THE GAME - Sun Devil Football will play back-to-back road games for the first time this season at it treks west to Los Angeles to take on the UCLA Bruins on Saturday, Oct. 26 at 4:30 p.m. AZT in the Rose Bowl Stadium. The contest will be broadcast live on the Pac-12 Network and can be heard over the airwaves locally on ESPN Phoenix 620 AM.

THE OPPONENT - UCLA leads the all-time series against the Sun Devils, 20-14-1, though ASU has been victorious in three of the last four games and is looking for its third win in the last four trips to the Rose Bowl.

UCLA in winless in three games at home this season, but enters the game with a potent offense that has racked up 512.3 total yards of offense per game over the last four games and has rushed for over 200 yards in three straight games.

KICKING OFF

- -ASU is one of just 7 teams nationally to not give up a 50-yard play this season.
- -The Sun Devils have converted 112 consecutive extra points, the sixth-longest active streak in
- -Kyle Williams has at least one pass receptions in 35 consecutive games, tied for the fifth-longest streak in ASU history and currently the fourth-longest active streak in the FBS.
- -ASU is coming off a season-high 9.0 tackles for loss in the loss against #13 Utah as well as a season-high four takeaways. Utah had only three tunrovers all season prior to ASU.
- -ASU has now held opponents to less than 30 points in 14 of 20 games since Danny Gonzales took over as defensive coordinator.

-Two of the longest standing streaks in ASU and FBS history came to an end against Utah. ASU had matched an FBS modern record with 125 consecutive games scoring over 10 points tied with Louisiana Tech (2008-18) prior to the 3-point outing against the Utes. Additionally, ASU had what was longest active streak of games scoring at least 7 points ended at 140 consecutive games.

AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- Improve ASU to 3-1 in road games this season. The three road wins would be the most since 2014 (4-2).
- Be ASU's fourth win in the last five matchups against the Bruins.
- Be the Sun Devils' third win in the last four games against UCLA at the Rose Bowl.
- Keep UCLA winless at home this season.
- Be the fifth time in seven year that the Sun Devils have won their road game in Los Angeles (2013-15, '18). ASU is 4-2 in the last six seasons in Southern California after going 1-12 from 2000-12.

MILESTONE COUNTDOWNS

- 1 100+ yard rushing game for Eno Benjamin to tie Art Malone (14 from 1967-69) for fourth in ASU school history.
- 58 rushing yards for Eno Benjamin to pass Ben Malone for 13th in ASU career history (currently at 2,417 yards behind Malone's 2,474 total from 1971-73).
- **83 rushing yards** for Eno Benjamin to reach 2,500 rushing yards in his career (currently at 2,417 yards)
- 1 game with a catch needed for Kyle Williams to move into fifth in ASU history in consecutive games with a receptions (currently at 35, needs 36).

#BYTHENUMBERS

Benjamin has continued to do his part to make people miss this year, forcing 42 missed tackles this season - a total tied for 11th nationally among running backs. In Pac-12 games, Benjamin has earned 298 yards after contact, one off the Pac-12 and tied for 18th among FBS running backs since Week 4. His 106.0 rush yards per game in Pac-12 games only is third in the league. He has helped rally the offense when attempting to come back, recording 12 rushing first downs when the team is trailing - the second highest total nationally - while his five rushing touchdowns while trailing lead the nation.

Kobe Williams has only been thrown at just 19 **times this season** - tied for the 10th-lowest total among corners that have played at least 50 percent of the coverage snaps this season. He has been targeted just once every 9.6 snaps in coverage this season, 12th-lowest among the nation's corners. Williams has allowed just 88 yards in coverage thus far, the 7th-lowest total among the nation's corners with at least 50 percent of their snaps in coverage. Williams is the 8th-highest graded defender in the Pac-12 at 79.6. He is the 31st-highest graded corner in covers in the FBS this year.

