).
- » Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play

to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 972 carries over 35 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.

- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.
- » ASU has just two turnovers this season - tied for third nationally. ASU has outscored opponents 21-0 on points off turnovers on the year.

## HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is currently seventh in program history with 6,661 career passing yards and he needs just 251 to move into the top five in program history.
- » His 551 career completions are good for sixth in program history.
- » Wilkins has 14 rushing touchdowns in his career, moving into a tie among all ASU quarterbacks for second in school history with Danny White (Mark Malone, 21). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins broke the school record for most consecutive pass attempts without an interception last season at 192 between the end of the 2016 season and the first half of last year, breaking Rudy Carpenter's previous school record of 149 from the end of 2005 to 2006. He has just one interception this season, tied for the 16th fewest in the country this season.
- » With his passing touchdown to Brandon Aiyuk in the first quarter against SDSU, Manny Wilkins notched his 50th career touchdown accounted for (38 passing, 12 rushing). Wilkins added a rushing TD and one more passing TD in the fourth quarter now giving him 53 career touchdowns (39 passing and 14 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 96.2 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 29th best total in the country (and 17th among QBs with at least 250 dropbacks).
- » The Sun Devil offense has scored a successful play (as graded by Pro Football Focus) on 39.8 percent of Wilkins' passing attempts this season - the 25th-best total among all quarterbacks in the FBS.
- » Wilkins has a 137.0 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the second-best total in the country and over 40 points higher than the national average of 90.7.
- » Wilkins has been pressured on 30.4 percent of his dropbacks this season (14th nationally) but has just a 10.4 sack percentage that sits as the 8th-lowest total in the nation. His 71.5 NFL QB rating under pressure is 13th nationally.
- » Wilkins is 12th nationally in adjusted completion percentage (73.8 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.

## DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 29 games of his career at Arizona State, tied for the seventh-longest active streak among all current FBS players.
- » N'Keal Harry is now in 5th place in program history with 166 receptions. He needs just two to tie Chris McGaha for fourth in program history.
- » Harry is currently 10th in school history with 2,136 career receiving yards.
- » At 5.72 receptions for game in his career, Harry is currently the NCAA's active career leader in the category. His 73.7 career receiving yards per game are second among all active players.
- » With 17 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 10th in ASU school history in that category as well and needs just one more to move him into ninth.
- » Harry has at least one touchdown reception in 7 of last 9 games. He has 9 touchdown receptions in those 9 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.
- » Harry has a 124.5 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for sixth nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.
- » Harry has forced 9 missed tackles this season, which is good for sixth-most among all FBS receivers.





## GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » During Week One, the Sun Devils averaged 8.1 yards per attempt on the ground - good for 15th nationally. The offensive line played a big role in that, as ASU led the FBS this week in yards gained before contact at 3.9 yards per carry.

## KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 125 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 70 of those games (57.0 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.

## THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 11 tackles this season - tied for fifth among all FBS corners.
- » Lucas has allowed just a 49.5 NFL QB rating when targetted this season - good for fifth in the Pac-12 (23rd nationally) among corners that have played at least 50 percent of their snaps in coverage. In coverage, opposing quarterbacks are just 10-of-19 for 116 yards and no interceptions while Lucas has one interception.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014 .He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.
- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference - regardless of year.

## MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 608-328 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 68.0 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (102 of 150) while finding the end zone 78 times in that span (52.0 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 51.4 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (55 of 107) with 43 touchdowns (40.2 percent).

## ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin has forced 21 missed tackles this season (13 rushing, 8 receiving) - leading the Pac-12 running backs and tied for 8th nationally.
- » He has posted a for a 63.6 elusive rating according to Pro Football Focus, good for 14th nationally.
- » Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 24.1 percent of the time - 11th nationally.
- » 28.6 percent of Benjamin's rushing attempts this season have resulted in a first down or touchdown - a total good for the 22nd-highest percentage nationally.
- » Benjamin has been equally impressive in the passing game, currently fourth among the nation's running backs with 17 catches this season and his 23 total targets are fourth nationally.

