**THE GAME** - Sun Devil Football will conclude the regular season on the road this weekend as the team travels south to take on in-state foe Arizona in the annual Territorial Cup Game. The rivalry match is scheduled to kickoff at 1:30 p.m. Arizona time on Saturday, Nov. 24. The game will be broadcast live on Fox Sports 1 with Christopher Vosters on the call, alongside analyst Petros Papadakis. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, on the call alongside analyst Jeff Van Raaphorst and sideline reporter Jordan Simone

**TERRITORIAL CUP** -This will be the 91st Duel in the Desert, with Arizona leading the all-time series 49-41-1. The winner of the game will receive (or retain) the Territorial Cup Trophy, and the game is recognized by the NCAA as the nation's oldest rivalry trophy game.

ASU downed the Wildcats in Tempe last season, 42-30. Arizona leads the series in games played in Tucson, 31-19. Neither team has truly dominated the series since the Wildcats went 8-0-1 against ASU over the course of the 1980s. Since then, there have only been two occurrences where one team has posted a three-game winning streak - once for each team (ASU 2005-07, UA 1993-95).

The Sun Devils will be looking to take their sixth victory in the past nine contests against Arizona. The home team has won each of the last five meetings, though the road teams won four in a row from 2009-12. The winning team has scored at least 41 points in the last 6 contests between the two teams. Eight of the previous 14 games have been decided by a touchdown or less.

- Give ASU 6 wins over Arizona in the last 9 matchups.
- Eliminate Arizona from bowl eligibility.

- Give ASU a second-place finish in the Pac-12 South

No ASU running back has **lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 854 consecutive carries**, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 30 consecutive games. That includes 279 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only RBs on rushing plays and does not include receptions). The fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back. If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,193 carries over 43 games (since 2015).

**Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 132 straight games.** The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 74 of those games (56.1 percent). The Sun Devils scored at least 30 points in each of their victories during it's three-game winning streak. ASU is 5-0 this year when scoring 30 or more points.

**Eno Benjamin needs just 122 rushing yards to set ASU's all-time single season school record.**

Benjamin is currently third in the nation with 1,444 rushing yards as he eyes Woody Green's 1972 school record of 1,565. Eno Benjamin ranks first among Pac-12 running backs with an overall grade of 82.6 according to Pro Football Focus, over 4 points higher than the next closest tailback. It is the 8th-highest grade among all Pac-12 offensive players, regardless of position. He has rushed for 70 first downs this season, second nationally and 6 behind the national leader

**N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 36 games of his career at Arizona State**, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among active FBS players. Harry has a 121.5 Pro Football Focus QB rating when targeted this season, good for 15th nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets. He has forced 17 missed tackles this season, which is good for 7th-most among Power Five receivers. Harry's ability to make plays pivotal situations has been a staple of his career. In 2018, he is 5th among all FBS receivers in receiving yards in the fourth quarter of games (327) and tied for 6th with four fourth quarter touchdown receptions. His 12 first down grabs in the fourth quarter of games are fifth nationally.

The Sun Devil have also closed games strongly, holding opponents to just 3.8 points per fourth quarter - the 6th lowest total nationally and allowing ASU to outscore opponents 99-42 in the frame this season. ASU struggled to close teams out last year, allowing 8.9 points per fourth quarter (112th nationally). ASU was 124th (10.7 points per fourth) in 2016, 121st (11.1 point per fourth) in 2015 and 101st (8.6 points per fourth) in 2014. The tough scoring defense has kept ASU in every game this season, with eight games this year being decide by one possession - tied for the most in the FBS this year. Unfortunately, ASU has been on the wrong end of five of those - the most losses by less than a TD in the FBS.

Cohl Cabral is one of just 17 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year and is the 26th-highest graded center as a pass blocker in all of the FBS according to Pro Football Focus (81.2) and 3rd-highest graded center overall in the Pac-12 (69.2) and 38th-highest graded center in the FBS. Cabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 9.9 percent of his rushing snaps this season - the 21st-best percentage among FBS centers in the country and 2nd in the Pac-12. ASU's 15 sacks allowed this season are 24th nationally. A year ago, ASU finished 124th in the nation with 41 sacks allowed and 119th in 2016 with 41 sacks.

