Oregon State and Arizona State open Pac-12 Conference play this week. The Beavers and Sun Devils open their series Thursday night at 6 p.m. PT at Phoenix's Municipal Stadium.

Last Game

Jake Thompson held Ball State to three hits and a run in 7 1/3 innings and Trevor Larnach posted three hits to help send Oregon State to a series sweep of the Cardinals with an 8-4 win at Goss Stadium on Saturday. Thompson tied a career and season high with eight strikeouts, while the three hits for Larnach marked a career-best. Oregon State rapped out 11 hits in the win, with five going for extra bases.

Where We Rank

Oregon State comes into the week with a 1.20 earned run average, which leads the nation. The Beavers are one of five teams with sub-2.00 ERAs, and No. 2 Louisville is at 1.75. OSU is also tops with a 0.86 WHIP, third with 2.00 walks issued per nine innings and fourth with 5.73 hits allowed per nine. The Beavers are also tied for fourth with four shutouts.

Pac-12 Opener

The Beavers are opening Pac-12 Conference play against Arizona State for the third consecutive season. OSU won all three games last season, including the opener, 3-2. OSU has won its last five Pac-12 openers dating back to 2013.

Singles

- The Beavers have held opponents to two runs or less in 12 of 15 games this season. In only one game, against Ohio State, has OSU allowed more than two earned runs.
- Oregon State is a consensus top five team according to the six rankings released this week. The Beavers are ranked as high as No. 1 by Collegiate Baseball.
- OSU will be the visiting team on the scoreboard for the first time this year. The Beavers were the home team for all eight neutral-site games in Surprise.
- Thursday's game is the first of 20 on TV for OSU in 2017. Nineteen of those games will air on Pac-12 Network while the 20th will be on ESPNU during the UCLA series.
- OSU's starters have an 11-1 record and 1.43 ERA in 94 1/3 innings.

Everyday Champions: SportUp

As part of the Everyday Champions program, Oregon State launched **SportUp**, college athletics' first start up incubator, during the 2015-16 academic year. With the help of the program, former student-athlete Maureen Tremblay has launched her own business – Revive, an app that tracks workouts for elite athletes to prevent injury.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed six service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 75 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.