- » He has an offensive success score of 39.1 percent as a receiver, according to PFF (which measures plays that are considered a "win" by the offense), a total good for 17th nationally.
- » 41.2 percent of his receptions have resulted in a first down or touchdown, good for 19th nationally.

## A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 17 interception returns for touchdowns in the last seven seasons, good for third in the nation behind only Alabama (19) and Ohio State (17) in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 94 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 21 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (27), Alabama (25) and Boise State (24).

## NO FLY ZONE

- » Kobe Williams has allowed just six yards after the catch this season - leading Pac-12 corners with at least 75+ coverage snaps and good for the 11th-lowest total nationally.
- » Williams has been targetted just once every 11.4 coverage snaps this season (9 targets on 103 snaps), tied for the fifth-lowest percentage among all FBS corners. He has allowed just 64 yards total when targetted this season, the 19th-lowest total nationally.
- » Terin Adams has been targetted just six times this season, second among Pac-12 corners that have played at least 75 pass snaps and tied for third nationally among all cornerbacks with at least 75 pass snaps in coverage.

## KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » Jalen Bates is tied for third among 3-4 defensive ends with 7 QB pressures this season for a 8.5 pass rush productivity score that is good for second nationally.
- » Jalen Harvey leads the Pac-12's safeties (and is 15th nationally) in run-stop percentage within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage (9.4 percent). He has six "stops" in the run game - or a play that Pro Football Focus considers a "loss for the offense" - and is third among safeties in the league with 13 tackles on running plays.
- » Shannon Forman is currently 6th nationally among 3-4 defensive ends in Pro Football Focus' run-stop percentage, logging six tackles in rush defense - all of which constituting as a "stop" - and a 7.1 stop percentage.
- » ASU is one of just 3 teams this season to not give up a play of over 40 yards, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively).
- » The Devils have given up just three plays over 30 yards, tied for eighth-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.

## RUIZ'S PIECES

- » Brandon Ruiz connected on all three of his field goal attempts (49, 24, 28), including the game-winning kick from 28 yards as time expired in ASU's 16-13 upset of then-No. 15 Michigan State to earn Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week Honors for the third time in his career.
- » Ruiz is 13th nationally with a 80.0 percent touchback percentage this season (16 of 20).
- » Ruiz is one of just 17 placekickers in the country to have no missed a field goal this season.

## DON'T SLEEP ON HIM

- » Michael Sleep-Dalton is tied for fourth in the nation this season with 11 punts downed inside the 20 yard line.
- » He is currently 26th nationally (third in Pac-12) in averaging 43.6 yards per punt and 13th nationally with his 42.5 net yards per punt as well.
- » Sleep-Dalton is tied for 14th nationally with just 20 yards allowed on punt returns this season, coming on just five total punt returns.

#### General

The Sun Devil Athletics media relations staff understands the importance of assisting the media in providing coverage of the institution, its athletics programs, administrators, coaches and student-athletes. We pride ourselves in being able to disseminate information as widely, uniformly and fairly as possible using normally accepted media standards. To this end, the best attempt will be made to fill reasonable requests by recognized media outlets. Members of the media are encouraged to work with the Sun Devil Football media relations staff to assist in that endeavor. It is not permissible for media members to contact any athletics department administrator, associate, coach or student-athlete directly without working through the media relations department.

#### Practice Policies

Due to the nature of Arizona State game dates this season, practices schedules each week will vary dependent upon that week's game. The ASU media relations office will provide a practice schedule prior to each game week for the media.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4. At the conclusion of Period 3, a member of the media relations staff will escort the media out of practice. The typical viewing period will last approximately 35-40 minutes.

No member of the media may shoot any portion of practice that includes team activities (anything 11-on-11) or that includes any play-calling signals and/or audio. Members of the media may only photograph and shoot individual or positions groups working separate of a team setting.

