#### **#BYTHENUMBERS**

The Sun Devils entered the majority of the rankings this week, including moving into the No. 24 spot by D1Baseball and at No. 22 by Baseball America - its first ranking by the outlet since 2020. The team also finds itself at No. 23 by both the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and the USA Today Coaches Poll and as high as No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball News, The Sun Devils are 10-2 in Pac-12 play with series victories in each of the four it has played thus far. The team has won 17 of its last 19 games entering the week.

The Sun Devils have shown an ability to be successful in close games, going 12-2 this season in games decided by three runs or less. A year ago the team was 14-16 in those games. More notably, ASU is 5-2 in one run games this season after going 1-7 in those games last year. ASU has also been impressive in its single-game midweek tilts this year, going 6-0 in such games after Tuesday's victory over Seattle U. ASU was 4-6 in single-game midweek tilts last season. ASU has trailed in 11 of its last 13 victories. ASU has trailed by three or more runs in five of those victories.

The Sun Devil bullpen has been pivotal to ASU's success this season and markedly better than last years with a combined 4.58 ERA this season. The group has a 14-3 record in decisions this year with nine saves and his holding opponents to a .232 average against. The squad has a 143 to 69 strikeout to walk ration for the season. These numbers pop when you consider last year's bullpen through 32 games was sitting with a 6.63 ERA and a 6-13 record in decisions. The team was allowing a .292 average against with 120 strikeouts to a whopping 93 walks.

Ryan Campos was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week following this weekend's sweep of Washington State and enters the week with the league's highest batting average (.419) and longest reached-base streak (30 games). Camposl leads the Pac-12 with 39 runs, tied for 10th with 7 homers and fourth in the league with 25 walks. His .527 OBP also paces the conference while his .675 slugging percentage is good for sixth. Campos is the only Pac-12 Player in the Top-10 in average, OBP, slugging, runs, homers and walks.

#### Photography/Videoography

Accomodations for B-Roll purposes at practice can be made through Jeremy Hawkes (jdhawkes@asu. edu). During games, credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times. At no point during game action should a member of the media be on the field of play. Contact Jeremy Hawkes for any details regarding shooting game action.

#### **Media Highlights Policy**

Highlightes Include Pac-12 Networks/ESPN/FOX network broadcasts (including affiliates such as ABC and ESPNU and CBS sublicensed telecasts), all home hosted non-televised competitions including those that are live streamed and any other sport events in which the Pac-12 controls the exhibition rights. No third-party organization may post competition footage of any Pac-12 game, non-conference home game or other contest for which the Pac-12 controls the media rights on its website without a license to the content from the Pac-12 Networks or its licensing partner (Wazee Digital), with the exception of news window

privileges described below. Alternatively, third parties are permitted to post video on their websites through the use of the Pac-12 Digital embeddable video player (embed code available at http://video. pac-12.com). Certified broadcast news outlets may use a maximum of 3 minutes of Pac-12 event footage on their regularly scheduled newscasts during the 48-hour news window following the conclusion of included events. If the highlights from a Pac-12 Networks production do not contain the Pac-12 Networks bug, the news outlet must insert "Courtesy of Pac-12 Networks" over the footage. Excerpts of those newscasts containing these highlights may also be posted to news providers' websites, but must be removed 48 hours after the conclusion of any included event, unless a license for that footage is obtained from Pac-12 Conference or its licensing Partner (Wazee Digital). Highlights may not be posted to YouTube, Facebook, or other social media properties.

#### 2023 Media Coverage

The vast majority the Sun Devils games this season will be available to fans via the Pac-12 Network or the Pac-12 Live Stream online.

The Sun Devil Sports Radio Network is scheduled to broadcast 32-35 Sun Devil Baseball games this season between NBC Sports Radio AM 1060 and other affiliated radio stations. Fans can listen to the broadcasts on the radio or via the Tuneln app on the sundevils.com. Links to the streaming audio can be found on the online baseball schedule.

Tim Healey is set to serve his 25th season as the "Voice of the Sun Devils" on baseball broadcasts and will be joined for the fifth-straight season by color analyst Max Rossiter, who was an all-conference catcher for the Devils from 2012-13.