ASU has held opponents to 30 or less points in 14 of **19 games** in Danny Gonzales' defensive scheme, notable as it DID allow 30+ in 32 of 43 previous games dating back in a span from 2013-17. ASU is 18th in the country and third in the Pac-12 in allowing just 18.1 points per game. The Sun Devils allowed just 25.5 points per game last season, good for 53rd nationally. The totals are notable as ASU was 103rd nationally at 32.8 points per game allowed in 2017 and had finished 99th or worse in three consecutive seasons prior to the marked improvement the past two seasons.

ASU's defense has held opponents to an average of -12.9 points per game under their current scoring **averages for the season.** With those opponents games against the Sun Devils removed from their scoring offense statistic, ASU has held opponents to an average of 14.1 points per game under their season averages to date. The Sun Devils are 39th nationally in allowing just 5.1 yards per play this season. Opponents average just 19.3 first downs per game this season, tied for the 31st-lowest total in the country. The Sun Devil defense is currently ranked 34th in the FBS in the DFEI rankings.

ASU has played eight total games decided by four points or less in the Herm Edwards era, the most in the FBS since the start of last year. ASU's six wins in games of four points or less (6-2) is tied with Nevada for the best in college football the past two seasons. The Sun Devils have now played 13 games under Herm Edwards decided by a touchdown or less, going 7-6 in those contests. Those 13 games are second-most in the country behind Texas (14) since the start of last season. ASU's seven wins in those games are second in the FBS in that time hehind Texas

Aashari Crosswell has not been credited with a missed tackle on a running play this season, marking him one of just 10 safeties in country to lay such a claim. His one missed tackle on the season, period, is tied with three others for fewest among Power Five safeties. Crosswell has allowed just 23 yards after the catch this season, the second-lowest total among Pac-12 safeties and 29th nationally - and his 71 total passing yards allowed are also fourth-lowest in the conference. Crosswell's five forced incompletions this season are most among Pac-12 safeties and sixth among Power Five safeties.

#10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

- 1. Brandon Aiyuk is second in the FBS with 433 yards after the catch and has forced 11 missed tackles this year - good for 12th in the nation.
- 2. On run defense, Evan Fields has recorded a 8.9 run-stop percentage that leads the league and is fifth in the FBS. His 16 defensive stops this season are 11th among Power Five safeties.
- 3. In Pac-12 games, @eno_benjamin5 has earned 298 yards after contact, one yard off the Pac-12 lead and tied for 18th among FBS running backs since Week 4. His 106.0 yards per game in Pac-12 games only are currently third in the league.
- 4. Aashari Crosswell (@YkgAashari) has been credited with just one missed tackle this season, a total that is tied with three others for first among Power Five safeties.
- 5. Jermayne Lole has the 12th highest positive run impact score in the country at 24.1 percent among players graded as interior linemen.
- 6. @JayD__5 has done his part to escape pressure as shown by his 39 QB scrambles this season, a total that leads FBS quarterbacks. His 306 yards on the ground - excluding quarterback sacks - are 24th among FBS quarterbacks.
- 7. Senior wide receiver @kylewilliamsVI has caught at least one pass in 35 consecutive games, dating back to his freshman season - a total good for fifth in ASU history and the fourth-longest active streak in the FBS.
- 8. ASU is one of just seven teams in the country to not allow a 50+ yard play from scrimmage this year. The Sun Devil defense is also first in the country in allowing just 14 rushing plays over 10
- 9. The Devils have turned the ball over just six times this season the 10th-lowest total in the FBS. ASU is 19th nationally in turnover margin this season (0.71).
- 10. Williams has only been thrown at just 19 times this season tied for the 10th-lowest total among corners that have played at least 50 percent of the coverage snaps this season.

