SCOUTING THE SERIES

Back in the desert after a hot weekend in Alaska, the Sun Devils (21-7-6) return to Mullett Arena for the final home series of the 2023-24 season as hosts to Long Island (16-18-2) on March 1-2. The Arizona State hockey team is chasing a 23-plus win season in the final four games of the year and celebrates its senior class on Saturday night.

Puck drop is slated for 7 p.m. MST on Friday night and 5 p.m. MST on Saturday. Fans should arrive by 4:40 p.m. on Saturday night to watch the pregame Senior Night ceremony. Seniors Benji Eckerle, Alex Young, Tim Lovell, Matthew Koppe-
rud, Ryan O'Reilly, Lukas Sillinger, and graduate students Brandon Tabakin, Brian Chambers, Tyler Gratton will be honored. Twins Ty and Dylan Jackson, although seniors, will not participate in the ceremony as they have announced their return for the 2024-25 season.

With the 2024 NCAA Tournament and postseason chase off of the table for the 2023-24 season, the team has set its sights on accomplishing a new goal: the most wins in a single season in program history. This team sits two wins away from breaking the record which is currently held by the 2019-20 squad who accomplished a 22-win season before the season was ultimately cut short due to Covid-19.

The Sun Devils and Sharks meet for the third-straight season and ASU looks to protect its 4-0 undefeated record against LIU. In the final season as an independent, ASU owns a 8-1-1 record against its fellow independents (Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks, Lindenwood, Long Island, and Stonehill).

TOP IN THE COUNTRY

The ASU team continues to rank among the top in the country in numerous categories:

- Tied-No. 2: ASU is tied for the second-fewest losses in the NCAA at 7 with reigning national champions No. 7 Quinnipiac. Only No. 1 Boston College and No. 13 Cornell have fewer losses this season (5).
- No. 4: ASU has scored 35 power play goals in 34 games
- No. 6: ASU's 21 wins is tied for fifth-best in the country and ranks sixth overall for best winning percentage (.706)
- No 8: Power play unit converts at a 25.9 percent success rate
- Tied-No. 8: ASU boasts one of the smallest goals against average in the country at 2.4
- No. 14: ASU has scored 113 goals in 34 games so far this season with an average of 3.32 goals per game

PLAYERS IN THE NATION'S TOP 15

- No. 1: Matthew Kopperud's power play goals continues to lead the NCAA with 14 this season.
- Tied-No. 1: Matthew Kopperud has a knack for scoring game-winning goals in 2023-24. The senior has scored eight GWG through his 34 games played.
- No. 4: Lukas Sillinger tallied 31 assists. He is one assist away from breaking the single season record for most assists in a season set by Robert Mastrosimone in 2022-23. He ranks ninth in the NCAA for assists per game at 0.91 through 34 games.
- No. 7: Tim Lovell notched 29 assists and continues to extend his program record setting mark for most assists in a single season by a defenseman. He is tied 10th for assists per game at .91 through his 32 games played.
- No. 10: TJ Semptimphelter holds the 10th spot in the NCAA for goaltender winning percentage at .696 (14-5-4)
- No. 14: Brian Chambers won 340 faceoffs this season, ranked 14th in the NCAA.

RECORD CHASE

- Hobey Baker nominee Lukas Sillinger is one assist away from breaking the single season program record for assists owned

by alum Robert Mastrosimone from his 2022-23 season with 31.
 - Tim Lovell is four points away from breaking the individual single-season record for most points by a defenseman. Sun Devil alum Brinson Pasichnuk set the record at 37 points in the 2019-20 season.
 - Tim Lovell currently sits at the No. 2 spot for all-time career assists and assists by a defenseman with 62. He is eight points away from breaking Brinson Pasichnuk's record that is set at 68. He is three assists away from the assist record for a single season set by Mastrosimone at 31.
 - Matthew Kopperud has 19 goals so far this season and is five away from breaking Johnny Walker's record for most in a single season at 23. Kopperud is 10 goals away from breaking the all-time career goals record currently set at 70, also by Walker.

ACTION JACKSON

Senior center Ty Jackson was injured in the first game at Colorado College on Dec. 1 and subsequently missed the next 15 games. He made his return as first line center on Feb. 9-10 and tallied two goals and two assists against the Nanooks. After the off weekend break, the Sun Devils traveled to Alaska to complete the home-and-home series with the Nanooks. Jackson kept his scoring ways humming with a goal and an assist and as a +2 on the weekend. He scored the game-winning goal in overtime on Saturday night in Fairbanks - his first GWG of the season.

BETWEEN THE PIPES

Gibson Homer continued to stand out in his fourth and fifth consecutive starts in State 49 last weekend. He reached 12 games played on the year and boasts a 1.86 goals against average and .935 save percentage complete with a 7-2-2 record.

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2023-24, and his 16th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year, as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Powers led ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents in 2021-22 for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their first-ever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

#10 Tucker Ness (So., D)

- Tallied his second career assist against Augustana on Benji Eckerle's goal

BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2020, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and received its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena. Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
