ASU LACROSSE GAME NOTES

STICK-Y NOTES (UPDATED 3/30)...

The Sun Devil Lacrosse program embarks on their second season at the Division I Level. The program put together a historic campaign a season ago, reaching several significant milestones and earning unexpected accomplishments under Head Coach Courtney Martinez Connor.

Arizona State will face its second rematch of the weekend, as they head across the Bay to take on California for the second time this season on Sunday, March 31 at 12 p.m. at California Memorial Stadium.

The Sun Devils may have fallen to No. 20 Stanford on Friday night, but it wasn't due to a lack of production from Emily Glagolev. The sophomore continues to cause opposing defenses fits, scoring 17 points over her last five games.

Emily Glagolev, the team leader in points (28), has shown versatility with the ability to both score and facilitate. Her 15 assists not only lead the team, but also ties her for second in the Pac-12 Conference. Through ten games in 2019, the sophomore ranks second in the conference averaging 1.5 assists/game. Glagolev leads the Pac-12 with nine assists during conference play.

Kerri Clayton has excelled offensively despite garnering a majority of the attention from defenses. While she continues to be a goal-scoring threat with a team-leading 17 goals this season, her passing prowess has been on display recently. She has at least one assist in five of her last six games. Clayton still can put the ball in the back of the net, scoring at least one goal in 24 of the 27 games she has played in since becoming a Sun Devil.

Goalkeeper Berkeley Bonneau has been outstanding in net for the Sun Devils, ranking second in the Pac-12 making 10.80 saves/game. The junior has reached double digits saves six times this season, highlighted by a record-breaking 20-save performance against No. 23 Colorado. Bonneau has started all ten games and played all 601 possible minutes in net.

Freshman midfielder Paige McGlothlin continues to come on strong as the season progresses. She reached the double-digit goal mark (11 goals) with a two-goal outing in the loss to No. 20 Stanford. It was her third multi-goal performance of the season.

Freshman midfielder Kaylon Buckner enjoyed quite the collegiate debut. She finished with a team-high six caused turnovers and five draw controls, while contributing four points (two goals & two assists) on the offensive end. For her efforts, she was named the Pac-12 Conference Defensive Player of the Week for the first week of the season.

RECAP VS. STANFORD...

The Sun Devil Lacrosse team came up short in a battle with No. 20 Stanford on Friday evening at Maloney Field in Laird Q. Cagan Stadium. Emily Glagolev continued her productive month of March, finishing with a goal and two assists (three points) to lead the offensive unit. Paige McGlothlin put together her third career multi-goal performance, as the freshman reached the double-digit goal plateau. A shorthanded Arizona State side put forth great effort despite the challenging circumstances. The team continues to show resiliency, as they compete hard every game while overcoming adversity. The defensive unit showed flashes of brilliance, holding Stanford scoreless for a 12-minute stretch and three separate nine-minute stretches, but a second half stretch in which the Cardinal scored five goals in five minutes put the game out of reach. The Cardinal captured their eighth win of the season in a 14-5 victory.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN BEARS...

Traveling across the Bay, the Sun Devils return to the site where they made history to face-off with California on Sunday, March 31 at 12:00 p.m. A season ago, Emily Glagolev scored an overtime goal as the program earned its first-ever victory over a Pac-12 opponent in Berkeley. The Golden Bears (5-8) are led by Head Coach Brooke Eubanks, who is in her fifth season in charge of the Cal Lacrosse program. A 2-3 conference record places them fourth in the Pac-12 standings. Arizona State is looking to make up for a narrow loss to the same Golden Bears side this past Monday. ASU led 11-9 late in the contest, but were unable to prevent a late Cal comeback to force overtime. A little over a minute into overtime, the Golden Bears scored a sudden victory goal to earn the 12-11 win. Four different Sun Devils recorded multi-goal performances and the Maroon and Gold held Cal scoreless for over 29-minutes, but were unable to secure their second Pac-12 victory.

SUN DEVILS ON THE NETWORK...

Four Sun Devil Lacrosse games will be broadcasted live on the Pac-12 Network, including both matchups with Top-25 Colorado. The season culminates with the 2019 Pac-12 Lacrosse Championship, hosted in Eugene by the University of Oregon. The Championships will be broadcasted live on Pac-12 Network.

YOUTH MOVEMENT...

In just their second season at the Division I level, the Sun Devils boast a talented and young roster. So far during the 2019 season, 11 members of the freshman class have seen playing time (Buckner, McCaffrey, McGlothlin, Martel, Kroah, Hood, Anotonucci, Brodsky, Odell, Class, Payne). The freshman class has made an instant impact, starting a total of 39 games while producing a combined 30 points (20 goals & 10 assists), 70 ground balls, 33 caused turnovers, and 33 draw controls.

Guiding the Sun Devil Lacrosse program through its inaugural Division I season, Coach Martinez Connor helped the Sun Devils enjoy one of the most successful inaugural seasons in NCAA history. In the season opener, Arizona State picked up the program's first-ever victory, an 18-8 road triumph against Kennesaw State. The Sun Devils started the season 5-1, highlighted by a come-from-behind win over Columbia, a game the Sun Devils trailed 4-0 and 7-1 at one point. The most significant result of the season came when ASU traveled to Berkeley to take on conference foe Cal. Despite trailing 6-2 in the first half, the Sun Devils would not quit, tying the game at 11 before the end of regulation to force overtime. Emily Glagolev would come through with the clutch, game-winning goal in overtime would give that would give the the program its first Pac-12 Conference victory.