FOCUSING ON FOOTBALL

- The Sun Devil secondary features two players ranked among the Top-8 in the Pac-12 in overall grading from Pro Focus Football. Aashari Crosswell is the 6th-highest graded defensive player in the league, regardless of position, with a score of 82.0. Kobe Williams is the 8th-highest graded defender in the league at 79.6.
- » Crosswell is the 15th-highest graded safety in the country overall, also setting in the Top-30 nationally among safeties in coverage (30th/79.8) and run defense (28th/80.5).
- Williams is the 31st-highest graded corner in covers in the FBS this year and the 24th highest graded corner nationally in coverage (81.3).
- » Additionally, Jermayne Lole checks in the Top-25 as the 23rd-highest graded defensive player in the Pac-12 with a score of 74.4 and the fourth-highest graded edge defender in the league. He has a 82.2 grade in run defense this season, 27th among edge defenders nationally.
- » Evan Fields is the 33rd-highest graded safety in the FBS as a pass rusher (64.2).
- Despite being one of less than 20 true freshman offensive linemen to start in the country, Dohnovan West is the 33rd-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 this season (71.5) and the 39th highest-graded guard in the nation. However, that grade includes his first two weeks as a center as well. Since shifting to guard in Week 3, West has been the 13th-highest graded guard in the country.
- » Brandon Aiyuk has been ASU's highest graded offensive player this season, coming in as the 16th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 and third-highest graded wide receiver (76.5).

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin is second in the Pac-12 with seven rushing touchdowns this season (20th nationally). His nine total touchdowns are also 17th nationally and second in the league. He is fourth in the league (44th nationally) with 116.86 all-purpose yards per game.
- Benjamin has scored at least one touchdown in 11 of the last 13 games, dating back to last season.
- » Benjamin has continued to do his part to make people miss this year, forcing 42 missed tackles this season a total tied for 11th nationally among running backs.
- In Pac-12 games, Benjamin has earned 298 yards after contact, one off the Pac-12 and tied for 18th among FBS running backs since Week 4. His 106.0 rush yards per game in Pac-12 games only is third in the league
- With six rushing touchdowns in Pac-12 games, Benjamin is tied for third nationally among all running backs in conference-only rushing TDs.
- » Benjamin has recorded 13 career games with at least 100 rushing yards tied for 5th in program history with Demario Richard and needing just one to move into a tie for fourth.
- When the has rushed for 9 first downs this season when the team is facing third down tied for 12th nationally among FBS running backs.
- When the has helped rally the offense when attempting to come back, recording 12 rushing first downs when the team is trailing the second highest total nationally while his five rushing touchdowns while trailing lead the nation.
- » Benjamin has played 187 snaps in passing routes this season, the second-highest total among FBS running backs and his 28 targets are tied for 6th. His 185 receiving yards this season are 12th among all FBS running backs.
- Benjamin became the 20th Sun Devil in program history to reach 2,000 rushing yards with his effort against Colorado. The junior has 2,417 rushing yards in his career and is one of just five three-year players to find themselves in the 2,000-yard club (Mario Bates, Ben Malone, Art Malone and Woody Green). Benjamin also joined the 3,000-yard club as he eclipsed the 3K all-purpose yards mark for his career this season against Utah.

DAAAAMMNNNN DANIELS

- Jayden Daniels is 14th nationally and first in the Pac-12 in pass yards per completion (14.22) while his 8.43 yards per pass attempt are 28th in the FBS. He is 36th in the FBS (third in the Pac-12) with 263.0 yards of total offense per game.
- The true freshmen is tied for 28th nationally in fewest interceptions with only two to date one of which coming on a half-ending Hail Mary attempt.
- » Daniels has been exceptional on third downs this season, with his 451 passing yards on

- third downs good for 19th in the country. His 156.04 passer rating on third down is 25th nationally
- » In addition, Daniels has rushed for 9 first downs on third downs this season tied for 27th in the nation.
- » Daniels has accounted for 484 total yards of offense and four touchdowns in the fourth quarter of games (399 passing, 85 rushing). His 399 passing yards in the fourth quarter are 19th nationally while his 19 passing first downs are 11th.
- While under pressure this season, Daniels has posted the 16th-highest NFL passer rating of any quarterback in the FBS at 90.0. For reference, the national average is 68.5.
- » Daniels has done his part to escape pressure as shown by his 39 QB scrambles this season, a total that leads FBS quarterbacks. His 306 yards on the ground - excluding quarterback sacks - are 24th among FBS quarterbacks.