## #10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

- ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 12 of its last 16 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard with 4 and Eno Benjamin with 8).
- Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have combined for 2,893 play snaps on defense this season with two games left to play. Comparatively, freshmen combined for just 918 total defensive snaps played in 2017 and 1,035 in 2016.
- Only three Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 600 defensive snaps this season and all of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson/661, Darien Butler/616, Aashari Crosswell/634).
- Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 132 straight games.
- No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 854 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 30 consecutive games.
- According to Pro Football Focus, there are just 17 3-4 outside linebackers in the FBS to not miss a tackle on a running play this season that have played at least 100 snaps on rushing plays - with Merlin Robertson being one of those.
- ASU has held opponents to just 3.8 points per 4th quarter - the 6th lowest total in FBS as ASU's outscored opponents 99-42 in the frame. ASU was 112th last season (8.9 points per 4th), 124th (10.7 points) in '16, 121st (11.1 point) in '15 and 101st (8.6 points) in '14.
- ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently tied for 23rd in the FBS with 1.36 allowed per game.
- The Sun Devils are forcing opponents into the 6th-worst starting field position nationally, with teams starting on average at their own 25.1 yard line.
- N'Keal Harry is within 103 receiving yards of second in program history, despite the fact that seven of ASU's 10 all-time leading receivers did so in four seasons while Harry still has at least two games left in his junior campaign.



## HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is the 21st-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 (77.3) by Pro Football Focus, regardless of position and the fourth-highest quarterback in the league.
- » Wilkins currently sits at 8,230 career passing yards, good for fifth in Sun Devil football history - within striking distance of moving into the Top 3 in ASU history (8,827 yards by Jake Plummer) with two games remaining.
- » His 667 career completions are good for fourth in program lore while his 50 career touchdown passes are 6th in program history.
- » Wilkins has 19 rushing touchdowns in his career, good for second among all ASU quarterbacks in school history behind only Mark Malone (21). He has 7 rushing touchdowns this season, tied for 17th nationally, and needs two more touchdown passes to join what is currently a list of eight quarterbacks this season with 20+ passing touchdowns and 7+ rushing touchdowns.
- » Last season, Wilkins had 7 rushing touchdowns as well, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS on the year to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins has accounted for 69 career touchdowns (50 passing and 19 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 101.2 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 21st-best total in the FBS.
- » Wilkins has a 123.5 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the 8th-best total in the country.
- » Wilkins has just an 12.5 sack percentage (percentage of time sacked when under pressure) that sits as the 24th-lowest total in the nation.
- » Wilkins is 24th nationally in adjusted completion percentage (73.4 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.
- » Wilkins is one of just six quarterbacks in ASU history to win a game at the Los Angeles Coliseum and just the second one since 2000 (joining Mike Bercovici).

## DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 36 games of his career at Arizona State - tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players - and is on pace to join school record holder D.J. Foster (53 straight games with a catch) as the only other Sun Devil to log a reception in every game of their career.
- » Harry is third in program history with 209 career receptions and he has moved to fourth in program history with 2,834 career receiving yards. That tally is within 103 yards of second in program history, despite the fact that seven of ASU's 10 all-time leading receivers did so in four seasons while Harry still has at least two games left in his junior campaign.
- » At 5.81 receptions per game in his career, Harry is third among the NCAA's active career leaders in the category. His 78.7 career receiving yards per game are fifth among all active players.
- » His 209 career receptions are 6th among all active players but first among players that are not seniors. All five players ahead of him in the category are seniors. Similarly, Harry's 22 career touchdown receptions are 9th among active players but second among players that are not seniors.
- » With 22 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 5th in ASU school history and needs just two more to move into fourth. Harry has at least one touchdown reception in 10 of last 16 games. He has 14 touchdown receptions in those 16 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.

