ASU LACROSSE GAME NOTES

STICK-Y NOTES...

• The Sun Devil Lacrosse program embarks on their second season at the Division I Level. The program put together a historic campaign a season ago, reaching several significant milestones and earning unexpected accomplishments under Head Coach Courtney Martinez Connor.

- Arizona State prepares for their first two-game weekend of the 2019 season. First up, the Columbia Lions come to Tempe for a showdown on Friday, Feb. 22nd at 6 p.m. Next, the Sun Devils take on the Stetson Hatters on Sunday, Feb. 24th at 11 a.m.
- Freshman midfielder Kaylon Buckner enjoyed quite the collegiate debut. The St. Louis native finished wtih a team-high six caused turnovers and five draw controls, while contributing four points (two goals & two assists) on the offensive end. For her efforts, she was named the Pac-12 Conference Defensive Player of the Week. She becomes the first Sun Devil in program history to receive a weekly conference honor.
- Redshirt junior attacker Kerri Clayton picked up right where she left off a season ago, when she scored 44 goals during one of the nation's most impressive offensive campaigns. Clayton set the tone early in the Sun Devil's 14-7 victory over Kennesaw State, scoring a pair of goals in the first 60 seconds. Her four goals tied her for the Pac-12 lead in that category after the first weekend.
- The first of Kerri Clayton's four goals against KSU came just 27 seconds into the contest, breaking the school record for the quickest goal scored to start a game.
- Junior goalkeeper Berkeley Bonneau was in net for all 60 minutes of the Sun Devils' 2019 opener. She settled in nicely in the second half, allowing just two goals over the final 29 minutes of play.
- A talented freshman class got their first taste of collegiate action in the 2019 season opener. n addition to Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week Kaylon Buckner, fellow midfielders Paige McGlothlin and Morgan McCaffrey recorded their first goals at Arizona State. Freshman defender Cabrini Class received praise from the coaching staff after the game, pointing to her fearlessness on the defensive end.





SCOUTING THE LIONS...

Columbia is coached by Andrea Cofrin, who is in her fourth season at the helm of Lions Lacrosse. Cofrin led the program to its first-ever berth in the lvy League Tournament, reaching three conference wins for the first time in school history last season. This past weekend, Columbia opened their 2019 season with a 13-12 home victory over Siena. Attacker Alexandria Absey led the way for the Lions, scoring a game-high four goals. Down by two at halftime, Columbia rallied with 10 goals in the second half to earn the victory. Next up, the Lions hosts Fairfield on Wednesday before heading out West to take on the Sun Devils.

SCOUTING THE HATTERS...

Stetson is coached by Christy Leach, who is in the midst of her fifth season in charge of the Hatters Lacrosse program. As a player, Leach was a part of four national titles during her time at Northwestern. Her squad opened the season with a closely-contested home loss in double overtime to Quinnipiac. Stetson squared off with Monmouth this past weekend, their second game of the 2019 season. The Hatters were unable to make up a 10-4 halftime deficit, as they fell to 0-2 on the season.

2019 SCHEDULE PREVIEW...

There will be plenty of opportunities to see the 2019 Sun Devils as they open up the season with five consecutive home games and host ten games overall, all of which will take place at Sun Devil Soccer/Lacrosse Stadium. In total, Arizona State's 17-game schedule includes 10 Pac-12 Conference games and seven non-conference games. The Sun Devils will square off with three teams that begin the season ranked in the Preseason Top 25 Coaches' Poll. Four contests will air live on Pac-12 Network, including both matchups with No. 18 Colorado. The season culminates with the 2019 Pac-12 Lacrosse Championship, hosted in Eugene by the University of Oregon.

LAST TIME OUT...

The Sun Devils kicked off the 2019 season with a 14-7 victory over Kennesaw State on Friday, February 9th. A strong second half led by a balanced offensive attack pushed Arizona State past Kennesaw State for the second consecutive season. Attacker Kerri Clayton picked up where she left off a year ago, when she finished with 44 goals. The redshirt junior recorded a team-high four goals, including two in the first 50 seconds. Goalkeeper Berkeley Bonneau kept the Sun Devils in the game as they attempted to establish a rhythm, making nine saves and boasting a .556 save percentage. Freshman Kaylon Buckner made an impact on the game many ways in her collegiate debut, tallying four points (two goals and two assists) and creating six turnovers.

