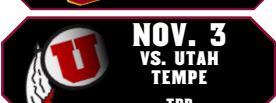

**THE GAME** - No. 23/25 Sun Devil Football heads on the road for the first time this season, trekking West to take on San Diego State on Saturday, September 15 at SDCCU Stadium in San Diego, Calif. The game, scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. PT kickoff, will be broadcast live on the CBS Sports Network with Carter Blackburn, Aaron Taylor and John Schriffen on the call. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on ESPN 620 AM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, joined by Jeff Van Raaphorst and Jordan Simone.

**SUN DEVIL CLEAN UP WEEKLY AWARDS** - Arizona State redshirt senior quarterback Manny Wilkins was named to the **Davey O'Brien Award's "Great 8"** players for week two of the college football season.

Wilkins came through with a top-notch performance in ASU's 16-13 upset of then-No. 15 Michigan State on Saturday, completing 30-of-48 passes for a career-high 380 yards and one touchdown. He led ASU to 13 points in the fourth quarter to help the Sun Devils overcome 13-3 fourth-quarter deficit. Wilkins connected on consecutive passes of 38 yards (WR Kyle Williams) and 27 yards, the latter a touchdown strike to WR N'Keal Harry to tie the game at 13-13 with under nine minutes remaining. Wilkins had several clutch throws when it mattered most, finding RB Eno Benjamin for 25 yards on 3rd&8 at the ASU 23 to help the Sun Devils continue a 13-play, 69-yard drive that resulted in game-winning field goal as time expired.

Arizona State freshman linebacker Merlin Robertson was named the **Walter Camp National Defensive Player of the Week**.

Robertson's performance was one of the major factors in Arizona State's 16-13 win over then-No. 15 Michigan State on Saturday night. Playing in just his second game at the collegiate level, Robertson (Gardena, Calif./Junipero Serro) registered nine tackles, 1.5 sacks, one forced fumble and one pass breakup. In the second half alone, Robertson recorded seven tackles, 1.5 sacks, 1.5 TFL, and one forced fumble.

Arizona State sophomore placekicker Brandon Ruiz was named the **Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week**.

Ruiz connected on all three of his field goal attempts (49, 24, 28), including the game-winning kick from 28 yards as time expired in ASU's 16-13 upset of then-No. 15 Michigan State on Saturday. Ruiz, who was also successful on one PAT attempt, scored ASU's first points of the game with a 49-yard field goal to cut Michigan State's lead to 6-3 in the third quarter. His second field goal (24 yards) early in the fourth quarter got ASU within a touchdown, 13-6, of the Spartans. In addition to the 10 points he was responsible for scoring, Ruiz also did not allow any kickoff returns with touchbacks on all four of his kickoffs.

## #BYTHENUMBERS

578

No ASU running back has put the ball on the ground in **578 consecutive carries**, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 21 consecutive games. That includes 43 running back carries this season. ASU turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers. Since 2012, ASU has scored 68.2 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (101 of 148) while finding the end zone 77 times in that span (52.0 percent).

The last time ASU didn't score in the red zone (not including game-ending victory formations) was in the second quarter at Washington in 2016 (interception in the red zone). Since then, the Sun Devils have scored on **62 consecutive red zone trips (16 1/2 games)** in which it did not take a knee to end a game. The Sun Devils are a perfect 6-for-6 in the red zone this season, continuing a trend that has been commonplace in the last two seasons. ASU is the only team in the country to be ranked in the Top 10 in red zone scoring in each of the past two seasons.

In 2018, ASU has **61 plays in which the opponent has gained zero or negative yardage** (36 incomplete passes, 20 tackles for loss, 5 plays of no gain) on 143 total plays (42.7 percent). ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons and was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013. ASU is one of just 17 teams this season to not give up a play of over 40 yards, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively).

**N'Keal Harry has a catch in each of his 27 games as a Sun Devil** - tied for the eighth-longest active streak in the nation. Harry has a touchdown reception in each of his last 4 games dating back to last season and at least one in 6 of last 7 games. He has 8 touchdown receptions in those 7 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career. Harry has a 149.3 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for 11th nationally. At 5.63 receptions per game in his career, Harry is currently the NCAA's active career leader and his 75.2 career receiving yards per game are second among all active players.

