## SUN DEVIL REWIND

Without any regular season home games this season, seven Sun Devil seniors could potentially be playing in their final games in the Maroon & Gold this week. Several may take advantage of the extra year of eligibility provided by the NCAA, while several could also sign and move on to professional hockey. One of those seniors is forward **JOHNNY WALKER**, who last weekend became the program's all-time leading point scorer with his 108th career point (63g-45a). Other seniors include four-year Sun Devils in **DOMINIC** GARCIA, JACOB WILSON and GVIDO JANSONS, while transfers JAMES SANCHEZ, WILLIE KNIERIM and SEAN DHOOGHE all have spent one to two years at ASU. GARCIA is one senior who has decided to not take on an extra year of eligibility as he pursues his goals of becoming an FBI agent. Between the pipes, freshman goaltender COLE BRADY added his fifth and sixth game with 30 or more saves last weekend and seems to have found his groove since returning from mononucleosis. In the most recent game. BRADY posted 41 saves on 42 shots faced in a 1-1 overtime tie against No. 7 Michigan.

## **SCOUTING THE BUCKEYES**

As it stands entering the weekend, Ohio State currently sits tied for 5th in the Big Ten standings with the conference tournament just a week away. Despite the Buckeyes record, they have found a way to defeat all but one Big Ten team (Minnesota) going 1-3 against the other five. In mid-December, OSU and ASU skated to a 4-4 tie followed by a 3-2 Sun Devil win. Recently, the Buckeyes have just two wins over their last 13 games and have allowed 4.46 goals while averaging just over one-goal per game during that stretch. They have also been shutout three times and twice in their last three games. The Buckeyes will honor six seniors themselves this weekend, including Eugene Fadyeyev, Grant Gabriele, Evan Moyse, Tommy Nappier, Collin Peters and Austin Pooley.

## OUOTES OF THE WEEK

- "We've learned a ton. It wasn't the most ideal schedule for anybody that would have played this. Looking back, if we had to do it all over again, with the options we were given, we'd do it all over again. We want to be in NCAA Tournament's and play into April, and the last two years running we've had that carrot in front of us to play for. - "My personal and number one goal was to get every game in that was on our schedule under our control. Obviously we can't control what happened with Penn State, but assuming we get these two games in, that is the story I think we can tell and be most proud of. Regardless of record or anything is that our guys had the diligence and the discipline, and everything it took to get this season in under these circumstances. It says tremendous amount about the character we have in our program." -Head coach Greg Powers on not having any COVID issues that affected their schedule

## HEALTHY AT LAST

- The injury to senior forward **JOHNNY WALKER** in the second game of the season started a landslide of injuries and Sun Devils out of the lineup.
- WALKER, who entered the 2020-21 season as the active leader in goals scored in the NCAA, finally returned to the lineup on Jan. 3-4 after missing 10-straight games with an injury suffered in game two at Michigan. Since returning, he's recorded nine points in the eight games.
- At one point during the most recent 23-day road trip, the Devils were missing 20% of the team's scoring with
  the likes of RYAN O'REILLY, DEMETRIOS KOUMONTZIS, WILLIE KNIERIM and MICHAEL MANCINELLI out
  of the lineup. In addition to two of their top d-men in JARROD GOURLEY & JACOB WILSON. Not to mention
  goaltender COLE BRADY out with mononucleosis.

## FRESHMEN IMPACT

- Since the start of the season, four of the Sun Devils' six freshmen have seen significant playing time. Goaltender **COLE BRADY**, who was out since early January due to mononucleosis, had also seen nearly half the starts before his departure. He has started each of the last six games (two exhibition) since his return from illness. In his last four, he holds a 2.22 goals against average and .936 save percentage.
- KOPPERUD and Detroit Red Wings' draft pick RYAN O'REILLY are two of the Sun Devils' top point producers
  this season, seeing ample time on the team's top two lines.
- KOPPERUD is also currently tied for second in goals scored among all NCAA freshman with 12.

## POPULAR DESTINATION

- The Sun Devils have fallen fortunate to transfers since the program transitioned to Division I, including players like Dylan Hollman, Robbie Baillargeon, Wade Murphy and David Norris.
- In 2019-20, forwards JAMES SANCHEZ (Michigan) and WILLIE KNIERIM (Miami) made immediate impacts in their junior seasons. SANCHEZ led the entire team and became the first player in program history to reach 40 points in a season, while KNIERIM contributed 15 goals and was 5th in scoring for the Devils.
- While CHRIS GRANDO (Boston College) came in a season ago and had to sit out during the 2019-20 season due to transfer rules, he joins SEAN DHOOGHE (Wisconsin) and TANNER HICKEY (Alabama-Huntsville)
   -- all of which were key contributors to their respective programs before transferring -- as the 2020-21 transfers hoping to contribute to the Maroon & Gold transfer reputation.

## **DEVILS IN THE PROS**

- Former netminder Joey Daccord, who helped catapult the program to its first NCAA Tournament berth, signed
  a three-year, two-way extension with the Ottawa Senators prior to the season. Daccord was not only the first
  Sun Devil to sign an NHL contract, but play in the NHL as he made his debut on April 4, 2019. He was also the
  first Sun Devil committed to the program when getting drafted. He just made his second NHL start -- and first
  since April 2019 -- on Tuesday night vs. Montreal, making 30 saves on 32 shots with the only two goals allowed
  coming by power play.
- This past season, senior defenseman Brinson Pasichnuk became the program's second player to sign an NHL
  contract and first to sign a free agent deal. Pasichnuk signed with the San Jose Sharks for two years back in
  June, and is currently with the AHL's San Jose Barracuda.
- Most recently in August, rising junior Josh Maniscalco signed a three-year free agent deal with the Pittsburgh Penguins and started the season with the organization's AHL squad. Maniscalco recorded 11 goals and 21 assists last year and was ranked 6th among national defensemen in scoring.

## WE GOT THE POWER(S)

Coach Powers enters his sixth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2020-21, and his 13th overall at the helm at ASU. The two-time finalist for the Spencer Penrose National Coach of the Year led the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2018-19 and were on track for a repeat appearance in 2019-20 before COVID-19 ended the season. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. He holds a 241-133-30 career record at ASU.

Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.



## **BREAKING GROUND**

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received
  for the commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve
  as the future home for Sun Devil men's ice hockey, wrestling and women's gymnastics. This project continues the development of
  the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north
  of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction is scheduled to begin in January 2021, with full completion projected for December 2022.
- The 5,000-seat venue will be managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for the Multi-Purpose Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- A 942-seat student section will occupy the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the
  north side of the arena. Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and
  community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