NOT THE AVERAGE FRESHMAN

- » Daniels became the first true freshman quarterback in program history to start the first game of the season.
- » Daniels broke the Sun Devil record for passing yards in a first career game in the season opener, which was previously 160 by Jeff Krohn in 2000. It should be noted that this includes just a first career GAME appearance, not first career start.
- » Daniels became the third freshman in ASU history to win his first career start, joining John Walker (1984) and Dennis Sproul (1974) as the only other QB's to win their first career starts as freshmen.
- With his 72-yard touchdown pass to Eno Benjamin in the fourth quarter against Sacramento State, Daniels became the first ASU quarterback ever to throw a touchdown pass over 70 yards in consecutive games (had a 77-yard pass to Brandon Aiyuk in Week One).
- Only 10 times in ASU history has a freshman quarterback recorded a 300+ yard passing performance, of which Daniels now has three.

KEEP IT CLOSE

- » ASU has played eight total games decided by four points or less in the Herm Edwards era, the most in the FBS since the start of last year.
- » ASU's six wins in games of four points or less (6-2) is tied with Nevada for the best in college football the past two seasons.
- The Sun Devils have now played 13 games under Herm Edwards decided by a touchdown or less, going 7-6 in those contests. Those 13 games are second-most in the country behind Texas since the start of last season.
- » ASU's seven wins in those games are second in the FBS in that time behind Texas.
- » ASU has played four games this season decided by a touchdown or less all four of which decided by four points or less.

MAKE 'EM PAY

- » The Devils have turned the ball over just six times this season the 10th-lowest total in the FBS. ASU is 19th nationally in turnover margin this season (0.71).
- » ASU has outscored opponents 694-365 in points off takeaways since 2012. ASU has padded that stat this season, outscoring the opposition 20-10.
- Since 2012, ASU has scored 65.9 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (116 of 176) while finding the end zone 86 times in that span (48.9 percent).
- Conversely, opponents have scored just 50.8 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (62 of 122) with 47 touchdowns (38.5 percent).

LOCKING IT DOWN

- ASU has allowed just nine plays over 30 yards this season, a total tied for 19th nationally. The Sun Devils are one of just 7 teams nationally to not give up a 50-yard play on the year.
- » ASU's run defense has been especially efficient, leading the country with only 14 rushing plays allowed over 10 yards this season. With just three rushing plays over 20 vards allowed this season. ASU is 6th in the country.



- In 2018, ASU was tied for 11th nationally in allowing just 8 plays over 40 yards, an area the Devils had struggled in in previous seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). ASU was also tied for 9th nationally in allowing just 3 plays of over 50 yards on the year after sitting in the bottom 10 nationally in the previous four years...
- » In 2018, The Devils gave up just 22 plays over 30 yards, tied for 34th-fewest nationally. In the previous four years, ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.
- » In 2018, ASU was tied for 13th nationally for fewest passing plays over 40 yards allowed last season, allowing just five. ASU was 90th in the category the previous year with 12 such plays allowed and 127th in 2016 with 22 passing plays over 40 yards allowed.

KEEP 'EM OFF THE BOARD

- ASU is 18th in the country and third in the Pac-12 in allowing just 18.1 points per game. The Sun Devils allowed just 25.5 points per game last season, good for 53rd nationally. The totals are notable as ASU was 103rd nationally at 32.8 points per game allowed in 2017 and had finished 99th or worse in three consecutive seasons prior to the marked improvement the past two seasons.
- » The Sun Devils are 30th nationally in allowing just 10.3 points per first half this season against FBS opponents and just 5.2 points per second quarter (21st nationally).
- » ASU has been able to close games strong, allowing just 9.7 second half points per game, good for 24th in the nation.
- » ASU has held four opponents under 20 points through six games, a feat it hadn't achieved since 2014. The next milestone would be six such games, which ASU accomplished in 2012.
- ASU has held opponents to 30 or less points in 14 of 20 games in Danny Gonzales' defensive scheme, notable as it DID allow 30+ in 32 of 43 previous games dating back in a span from 2013-17.
- ASU hasn't allowed a first quarter score in 9 of 20 games in the Edwards era and is 7-2 in those games.

