SCOUTING THE SERIES

The No. 16/17 Arizona State Sun Devils will faceoff against the No. 2/2 Denver Pioneers in the desert this weekend for their sixth meeting in program history. Head coach Greg Powers and the team look to continue the magic in Mullett and remain undefeated on home ice. Puck drop is slated for 7 p.m. MST on Friday and 5 p.m. MST on Saturday. Fans can watch the free ASU Live Stream or listen on Fox Sports 910, the home of Sun Devil Hockey.

The Sun Devils (6-1-1) host the Pioneers (6-1-1) after competing at Denver last December when DU took the series sweep at Magness Arena, 3-2 and 5-2, moving the all-time record between the schools to 1-8-1. ASU looks to close the record gap as they come off of a third-straight series sweep at home against Stonehill this past weekend.

KRAZY FOR KOPPERUD

The long-awaited return of Matthew Kopperud is finally upon Sun Devil Hockey. The senior leads the country in game-winning goals with four. His hot start and seven career game-winning goals has boosted him to just one shy of Johnny Walker's record for most career GWG with eight. On Saturday night against Northern Michigan, Kopperud scored his 26th career power play goal to break the ASU record also set by ASU alum Johnny Walker (2017-22) at 25. His fifth goal this season, scored on Saturday night against Stonehill, became his 80 career point (46G, 34A).

QUOTES OF THE WEEK

Head coach Greg Powers on preparing for Denver:

"You don't really change too much. We worry about us. We have a lot of focus on ourselves. We know how Denver plays. We have played them a lot, we've played them almost more than anybody. We know how good they are offensively, how active they are in the offensive zone. So, there's some things we're working on to prepare for that but really we're just focused on us. You have to take care of the puck, going against teams like this. If you handle the puck they way we did last weekend, then we stand no chance."

Defenseman Ty Murchison on series against Stonehill and Denver:

"I think it was a bit of a wake up call. Just going into every game with that mindset of its a game seven as an independent. Obviously, I think the guys will be really prepared for Denver this weekend and I have no doubt we'll be ready to go."

SUN DEVIL NOTES

POWERED UP POWER PLAY

The Sun Devils boast a 23.7 power play percentage through the first eight games, which ranks 12th among all NCAA Division I teams. ASU's nine power play goals is tied at fifth in the country. Skaters Matthew Kopperud and Anthony Dowd lead the power play point scoring for the maroon and gold. Kopperud tallied three goals and two assists for five points on the man-advatnage while freshman Dowd notched five assists.

RANKED DEVILS

ASU continues its fourth-straight week in the national polls. Last week, ASU came in at No. 16 and No. 19 in the USCHO.com and USA Hockey/The Rink Live, respectively. After remaining undefeated at home, the Sun Devils made the biggest jump of all poll teams from No. 18 to No. 13 heading into the series with Miami. After going 0-1-1 on their first road trip, the Sun Devils fell back a few spots to No. 16 and No. 19. Following the series sweep of Stonehill at home, ASU held strong at No. 16 in the USCHO.com Poll and moved up two spots to No. 17 in the USA Hockey Poll. The highest national poll ranking ever received by the Sun Devils was No. 9 on Feb. 17, 2020 in the 2019-20 season.

THE UNDISPUTED CAPTAIN

Unknown to many Sun Devil fans could be the ninth captain in Sun Devil Hockey history: Tyler Gratton. The graduate transfer joins the ASU roster for his fifth and final year of college eligibility and was unanimously named captain, as voted on by players and staff in September. In previous seasons, the captains group was appointed by head coach Greg Powers and his assistant coaches. This time around, Powers put the power in the players hands. giving the team a vote on the leadership group. Gratton was unanimously voted as captain for the 2023-24 season. He is accompanied by alternate captains (also voted on by the players and staff): Matthew Kopperud, Lukas Sillinger, Ryan O'Reilly, and Ethan Szmagaj.

TWO IS BETTER THAN ONE

The Sun Devil netminders boast the sixthbest goals against average in NCAA at 2.1 through eight games. ASU fans saw their first look at Gibson Homer (2-0-1)at Miami and at home against Stonehill last weekend. The tandem netminder pair of standout TJ Semptimphelter (4-1-0) and rookie Homer put up 100 combined saves.

CHECK CHAMBERS

Graduate center Brian Chambers has quickly become a crucial playmaker in the Sun Devils' offense. The Massachusetts native is ranked 15th in faceoff wins in the country and leads the team in faceoff percentage at .546. He is tied with Matthew Kopperud for the ASU team lead in points at eight - for a point per game average. His seven assists through eight games leads all Sun Devil skaters and he boasts a +5 plus/minus. Chambers tallied his second career three-point night against Stonehill on Nov. 2, 2023 at Mullett Arena (1G, 2A).

FIRST TIMERS

Last weekend held plenty of firsts for several ASU players, including freshman Cole Gordon, who scored his first NCAA career goal on a short-handed breakaway. It was ASU's first short-handed goal since Chris Grando against then-No. 17 Minnesota State on Jan. 14, 2023. Tucker Ness also logged his first point of the season with an assist on Tyler Gratton's opening goal Friday night. Junior transfer Cade Alami and freshman Cole Helm also made their first appearances for their Sun Devils.

THIRD PERIOD SURGE

The Sun Devils found themselves down 4-1 early in the third period on Friday night against Stonehill, but rallied through four unanswered goals to clinch the overtime game-winner and 5-4 victory. The late onslaught at the hands of the Devils has become customary this season as 11 goals have been scored in the third period combined to 13 in the first and second combined. ASU has allowed only six goals in the final frame.

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2023-24. and his 16th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year, as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Powers led ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents in 2021-22 for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their firstever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2020, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the
 commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun
 Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado
 Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and recieved its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena.
 Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- · A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.