COURTNEY MARTINEZ CONNOR HEAD COACH SECOND SEASON MARYLAND '01

Guiding the Sun Devil Lacrosse program through its inaugural Division I season, Coach Martinez Connor helped the Sun Devils enjoy one of the most successful inaugural seasons in NCAA history. In the season opener, Arizona State picked up the program's first-ever victory, an 18-8 road triumph against Kennesaw State. The Sun Devils started the season 5-1, highlighted by a come-from-behind win over Columbia, a game the Sun Devils trailed 4-0 and 7-1 at one point. The most signif-

icant result of the season came when ASU traveled to Berkeley to take on conference foe Cal. Despite trailing 6-2 in the first half, the Sun Devils would not quit, tying the game at 11 before the end of regulation to force overtime. Emily Glagolev would come through with the clutch, game-winning goal in overtime would give that would give the program its first Pac-12 Conference victory.

Under Coach Martinez Connor's tutelage, several Sun Devil Lacrosse student-athletes enjoyed breakout seasons. Sun Devil Lacrosse co-captain Kerri Clayton nabbed Second Team All-Pac-12 honors after an outstanding first season in Tempe. Clayton finished with 59 points, compiling 44 goals and 15 assists. Her 2.59 goals per game average placed her fourth in the conference while her 3.47 points per game was good enough for fifth. She recorded two game-winning goals, tying for the team-lead with Maddy Hunter. Clayton put her name in the Sun Devil record books the very first weekend of the season, scoring a program record seven goals in the team's first win over Kennesaw State on Feb. 9. The junior added five goals and two assists the very next game against Stetson on Feb. 11 to cement her name at the top. For that weekend's performance Clayton was named Inside Lacrosse's Alpha Lacrosse Player of the Week on Feb. 14 as voted on by lacrosse fans across the country, the first National Player of the Week honor for the program.

The Sun Devils captured five non-conference victories, two of which came by double-digits (Manhattan, Presbyterian). The Arizona State offense clicked in the non-conference, scoring 103 goals in six games (17.2 goals/game). Competing as the six seed at their first-ever Pac-12 Tournament, Arizona State saw freshman midfielder Maria Vallanti be named to the 2018 Pac-12 Women's Lacrosse All-Tournament Team after scoring a pair of goals against USC. In total, 2,530 fans attended Sun Devil Lacrosse home games, for a Pac-12 best average crowd of 361 fans per game. The team got it done off the field as well as on it, as Coach Martinez Connor continues to stress the importance of academics. Arizona State placed a pair of student-athletes (Sydney Bosmans, Rachel Gregory) on the IWLCA All-Academic Team, honoring those with a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or higher. Five different Sun Devils earned Pac-12 All-Academic honors, led by Sydney Bosmans, who received Second Team honors.

Courtney Martinez Connor was named the first head coach for Arizona State's varsity women's lacrosse program, Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson announced in Nov. 2015. Martinez Connor, a gifted lacrosse student-athlete and standout collegiate coach, is building the foundation of Sun Devil Athletics' 25th varsity sport.

TIERNEY CONLON ASSISTANT COACH SECOND SEASON MONTCLAIR STATE '15

In charge of the Sun Devils offensive unit during their innagural Division I sea son, Coach Tierney Conlon developed some of the most productive attackers in the conference. The offense was a big part of Arizona State's 5-1 start in non-con ference play, averaging 16.3 goals/game, including a school record 23 goals in

the home opener. The Sun Devil offense scored at least 12 goals in eight of their contests. Redshirt sophomore attacker Kerri Clayton enjoyed a breakout season under Conlon's tutelage, scoring 44 goals on her way to receiving Second Team All-Conference honors from the Pac-12. Former Drexel Assistant Coach Caroline Fitzgerald, a three-time All-American defender at the University of Florida, is joining the Arizona State Lacrosse staff as an Assistant Coach, as announced by head coach Courtney Martinez Connor on Friday.

Fitzgerald joins the Sun Devil Lacrosse staff after one season as an Assistant Coach at Drexel, where she worked primarily with the defense. Working under Dragons head coach Hannah Wszalek, Fitzgerald assisted with defensive concepts, helped implement defense schemes, and developed practice/game plans.

A four-year starter at the University of Florida, Fitzgerald made a tremendous impact in her career in Gaines-ville. Graduating as the program's all-time leader in ground balls (152) and caused turnovers (87), Fitzgerald will go down as one of the Gator's most productive defenders.