ON THE DEFENSE

- » ASU is 34th nationally in allowing just 0.69 points per opponent drive this season. The defense has been especially adept at buckling down when opponents have good field position, allowing just 1.50 points per opponent drive on drives that start less than 60 yards from the end zone good for 12th nationally.
- The Sun Devil defense is currently ranked 34th in the FBS in the Defensive Fremeau Efficiency Index, which represents the per possession scoring advantage a team's defense would be expected to have on a neutral field against an average offense.
- » ASU's defense has held opponents to an average of -12.9 points per game under their current scoring averages for the season. With those opponents games against the Sun Devils removed from their scoring offense statistic, ASU has held opponents to an average of 14.1 points per game under their season averages to date.
- » The Sun Devils are 39th nationally in allowing just 5.1 yards per play this season.
- » Opponents average just 19.3 first downs per game this season, tied for the 31st-lowest total in the country.

NO FLY ZONE

- » Kobe Williams is the 8th-highest graded defender in the Pac-12 at 79.6. He is the 31st-highest graded corner in covers in the FBS this year and the 24th highest graded corner nationally in coverage (24th/81.3).
- Williams has only been thrown at just 19 times this season tied for the 10th-lowest total among corners that have played at least 50 percent of the coverage snaps this season. He has been targeted just once every 9.6 snaps in coverage this season, 12th-lowest among the nation's corners.
- » Williams has allowed just 88 yards in coverage thus far, the 7th-lowest total among the nation's corners with at least 50 percent of their snaps in coverage.
- » Chase Lucas has allowed only 46 yards after the catch in Pac-12 games only this far, the ninth-lowest total out of the corners in the league.

- » Jack Jones is tied for 8th in the country with 11 passes defended this season.
- Jones' five pass breakups against Washington State are the most by an FBS player this season. He was a part of 12 pass breakups by the Sun Devils - the fifth highest total in the FBS this season and the first time ASU posted 10 or more since 2011.
- » ASU's 40 total passes defended this season are tied for 14th in the country.

MIDDLE OF THE LINE-UP

- » Darien Butler's 12 quarterback pressures this season are the fourth-most among Pac-12 linehackers.
- » Khayan Kearse-Thomas and Butler have each been credited with 19 defensive "Stops" this season, tied for 12th among Pac-12 linebackers.
- » Merlin Robertson has been credited with only five missed tackles this season, tied for sixth among Pac-12 linebackers.
- Butler the first true sophomore captain in ASU school history has been credited with just six missed tackles this season this season, tied for the 10th-lowest total in the Pac-12.

SAFETY VALVE

- » Aashari Crosswell is the 6th-highest graded defensive player in the league, regardless of position, with a score of 82.0. Crosswell is the 15th-highest graded safety in the country overall, also setting in the Top-30 nationally among safeties in coverage (30th/79.8) and run defense (28th/80.5).
- Crosswell has not been credited with a missed tackle on a running play this season, marking him one of just 10 safeties in the country with over 100 snaps to lay such a claim.
- » His one missed tackle on the season, period, is tied with three others for fewest among Power Five safeties.
- » Crosswell has allowed just 23 yards after the catch this season, the second-lowest total among Pac-12 safeties and 29th nationally - and his 71 total passing yards allowed are also fourth-lowest in the conference.
- » Crosswell's five forced incompletions this season are most among Pac-12 safeties and sixth among Power Five safeties.
- » Evan Fields has 16 total defensive "stops" this season, a total that leads all safeties in the Pac-12 and tied for 11th among Power Five safeties in the FBS.
- » On run defense this season, Fields has recorded 13 total defensive "stops" to lead all Pac-12 safeties and 12 nationally. His 8.9 run-stop percentage also leads the league and is fifth in the FBS among safeties with over 100 run snaps.
- When he plays within eight yards of the line of scrimmage at the snap, Fields has recorded a 11.3 run-stop percentage - nearly five percentage points higher than any other Pac-12 safety and seventh in the FBS.

