MEN'S HOOPS TAKES ON SANTA CLARA IN LAS VEGAS

Arizona State will experience The Kennel and battle the Bulldogs for the first time

Sun Devil Men's Basketball gets ready for their toughest test so far in the 2024-25 season when they take on Gonzaga on Sunday at 3 PM MST. Arizona State (2-0) will play in the renowned McCartney Athletic Center, more commonly known as "The Kennel", which is one of the toughest atmospheres in college basketball. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's team takes on a Bulldogs' squad that is ranked No. 6 in the AP Preseason Top-25 and is coming off a victory over No. 8 Baylor to open the season.

THE MATCHUP

Sun Devil Men's Basketball agreed to a home-and-home series with Gonzaga, set to begin on Sunday in Spokane. Gonzaga will make the return trip to Tempe in 2025.

"McCartney Athletic Center and 'The Kennel' provide one of the premier atmospheres in college basketball," Coach Hurley remarked. "It will present a fantastic road environment for our team early in the season. It was also important for us to secure a home game with a marquee opponent in 2025 for our amazing fan base."

The matchup in Spokane in 2024 will be the first meeting between the two schools. Gonzaga has emerged as one of the nation's most consistent programs, reaching the Sweet 16 in each of the last nine seasons

LAST TIME OUT

Sun Devils Men's Basketball defeated Santa Clara in a neutral site matchup at Lee's Family Forum on Friday. Arizona State (2-0) took down the Broncos (1-1), 81-74, in a back-and-forth contest. Senior guards BJ Freeman and Adam Miller led the way offensively, combining to score 33 points and making five three pointers. The freshman trio of guard/forward Amier Ali (13 points), guard Joson Sanon (11 points), and forward Jayden Quaintance (13 rebounds) each had a major impact on the game.

DIALED IN FROM DEEP

ASU made 15 three-point field goals last night, tied for the third-most three pointers made in a single-game in the Bobby Hurley era. The last time they made 15 three-pointers was at the Pac-12 Tournament against Stanford back on March 9, 2022).

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Arizona State currently leads the Big 12 in field goal percentage defense, allowing teams to shoot 33.1% overall against them. In the win over Santa Clara, the Sun Devils held the Broncos to just 40.9% from the field. In the first half of games, ASU's opponents are shooting a putrid 31.3%.

BLOCK PARTY

Jayden Quaintance leads the Big 12 in total blocks (10) and blocks per game (5.0). He had four in the win over Santa Clara last night and is a big reason why ASU ranks second in the league in block shots. Credited with six blocks in his collegiate debut, the most in a single game by a Sun Devil since De'Quon Lake had seven against Pacific on December 22, 2017. ASU finished with nine blocks, more than they had in any game last year and the most since recording nine blocks in a road win over Oregon State back on Jan. 14, 2022.

2-0 START

Arizona State moved to 2-0 to start a season for the fourth time under Coach Hurley. The last time they did so was to begin the 2022-23 season, a team that ended up winning a game in the NCAA Tournament.

PHENOMENAL FRESHMAN

Head Coach Bobby Hurley put together a Top-10 recruiting class, the highest in program history. It was ranked No. 9 by 247 Sports and No. 8 by Rivals and features a five-star recruit (Jayden Quaintance) alongside two high four-star prospects

(Joson Sanon, Amier Ali).

IMPACT TRANSFERS

A five-man transfer class immediately bolstered the Sun Devil Men's Basketball roster. It is one of the premier transfer classes in program history. BJ Freeman, Alston Mason, and Basheer Jihad join the fold after leading their teams in scoring a season ago. Brandon Gardner and Austin Nunez return to Arizona State after making strong connections with the connections in their previous recruitment process.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Arizona State freshman forward Jayden Quaintance enters the 2024-25 season as the youngest player in college basketball. He is over six months younger than the second-youngest on the list, which is Duke's Cooper Flagg. Sunday's matchup features three of the five youngest players in college basketball.

FAMILY TIES

The Sun Devil Men's Basketball roster features several connections through bloodline. Head Coach Bobby Hurley's son, Bobby Hurley, is a senior guard on the team. Senior guard Alston Mason's father, Alton Mason, played at Arizona State from 1998-2001. Senior guard Jordan Williams cousin is legendary Sun Devil guard James Harden.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 157 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark.

- The Big 12 is 28-2 through 30 games with 12 teams starting 2-0. Arizona State is the lone 2-0 team to have a win away from home.

- Marquee Big 12 wins include UCF over No. 13 Texas A&M, Kansas over No. 9 North Carolina and Baylor over No. 16 Arkansas

- The Big 12 is the first conference to have at least five teams in the preseason top 10 in the history of the AP Poll, which began releasing a preseason poll in 1961-62.

- Six Big 12 teams are in the preseason AP Poll, including No. 1 Kansas, No. 4 Houston, No. 5 Iowa State, No. 8 Baylor, No. 10 Arizona and No. 20 Cincinnati.

- The Big 12 has led all conferences in average NET ranking in four consecutive seasons and has been the top ranked Conference in NET/ RPI (prior to 2019) in nine of the past 11 seasons.

- The Big 12 has led the nation in non-conference winning percentage in each of the past three seasons. The Conference was 147-34 (.812) in regular season non-league games in 2023-24.