## REAL DEAL N'KEAL

- » Harry posts an 86.0 overall grade from Pro Football Focus, the fifth-highest graded wide receiver nationally and the third-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 - regardless of position. The junior ranks in the Top-30 nationally in receiving touchdowns (9/15th), receiving yards (1,033/12th), receiving yards per game (93.9/14th) and receptions per game (6.3/21st).
- » Harry has a 121.5 Pro Football Focus QB rating when targeted this season, good for 15th nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.
- » He has forced 17 missed tackles this season, which is good for 7th-most among Power Five receivers.
- » Harry's ability to make plays pivotal situations has been a staple of his career. In 2018, he is 5th among all FBS receivers in receiving yards in the fourth quarter of games (327) and tied for 6th with four fourth quarter touchdown receptions. His 12 first down grabs in the fourth quarter of games are fifth nationally.
- » That ability has kept ASU in striking distance of games as well as Harry is 7th in the nation

with 318 receiving yards when the Sun Devils are trailing by a touchdown or less with 16 first-down grabs (second nationally).

- » The junior out of Chandler, Ariz., has demonstrated his versatility throughout the season, scoring touchdowns receiving, rushing and on punt return this season and being responsible for numerous game-changing plays all across the football field. Harry is averaging 109.9 all-purpose yards per game (7th in the Pac-12 and Top 60 nationally) and has played 753 snaps this season - 9th-most among all Power Five receivers - and has at times handled direct snap-taking duties in the team's Sparky formation.
- » In the past four weekends, Harry has been named both the Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week and the Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week and totaled over 100 all-purpose yards in each game during ASU's three-game win streak. Harry has posted 568 all-purpose yards (461 receiving, 4 rushing, 103 punt returns) and a combined six touchdowns (5 receiving, 1 punt return) in that span.

## ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin is 7th nationally and 2nd in the Pac-12 conference in averaging 150.73 All-Purpose Yards per game.
- » He leads the Pac-12 (17th nationally) with 12 rushing touchdowns this season and is first in the league (11th nationally) in total touchdowns (14).
- » He is 3rd nationally (leads Pac-12) with 1,444 rushing yards this season and fourth nationally (first in Pac-12) at 131.3 rushing yards per game.
- » He has rushed for 70 first downs this season, second nationally and 6 behind the national leader
- » At 1.44 rushing yards this year, Eno Benjamin has easily eclipsed Ryan Torain's Pac-12-era ASU school record of 1,229 yards for a single season (2006).
- » The Sun Devil school record is 1,565 yards - set by Woody Green in 1972 - a mark that will be worth keeping an eye on as early as this weekend against Arizona.
- » Mario Bates (1993) and J.R. Redmond (1999) are the only other running backs since 1978 to average over 100 yards per game in a single season. Benjamin is currently at 131.3 yards per game.
- » In the Pac-12 era, no ASU running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently 3rd nationally at 1,444 yards. Darryl Clack (1984) and Mario Bates (1993) both finished 18th nationally - the highest for a Sun Devil Running back in the Pac-12 era.

## NUMERO ENO

- » Eno Benjamin ranks first among Pac-12 running backs with an overall grade of 82.6 according to Pro Football Focus, over 4 points higher than the next closest tailback. It is the 8th-highest grade among all Pac-12 offensive players, regardless of position.
- » Benjamin ranks 6th among Power-Five running backs with that 81.4 score, though he only had 23 career rushes prior to this season. No players in PFF's current Top-10 Power Five running backs had fewer than 100 touches last season.
- » His 88.4 score from PFF on rushing plays only is 3rd among all Power Five backs and 9th among all FBS running backs.
- » Benjamin has forced 76 missed tackles this season (65 rushing, 11 receiving) - second among all FBS players in the category.
- » Benjamin does not have a fumble on 256 carries this season - one of just 38 running backs that have played 300+ snaps without a fumble and the most carries without a fumble among any running back in the FBS.
- » 36.0 percent of Benjamin's rushes this season have resulted in a "win" for the Sun Devil offense according to Pro Football Focus, the 15th-highest total among FBS running backs with at least 150 carries. 31.7 percent of his rushes have resulted in a first down or touchdown, the 16th-highest percentage in the FBS with 150+ carries.
- » Benjamin's 28 explosive runs this season (runs for over 15 yards) are third nationally and his explosive run percentage of 10.7 percent is 12th in the FBS.
- » Since Pac-12 play started for ASU in Week 4, Benjamin has rushed for 1,273 yards 0 the second most in the country in that span.
- » Benjamin set a single-game school rushing record with 312 yards against Oregon State, placing him eighth all-time on the Pac-12 conference single-game rushing list and the highest single-game performance in the FBS this season.





## THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 21 solo tackles this season - tied for 11th among all FBS corners.
- » Lucas is the 30th-highest graded pass rushing corner in the FBS, scoring a 63.5 score as a pass rusher this year. He has six quarterback pressures this season, 4th among FBS cornerbacks and his push-rush productivity score of 27.8 from PFF is second nationally.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014. He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.
- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference - regardless of year.

## DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU is currently 25th nationally and second in the Pac-12 in averaging 7.5 tackles for loss per game this season. ASU was 50th a year ago in the category, averaging just over 6 tackles for loss per game.
- » The Sun Devils are 41st in the nation and fourth in the Pac-12 in sacks per game, averaging 2.45 per game thus far.
- » 21 players have logged a tackle for loss this season for ASU, making the Sun Devils one of just one of 14 teams nationally to lay such a claim. 12 different players have scored a sack.
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.

## DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » The Sun Devils have allowed just 23.0 points per game this season, good for 40th nationally. A year ago, ASU was 103rd nationally at 32.8 points per game and had finished 99th or worse in three consecutive seasons prior to the marked improvement this year.
- » ASU did not allow more than 30 points in the first 7 games of the season, one of just 11 teams in the nation to do so in 2018. ASU has held opponents to 30 or less points in 9 of 11 games this season.
- » This was just the fifth season in the Pac-12 era that ASU has opened the year with seven consecutive games not allowing 30 points, joining the 1982, 1986, 1991 and 1997 campaigns
- » The Sun Devil defense did not allow a single point in the first quarter of games against non-conference opponents and haven't allowed one in six of 11 games this year. ASU has allowed just 4.5 points per first quarter this season, good for 31st nationally. Last season, ASU allowed 6.7 first quarter points per game - the 82nd worst tally nationally.
- » The Sun Devil have also closed games strongly, holding opponents to just 3.8 points per fourth quarter - the 6th lowest total nationally and allowing ASU to outscore opponents 99-42 in the frame this season. ASU struggled to close teams out last year, allowing 8.9 points per fourth quarter (112th nationally). ASU was 124th (10.7 points per fourth) in 2016, 121st (11.1 point per fourth) in 2015 and 101st (8.6 points per fourth) in 2014.
- » The tough scoring defense has kept ASU in every game this season, with eight games this year being decide by one possession - tied for the most in the FBS this year. Unfortunately, ASU has been on the wrong end of five of those games - the most losses by a touchdown or less of any team in the nation.

## HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 854 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 30 consecutive games. That includes 279 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions).

- » Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1,193 carries over 43 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.
- » ASU ranks tied for seventh nationally with only 9 turnovers this season and are one of just three teams from a Power Five conference with fewer than 10 turnovers on the year. ASU is outscoring opponents 59-20 in points off turnovers this season.
- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.

## MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 646-348 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 67.5 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (108 of 160) while finding the end zone 82 times in that span (51.3 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 51.8 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (59 of 114) with 45 touchdowns (39.5 percent).

## KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » Renell Wren has scored a positive grade on 17.9 percent of his plays on running snaps, the 9th-highest percentage of all Pac-12 front-seven players this season. He is 39th nationally among all defensive interior linemen in the FBS in the category.
- » Wren has the 12th-highest run defense score among Pac-12 interior defenders with a 76.1 grade from PFF.
- » Jalen Harvey has made 40 tackles within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage as a safety - the 11th-highest total among all safeties nationally despite essentially missing two games this year
- » According to Pro Football Focus, there are just 17 3-4 outside linebackers in the FBS to not miss a tackle on a running play this season that have played at least 100 snaps on rushing plays - with Merlin Robertson being one of those.

## LOCKING IT DOWN

- » ASU is tied for 14th nationally in allowing just 6 plays over 40 yards this season, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). ASU is also tied for 9th nationally in allowing just 2 plays of over 50 yards on the year.
- » The Devils have given up just 17 plays over 30 yards, tied for 29th-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.
- » ASU is tied for 16th nationally for fewest passing plays over 40 yards allowed this season, allowing just four. ASU was 90th in the category a year ago with 12 such plays allowed and 127th in 2016 with 22 passing plays over 40 yards allowed.
- » The Sun Devils are 55th in allowing 5.56 yards per play this year, an improvement of nearly 60 positions from the team's 111th place finish in the category last year (6.33 yards per play). ASU had finished 109th or worse in the category in three consecutive seasons prior to the current campaign.

## ON THE DEFENSE

- » The Sun Devils are forcing opponents into the 6th-worst starting field position nationally, with teams starting on average at their own 25.1 yard line.
- » ASU is 42nd nationally in average opponent third-down distance (7.8 yards).
- » On those passing downs, opponents are averaging a marginal explosive tally of -0.11, according to Bill Connelly's advanced metrics, the 18th-best score nationally.
- » A testament to ASU's ability to crack down on the big play, the Sun Devils are 27th nationally with a -0.05 defensive marginal explosiveness rating.
- » The defense has been exceptional in limiting scoring, logging in a 1.07 IsoPPP (points per play) score based on Connelly's metrics, the 28th-best total among FBS defenses. A year ago, ASU was 111th (1.17).
- » ASU's 327 points allowed per play (minus fancy calculations) is 33rd nationally after finishing 98th last season (.445) and 125th in 2016 (.552)
- » The Sun Devil defense causes havoc (tackles for loss, fumbles forced or passed defended/intercepted) 18.2 percent of the time - good for 28th nationally - and 2 points over the nation average. ASU had just a 14.1% havoc rate last season (94th nationally).
- » ASU's defense has held opponents to just 2.17 points per possession on "short" field drives



(drives that start with 60 or fewer yards to go to the end zone). That's the 7th-lowest total nationally. ASU was 64th a year ago in the category (3.35).

- » The Sun Devil defense has surrendered a touchdown on just 25.0 percent of opponent drives, the 51st-best total nationally after being ranked 90th (31.3 percent) a year ago.
- » The Sun Devil defense has bent but not broke this year, allowing an opponent touchdown on drives where a first down was allowed only 32.6 percent of the time this season (36th nationally) after sitting 91st (42.4 percent) in the country last season.

### TAKING OFFENSE

- » ASU is 13th nationally in Offensive Ball Control Rate (drives that last 4 plays or more) - doing so 73.5 percent of the time.
- » The Devils are 25th nationally in Offensive First Down rate (drives that result in at least a single first down) with 76.9 percent of its drives resulting in at least one first down.
- » ASU has capitalized on short field position, scoring 4.13 points per drive when the possession STARTS within 60 yards of the opponent end zone - 27th nationally.
- » ASU is also 30th nationally in total points per drive, sitting at 2.59.
- » ASU's offense has been fairly successful when backed up against their own goal line, scoring a successful play 46.7 percent of the time - the 30th-best total nationally.
- » ASU gets itself into manageable third-and-short situations 15.3 percent of the time (13th nationally).
- » ASU only finds itself in third-and-long situations 42.0 percent of the time this season, good for the 16th-lowest total national. Its average third-down distance is 6.9 yards - the 31st-best total in the country.
- » ASU is 26th nationally in fourth quarter points per game (9.0) and have outscored opponents 99-42 in the fourth quarter of games this year.

### THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

- » Only three Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 600 defensive snaps this season and all of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson/661, Darien Butler/616, Aashari Crosswell/634).
- » Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have combined for 2,893 play snaps on defense this season with two games left to play. Comparatively, freshmen combined for just 918 total defensive snaps played in 2017 and 1,035 in 2016.
- » Robertson's 661 snaps are the 5th-most among any Power Five true freshman in the country.
- » Robertson was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week for his performance against #16 Utah, becoming the first freshman offensive or defensive player to accomplish the task since 2010.
- » Among all true or redshirt freshmen playing for Power Five teams in the country, none have more defensive stops (as graded by Pro Football Focus) than Robertson (33) and Butler (31). The duo ranks 12th and 18th overall in the Pac-12, regardless of year in school.
- » Sun Devil freshmen (true or redshirt) have accounted for 34.4 percent of all of ASU's tackles this season (248 of 720) and 43.8 percent of the team's total tackles for loss (35 of 80).
- » Robertson is third among all Pac-12 linebackers with 22 QB pressures this season while Butler sits ninth among the league's linebackers.

### IN THE TRENCHES

- » ASU has now twice gone consecutive games without allowing a sack (Washington/Oregon State and USC/Utah) The last time ASU had consecutive games doing so even once in a season was 2005 (LSU and Northwestern).
- » The Devils now have 5 such games this year (UTSA, UW, OSU, USC and Utah). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack.
- » ASU's 15 sacks allowed this season are 24th nationally. A year ago, ASU finished 124th in the nation with 41 sacks allowed and 119th in 2016 with 41 sacks allowed as well.
- » ASU hasn't finished in Top-100 in fewest sacks allowed per game since 2011 (74th). In fact, since 2003 (as far back as easily accessible team rankings go), ASU has finished in the top-100 just 3 times, and never better than 70th. ASU is currently tied for 23rd in the FBS with 1.36 allowed per game.
- » Cohl Cabral is one of just 17 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year and is the 26th-highest graded center as a pass blocker in all of the FBS according to Pro Football Focus (81.2) and 3rd-highest graded center overall in the Pac-12 (69.2) and

38th-highest graded center in the FBS.

- » Cabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 9.9 percent of his rushing snaps this season - the 21st-best percentage among FBS centers in the country and 2nd in the Pac-12.
- » Quinn Bailey is tied for 15th among all offensive tackles in the FBS (with 50 percent of the play snaps) with just one sack allowed this season.
- » Bailey's 11 pressures allowed are tied for 5th-fewest among Pac-12 tackles and 23rd-fewest among Power Five tackles. He is Pro Football Focus' 42nd-highest graded pass-blocking tackle among all tackles in the FBS this season (82.9) - 9th best among Pac-12 tackles.
- » Getting it done on the outside has been important also, as wide receiver Kyle Williams is the 26th-highest graded receiver in the FBS this season as a run-blocker (76.5).
- » Following the non-conference slate, ASU's run game efficiency from PFF was ranked 85th nationally (8th in Pac-12) with a play success rate of 32.9. During the Pac-12 slate, ASU is ranked 39th nationally (3rd in Pac-12) with a success rate of 36.5 (4 points above national avg).

### GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 12 of its last 16 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard with 4 and Eno Benjamin with 8).
- » Benjamin's 8 100+ yard performances this season put him in rare company. He is now one of just five Sun Devils have had 7 or more in a season and tied for the school record with Freddie Williams and Art Malone (8). Woody Green (7, twice) and Demario Richard (7) are the only others to reach the 7-game milestone.
- » ASU had 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards six times in the last seven seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » ASU currently has the 11th-highest graded rushing attack of 2018, according to Pro Football Focus.

### KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State holds the FBS active streak for consecutive games scoring more than 7 points, currently doing so in 132 straight games. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 74 of those games (56.1 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.
- » The Sun Devils are 31-8 at home since 2013 and are one of just 17 teams in the FBS to win 30 home games in that time frame.