LOLEEEEEE, LOLE, LOLE, LOLE

- Jermayne Lole checks in the Top-25 as the 23rd-highest graded defensive player in the Pac-12 with a score of 74.4 and the fourth-highest graded edge defender in the league. He has a 82.2 grade in run defense this season, 27th among "edge" defenders nationally. However, it should be noted many of his grades come as an interior defender.
- » The sophomore has the 12th highest positive run impact score in the country at 24.1 percent among players graded as interior linemen.
- » Among 3-4 defensive ends, Lole's 12.1 run-stop percentage in first in the nation, as are his 13 defensive stops on run plays. His 21 tackles on run defense are third in the FBS.
- » Lole's 10 quarterback pressures are tied for seventh among 3-4 defensive ends in the country.

BRANDON AI-YAC

- WR Brandon Aiyuk is second in the FBS in yards after the catch with 433 this season while his 13.5 yards after the catch per reception are the third-most nationally.
- » He has helped that cause by forcing 11 missed tackles after the catch this year good for 12th among FBS receivers.
- » All five of his touchdown receptions in 2019 have been for more than 30 yards (77 yards vs. Kent State, 53 yards vs. Colorado, 40 yards vs. WSU, 86 yards vs. WSU, 33 yards vs. WSU).



He is averaging 47.8 yards per catch on his average longest individual catch per game.

- » Aiyuk is 12th nationally and 2nd in the Pac-12 with 658 receiving yards on the year and his 94.0 receiving yards per game are also 12th in the FBS and second in the league.
- » At 20.56 yards per recepttion, Aiyuk is first in the Pac-12 and 13th nationally in the category. His 8 plays over 25 yards are 12th nationally.
- » In five of seven games this season, Aiyuk has had at least one catch over 40 yards.
- » Aiyuk's 86-yard touchdown reception against Washington State is the longest passing play/score by a Sun Devil since Demario Richard's 93-yard catch and run against New Mexico in 2015. It was the eighth-longest catch in ASU history.
- » His 196 total receiving yards in the Washington State contest with the 11th-most in Sun Devil history. His 28.0 yard per catch average in the game was easily the highest single-game per-catch average of a Sun Devil recording seven catches in a game, passing N'Keal Harry's previous record of 24.3 in 2017. It is the highest yards-per-catch average in a single game for any receiver in ASU history with 7 or more catches in a game.
- The senior is currently 20th nationally and first in the Pac-12 in all-purpose yards at 129.43 per game.

NOBODY'S BUSINESS BUT THE TURKS

- » Michael Turk's 46.8 yards per punt average is 8th in the FBS and leads the Pac-12.
- » Turk has pinned 19 punts inside the 20, tied for the 5th-highest total nationally.
- The 63.0 yards per punt mark by Turk on Aug. 29 vs. Kent State broke an NCAA record. The previous record for highest average yards per punt in a game with minimum five attempts was Braden Mann of Texas A&M on Sept. 22, 2018, as he had a 60.8 yards per punt average vs. Alabama on punts of 56, 65, 62, 61 and 60 for 304 yards. Turks punted five times for 315 yards with boots of 64, 62, 65, 49 and 75 in his Sun Devil debut.
- » Turk crushed Sun Devils school records for punting average, breaking the previous school record for average on five punts of 55.0 by Danny White in 1972. Turk's 63.0 yards per punt would have set records for every minumum number of punts in a game with the closest being Tony Lorick's 59.3 yards per punt on three punts in 1962.
- Turk's 75-yarder to in the opener was tied for the seventh-longest punt in school history and remains the second-longest punt in the FBS this season.