Viewing periods are always subject to the discretion of the Sun Devil Football coaching staff and may change suddenly. Following that open viewing period, the members of the media will be escorted out of the facility and reconvene at the Student-Athlete Facility on the north end of Sun Devil Stadium for post-practice interviews. Under no circumstances will Periscope technology be permitted.

#### Interview Policies

All interviews will be conducted post-practice at the new Student-Athlete Facility, located at the north end of Sun Devil Stadium. Due to high demand, several players and members of the coaching staff might only be available on a limited basis each week. A full availability schedule will be provided to the media each week.

All interviews must be arranged through the Media Relations office. Under no circumstances are members of the media allowed to contact a student-athlete or member of the coaching staff without first contacting a member of the Media Relations staff. All coaches and student-athletes have been encouraged to check in with the Media Relations staff and not indulge any interview requests that have not been arranged through the proper channels. Every possible attempt will be made to accommodate all media requests.

Following home contests, Arizona State will bring several student-athletes to the media room at the new Student-Athlete Facility in the North End Zone for a post-game press conference. Head Coach Herm Edwards will follow

the student-athletes.

Please note that there is a new NCAA rule in effect that states that every NCAA athletic team must take one day off per week from all team-related activities, including practice, weight training, conditioning, meetings, interviews, etc. This means that one day per week (typically Monday for Sun Devil football), no Sun Devil student-athlete may conduct an interview. As this is an NCAA rule and will be monitored by compliance personnel, there can be no exceptions made.

#### Weekly Press Conferences

Head coach Herm Edwards will host his weekly press conferences each Monday prior to game week. The press conference is tentatively scheduled for 12 p.m. (Noon) Arizona Time each week.

#### Photography/Videography

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4 and those wishing to document practice via photograph or video will be able to do so during this time, so long as said documentation does not record play-calling signals. On-camera interviews will be conducted at the end of each practice.

For home games, a photographer work area has been established inside the Carson Student-Athlete Center (first floor). Internet access to transmit files is available in the photography workroom. Credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times.

#### Weekly Media Teleconference

The Pac-12 Football Coaches Weekly Media Teleconference Call will take place each Tuesday during the season. Coach Graham is scheduled to speak at 12:05 PT/1:05 MT each Tuesday. The teleconferences will be recorded and available at Pac-12.com that same afternoon of the call. ### ON THE AIR

Hear the hometown call with broadcaster Tim Healey and color analyst Jeff Van Raaphorst as well as sideline reporter Jordan Simone providing all the action for Sun Devil Football this season. The hometown broadcasts are boosted by Bonneville's powerful sports/talk lineup of Arizona Sports 98.7 FM, ESPN Phoenix 620 AM and 92.3 KTAR News FM. This week's game broadcast will be broadcast on ESPN 620 AM.

The Pac-12 will again provide access to Armed Forces Network for carriage of Pac-12 football games in 2017 for the benefit of the men and women in the military.

### LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION

The Sun Devils will get underway under the lights with the Pac-12 Network on the call for the first time this season. The Sun Devils are 20-7 all-time in games played on the Network. Roxy Bernstein will be on the call alongside analyst Anthony Herron with Lewis Johnson providing insight from the sidelines.

### Randall McDaniel to be Inducted into Rose Bowl Hall of Fame

PASADENA, Calif. -- Former Arizona State offensive lineman Randall McDaniel will be inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2018. McDaniel will join Pop Warner, Vince Young and George Halas being honored at the Rose Bowl Kickoff Luncheon in Pasadena on December 31, 2018.

McDaniel will be the third Sun Devil to be inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame after teammate and quarterback Jeff Van Raaphorst and head coach John Cooper, who coached the team that included both McDaniel and Van Raaphorst to 1987 Rose Bowl Title.

McDaniel, from nearby Avondale, Ariz., was a four-year starter along the offensive line in Tempe and helped lead ASU to the 1987 Rose Bowl Title, defeating Michigan 22-15. The following year, he was awarded the 1987 Morris Trophy for Pac-10 offensive lineman of the year. He was also a two-time first-team all-American in 1986 and 1987.
