LEADING OFF...

- · The No. 22 Sun Devil softball team will get their 2020 season underway this weekend as host of the 2020 Kajikawa Classic at Farrington Stadium and Tempe Sports Complex. Arizona State kicks off its schedule with a Friday double header, starting with Portland State at 3:30 p.m. followed by Kansas at 6 p.m.. ASU heads back to Farrington on Saturday for its second and final double header of the tournament against Western Michigan (4:30 p.m.) and No. 14 Northwestern (7 p.m.). To close out the tournament, ASU plays two single tilts on Sunday against Seattle at 2 p.m. and against No. 12 Tennessee on Monday at 7 p.m..
- The Sun Devils will look to continue their winning ways in season openers in Friday night's matchup. The squad enters the 2020 season winners of 23 of their last 24 season opening games. ASU has dropped just eight season-openers in the program's 46-year history, making the Sun Devils a remarkable 40-8 all-time in season openers.
- · ASU returns 12 letter winners, including two Top 100 players (K. Hackbarth & Loomis). The other 11 players to complete the 23-woman roster are all newcomers - eight freshmen and three transfers.
- · The Sun Devils finished the 2019 regular season with a 35-20 record on the season, finishing fourth in the Pac-12 with a 13-11 record in league play. The 35 wins pushes ASU to their 25th straight season with 30 or more wins, while the team's 13 wins in Pac-12 play marks the second-straight winning season in league play, and is the 12th winning season in conference play in program history.
- · ASU enters the new season with an impressive offensive finish in 2019. The Sun Devils concluded the year ranked No. 2 in the country in scoring with 411 runs in 55 games for an average 7.47 runs per game. The team's 1370 at-bats and 436 hits marked a .318 batting average, ranked 16th in the nation.
- There will be no shortage of ways to follow the Kajikawa Classic, as 12 games of the classic are scheduled to be broadcast across the Pac-12 Networks. Alongside the Pac-12's coverage of the annual event, FloSoftball will also be streaming five games to subscribers of their online streaming service.

ABOUT THE KAJIKAWA CLASSIC....

Since the beginning of ASU Softball in 1966, ASU has hosted the annual event. From 1966-1990, it was named the 'Sun Devil Invitational', which found its name changed in 1991 to the Coca-Cola Classic. It remained that until 1999 when the name changed yet again to the 'Fiesta Bowl Tournament'.

Six years later in 2005, the name was changed one final time to the 'Kajikawa Classic', after "Mr. Sun Devil" himself, Bill Kajikawa, a legendary coach and founder of Sun Devil athletics.

The tournament will feature 23 games played by nine teams over four days at three separate fields, continuing the tradition of being one of the largest preseason tournaments in the nation.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION....

PORTLAND STATE

The Portland State Vikings will travel to Tempe fresh off a 2019 season that saw the squad post a 20-31 (.392) record, that included a 8-9 mark in the Big Sky. The Vikings finished 2019 ranked 2nd in total batting average in the Big Sky and 54th in the nation, hitting .292 as a team on the year. The Vikings' boast two key senior returners in shortstop Darian Lindsey and righthanded pitcher Katie Schroeder. Lindsay's .404 batting average ties her with two others at No. 48 in the nation with 166 at-bats and 67 hits. Schroeder outpaces her fellow Portland State pitchers in innings pitched, commandeering the mound through 130 innings. She's allowed only 16 walks while striking out 48 batters and owns a 3.33 ERA.

KANSAS

The Jayhawks will make the trip out west after finishing 2019 with a 15-36 record, including a 2-13 away tally. Despite a frustrating end to last season, Kansas' defense landed at No. 28 for double plays per game with 25 through 51 games for an average .49 per game. Entering 2020, Kansas lost a strong senior pitcher in Brynn Minor who stood on the mound for 168 innings and finished her final year with a 4.08 ERA. Sophomore California native Lexy Mills looks to be the next Jayhawk go-to with 70 innings pitched with a 5.40 ERA. At the plate, Kansas returners all three batters with over 140 at-bats last season, Becki Monaghan (151), Madison Sykes (149), and Sydnee Ramsey (140).

WESTERN MICHIGAN

The Broncos finished last season with a 18-28 record and a 9-11 conference record. ASU and WMU met on the diamond 15 times since their first meeting in 1986. The Sun Devil's collected 13 wins to only two losses against the Broncos and look to extend their wins in Saturday's matchup. Junior standout Sydney Stefanick led the Bronco squad in home runs (12), hits (54), and RBI (47) for a team-leading .380 batting average. On the mound, Stefanick struckout 97 batters through 135.1 innings pitched for a 10-10 record.

SEATTLE

Following a slow start to the 2019 season, Seattle finished with an eight-game win-streak to push their record to 40-17 (.702). Home field advantage proved true for Seattle who only lost four times at Logan Field and notched 16 wins in front of a home Redhawks crowd. Seattle held the No. 22 rank on the national stage for batting average with .308 as a team. The Redhawks return an experienced pitcher in Carley Nance who threw for 147.2 innings with a 1.99 ERA. Senior firstbase Madison Cathcart returns with a team-high 377 putouts and 55 RBI from 2019 under her belt.

NORTHWESTERN

The 2019 Northwestern team completed last season ranked 17th in both ERA (1.95) and shutouts (17) with a 47-13 record. In Coach Kate Drohan's 18th season at the helm of Northwestern softball last season, the Wildcats felt at home during neutral site competition, earning 18 wins to only three losses. Northwestern returns its batting average leader, sophomore Jordyn Rudd who also leads the team in putouts (483) and RBIs (51).

TENNESSEE

In his 18th year as head coach of Tennessee, 1973 Arizona State alum Ralph Weekly and his wife and co-head coach Karen Weekly, led the Volunteers to a 43-17 record in 2019. The final game of Kajikawa and for ASU opens the Sun Devils play against SEC opponents. In 2020, Tennessee looks to fill the spot left by the graduation of Aubrey Leach who led the team in runs (65) and at-bats (175). Returner Chelsea Seggern hit .366 last season with 153 at-bats and a .614 slugging percentage.
