Notable: The No. 12 Ducks have won four straight after opening Pac-12 play with home wins over Oregon State and No. 22 Washington State. Oregon leads the Pac-12 in kills per set, assists per set and aces per set, and is No. 2 in digs per set and No. 3 in hitting percentage (.263). The Ducks have five players who are averaging 1.80 or more kills per set, and five who are averaging 2.00 or more digs per set.

UA boasts the Pac-12 kills per set (5.21) and points per set (5.47) leader in SR OH Kendra Dahlke, and Julia Patterson is third in the conference with 11.34 assists per set. Oregon and Arizona have played three straight five-set matches.

KEY STORYLINES

NO. 12 DUCKS HOST ARIZONA SCHOOLS IN MKA

The No. 12 Oregon volleyball team will continue its four-match homestand in Matthew Knight Arena this week against No. 24 Arizona and Arizona State. The Ducks have won four in a row and are one of four teams to start Pac-12 play 2-0 after beating Oregon State in their conference opener last Thursday and No. 22 Washington State in a five-set thriller on Sunday. Oregon's match vs. ASU on Sunday will be the Ducks' Stomp Out Cancer match.

VANDER WEIDE, STONE NAMED PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK (9/24)

After leading the Ducks to a 2-0 Pac-12 start, SR OH **Lindsey Vander Weide** and JR MB **Ronika Stone** were named the Pac-12 defensive and offensive players of the week, respectively. Vander Weide earned the defensive honor after a milestone weekend in which she surpassed 1,000 career digs (more on page 3), recorded back-to-back double-doubles and notched the first 20-plus kill, 20-plus dig match of her career. Stone was tabbed as the offensive player of the week after hitting .417 with 29 total kills and 13 blocks, including 13 kills vs. Oregon State and 16 vs. WSU.

NEWEST "LITTLE DUCK" GIVES OREGON VOLLEYBALL A TRUE WARRIOR

Oregon officially added a sixth member to its 2018 class on August 7, 2018, signing 8-year-old Eugene-native Danielle Bixby to the roster through the national non-profit Team IMPACT. Bixby has been fighting a rare form of cancer called Langerhans Cell Histiocytosis for the last year, and has become incredibly close with the Ducks over the last few months. "I'm their little Duck, and they're my girls," Danielle said after signing her letter of intent. Oregon will honor Danielle and will raise awareness for childhood cancer with a "Stomp Out Cancer Match" on Sunday, Sept. 30, when the Ducks host Arizona State in MKA.

VANDER WEIDE JOINS 1,000/1,000 CLUB

With a career-high 28 digs vs. WSU on Sunday, SR OH **Lindsey Vander Weide** surpassed 1,000 for her career and became only the fifth player in Oregon history to have 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs. Vander Weide is also one of just 11 active players in the NCAA to be in the 1,000/1,000 club, and her 1,150 career kills are tied for 38th in the nation among active players. The Turlock, Calif., native added a season-high 22 kills vs. the Cougars for the first 20-plus kill, 20-plus dig match of her career. Vander Weide also owns 1,348.0 career points, which ranks seventh all-time at Oregon, and she needs only two more blocks to reach 200 in her career and just 12 aces to get to 100.

RASKIE THRIVING AS PRIMARY SETTER

After splitting time in the 6-2 offense the last three years, SR S **August Raskie** has taken her game to a new level in 2018 as Oregon's lone setter in a 5-1 scheme. Raskie leads the Pac-12 and ranks third in the nation with 12.30 assists per set, and she has Oregon in the top five nationally as a team in both assists per set (3rd) and kills per set (4th). Raskie is tied for the team lead with five double-doubles, and she is one of five UO regulars averaging 2.00 digs per set or better (2.47). She has also become an offensive threat at the net with 42 total kills. With 529 assists so far in 2018 Raskie has 1,972 for her career, 10th-most in UO history and only 28 shy of 2,000. Raskie is already approaching her career-high for assists in a season (616, 2016).