Z'S PEDIGREE

- » Cristian Zendejas has quickly added his name to the ASU family legacy in two games at placekicker, following his dad (Luis Zendejas 1981-84) and uncle (Alan Zendejas 1987-89). Luis Zendejas is the former all-time leading scorer in Sun Devil history before he was passed in 2016 by Lou Groza Award winner Zane Gonzalez.
- Zendejas was named the Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week for his effort against Sacramento State as he became the first Sun Devil kicker since 2016 to make four field goals in a game, when Zane Gonzalez kicked four against UTSA. The four field goals are tied for sixth in a single game in school history.
- » Zendejas is 12-for-16 on field goals this season and is 17-for-17 on extra points. His 12 field goals are tied for 10th nationally.
- Zendejas has four field goals over 40 yards this season, tied for 8th in the country and matches ASU's total from last season. His five field goals from 30-39 yards are tied for seventh in the country.

KEEPING MOMENTUM

- The Sun Devils had a streak of scoring double-digit points in 125 consecutive games ended against Utah, matching the longest streak in the modern era of FBS football with Lousiana Tech (125 straight games from 2008-2018).
- » ASU also had the FBS' longest active streak of consecutive games scoring more than 7 points ended at 140 straight games in that Utah contest. The Sun Devils had last scored fewer than 7 points when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 77 of those games (55.0 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won as least seven games in five of the last seven seasons.
- Sun Devil Football has had one of the top home field advantages in the FBS in the last six seasons, recording a 38-12 record at Sun Devil Stadium since 2012. The 38 wins are tied for 18th nationally in that time while the 12 losses are the 12th-fewest in the FBS

since 2012.

THE KIDS WILL BE ALRIGHT

- » All told, 29 true or redshirt freshmen have played for the Sun Devils this year.
- » Five true freshmen have started a game for ASU, tied the fourth-highest total in the nation behind Alabama and UMASS (7) and Stanford (6).
- » Freshmen are responsible for 1,473 of ASU 1,884 total yards of total offense this season, a 78.1 percentage that ranks behind only Ole Miss (2,189 of 2,628/83.3 percent).
- » Overall, ASU has 40 true freshmen on the roster (sixth in the FBS) and 13 redshirt freshmen. The 54 total freshmen equates to 52.5 percent of ASU's roster of 101 the fourth-highest percentage of a roster in the FBS behind only Oklahoma State (57.1), UCLA (52.8) and Virginia Tech (52.5)
- The Sun Devils played 25 freshmen in the season opener (15 true, 10 redshirt) the most ever in the modern era at ASU. That was the third-highest total in the country behind only Clemson (38 27/11) and Baylor (35 20/15).
- » Jayden Daniels became the first TRUE freshman quarterback to start for the Sun Devils on Opening Day in ASU's modern era (freshmen became eligible to play in 1972).
- » Daniels is just the sixth true freshman to start any game at quarterback in ASU history, joining Dillon Sterling-Cole (2016), Brock Osweiler (2009), Jake Plummer (1993), John Walker (1984) and Dennis Sproul (1974).
- » For the first time in program history, a freshman was named a team captain after Herm Edwards dubbed true freshman quarterback/athlete Ethan Long as special teams captain before the season. Additionally, Darien Butler will be the first true sophomore captain in program history after the linebacker was named captain for the team's defense. Prior to this season, no player that had been with the program for less than three years had ever been named a team captain in ASU history.
- Arizona State is the only team in the country starting two true freshmen on its offensive line.

MANDRAKE OF THE WEEK

- The Mandrake has quickly become a figure of Herm Edwards' lore at Arizona State. The Mandrake embodies strength, speed, athleticism, aggressive, high motor, and mental toughness.
- This season, the Sun Devils have unveiled a special Mandrake practice uniform to be worn player that most embodies these characteristics in the previous weekend's game.
- » The Mandrake title is only rewarded after a win. As such there was no Mandrake of the Week selected following the Utah loss.
