ROAD TRIP CONTINUES FOR MEN'S BASKETBALL AT WEST VIRGINIA Arizona State will take on the Mountaineers for the first time on Tuesday at 7 PM MST.

Sun Devil Men's Basketball remains on the road to complete a two-game trip against West Virginia on Tuesday at 7 PM MST. Arizona State (10-7, 1-5) will look to snap a four-game losing streak when they take on the Mountaineers (13-4, 4-2) in their fifth road game of the season. It is the first of two straight games against Top-25 competition and the fourth overall game against a ranked foe for the Sun Devils.

THE MATCHUP

Part two of the trip back East has Arizona State traveling to West Virginia. Much like the UCF game, this will be the first meeting between the two programs. In fact, ASU has played five new programs total this year (Gonzaga, St. Thomas, UMass). This is also the only meeting of the season between the two teams.

HOW TO FOLLOW

Arizona State will appear on CBS Sports Network for the second straight game when

they face West Virginia on Tuesday at 7 PM MST. It is the 12th time the program will be featured on national television so far in 2024-25. Andrew Catalon (play-by-play) and Pete Gillen (analyst) are on the call. Make sure to listen to Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM (KMVP).

ONE OF ONE

FFreshman forward Jayden Quaintance has proven to be one of the nation's most unique and versatile athletes. He is currently the ONLY PLAYER IN THE

NATION averaging at least 9.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 3.0 blocks. He produces at that high of a level while playing 31.5 minutes per game. Quaintance is averaging exactly 10.1 points, 8.6 rebounds, and 3.2 blocks with room to spare on each qualifier.

BUYING "STOCKS"

Quaintance added six more 'stocks' and has combined for 75 'stocks' (54 blocks + 21 steals) so far this season. He is the only player in the nation to boast these numbers (50+ blocks and 20+ steals). The next closest Power 4 + Big East player is Creighton senior center Ryan Kalkbrenner with 61 stocks (49 blocks + 12 steals).

BLOCK PARTY

Freshman Jayden Quaintance has recorded 54 blocks thus far in the 2024-2025 season and is now the nation's leader in blocks per game (3.2) after adding five more in the matchup with Cincinnati. That is two straight games with five blocks for Quaintance. He has already surpassed Pac-12 career blocks leader Jordan Bachynski on the ASU freshman single-season blocks list. Quaintance is now only one block shy of matching the season-season record by a freshman in program history and has done it in only 17 games. He has two or more blocks in 15 of 17 games this year, including eight 4+ block performances.

WE WILL BLOCK YOU

Arizona State is first in the Big 12 and 19th nationally averaging 5.2 blocks per game. Freshman Jayden Quaintance is a big reason why, contributing a league-best 3.2. Basheer Jihad, Shawn Phillips Jr., and BJ Freeman each have seven or more blocks this season.

MR. RELIABLE

Alston Mason has been a steady presence in the lineup for Head Coach Bobby Hurley at point guard. Mason has led the team in minutes in 14 of the 17 games, including playing 37+ minutes in four straight games. For the second time this season, he played all 40 minutes of a regulation contest in the game against Cincinnati (Kansas). He is now up to 35.2 minutes per game, which is neck-and-neck with West Virginia's Javon Small for the most in the Big 12 and also Top-50 nationally (49th). Mason is also shooting a team-high 80.7% from the free-throw line, which is ninth-best in the Big 12.

FREE'D UP

Senior guard/forward BJ Freeman recent emergence has come at an important time with the absence of Joson Sanon. He once again scored in double figures against Cincinnati, extending his streak to seven-straight. Freeman has finished with 10+ points in 14 total games this season, the most of any Sun Devil.

GETTING ACQUAINTED

Jayden Quaintance continues to show improvement throughout the season. Take a closer look at a comparison between his first four and last 13 games.

DOUBLE DOUBLES

Jayden Quaintance now has five doubledoubles this season after registering another against Cincinnati. Quaintance is currently one of only five Big 12 players and one of only six freshman nationally with five or more double doubles this year.

80-POINT MARK

The Sun Devils have scored 80 points or more nine times through 17 games this season after doing it only six times in 32 games last year. ASU is 7-2 when reaching the 80-point mark.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 165 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark. He is now the second-winningest coach in program history.

HEAD COACH BOBBY HURLEY



One of the most recognizable names in college basketball history became the 14th men's head coach of the Sun Devil Men's Basketball program, as Arizona State named 1992 NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player Bobby Hurley as the head coach on April 9, 2015. What has followed is aggressive scheduling, lots of fast-paced hoops, playing hard, several big-time wins both home and away and back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for Arizona State for the first time since Byron Scott, Fat Lever and Alton Lister were starring in Tempe (1980-81 to be exact).

In his ten seasons as head coach, Sun Devil Men's Basketball has matched its highest ranking in school history (third in the Associated Press Poll in December of 2017), notched its best two average attendances in history (10,603 in 2017-18 is the ASU record), reached the NCAA Tournament three times, notched its best two non-conference wins in school history (vs. No. 1 Kansas on Dec. 22, 2018 and at No. 2 Kansas on Dec. 10, 2017) and defeated two eventual 2018 No. 1 seeds in a span of a few weeks (Kansas and Xavier).

Following a three-year drought without a First or Second Team Pac-12 All-Conference selection, ASU had at least one in six straight seasons under Hurley (2018-23) and Frankie Collins received Honorable Mention distinction in 2024. Hurley has

coached two Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year winners in addition to the 2019 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year (Lu Dort). Three Sun Devils have been selected to the Pac-12 All-Tournament team and three received All-Defensive Team distinction during Hurley's tenure.

A signature of Hurley's teams have been their successs in close games and ability to erase deficits. Arizona State is 40-20 (.666) in close games (two possesions or less) over the past five seasons. The 40 wins are a Top-10 total in the nation during that span. To take it a step further, ASU is 25-17 in two point or less games under Bobby Hurley. - Four Big 12 teams are ranked in this week's AP Top 25 Poll. No. 3 lowa State, No. 7 Houston, No. 12 Kansas, and No. 23 West Virginia comprise the Conference's ranked teams. Texas Tech is ranked No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
- -Houston holds the nation's longest home winning streak at 32 games and is tied for third with a 10-game overall win streak. Iowa State has the second- longest home winning streak in the nation at 28 games.
- Arizona State's Jayden Quaintance leads Division I with 3.18 blocks per game. He is looking to be the first player in Big 12 history finish the season as the national leader in blocks.
- West Virginia is tied for the national lead with three wins against AP Top 10 opponents this season. WVU is one of five teams with four AP Top 25 wins, while Arizona and lowa State join the Mountaineers in the club of 15 teams with at least three ranked wins this season
- The Big 12 embarks on its first season as a 16-team league, with league games starting December 30. The Conference schedule increases to 20 games, with teams playing five opponents twice and 10 foes once.
