### SUN DEVIL LACROSSE PREVIEW

Arizona State Lacrosse (5-4.1-0) continues Pac-12 Conference play at home against No. 17 USC (7-3, 1-0) on Saturday, March 23. The game is slated for 12 p.m. MST, and can be viewed on the Arizona State Live Stream-2. ASU will be celebrating its alumni on Saturday in the team's fourth matchup against a ranked opponent this season.

#### Program History:

The two programs have met 13 times, with the Trojans holding the series edge 11-2. The Sun Devils have dropped the last three games to USC, and have not seen a victory against them since May 5, 2022 when ASU came out on top 13-12 in the Pac-12 tournament semifinals matchup and earned a spot in the Pac-12 championship game.

#### Sun Devil Outlook:

The Sun Devils recorded back-to-back wins last week with the 12-5 contest over Liberty at home followed by the 17-9 victory over SDSU in the Pac-12 opener in San Diego. Junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle hit the 400 career save mark against the Aztecs, needing seven to hit the mark she tallied 10 in the win. Vahle has now recorded 10+ saves in back-to-back games after 15 saves against Liberty, with ASU outscoring opponents 29-14 during the two-game span.

ASU has earned four of five wins this season at home, but has dropped both home matchups against ranked teams (No. 9 Michigan and No. 11 Florida).

#### **Scouting the Opponent:**

USC comes off of a loss to unranked Dartmouth (5-2, 0-1) on Monday at home to wrap up their non-conference play this season. Prior to Monday's loss, USC was riding a threegame win streak. The Trojans hold a 4-1 road record with their only road loss coming to No. 15 Johns Hopkins.

#### IN THE RECORD BOOKS:

- -Senior attacker Mina Scott is 6th all-time in goals with 71, and 6th all-time with 85 points. No other active player is in the top-10 for all time goals or assists.
- -With five wins in nine starts this season, Vahle is just one win shy of breaking the tie with Berkeley Bonneau for a program-best 21 wins.
- -Zoe Mazur's 76 draw controls have her on the single-season leaderboard, sitting at fifth all-time behind her 80 draw controls in fourth, which came in 2023.

#### **TEAM NOTABLES:**

- -ASU earned their first road win of the season against SDSU on March 17. The Sun Devils outscored the Aztecs 10-2 in the second half to secure the 17-9 win.
- -The Sun Devils have the 18th-best clearing percentage in the NCAA at 91.6%.
- -ASU has held opponents to a 81.9% clear percentage allowing 118 clears in 144 attempts.
- -The Sun Devils' 3-0 start to the season was the first time in program history, but was halted after a loss to Stony Brook in the team's first road game.

#### **PLAYER NOTABLES:**

- -Zoe Mazur's 8.44 draw controls per game are the ninth-best individual mark in the NCAA and third best in the Pac-12.
- -Attackers Mina Scott and Lydia Oldknow leads the Sun Devils with 28 points, each with 23 goals and five assists.
- -Last weekend against SDSU, junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle hit the 400 career save mark and was the second goalie in the Pac-12 with 400 career saves.
- -Oldknow and Scott have five hat tricks in nine games for ASU, which leads the team.
- -Graduate attacker Shannon Urey is two points away from 200 in her career. 178 points came during her time at Mercer University.

#### PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

-Katie Vahle earned the first weekly award for ASU this season after being named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the week on 3/19.

Sun Devil Athletics hired Taryn VanThof as the new Lacrosse Head Coach, Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson announced on July 5, 2022

VanThof comes to Arizona State after an extremely successful six-year stint as the Assistant Coach at national power Florida. There she served as the Offensive Coor dinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator for the Gators.

"Thank you to Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson and Senior Associate AD/SWA Christina Wombacher for this opportunity to lead the Sun Devil Lacrosse program," VanThof remarked. "I could not be more thrilled to coach at this extraordinary university."

Under the direction of VanThof and Head Coach Amanda O'Leary, Florida has emerged as one of the nation's premiere programs over the past six years. In 2022, the Gators made their fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament, earning a bid every year of VanThof's tenure. She arrives in Tempe coming off two straight appearances in the NCAA Quarterfinal Round (Elite Eight) with Florida.

"Taryn VanThof is a tremendous addition to the Sun Devil Family." Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson stated. "We identified her as the right person to lead this program on the rise because of her energy, passion, and desire to be at Arizona State."

She began her coaching career at Rutgers in 2016, getting a taste of Big Ten action immediately following the completion of her collegiate career. During her only season in New Brunswick, she helped orchestrate a four-win improvement, with two Scarlet Knights named to the Big Ten All-Conference Team.