NUNEVILLER LEADING IMPROVED FLOOR DEFENSE

The Ducks entered 2018 with questions at the libero position, but any concerns have been immediately put to rest by the stellar play of FR L Brooke Nuneviller. Nuneviller is the first true freshman to start at libero for Oregon since Amanda Benson in 2013, and the Chandler, Ariz., native

has shined with 4.79 digs per set, No. 2 in the Pac-12. Nuneviller was the Pac-12 freshman of the week on Sept. 10 after racking up 28 digs in UO's upset of then-No. 1 Minnesota, and she tallied a season-high 35 in last Sunday's five set win vs. No. 22 Washington State. Nuneviller's 35 digs are tied for seventh-most in UO single-match history, and are the most by a Duck since Benson in 2015. FR L Camryn Tastad has helped stabilize the back-row defense as well with 2.13 digs per set, and the return of RSO L/ OH **Brooke Van Sickle** (2.19 d/s) has also helped take pressure off of SR OH **Lindsey Vander Weide** and the rest of UO's passers. As a team, the Ducks are No. 2 in the Pac-12 with 16.93 digs per set. In last Sunday's win vs. WSU, Oregon racked up 103 total team digs, the most for the program since 2014.

MIDDLES RUNNING WILD IN 5-1 OFFENSE

Oregon's change to a 5-1 offense has paid immediate dividends for middle blockers **Sumeet Gill** and **Ronika Stone**, who have thrived with the increased touches. Stone is No. 10 in the Pac-12 with 4.09 points per set and fifth with a .363 hitting percentage, while Gill is third in the conference with a .373 hitting percentage while averaging 1.81 kills per set. Stone has double-digit kills in four straight matches and seven of the last eight, including a career-high 19 in UO's upset of then-No. 1 Minnesota on Sept. 8, and Gill has already set career-high in kills twice this year with 12 (vs. LBSU & UAPB). JR RS **Willow Johnson** has also played well with Raskie as the lone setter, averaging 2.79 kills per set on .318 hitting.

NINE PAC-12 TEAMS IN AVCA TOP 25

At No. 12 in the AVCA coaches poll, the Ducks are the second-highest ranked team in the Pac-12 and one of nine teams from the conference in the top 25. Defending Pac-12 champion Stanford leads the way at No. 2, and is followed by Oregon, USC (T13), Washington (T13), UCLA (18), Washington State (22), Colorado (23), Arizona (24) and Utah (25).

DUCKS WRAP NONCONFERENCE WITH PAIR OF WINS AT HAWAII

The Ducks closed nonconference action with a pair of wins at Hawai'i, winning in straight sets on Sept. 13 before holding on to win in five the next day. JR MB **Ronika Stone** (12 K, .500, 5 B) and SR OH **Lindsey Vander Weide** (15 K, .375) led UO to the 25-18, 25-23, 25-22 sweep on Thursday. SR S **August Raskie** (50 A, 16 D, 7 K), Stone (11 K, 10 B, 8 D) and Vander Weide (14 K, 12 D, 3 SA) all

OREGON PULLS UPSET OF NO. 1 MINNESOTA

The Ducks picked up one of the program's biggest wins in recent memory on Sept. 8, defeating then-top-ranked Minnesota, 25-23, 25-23, 25-27, 25-23, for Oregon's first win over a No. 1 ranked team since UO beat Penn State in the 2012 Final Four. Oregon outperformed Minnesota statistically in hitting percentage (.298-.295), kills (74-63), digs (65-63) and aces (5-2). JR MB **Ronika Stone** led the way with a career-high 19 kills on .615 hitting, and JR RS Willow Johnson hit .278 with 16 kills. Left sides **Lauren Page** (career-high 16 K, .324) and **Lindsey Vander Weide** (14 K, .279) delivered breakout performances, FR L **Brooke Nuneviller** shined defensively with a match-high 28 digs, and SR S **August Raskie** filled up the stat sheet with a career-high 66 assists, the most by a Duck since 2012, plus eight digs and two kills.

