# PREVIEWING THE MATCH VS. OHIO STATE

**TEMPE, Ariz.-** Sun Devil Women's Tennis will end their four-match homestand against No. 7 Ohio State (6-3) on Sunday, February 25 at 11 a.m. MST.

#### Sun Devil Notables (6-3)

- Arizona State won its most recent match on Sunday in a 4-0 sweep over Cal Poly. Emilija Tverijonaite and Marianna Argyrokastriti clinched the doubles point on court three for the Sun Devils. ASU picked up three straight singles victories from Giulia Morlet, Tverijonaite, and Patricija Spaka to win the match against the Mustangs.
- The Sun Devils are 5-1 on the season at Whiteman Tennis Center to begin the season. They had their first undefeated season at home in school history last season and have a 39-4 record at Whiteman since 2021.
- ASU has two ranked in ITA's singles rankings with Morlet at No. 75 and freshman Emilija Tverijonaite ranked No. 104.
- Spaka and Morlet lead the way for ASU in singles wins as each of them have six to begin the season.
- Chasing 600: Head coach Sheila McInerney picked up her 580th career win in her 40th season with the Sun Devils against Cal Poly.

#### Previewing No. 7 Ohio State (6-3)

- Ohio State reached the quarterfinals of the ITA National Team Indoor Championship in Seattle over the weekend after coming back to beat No. 8 Georgia, 4-3.
- Ohio State has three ranked players in the ITA singles rankings: Irina Cantos Siemers (No. 15), Luciana Perry (No. 68), and Sydni Ratliff (No. 115). They also have two ranked doubles pairs: Perry/Ratliff (No. 32) and Perry/Siemers (No. 36).
- Head coach Melissa Schaub has led the Buckeyes since 2012, winning Big Ten Coach of the Year honors four times.
- The Buckeyes made history in their 4-0

- victory over No. 13 UCLA on February 4. The win was No. 225 of head coach Melissa Schaub's coaching career, making her the program's all-time wins leader.
- Captain Irina Cantos Siemers also became the school's leader in singles wins with 113

- In the past 39 years, McInerney has seen a vast amount of change at Arizona State, from new athletic directors, new head coaches, schools added to the conference, and numerous renovations to athletic facilities. Through the countless changes across Arizona State, McInerney has continued to lead the women's tennis program in a successful direction heading into her 40th season in 2023-24 after being hired on Aug. 16, 1984.
- Since her first season as head coach in 1985, Sun Devil women's tennis has won 574 matches, advanced to 36 of 37 NCAA Tournaments (no championship season in 2020), including 35 straight, and has finished each season in the top-40 nationally. McInerney has twice been named both the Southwest Region Coach of the Year by the ITA as well as the Pac-12 Coach of the Year in the same season (2016, 2022). In 2016, she also was awarded the ITA Meritorious Service Award, which is given to an ITA coach who has gone "above and beyond" in their commitment and contributions to the ITA and college tennis in general.
- On the court, the Sun Devils have over 100 wins against ranked opponents since 2008. Leading the way for the tennis program have been 49 All-Americans and 51 All-Pac-12 student-athletes. Of these integral players in Arizona State's history, there have been 40 players ranked in the Top 50 of the singles season-end ranking and 21 in the Top 25 of the doubles season-end ranking.
- McInerney attended USC, where she captained the Trojans during her senior season. The four-time All-American also was a four-time Trojan Spirit Award winner, as voted by her teammates. The Trojans won three national champion-ships during McInerney's collegiate career, and she was the national collegiate doubles runner-up three times and a singles semifinalist in 1977. McInerney collected a half-dozen USTA national titles and was a member of the 1977-80 USTA Junior Federation Cup team. As a professional, she played on the major international tour, earning a world ranking in the top 75. McInerney competed at three grand slam venues -- Wimbledon, French Open and the U.S. Open where she reached the round of 32. She also served a short term as assistant pro at the highly acclaimed L.A. Tennis Club.



- Langley will begin his ninth season with the Sun Devils and has been named ITA Southwest Region Assistant Coach of the Year twice, in 2018 and 2022.
- Langley joined the Sun Devils in 2015 from Middle Tennessee State University, his alma mater, where he served as assistant coach for its women's tennis program. At MTSU, Langley helped coach the Blue Raiders to one of their best seasons in program history, recording a 19-5 overall record, 7-1 in Conference USA competition.
- A member of the MTSU men's tennis team from 2009-12, Langley was a two-year co-captain and three-time Sun Belt Conference Champion, earning two Most Outstanding Player honors at the Sun Belt Conference Championships. Langley also recorded three career appearances at the NCAA Championships.
- Langley graduated from MTSU with a degree in exercise science, and was a two-time Academic All-American and ITA Scholar-Athlete
- Competed on the AVP Tour from 2005-18, recording three top-10 finishes in his career. His best finish was seventh place in 2016 at the Seattle Open.
- He played on San Diego State's club team, where he was selected to the all-tournament team in both 2004 and 2005.
- He graduated with a degree in psychology. He played at Grossmont College for two years before transferring to SDSU.

- Olmscheid enters his second season with the Sun Devils in 2023-24.
- Prior to coming to ASU, Olmscheid served as both head and assistant coach at Ottawa University (AZ) for two seasons for both tennis programs.
- In the 2022 season, the Ottawa women won their first GSAC championship, earned their first national ranking (#24 NAIA), and reached No. 1 in the NCCAA poll. Olmscheid was named the the ITA West Region Assistant Coach of the Year. With the Ottawa men, they received votes in the the NAIA Coaches Poll and reached the finals of the 2021 GSAC Tournament.