Under Coach Martinez Connor's tutelage, several Sun Devil Lacrosse student-athletes enjoyed breakout seasons. Sun Devil Lacrosse co-captain Kerri Clayton nabbed Second Team All-Pac-12 honors after an outstanding first season in Tempe. Clayton finished with 59 points, compiling 44 goals and 15 assists. Her 2.59 goals per game average placed her fourth in the conference while her 3.47 points per game was good enough for fifth. She recorded two game-winning goals, tying for the team-lead with Maddy Hunter. Clayton put her name in the Sun Devil record books the very first weekend of the season, scoring a program record seven goals in the team's first win over Kennesaw State on Feb. 9. The junior added five goals and two assists the very next game against Stetson on Feb. 11 to cement her name at the top. For that weekend's performance Clayton was named Inside Lacrosse's Alpha Lacrosse Player of the Week on Feb. 14 as voted on by lacrosse fans across the country, the first National Player of the Week honor for the program.

The Sun Devils captured five non-conference victories, two of which came by double-digits (Manhattan, Presbyterian). The Arizona State offense clicked in the non-conference, scoring 103 goals in six games (17.2 goals/game). Competing as the six seed at their first-ever Pac-12 Tournament, Arizona State saw freshman midfielder Maria Vallanti be named to the 2018 Pac-12 Women's Lacrosse All-Tournament Team after scoring a pair of goals against USC. In total, 2,530 fans attended Sun Devil Lacrosse home games, for a Pac-12 best average crowd of 361 fans per game. The team got it done off the field as well as on it, as Coach Martinez Connor continues to stress the importance of academics. Arizona State placed a pair of student-athletes (Sydney Bosmans, Rachel Gregory) on the IWLCA All-Academic Team, honoring those with a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or higher. Five different Sun Devils earned Pac-12 All-Academic honors, led by Sydney Bosmans, who received Second Team honors.

Courtney Martinez Connor was named the first head coach for Arizona State's varsity women's lacrosse program, Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson announced in Nov. 2015. Martinez Connor, a gifted lacrosse student-athlete and standout collegiate coach, is building the foundation of Sun Devil Athletics' 25th varsity sport.

TIERNEY CONLON ASSISTANT COACH SECOND SEASON MONTCLAIR STATE '15

In charge of the Sun Devils offensive unit during their innagural Division I season, Coach Tierney Conlon developed some of the most productive attackers in the conference. The offense was a big part of Arizona State's 5-1 start in non-conference play, averaging 16.3 goals/game, including a school record 23 goals in the home opener. The Sun Devil offense scored at least 12 goals in eight of their contests. Redshirt sophomore attacker Kerri Clayton enjoyed a breakout season under Conlon's tutelage, scoring 44 goals on her way to receiving Second Team All-Conference honors from the Pac-12. Freshman Emily Glagolev found the back of the net 21 times from the midfield, including the game-winning goal in the Sun Devil's first conferene victory over California. It total, a balanced offensive unit saw eight different Sun Devils reached a double-digit goal output in 2018.

Sun Devil Lacrosse Assistant Coach Tierney Conlon enters her second season on the coaching staff. In charge of the offensive unit, Conlon joined the Sun Devils after acting as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Montclair State. Conlon assisted head coach Nicol Parcelluzzi in all aspects of the sport including practice planning, recruiting, film breakdowns, strength and conditioning programming, and academic monitoring.



CAROLINE FITZGERALD ASSISTANT COACH FIRST SEASON FLORIDA '17

Former Drexel Assistant Coach Caroline Fitzgerald, a three-time All-American defender at the University of Florida, is joining the Arizona State Lacrosse staff as an Assistant Coach, as announced by head coach Courtney Martinez Connor on Friday.

Fitzgerald joins the Sun Devil Lacrosse staff after one season as an Assistant Coach at Drexel, where she worked primarily with the defense. Working under Dragons head coach Hannah Wszalek, Fitzgerald assisted with defensive concepts, helped implement defense schemes, and developed practice/game plans.

A four-year starter at the University of Florida, Fitzgerald made a tremendous impact in her career in Gainesville. Graduating as the program's all-time leader in ground balls (152) and caused turnovers (87), Fitzgerald will go down as one of the Gator's most productive defenders. Fitzgerald compiled several major accolades during her career at Florida. She was a two-time Tewaaraton Award Nominee (2016, 2017), an award which is recognized as the pre-eminent lacrosse award, annually honoring the top male and female college lacrosse player. Earning IWLCA All-American honors in each of her final three seasons, Fitzgerald became just the fourth Gator to be selected to three All-America teams. The two-time Big East Defender of the Year (2016, 2017) also was named to the All-Big East First Team on three occasions (2015-2017).

"I'm so glad to have Caroline join our staff" Coach Courtney Martinez Connor remarked. "She will be a wonderful addition and influence to our student-athletes and program. I'm so happy that she has joined our family to become a Sun Devil."

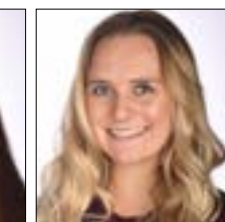
