#### Sun Devil Update

The Sand Devils most recently competed at the Pac-12 South Invitational, narrowly losing to crosstown rival Arizona in the fourth matchup 3-2. The Devils also faced off against Stanford, USC and Cal, falling in each dual.

Sophomore Kate Fitzgerald and freshman Kylie Wickley earned the most wins in the last weekend of competition, the two of them teaming up to win the two matches they played together, both against ranked opponents. Fitzgerald leads the team in individual wins this season with 12. The next three Sand Devils are tied at 11: Wickley, sophomore Taryn Ames and senior Maddy Salazar.

#### Record Book Watch

Fifth-year senior Cierra Flood reached another milestone with her 60th career win. That put her in third place in the ASU record books. Meanwhile, junior Lexi Sweeney moved up to 13th with 26 wins while fellow junior Sarah Waters is in 14th with 25. As a pair, sophomores Taryn Ames and Kate Fitzgerald are in eight place for career pair wins.

#### **Debuts**

Four Sand Devils have made their collegiate debuts this season. Freshmen Rylie Kael and Anya Pemberton have played in every dual so far. Sophomore Cambria Hall also made the lineup for the first time in the opening weekend, while freshman Kylie Wickley played at the No. 5 spot in all four duals at the Cactus Classic..

#### **New Home**

Arizona State has a brand new facility for the 2022 season. The Sun Devil Beach Volleyball Facility opened in February 2022 and features four championship courts. With flexible seating, fans can bring their beach chairs to watch the action. The courts will also be available to host open tournaments, intramural sports and other events and activities.

The Sand Devils will have three days this season with competitions on their home courts: March 8, March 24 and April 15. The new Sun Devil Beach Volleyball

#### Fifth-Year Flood

Fifth-year senior Cierra Flood used her extra season to return to the Sand Devils and add to her illustrious career. She is the current career wins leader on the roster and started the season in sixth place in the record book. In 2021, she led the team in total wins with 12.

#### Returners

The 2022 roster sees fifteen athletes returning with the combo of Flood and junior Sarah Waters among them. The two teamed up in the No. 3 spot for nearly all duals in the 2021 season. They had a record of 12-9 for the season, capturing wins over three pairs from ranked teams.

Half of the No. 1 duo will return with Lexi Sweeney as she enters her junior season. Teamed with former Sun Devil student-athlete Katelyn Carballo, the two clinched a record of 11-11 for the 2021 season. Taryn Ames also returns after recording an 11-9 record playing at the No. 5 spot with Kate Fitzgerald, Weintraub, or Maddy Salazar, all who are returning this season.

#### **New Faces**

Six freshmen join the 2022 roster, all of whom have worked their way to success in the sport. The Sand Devils have the dual winners of the p1440 Southwest Championship both on the roster in that of Anya Pemberton and Rylie Kael.

Success does not run short in the talent coming onto the roster with Katie Blomberg fresh off a win at the 2021 TAPPS Beach State Championship and Kylie Wickley with a Gold Metal at the 2021 AVP Arizona State Championships (AVP 4 Star 18U).

#### **Last Season**

The Sand Devils ended the 2021 season with a 10-12 record, collecting four sweeps. In head coach Brad Keenan's fifth season at the helm, the Sand Devils went 4-7 in the Pac-12, earning wins over Washington, Utah and No. 11 Cal. They pushed forward into the Pac-12 Championships where they picked up a win over Washington before bowing out.

#### 2022 Schedule Outlook

The schedule is packed with competitive teams to strengthen the Sand Devils. Six teams on the schedule made it to the 2021 NCAA Championships: Cal Poly, Loyola Marymount, Stanford, TCU, UCLA and USC. The Bruins and Trojans advanced to the championship match and USC won the title. Ten opponents are ranked in the AVCA Preseason Coaches Poll, including USC at No. 1 and UCLA at No. 2.

- Hired as the eighth head coach on May 13, 2016
- Has three wins over ranked opponents (3 in 2019)
- Led ASU to its winningest season in program history in 2019, finishing the season ranked No. 20. The team did not lose to a single unranked team in 2019.
- Previously coached at Concordia University with the men's volleyball team in 2015.
- Also served as a volunteer assistant coach with the USA Women's National Team, Balboa Bay Volleyball Club, Surf City Volleyball Club and with the Fountain Valley High School Varsity Volleyball program.
- Made his professional beach volleyball debut in 2006, and has since earned 25 top-three finishes on the Association of Volleyball Professionals (AVP) tour. He was named the 2006 Rookie of the Year, and earned Most Improved Player accolades in 2007. In 2014 he was recognized as the AVP's Best Server. He also spent seven years with the Fédération Internationale de Volleyball (FIVB), from 2009-15.
- Keenan was a four-time AVCA All-American and two-time National Player of the Year at Pepperdine, where he was a middle blocker from 2000-03. He finished his career as the record holder in blocks and service aces and earned his Bachelor of Science in Accounting. In 2014, Keenan was inducted into the Pepperdine Hall of Fame.



- He came to ASU after a season with Cal's beach volleyball team as the volunteer assistant coach.
- Prior to his time with the Bears, he was part of the UC Berkeley beach volleyball coaching staff and spent time working with various top beach volleyball clubs in California.
- He also coached indoor volleyball teams at the high school level, winning three state championships in four years at Cathedral Catholic High School with the women's team and then moved to the men's indoor team to win two CIF titles.
- He also won a state title in his first season with Point Loma High School's indoor women's team.
- Competed on the AVP Tour from 2005-18, recording three top-10 finishes in his career. His best finish was seventh place in 2016 at the Seattle Open.
- He played on San Diego State's club team, where he was selected to the all-tournament team in both 2004 and 2005.
- He graduated with a degree in psychology. He played at Grossmont College for two years before transferring to SDSU.
