QUICK HITS

- Arizona State went 2-1 at the OU Nike Invitational, beating Louisiana and Georgia Tech. Andrea Mitrovic and Kennedi Boyd were named to the all-tournament team. Mitrovic led the team in kills in all three matches, while Boyd earned career numbers in kills (7) and blocks (6).
- Junior outside hitter Andrea Mitrovic leads the Sun Devils in kills with 114, hitting .283. She has had double-digit kills in all matches but one.
- Senior libero Courtney Leffel already has almost 200 digs this season, just three shy at 197. She is currently on a 13-match streak of reaching double figures in digs. This season, she has had 20-plus digs in all but three matches.
- The setting duties have been split this season between senior Callie Jones, sophomore Noa Miller and senior Nicole Peterson. Jones leads the trio in assists with 169, with Miller notching 114 so far.

Scouting the Opposition UNLV (3-6)

- The Rebels are home for the second weekend in a row. At the UNLV Invitational last weekend, they lost all three matches.
- UNLV is led by freshman outside hitter Shelby Capllonch, who leads the team in kills with 152 and in digs with 116.
- ASU leads in the series history, 5-4. The Sun Devils have dominated the last two matchups, winning both in three sets.

Kansas (4-4)

- The Jayhawks have lost four of their last five matches, going 2-1 at the Kansas Invitational last weekend.
- ASU's senior transfer Jada Burse came to Arizona State from Kansas, where she spent three seasons.
- This will be the second meeting between these two teams in program history, with Kansas winning that match.

Can You Dig It?

Senior libero Courtney Leffel is the 20th Sun Devil in program history to reach 1,000 career digs. All she needed was 39 and she totaled 83 over the three matches. Against LSU, she had 39 digs, good for ninth in a single match inthe record books at ASU, seventh in the rally-scoring era. Her stellar performance at the Flo Hyman Collegiate Cup earned her the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week nod.

All-Tournament Players

Courtney Leffel and Andrea Mitrovic were named to the Flo Hyman Collegiate Cup All-Tournament Team. Leffel was also named to the Fleur De Lis All-Tournament Team. Mitrovic and Kennedi Boyd earned the all-tournament nods at the OU Nike Invitational.

Road Warriors

For the first four weekends of the season, Arizona State will be on the road. ASU will play in four tournaments starting in Houston and ending in Las Vegas. This is the first time since 2016 with no home tournaments in the non-conference schedule. The first home match will not be until September 26.

New Kids On The Block

There are nine new faces on the 2019 roster: six freshmen and three transfers. Of

the six freshmen, three are liberos, one is an outside hitter and the other is a middle blocker. The transfers include two outside hitters and one setter.

Serbia Squad

Serbia is well-represented on the 2019 Sun Devil roster. In addition to head coach Sanja Tomasevic, three players have Serbian ties. Senior Ivana Jeremic and redshirt sophomore Danica Krstonošic are from Serbia while junior Andrea Mitrovic, Canada natvie, has a strong Serbian heritage and speaks Serbian.

Oh, Canada

Canadians Andrea Mitrovic and Megan Beedie spent their summers with Canadian national teams. Mitrovic made the Canadian National Team and traveled to multiple tournaments this season, including the Olympic qualification tournament. Beedie was part of the NextGen squad and most recently competed in the 2019 Pan American Games.

2019 Outlook

After seeing improvement in 2018, the Sun Devils look to take an even bigger leap in 2019. Arizona State finished the season at 14-18, 5-15 Pac-12. Following a tough 2017 season, the Sun Devils improved immensely, earning four more wins in the season total and five more in conference play. This has been the biggest improvement from season to season for an ASU team since 2012 when the nine 2011 wins jumped to 20.

Last season, the Sun Devils were ranked in the AVCA Coaches Poll at No. 25 on Oct. 8, the first time being ranked since 2015 when they reached as high as No. 5. They also received votes on Oct. 1 and 15. They got recognition nationwide after three ranked wins, all top-15 teams.

Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 11th in the Pac-12 preseason poll, ahead of Oregon State. ASU finished the 2018 season 11th as well. Reigning national champion Stanford was picked to win the conference again.






