SCOUTING THE SERIES

The No. 13 Arizona State hockey team (11-3-4) heads to the Steel City this weekend to face Robert Morris (4-11-3) on Saturday, Dec. 16 and Sunday, Dec. 17. Both games can be heard on the airwaves at Fox Sports 910AM radio, the home of Sun Devil Hockey. The two programs will faceoff for only the second time in program history.

The last time the Sun Devils tussled with the Colonials was during the 2019-2020 season where ASU collected the series sweep in 3-2 and 5-4 victories at Oceanside Ice Arena.

ASU is 17-7-0 all-time against Atlantic Hockey opponents, including the 2-0-0 record versus Robert Morris. Of all Atlantic Hockey teams, ASU has faced Air Force most for a total of seven times, featuring a 4-3-0 record and a 1-0 win in the last meeting in January 2023.

ASU logged two straight ties this past weekend against Dartmouth where the Sun Devils won both shootouts with the help of Lukas Sillinger on Friday night and Jackson Niedermayer on Saturday night. This was the first meeting between the two teams in program history.

SUN DEVIL NOTABLES

- Junior goaltender TJ Semptimphelter remains in the top-ten nationally for best goalie winning percentage and is tied at eighth in the NCAA with a .714 percentage.
- Brian Chambers took his 400th faceoff of the season against Dartmouth last Saturday night. The graduate center ranks 10th in the nation for faceoffs won with 200 so far this season.
- ASU freshman Kyle Smolen has a sister who skates for Robert Morris women's hockey. Lindsey Smolen is the older sister of Kyle, who is also a freshman for the Colonials.
- ASU's 20 power play goals ranks second in the NCAA
- ASU's 56 goals this season is tied at 11th in the country

POWERED UP POWER PLAY

ASU ranks eighth in the nation among NCAA Division I teams for best power play percentage at 26.3 though 18 games. The special teams unit held strong this weekend and scored two power play goals including Matthew Kopperud's 30th career power play goal. Lukas Sillinger continues to lead the power play scoring for the Sun Devils with two goals and 11 assists for 13 points after two power play assists this past weekend. Matthew Kopperud is second on the team in power play scoring with 10 points (6G, 4A). Kopperud has been the go-to goal scorers on the man-advantage with six PPG. Kopperud tallied his 30th power play goal of his career against Dartmouth on Friday night to further extend his program record-setting career PPG.

RANKED DEVILS

ASU continues its ninth-straight week in the national polls. Two weeks ago The Sun Devils earned a tie and win at Colorado College, holding strong at a No. 12 ranking in the polls. After two ties this weekend against Dartmouth, ASU came in at No. 13 and No. 14 in the USCHO.com and USA Hockey/The Rink Live polls, respectively. The highest national poll ranking ever received by the Sun Devils was No. 9 on Feb. 17, 2020 in the 2019-20 season.

CAREER MILESTONES

Lukas Sillinger and Alex Young are in the chase for 100 career points. Sillinger currently boasts 93 total points through four years of college hockey. Through his two years at Bemidji State and two at ASU, Sillinger tallied 37 goals and 56 assists for 93 points. Young is close behind with 91 career points. He transferred to ASU this year after three seasons at Colgate and has 43 goals and 48 assists for his 91 career points.

CENTURY CLUB CHASE

Tim Lovell encloses on his 100th NCAA game after competing in his 99th game vs. Dartmouth on Saturday night. Matthew Kopperud will reach his 100th NCAA game in two games, after playing in his 98th career game vs. Dartmouth on Saturday. Benji Eckerle follows them in the chase for 100 career games - he played in his 97th on Saturday vs. the Big Green.

SUPER SENIORS CLASS

The senior class is made up of Matthew Kopperud, Ty and Dylan Jackson, Lukas Sillinger, Ryan O'Reilly, Tim Lovell, Alex Young, and Benji Eckerle combine to be ASU's largest point scoring class this season. The seniors scored 33 of ASU's 57 goals this season and assisted on nearly half of all goals (48 of 98). Kopperud leads the class in goal scoring with eight. Sillinger leads the entire team in points and assists with 19 and 14, respectively. Multiple seniors are instrumental in ASU's special teams, especially the power play unit. Fifteen of ASU's 20 power play goals were scored by members of the senior class.

BETWEEN THE PIPES

Sophomore Gibson Homer got the nod to start on Saturday vs. Dartmouth - his fourth NCAA start. He boasts an undefeated record at 2-0-2, complete with 92 saves and a 1.90 goals against average and .920 save percentage. His counterpart, TJ Semptimphelter, still stands within the national rankings in goalie winning percentage. most wins, and save percentage. In game two at Colorado College two weeks ago, Semptimphelter tied a program record for career shutouts set by ASU alum and current NHL Seattle Kraken netminder Joev Daccord (8). Semptimphelter completed the shutout with 38 saves against the Tigers.

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2023-24, and his 16th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year, as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Powers led ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents in 2021-22 for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their firstever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2020, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the
 commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun
 Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado
 Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and recieved its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena.
 Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- · A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