DUCKS DOMINATE OREGON CLASSIC

After picking up their first win of 2018 on Aug. 28 vs. Portland State, the Ducks completed an undefeated weekend at the Oregon Classic in Matthew Knight Arena with dominant sweeps of Utah Valley, Long Beach State and Arkansas-Pine Bluff. SR S/RS **August Raskie** was named the Oregon Classic MVP after averaging 12.00 assists and 2.11 digs per set while adding four aces, six kills and six blocks. SR MB **Sumeet Gill** and JR RS **Willow Johnson** were also named to the all-tournament team. Gill hit an astounding .622 with 3.22 kills per set over the weekend, twice recording a career-high 12 kills, and Johnson averaged 3.00 kills per set on .500 hitting.

VAN SICKLE SERVES DUCKS TO SWEEP OF PORTLAND STATE IN 2018 HOME OPENER

The Ducks picked up their first win of the 2018 season on Aug. 28 in their home opener with a dominant 25-15, 25-10, 25-13 sweep of Portland State. RSO L/OH **Brooke Van Sickle** dominated on the serve with a career-high nine aces, the second-most in UO single-match history, to lead the Ducks to 13 total. Van Sickle is No. 2 in the Pac-12 this year with 0.44 aces per set (19 total).

OREGON GETS VALUABLE EXPERIENCE AGAINST ELITE OPPONENTS

Oregon was unable to come away with a win in their opening weekend at the VERT Challenge in Lincoln, Neb., but the Ducks gained valuable experience playing a pair of top-three teams in an NCAA Tournament-like environment in front of 8,000-plus fans. Oregon was right with No. 3 Texas and No. 2 Nebraska in every set, but struggled putting its opponents away late in sets. Said HC **Matt Ulmer**: "I thought the talent for each team was very comparable as well as the styles of play, but we have to be mentally tougher and we have to outthink our opponents a little bit better."

JOHNSON SHINES ON OPENING WEEKEND

JR RS **Willow Johnson** got her junior season off to a terrific start at the VERT Challenge, earning a spot on the all-tournament team after leading UO with 3.57 kills per set on .380 hitting. Johnson was stellar in the season opener vs. No. 3 Texas, tying her career-high with 17 kills to lead all players while hitting .517. Also impressing for the Ducks in Lincoln were FR L **Brooke Nuneviller** (3.86 d/s) and SR MB **Sumeet Gill** (1.86 k/s, .379).

DUCKS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN PAC-12

The Ducks were picked to finish third in the Pac-12 this season in a vote of the conference's coaches. Stanford was picked to win, with USC second and receiving one first-place vote. Oregon was followed in the poll by UCLA, Colorado, Washington, Washington State, Utah, Arizona, Oregon State, Arizona State and California.

STONE, VANDER WEIDE NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-PAC-12 TEAM

JR MB **Ronika Stone** and SR OH **Lindsey Vander Weide** were both named to the preseason all-Pac-12 team in the preseason coaches' poll. Stone was an all-Pac-12 pick in 2017 after leading UO and ranking fourth in the conference with a .366 hitting percentage, while Vander Weide was an honorable mention selection after averaging 2.48 kills per set and 2.70 digs per set. Vander Weide was a third-team AVCA all-American in 2016.

DUCKS RETURN VETERAN ROSTER

Oregon returns nine players from last season's team that went 18-12 overall and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Ducks will be led by the trio of SR OH **Lindsey Vander Weide**, SR S/RS **August Raskie** and JR MB **Ronika Stone**. UO will be without JR OH **Jolie Rasmussen** in 2018 as she recovers from injury, but the Ducks get RSO L/OH **Brooke Van Sickle** back after she was a medical redshirt in 2017. Head coach **Matt Ulmer** has consistently said Van Sickle was the best player at last year's VERT Challenge when the Ducks defeated Nebraska in the season opener. UO also brings back JR RS **Willow Johnson**, a dynamic lefty hitter, as well as SR MB **Sumeet Gill**, SR MB/OH **Lauren Page** and SO L **Kyra Hanawahine**.