Kobe Williams has allowed just **five yards after the catch** this season - tied for fourth among Pac-12 corners. Williams is allowing just 0.50 yards per play in which he is the primary man in coverage, tied for fourth among Pac-12 corners. Williams has allowed just 31 total yards when targetted - the sixth-lowest total in the Pac-12. Desmond Tautalatasi and Demonte King have combined to allow just three receptions on 143 plays in coverage from the safety position this season. Robertson has graded out at 70.6 this season by Pro Football Focus when in coverage - the 10th best score for an outside defender in the country.

## #10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

1. The Sun Devils have allowed just 3 first half points this season, tied for the third-lowest total in the country among teams who have played at least two FBS opponents (Alabama and Missouri each at 0 first half points).
2. ASU has 61 plays this season in which the opponent has gained zero or negative yardage (36 incomplete passes, 20 tackles for loss, 5 plays of no gain) on 143 total opponent plays (42.7 percent).
3. @mjsleepdalton36 is tied for the national lead with 8 punts inside the 20 through two games. Of his 10 punts, only one has been returned - also tied for first nationally.
4. ASU has scored on 62 consecutive red zone trips (16 1/2 games dating back to Washington, 2016) in which it did not take a knee to end a game.
5. No ASU running back has coughed up the ball in 578 consecutive carries (21 straight games without a fumble).
6. Jalen Bates is tied for the national lead among defensive ends with 6 QB pressures this season for a 20.5 pass rush productivity score that is good for second nationally.
7. ASU has allowed just 20 points through the first two games of the season - the fifth lowest total in the Pac-12 era, which began in 1978 and the fourth-best number since 1988.
8. @NkealHarry15 has a touchdown reception in each of his last 4 games and at least one in 6 of last 7 games. He has 8 touchdown receptions in those 7 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.
9. N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 27 games of his career at Arizona State, the eighth-longest active streak of games for any returning player in the NCAA.
10. Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 123 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points.



## GOLD ZONE

- » The Sun Devils are a perfect 6-for-6 in the red zone this season, continuing a trend that has been commonplace in the last two seasons.
- » ASU finished fifth nationally in converting on 96.23 percent of its red zone appearances last season (51-of-53). HOWEVER, the Devils took a knee in the red zone in the final seconds of the team's victories over fifth-ranked Washington and in the Territorial Cup contest against Arizona.
- » The Sun Devils scored on 43-of-47 trips to the red zone in 2016 (91.5 percent), a total that ranked 10th in the nation.
- » The last time ASU didn't score in the red zone (not including game-ending victory formations) was in the second quarter at Washington in 2016 (interception in the red zone). Since then, ASU has scored on 62 consecutive red zone trips (16 1/2 games) in which it did not take a knee to end a game.
- » ASU is the only team in the country to be ranked in the Top 10 in red zone scoring in each of the past two seasons.

## DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » In 2018, ASU has 61 plays in which the opponent has gained zero or negative yardage (36 incomplete passes, 20 tackles for loss, 5 plays of no gain) on 143 total plays (42.7 percent)

## DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » ASU has allowed just 20 points through the first two games of the season - the fifth lowest total in the Pac-12 era, which began in 1978 (12 - 1985; 13 - 1982; 17 - 1986, 2000, 2007, 2009; 19 - 1987; 20 - 2012, 2018) and the fourth-best number since 1988.

## HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has put the ball on the ground in 578 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 21 consecutive games. That includes 43 running back carries this season.
- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.

## HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is currently eight in program history with 6,216 career passing yards and he needs just 394 to move into a tie for seventh.
- » His 503 career completions are tied for sixth in program history.
- » His 12 career rushing touchdowns are fourth among quarterbacks in ASU history behind Mark Malone (21), Danny White (14) and Taylor Kelly (13). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins broke the school record for most consecutive pass attempts without an interception last season at 192 between the end of the 2016 season and the first half of last year, breaking Rudy Carpenter's previous school record of 149 from the

end of 2005 to 2006.

- » Wilkins needs one touchdown (rushing or passing) to account for 50 in his career.
- » The Sun Devil offense has scored a successful play (as graded by Pro Football Focus) on 44.0 percent of Wilkins' passing attempts this season - the 17th-best total among all quarterbacks in the FBS.
- » Wilkins has a 147.1 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the seventh best total nationally.

## DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 27 games of his career at Arizona State, tied for the eighth-longest active streak among all current FBS players.
- » His 152 career receptions are good for ninth in Sun Devil school history and he is just four away from moving into a tie for seventh (and 5 away from a tie for sixth).
- » Harry is already within 119 yards of cracking ASU's all-time Top-10 in career receiving yards.
- » At 5.63 receptions for game in his career, Harry is currently the NCAA's active career leader in the category. His 75.2 career receiving yards per game are second among all active players.
- » With 16 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is within one of moving into a tie for 10th in ASU school history in that category as well and two would move him into ninth.
- » He was named to PFF's Offensive Team of the Week, finishing with a 90.7 grade and accounted for 114 yards after the catch on his 140 total receiving yards.
- » Harry has a touchdown reception in each of his last 4 games dating back to last season and at least one in 6 of last 7 games. He has 8 touchdown receptions in those 7 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.
- » Harry has a 149.3 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for 11th nationally

## NO RUSH

- » The Devils have allowed just 65 rushing yards through two games this season, allowing just 32.5 rushing yards per game - a total that currently leads the nation.
- » ASU is allowing an FBS low 1.07 yards per opponent rush this season.
- » ASU allowed just 2 rushing yards against UTSA - the seventh-lowest total it has allowed against any opponent since the 1996 season.

## GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » During Week One, the Sun Devils averaged 8.1 yards per attempt on the ground - good for 15th nationally. The offensive line played a big role in that, as ASU led the FBS this week in yards gained before contact at 3.9 yards per carry.

## KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 123



consecutive games scoring more than 7 points. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 70 of those games (57.0 percent).

- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.

### THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 5 tackles and two stops for a 6.3 run stop percentage that is currently second among Pac-12 cornerbacks.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014.
- » He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.
- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference – regardless of year.

### MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 601-328 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 68.2 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (101 of 148) while finding the end zone 77 times in that span (52.0 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 51.8 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (55 of 106) with 43 touchdowns (40.6 percent).

### ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin has forced 13 missed tackles this season (7 rushing, 6 receiving) on 37 total touches for a 113.9 elusive rating according to Pro Football Focus, 28th-best nationally.
- » Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 34.2 percent of the time – good for 11th among all Power Five running backs.
- » 40 percent of Benjamin's rushing attempts this season have resulted in a first down or touchdown – a total good for the 9th-highest percentage among all Power Five running backs.

### A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 17 interception returns for touchdowns in the last seven seasons tied for second in the nation behind only Alabama (18) in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 92 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 21 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (25), Alabama (24) and Boise State (24).

### ON THE DEFENSE

- » Jalen Bates is tied for the national lead among defensive ends with 6 QB pressures this season for a 20.5 pass rush productivity score that is good for second nationally. Teammate Doug Subtyl is tied for second among ends with five QB pressures this season and sixth in the national with a 12.9 PRP, according to PFF.
- » Kobe Williams has allowed just five yards after the catch this season – tied for fourth among Pac-12 corners.
- » Williams is allowing just 0.50 yards per play in which he is the primary man in coverage, also tied for fourth among Pac-12 corners. In general, Williams has allowed just 31 total yards when targeted – the sixth-lowest total in the Pac-12.
- » Dasmond Tautalatasi and Demonte King have combined to allow just three receptions on a combined 143 plays in coverage from the safety position this season.
- » Merlin Robertson recorded seven tackles, 1.5 sacks, 1.5 TFL, and one forced fumble in the second half alone against #15 MSU en route to being named the Walter Camp National Defensive Player of the Week.
- » Robertson has been one of the top edge defenders in the country in coverage, grading out at 70.6 this season by Pro Football Focus – the 10th best score for an outside defender in the country.
- » ASU is one of just 17 teams this season to not give up a play of over 40 yards, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively).

### RUIZ'S PIECES

- » Ruiz connected on all three of his field goal attempts (49, 24, 28), including the game-winning kick from 28 yards as time expired in ASU's 16-13 upset of then-No. 15 Michigan State to earn Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week Honors for the third time in his career.
- » Ruiz is 13th nationally with a 83.33 percent touchback percentage this season (10 of 12).
- » The true freshman finished 12th nationally and led all FBS freshmen in touchback percentage (69.3 percent) and 10th nationally with 52 total touchbacks.
- » Ruiz was second among all freshmen kickers in the country with 19 field goals last season – good for a tie for 18th among all kickers in the country.

