BACK ON THE ROAD

Closing out the regular season, No. T-11 Sun Devil Water Polo (17-7, 1-4 MPSF) head to California to face the top ranked USC (24-1, 3-0 MPSF) at Uytengsu Aquatics Center this Saturday at 1 p.m. Live stats will be on 6-8 sports and the match will be streamed on Overnht.

The trip to LA is a familiar one for redshirt junior Molly Glad as she graduated with her undergraduate degree from USC in 2024. As a Trojan, Glad accumulated 15 points with 13 of those being goals.

THE RUNDOWN

- The Sun Devils return 11 from the previous season with Millie Quin leading the way in scoring with a career high 69 goals in 2024.
- Arizona State finished the 2024 season with a win after defeating Indiana in last seasons' MPSF Conference tournament.
- With 11 returners, the Sun Devils also boast 11 newcomers, including transfer Molly Glad who spent three seasons at USC before joining the Maroon and Gold.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Sun Devils dropped an MPSF match to No. 5 California 14-18 over the weekend. ASU was led by Itziar Almeda and Millie Quin, who scored eight and six points respectively, but were unable to pull off the upset.

IT'S A FAMILY MATTER

- The 2025 roster boasts two sets of sisters, junior Zoe Frangieh and freshman Karly Frangieh as well as redshirt junior Molly Glad and freshman Keri Glad.

WATER POLO HISTORY

- Originally established in 2002, the Maroon & Gold have an all-time record of 378-279.
- ASU boasts 30 All-Americans and have had at least one all-american in 18 straight seasons.

AROUND THE GLOBE

- The team has talent from all over the world, coming from six different countries totaling ten athletes. The countries are the Netherlands, Hungary, New Zealand, Spain, Canada, and Australia.
- Two freshmen represented their respective countries at the World Aquatics Women's U18 World Championships this past fall. Itziar Almeda took home gold, notching 16 goals throughout the tournament to help solidify the win for Spain. Keri Glad represented the United States and finished in fourth.

LOCAL TALENT

- Ashley Byron is from Chandler, Arizona and attended Corona Del Sol High School, seven miles from Tempe. She is the first Arizona native to rep the Maroon and Gold in program history.

- CWPA Ranking: T-11

MPSF LEADERS

- The MPSF stats leader board is littered with Maroon and Gold as five individuals rank among fellow conference members. Millie Quin sits in third for goals and points with 78 and 99 respectively. She also has 31 steals which puts her in fourth place for steals. Itziar Almeda has 61 goals (fifth place) and 33 assists (sixth place) for a combined 94 points (fourth place). In net, Keri Glad has 122 saves, landing her in fifth place for saves. She also boasts the third highest save percentage of .2857%. Sanne Keijzer sits in eighth for her 71 saves. Senior Marie Rudasics has the second highest save percentage in the conference at 66.04%.

MPSF NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

- Itziar Almeda was named MPSF Newcomer of the Week for the second time this season. This award comes off an impressive 8-point performance last weekend against No. 5 Cal. Almeda was an integral part in keeping the Sun Devils in the game with six goals and two assists. She also added two steals and two field blocks to her weekend statistics.

ABOUT THE MPSF CONFERENCE

- Established in 1992 to serve the needs of the Big West, Pac-10/12, Western Athletic Conference and many other institutions in the United States to provide Division I Intercollegiate Olympic Sports in a conference setting.
- The MPSF has won 107 NCAA titles since 1992 and the conference has stayed perfect in collegiate water polo winning all 22 women's national titles since 2000, and all 31 national titles in men's water polo.

BIO BLAST:

Petra Pardi was announced as head coach of Sun Devil Water Polo on May 18, 2022 and is an alumnae of the program and a two-time Arizona State graduate. Pardi ranks among the top of the Sun Devil record books, for goals scored (157), assists (71), and points (228). Pardi is one of 30 All-Americans in program history and served as team captain in her senior season. In August of 2018 she was promoted as assistant coach under Todd Clapper after earning her master's degree in Higher Education Administration and being a graduate assistant upon returning to ASU in 2016. Pardi was part of the 2014 NCAA tournament team, and was an assistant for the team that finished in third at the 2021 NCAA tournament. She played for the Hungarian national team and the youth, junior and senior levels before coming to Tempe.