FRESHMEN CLASS RANKED NO. 4 IN NATION

The Ducks welcome a five-player freshmen class this fall that was ranked No. 4 in the nation, adding to an already talented returning roster. FR L/OH **Brooke Nuneviller** will see the floor right away for the Ducks, bringing tremendous experience at the libero spot after manning that role for the U.S. junior national team the last three summers. FR S **Kylie Robinson** is the highest-rated recruit in program history at No. 8, and FR MB **Karson Bacon** was close behind at No. 11 and is a very physical addition for UO at 6-foot-4. FR L **Camryn Tastad** is regarded as an elite floor defender who could contribute in 2018, and FR MB **Chandler Duff** provides another long body in the middle.

OREGON ADDS TAYLOR BORUP OUT OF UNC

In addition to adding a highly-regarded freshmen class, Oregon strengthened its 2018 roster with the addition of JR OH/RS **Taylor Borup**, a transfer from North Carolina. A physical presence at 6'4", Borup was a 2016 ACC all-freshman selection and contributed in both of her seasons with the Tar Heels despite battling through injuries.

RASKIE SHINES FOR TEAM USA OVERSEAS

SR S/RS **August Raskie** enjoyed what Ulmer has termed a "perfect" summer prior to her senior season, playing overseas on the U.S. women's collegiate national team Europe-tour roster. Raskie helped the U.S. to the gold medal in the European Global Challenge and was named to the event's all-tournament team.

ULMER ADDS ERIKA DILLARD AS ASSISTANT

Matt Ulmer dipped into his past to round out his 2018 coaching staff, adding **Erika Dillard** as an assistant coach. Dillard coached with Ulmer at Long Beach State, and she was his beach assistant when he led the 49ers to the 2013 national title. Said Ulmer, "Erika is one of the best coaches in our sport, period." Dillard is back with the Ducks for Pac-12 play after she and her husband, Jason, welcomed their second child, Caden, on Aug. 20.

2017 RECAP NOTES

DUCKS MAKE SEVENTH STRAIGHT NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCE

The Ducks reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2017, their first season under head coach Matt Ulmer, despite battling through injuries for much of the season. Oregon reached the postseason for the seventh straight year as a program, and advanced past the first round for the second season in a row. The Ducks swept Kennesaw State, 28-26, 25-19, 25-18, in the opening round of NCAA play behind 11 kills by **Taylor Agost** and nine blocks from **Ronika Stone**. Oregon fell to No. 13 seeded and No. 7 ranked BYU in the second round, 25-20, 25-21, 25-19, on the Cougars' home floor despite 18 kills on .457 hitting by Agost.

OREGON FINISHES EIGHTH IN THE PAC-12

Playing in a loaded Pac-12 Conference, the Ducks finished eighth in the league at 10-10 with Stanford (19-1) winning the Pac-12 title. Oregon started conference play 9-6 before a tough four-match losing streak, holding a top-10 RPI ranking for most of the season. The Ducks beat four top-25 ranked teams throughout the year, including a season-opening win over the No. 5 seed in the tournament, Nebraska.

UO LOCKS IN MATT ULMER AS HEAD COACH THROUGH 2021

University of Oregon director of athletics Rob Mullens announced on Nov. 30, 2018, the signing of **Matt Ulmer** to a new four-year, \$630,000 contract to keep Ulmer as the head coach of Oregon volleyball through 2021. Ulmer took over as head coach prior to the 2017 season on a one-year deal after serving the previous three as an assistant for the Ducks, leading UO to a 18-12 overall record, and NCAA Tournament second round appearance and eighth place in the Pac-12 (10-10).

