QUICK HITS

- To kick off conference play, Arizona State swept instate rival Arizona in the home opener, hitting a season-high .330 in the first win over the Wildcats since 2016. ASU then went on the road and fell at UCLA in three, the Sun Devils' only time getting swept this season.
- Junior outside hitter Andrea Mitrovic leads the Sun Devils in kills with 152, hitting .286. She has had double-digit kills in nine matches this season.
- Senior libero Courtney Leffel is the only Sun Devil in triple digit digs with 252. Dating back to last season, she had a career-long streak of reaching double figures in digs with 14 consecutive matches. This season, she has had 20-plus digs in seven matches.
- Led by Leffel, ASU is ranked first in the Pac-12 in digs with 829. Leffel is ranked first in the conference in total digs.
- The setting duties have been split this season between senior Callie Jones, sophomore Noa Miller and senior Nicole Peterson. Jones leads the trio in assists with 246.

Scouting the Opposition Colorado (8-4, 0-2 Pac-12)

- Colorado's big win this season came at then-No. 5 Illinois. The Buffs competed the upset in three sets. That was also their fifth win in a row to open up the season 5-0. Since then, they are 3-4.
- ASU leads the overall series against Colorado, 9-8. The Sun Devils have lost the last four matches, the last win coming in 2016 at home.

Utah (9-4, 1-1 Pac-12)

- The Utes started the season strong, winning their first eight matches, including two victories over top 25 teams. Utah beat then-No. 7 Kentucky for its best win so far this year. The winning streak snapped against then-No. 6 Pittsburgh. Since then, the Utes have been 1-4 in the last five matches.
- In the all-time series, Utah leads Arizona State 15-13, winning the last five matches. ASU last won on the road in 2015.

Can You Dig It?

Senior libero Courtney Leffel is the 20th Sun Devil in program history to reach 1,000 career digs. All she needed was 39 and she totaled 83 over the three matches. Against LSU, she had 39 digs, good for ninth in a single match int he record books at ASU, seventh in the rally-scoring era. Her stellar performance at the Flo Hyman Collegiate Cup earned her the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week nod.

All-Tournament Players

Courtney Leffel and Andrea Mitrovic were named to the Flo Hyman Collegiate Cup All-Tournament Team. Leffel was also named to the Fleur De Lis All-Tournament Team. Mitrovic and Kennedi Boyd earned the all-tournament nods at the OU Nike Invitational.

Road Warriors

For the first four weekends of the season, Arizona State was on the road. ASU played in four tournaments, starting in Houston and ending in Las Vegas. This is the first time since 2016 with no home tournaments in the non-conference schedule. The first home match is on September 26.

New Kids On The Block

There are nine new faces on the 2019 roster: six freshmen and three transfers. Of the six

freshmen, three are liberos, one is an outside hitter and the other is a middle blocker. The transfers include two outside hitters and one setter.

Serbia Squad

Serbia is well-represented on the 2019 Sun Devil roster. In addition to head coach Sanja Tomasevic, three players have Serbian ties. Senior Ivana Jeremic and redshirt sophomore Danica Krstonošic are from Serbia while junior Andrea Mitrovic, Canada natvie, has a strong Serbian heritage and speaks Serbian.

Oh, Canada

Canadians Andrea Mitrovic and Megan Beedie spent their summers with Canadian national teams. Mitrovic made the Canadian National Team and traveled to multiple tournaments this season, including the Olympic qualification tournament. Beedie was part of the NextGen squad and most recently competed in the 2019 Pan American Games.

2019 Outlook

After seeing improvement in 2018, the Sun Devils look to take an even bigger leap in 2019. Arizona State finished the season at 14-18, 5-15 Pac-12. Following a tough 2017 season, the Sun Devils improved immensely, earning four more wins in the season total and five more in conference play. This has been the biggest improvement from season to season for an ASU team since 2012 when the nine 2011 wins jumped to 20.

Last season, the Sun Devils were ranked in the AVCA Coaches Poll at No. 25 on Oct. 8, the first time being ranked since 2015 when they reached as high as No. 5. They also received votes on Oct. 1 and 15. They got recognition nationwide after three ranked wins, all top-15 teams.

Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 11th in the Pac-12 preseason poll, ahead of Oregon State. ASU finished the 2018 season 11th as well. Reigning national champion Stanford was picked to win the conference again.