### DON'T SLEEP ON HIM

- » Michael Sleep-Dalton is currently one of four players tied for first in the nation this season with 8 punts downed inside the 20 yard line.
- » He has had just one of his 10 punts against him returned, also a total tied for the national lead.
- » He is currently 11th nationally in averaging 45.4 yards per punt and eighth nationally with his 43.9 net yards per punt as well.

#### General

The Sun Devil Athletics media relations staff understands the importance of assisting the media in providing coverage of the institution, its athletics programs, administrators, coaches and student-athletes. We pride ourselves in being able to disseminate information as widely, uniformly and fairly as possible using normally accepted media standards. To this end, the best attempt will be made to fill reasonable requests by recognized media outlets. Members of the media are encouraged to work with the Sun Devil Football media relations staff to assist in that endeavor. It is not permissible for media members to contact any athletics department administrator, associate, coach or student-athlete directly without working through the media relations department.

#### Practice Policies

Due to the nature of Arizona State game dates this season, practices schedules each week will vary dependent upon that week's game. The ASU media relations office will provide a practice schedule prior to each game week for the media.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4. At the conclusion of Period 3, a member of the media relations staff will escort the media out of practice. The typical viewing period will last approximately 35-40 minutes.

No member of the media may shoot any portion of practice that includes team activities (anything 11-on-11) or that includes any play-calling signals and/or audio. Members of the media may only photograph and shoot individual or positions groups working separate of a team setting.

Viewing periods are always subject to the discretion of the Sun Devil Football coaching staff and may change suddenly. Following that open viewing period, the members of the media will be escorted out of the facility and reconvene at the Student-Athlete Facility on the north end of Sun Devil Stadium for post-practice interviews. Under no circumstances will Periscope technology be permitted.

#### Interview Policies

All interviews will be conducted post-practice at the new Student-Athlete Facility, located at the north end of Sun Devil Stadium. Due to high demand, several players and members of the coaching staff might only be available on a limited basis each week. A full availability schedule will be provided to the media each week.

All interviews must be arranged through the Media Relations office. Under no circumstances are members of the media allowed to contact a student-athlete or member of the coaching staff without first contacting a member of the Media Relations staff. All coaches and student-athletes have been encouraged to check in with the Media Relations staff and not indulge any interview requests that have not been arranged through the proper channels. Every possible attempt will be made to accommodate all media requests.

Following home contests, Arizona State will bring several student-athletes to the media room at the new Student-Athlete Facility in the North End Zone for a post-game press conference. Head Coach Herm Edwards will follow

the student-athletes.

Please note that there is a new NCAA rule in effect that states that every NCAA athletic team must take one day off per week from all team-related activities, including practice, weight training, conditioning, meetings, interviews, etc. This means that one day per week (typically Monday for Sun Devil football), no Sun Devil student-athlete may conduct an interview. As this is an NCAA rule and will be monitored by compliance personnel, there can be no exceptions made.

#### Weekly Press Conferences

Head coach Herm Edwards will host his weekly press conferences each Monday prior to game week. The press conference is tentatively scheduled for 12 p.m. (Noon) Arizona Time each week.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4 and those wishing to document practice via photograph or video will be able to do so during this time, so long as said documentation does not record play-calling signals. On-camera interviews will be conducted at the end of each practice.

For home games, a photographer work area has been established inside the Carson Student-Athlete Center (first floor). Internet access to transmit files is available in the photography workroom. Credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times.

#### Weekly Media Teleconference

The Pac-12 Football Coaches Weekly Media Teleconference Call will take place each Tuesday during the season. Coach Graham is scheduled to speak at 12:05 PT/1:05 MT each Tuesday. ### Randall McDaniel to be Inducted into Rose Bowl Hall of Fame

PASADENA, Calif. -- Former Arizona State offensive lineman Randall McDaniel will be inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2018. McDaniel will join Pop Warner, Vince Young and George Halas being honored at the Rose Bowl Kickoff Luncheon in Pasadena on December 31, 2018.

McDaniel will be the third Sun Devil to be inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame after teammate and quarterback Jeff Van Raaphorst and head coach John Cooper, who coached the team that included both McDaniel and Van Raaphorst to 1987 Rose Bowl Title.

McDaniel, from nearby Avondale, Ariz., was a four-year starter along the offensive line in Tempe and helped lead ASU to the 1987 Rose Bowl Title, defeating Michigan 22-15. The following year, he was awarded the 1987 Morris Trophy for Pac-10 offensive lineman of the year. He was also a two-time first-team all-American in 1986 and 1987.
