PREVIEWING THE MATCH AT BAYLOR

TEMPE, Ariz.- After a little over a week off, No. 23 Sun Devil Women's Tennis (7-3) will take a brief road trip to No. 30 Baylor (6-5) on Tuesday, March 5 at 11 a.m. AZT at the Hurd Tennis Center before the start of conference play.

Live stats and a live stream will be available for the match.

Sun Devil Notables (7-3)

- The Sun Devils are coming off an impressive win on February 25 as they upset then-No. 7 Ohio State for the first victory over the Buckeyes since 1990. The duos of Giulia Morlet/Sara Svetac and Marianna Argyrokastriti/Emilija Tverijonaite picked up the doubles wins and Tverijonaite, Argyrokastriti and Rachel Hanford each won singles matches to win the dual match for ASU.
- Arizona State has been ranked in each of the ITA team rankings this season, most recently checking in at No. 23.
- The Sun Devils also have individual singles rankings with Giulia Morlet ranked No. 75 and Tverijonaite ranked No. 104.
- Morlet and Argyrokastriti each lead the Sun Devils in singles with six this season. The duo of Patricija Spaka/Chelsea Fontenel lead the team in doubles wins with five

- Baylor is coming off a pair of wins over conference opponents Cincinnati and West Virginia.

- In the past 39 years, McInerney has seen a vast amount of change at Arizona State, from new athletic directors, new head coaches, schools added to the conference, and numerous renovations to athletic facilities. Through the countless changes across Arizona State, McInerney has continued to lead the women's tennis program in a successful direction heading into her 40th season in 2023-24 after being hired on Aug. 16, 1984.
- Since her first season as head coach in 1985, Sun Devil women's tennis has won 574 matches, advanced to 36 of 37 NCAA Tournaments (no championship season in 2020), including 35 straight, and has finished each season in the top-40 nationally. McInerney has twice been named both the Southwest Region Coach of the Year by the ITA as well as the Pac-12 Coach of the Year in the same season (2016, 2022). In 2016, she also was awarded the ITA Meritorious Service Award, which is given to an ITA coach who has gone "above and beyond" in their commitment and contributions to the ITA and college tennis in general.
- On the court, the Sun Devils have over 100 wins against ranked opponents since 2008. Leading the way for the tennis program have been 49 All-Americans and 51 All-Pac-12 student-athletes. Of these integral players in Arizona State's history, there have been 40 players ranked in the Top 50 of the singles season-end ranking and 21 in the Top 25 of the doubles season-end ranking.
- McInerney attended USC, where she captained the Trojans during her senior season. The four-time All-American also was a four-time Trojan Spirit Award winner, as voted by her teammates. The Trojans won three national champion-ships during McInerney's collegiate career, and she was the national collegiate doubles runner-up three times and a singles semifinalist in 1977. McInerney collected a half-dozen USTA national titles and was a member of the 1977-80 USTA Junior Federation Cup team. As a professional, she played on the major international tour, earning a world ranking in the top 75. McInerney competed at three grand slam venues -- Wimbledon, French Open and the U.S. Open where she reached the round of 32. She also served a short term as assistant pro at the highly acclaimed L.A. Tennis Club.



- Langley will begin his ninth season with the Sun Devils and has been named ITA Southwest Region Assistant Coach of the Year twice, in 2018 and 2022.
- Langley joined the Sun Devils in 2015 from Middle Tennessee State University, his alma mater, where he served as assistant coach for its women's tennis program. At MTSU, Langley helped coach the Blue Raiders to one of their best seasons in program history, recording a 19-5 overall record, 7-1 in Conference USA competition.
- A member of the MTSU men's tennis team from 2009-12, Langley was a two-year co-captain and three-time Sun Belt Conference Champion, earning two Most Outstanding Player honors at the Sun Belt Conference Championships. Langley also recorded three career appearances at the NCAA Championships.
- Langley graduated from MTSU with a degree in exercise science, and was a two-time Academic All-American and ITA Scholar-Athlete
- Competed on the AVP Tour from 2005-18, recording three top-10 finishes in his career. His best finish was seventh place in 2016 at the Seattle Open.
- He played on San Diego State's club team, where he was selected to the all-tournament team in both 2004 and 2005.
- He graduated with a degree in psychology. He played at Grossmont College for two years before transferring to SDSU.

Olmscheid was named the the ITA West Region Assistant Coach of the Year. With the Ottawa men, they received votes in the the NAIA Coaches Poll and reached the finals of the 2021 GSAC Tournament.
- Prior to Ottawa, Olmscheid spent the 2020 season as the Interim Head Coach of men's and women's tennis at the University of the Ozarks. Olmscheid was the Head Boys and Girls Tennis Coach at his alma mater, Farmington High School (Minn.), from
- 2017-19.
 Olmscheid played collegiate tennis at St. Mary's (MN), earning a degree in Graphic Design. He finished his career in the top-10 in doubles wins.