AGOST, STONE EARN ALL-PAC-12 HONORS

Taylor Agost and **Ronika Stone** were named to the all-Pac-12 team after putting together terrific seasons for the Ducks. **Agost** led Oregon with 3.08 kills per set on .288 hitting throughout season, stepping into a six-rotation role on the outside for the first time in her career. **Stone** finished the year ranked fourth in the Pac-12 with a .366 hitting percentage, and she also led the Ducks with 30 service aces while averaging 2.14 kills per set and a team-best 1.14 blocks per set. **Agost** was also an AVCA all-America honorable mention selection, and both she and **Stone** earned AVCA Pacific North all-Region honorable mention recognition. **Lindsey Vander Weide** and **Jolie Rasmussen** also earned all-Pac-12 honorable mention honors for the Ducks.

DUCKS A TOP-25 STAPLE

After slotting in at No. 24 in the final 2017 regular-season AVCA coaches poll, the Ducks were inside the top 25 in 28 straight polls, dating back to Sept. 12, 2016, before falling just outside in the final 2017 poll. UO was inside the top 25 every week during the 2017 season, and peaked at No. 8 on Sept. 18, the program's first top-10 ranking since November 2014 and highest since being No. 8 in the 2013 preseason poll. Oregon is ranked No. 18 in the 2018 preseason poll.

DUCKS AMONG PAC-12 AND NATION'S BEST

The Ducks were among the best teams in both the Pac-12 and the nation in 2017, as apparent by their standing in multiple statistical rankings. Oregon was second in the Pac-12 and 25th in the nation with a .263 team hitting percentage, and third in the conference with 1.24 service aces per set. Defensively, Oregon ranked fifth in the conference and 38th nationally with 2.49 blocks per set.

STONE ONE OF PAC-12's TOP HITTERS

Ronika Stone was one of the most efficient hitters in all of the Pac-12 Conference throughout the 2017 season, ranking fourth in the league and 50th in the nation with a .366 hitting percentage. Stone's mark ranks fourth in Oregon single-season history. Stone was also 10th in the conference with 0.27 aces per set. **Maggie Scott** was 10th in the conference with 6.22 assists per set while splitting time with **August Raskie** in Oregon's 6-2 offense.

EFFICIENCY KEY FOR OREGON

There was one constant in nearly all of the Ducks' victories in 2017: an advantage in team hitting percentage. Oregon went 17-3 when leading in hitting percentage, but 1-9 when its opponent finished with a more efficient night on the attack. The Ducks were 9-1 when hitting .300 or better and 16-0 when holding their opponent under the .200 mark, compared to 2-12 when their opponent hits better than .200. Oregon was also 14-6 when winning on the block, 12-4 when leading in kills and 13-1 when winning the first two sets.

DUCKS STREAK INTO PAC-12 PLAY ... AGAIN

The Ducks carried a significant winning streak into their conference schedule for the second straight year in 2017, winning six straight to close nonconference play after taking a seven-match winning streak into the 2016 Pac-12 opener. The Ducks beat Oregon State in their conference opener to extend their streak to seven before falling at UCLA (Sept. 22). In 2016, Oregon won its first four Pac-12 matches to push its winning streak to 11.

ULMER ERA BEGINS WITH TOP-FIVE WIN

The Ducks got head coach Matt Ulmer's head coaching career off to a magical start at the VERT Challenge in Gainesville, Fla., upsetting No. 5 Nebraska in four sets for the program's first win over a top-five team since beating No. 1 Penn State in December 2012. The win also gave UO its first win in three years in the VERT Challenge. The Ducks would play then-No. 1 Texas tough the following day, winning the first set before falling in four tightly-played sets. **Lindsey Vander Weide** (3.75 k/s, 2.00 d/s, sa) was named to the VERT Challenge all-tournament team. **Brooke Van Sickle** was outstanding for Oregon against Nebraska, recording career-highs in digs (22) and aces (3) while adding 11 kills for her first career double-double. Van Sickle was also dominant the next night against No. 1 Texas, putting down 10 kills with 15 digs through two sets before leaving with an injury.

On Nov. 30, 2017, Oregon director of athletics Rob Mullens announced that Ulmer had signed a four-year contract to remain at the helm of the Ducks through at least 2021.

