QUICK HITS

- The Sun Devils are looking to build on their momentum from their first conference win against the Cal Golden Bears on Sunday. Last weekend, ASU split its road matches, losing to No. 17 Stanford in four and ending a four-match skid at Cal with a 3-1 win on Sunday.
- Junior outside hitter Iman Isanovic continues to lead the Sun Devils and the Pac-12 with 231 kills on the season. Isanovic has a 16-match streak of double-digits in kills that dates back to last season.
- Leading ASU defensively is junior libero Annika Larson, who has a team and conference-high 254 digs so far this season. In Sunday's win over Cal, Larson had 20 digs and now has six matches in a row with 10 or more digs
- Sophomore setter Ella Snyder has 482 assists in 15 matches where she's been the primary setter for ASU this season. She has reached 40+ assists in three matches and most recently in Sunday's match she had 43 assists. In career assists, she is closing in on 1,000 with 974 total after last weekend.
- The other leaders on offense this season for ASU have been sophomore middle blocker Claire Jeter with 143 kills and sophomore pin hitter Marta Levinska with 175. Levinska and Jeter, along with Isanovic, are the three Sun Devils in triple digits with total kills.

Scouting the OppositionWashington State

- Last weekend the Cougars faced USC and No. 15 UCLA where they were defeated in both matches in a homestand in Pullman. This season, WSU has wins over then-No. 24 Colorado and in-state rivals then-No. 16 Washington.
- The Cougars appeared in their fifth-straight NCAA tournament last season after finishing fourth in the Pac-12 conference. In the 2020-21 NCAA tournament, WSU was the No. 15 seed where they were defeated by Western Kentucky in the second round.
- In the spring, the Cougars played the Sun Devils in a two-match series at Desert Financial Arena, where ASU fell in both of the matches. Arizona State has a 13-16 all-time record against Washington State.
- Junior outside hitter Pia Timmer leads WSU with 197 kills so far this season and was the Sport Imports/AVCA Division I Women Player of the Week last week, as well as the Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week for the second-straight week.

No. 11 Washington

- Over the weekend, the Huskies got back on track after an 0-2 start to Pac-12 play. UW defeated No. 15 UCLA in a five-set match on Friday before beating USC in four on Sunday. UW has two ranked wins this season: No. 15 UCLA and No. 22 Pepperdine.
- Last season, the Huskies finished with a 20-4 record. Washington won the Pac-12 conference title and made it to the semifinals of the NCAA tournament where they came up short to eventual national champion Kentucky.
- The Sun Devils opened the spring 2021 season against the Huskies, where they split the two matches in Seattle. ASU upset the then-ranked No. 8 Huskies in straight sets in the first match but lost the second to Washington in four sets.
- Junior outside hitter Claire Hoffman leads UW with 162 kills this season and has reached 20 kills twice this season, most recently in Friday's win over UCLA. Junior setter Ella May Powell is the leader in assists and digs for the Huskies as she has 505 assists and 131 digs so far this season.

New Kids On The Block

There are eight new faces on the roster: five freshmen and three transfers. Of the five freshmen, one is a libero, two are outside hitters, one is a setter and one is a middle blockers. The transfers include two middle blockers and one libero.

National Team Experience

Over the summer, Sun Devil Volleyball pin hitters Iman Isanovic and Marta Levinska played for their national teams in their home countries of Bosnia-Herzegovina and Latvia, respectively. Isanovic helped her team earn a bid for the European Women's Volleyball Championship for the first time ever.

Worldwide Sun Devils

The Sun Devils continued to be represented by countries all around the world. On the coaching staff, head coach Sanja Tomasevic is from Serbia and associate head coach Carlos Moreno is from Brazil.

On the roster, there are six international studentathletes. Jinna Zeng is from Canada, Ayyuce Altintas is from Turkey, Iman Isanovic is from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Marta Levinska is from Latvia, Roberta Rabelo is from Brazil and Beatrice Badini is from Italy.

2020-21 Recap

In the fourth season under head coach Sanja Tomasevic, the Sun Devils competed in 20 matches, all against Pac-12 opponents. The team went 6-14 on the year and finished in ninth place in the conference. The roster was made up of primarily underclassmen (82 percent), eight student-athletes making their Division I NCAA volleyball debut.

Arizona State earned two wins over ranked opponents in the 2020-21 season, beating Sweet Sixteen teams Washington and Oregon. The Sun Devils made history at Stanford this season, winning there for the first time since 1982.

Pac-12 Honors in 2020-21

A few Sun Devils made a splash in conference play in the spring. Iman Isanovic was named to the All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention list last season. Marta Levinska made the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team after being named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week twice.

Career Leaders

On this young squad, junior Iman Isanovic has the highest career numbers in multiple categories. She has 481 kills and 35 aces. Junior Annika Larson has 387 career digs and junior Shannon Shields has 558 career assists.

Tried and True

The roster features 12 returning letterwinners, including the kill leaders (Isanovic and Levinska), digs leader (Annika Larson) and assists leader (Ella Snyder). Seven Sun Devils who started in a match last season are returning.

Pac-12 Preseason Poll

The Sun Devils were picked to finish 11th in the Pac-12 preseason poll. ASU finished the 2020-21 season in 9th place. Washington was picked to win the conference.