In his first match as the Ducks' head coach, Ulmer led Oregon to a four-set upset of No. 5 Nebraska at the VERT Challenge, securing the program's first win over a top-five team since 2012. Ulmer guided the 2017 Ducks to an 18-12 overall record, 10-10 in the Pac-12, and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Ulmer came to Eugene after spending seven seasons at Long Beach State, five of which were served as a full-time assistant. He was also the sand volleyball program's head coach at Long Beach, where he led the 49ers to a national championship during the 2013 season to become the youngest head coach to win a Division I volleyball championship (indoor included, men and women).

The Ducks have made the NCAA Tournament in each of Ulmer's four seasons, including a run to the regional semifinals during his first season in 2014. In 2016, with Ulmer in an elevated role as associate head coach, the Ducks finished fourth in the Pac-12 at 21-10 (13-7 Pac-12) and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Ulmer was in charge of the Oregon defense, which held opponents to a .194 hitting percentage overall, the best since 2005, and a .198 hitting percentage in Pac-12 play, the best mark in conference play since 2006. The Ducks also enjoyed an 11-game winning streak and took down No. 8 Washington with a three-set sweep for their first win in Seattle since 2009.

Ulmer has helped mentor three all-American selections while at Oregon, including a third-team selection for Lindsey Vander Weide in 2016, as well as five all-Pac-12 selections. Amanda Benson also earned honorable mention all-American recognition in 2016, and was all-region and all-Pac-12 selection along with Vander Weide. The Ducks have also produced three Pac-12 all-freshman



selections in Ulmer's three seasons, with Ronika Stone becoming the latest to earn that honor in 2016.

As the recruiting coordinator for the Ducks in 2016, Ulmer brought in a class that garnered the No. 2 national ranking and proved vital to yet another tournament run for Oregon. Ulmer was also a part of two more top 10 classes in 2014 and 2015. While at Long Beach, each of Ulmer's six recruiting classes garnered rankings, including three in the top 20 and a No. 10 ranking in 2014 that made LBSU the highest-ranked mid major program.

As a beach coach, in addition to guiding Long Beach to the title in 2013, Ulmer has coached five athletes who have won FIVB medals and four that have made main draws in AVP events. He has coached four beach all-Americans, and was the only coach to appear in every national championship match, pairs and teams, in 2012 and 2013.

In total, Ulmer has coached 25 players who have played at the professional level.

In addition to molding success on the court, Ulmer has been instrumental in academic excellence for his players. Ulmer's student-athletes have garnered 12 Pac-12 all-academic honors in his time at Oregon, and 28 Big West all-academic awards during his time at Long Beach.

Away from the collegiate game, Ulmer has worked with USA Volleyball Select A1 for the past three years. In 2014, he was honored with the Long Beach Century Club Ernie Pollman Award, which recognizes an individual who impacts the community's youth through sports.

In 2012, Ulmer was honored by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) as a recipient of the "Thirty Under 30" award, recognizing outstanding up-and-coming coaches in the profession throughout all levels under the age of 30. Ulmer was one of 10 coaches recognized from Division I.

Ulmer spent his playing days at Carthage College, where he was a setter under head coach LJ Marx. While at Carthage, he led the team to two National Championship appearances, and was named a first-team D-III All-American as a senior. He finished his college career as the Carthage career leader in both assists and service aces, and in 2015 he was inducted into the Carthage Hall of Fame.

While at Carthage, Ulmer also worked as an assistant coach for the women's team, serving for five years from 2002-2006. He also worked as the club coach for TNT Volleyball Club from 2003-07, and has served with the Cal Juniors club team while in Southern California, helping the team earn two All-America selections on the way to a bronze medal in the Junior Olympics.

Ulmer completed his Master's degree in education in 2008 at Carthage. He graduated from Carthage in May 2006.

Ulmer and his wife, Kara, have one son, Camden, and one daughter, Harper.

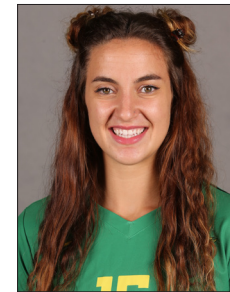
