

#### **Opponents Outlook**

No. 1 Oklahoma (3-0)

- For the third season in a row, ASU is facing Oklahoma while the Sooners are ranked No.
- 1. Last season, Oklahoma won the Perfect 10 Challenge while Arizona State took third.
- In the first meet of the season, the Sooners won the second session of the Collegiate Challenge with a 197.350, the best score of the season so far. Senior Maggie Nichols won the bars title with a 9.975, while junior Anastasia Webb tied for the vault title with a 9.900.

#### **Last Season**

Jay and Jessica Santos led the Gym Devils to a successful season in 2019, the first since 2014 to have a winning record (11-10) in the regular season. The team was ranked in the top-25 on Road to Nationals all year, finishing at No. 25, and earned four wins over top-25 teams throughout the season. They scored a 196.000 or better six times and had a team RQS (Regional Qualifying Score) of 196.320 at the end of the year, the second season in a row with an RQS over 196.000.

To start off the postseason, the Sun Devils took fifth at the Pac-12 Gymnastics Championships, the best team finish since 2006. At NCAA Regionals, the team finished in seventh, but Cairo Leonard-Baker won the regional bar title with a 9.925, automatically qualifying her for nationals as an individual. At the NCAA Championships, she scored a 9.900, earning Second Team All-America honors in that event.

#### Cairo: 2x All-American & History-Maker

In 2019, Cairo Leonard-Baker earned Second Team All-America honors on bars after scoring a 9.900 at the NCAA Championships. She was also named a WCGA Regular Season All-American for the second-straight season, this time on bars. She garnered regular season All-America Second Team honors in 2018 in the all-around from the National Association of College Gymnastics Coaches (NACGC). She was the first Gym Devil to earn regular season honors since they started in 2013.

She was also named to the 2019 All-Pac-12 First Team in both the all-around and on bars. She is the first Gym Devil to receive both of those awards in back-to-back seasons since Ashley Kelly from 2003-04.

#### **More Than An Athlete**

The Gym Devils continued their tradition of incredible work in and out of the classroom. Tying last year's record, nine student-athletes were placed on Pac-12 All-Academic Teams.

There were six on the first team, which is a program record. The six on the first team are

Corinne Belkoff, Jessica Ginn, Anne Kuhm, Kaitlyn Szafranski, Ashley Szafranski and Heather Udowitch. On the second team, the Gym Devils represented are Morgan Hart and Morgan Wilson. Justine Callis is the Sun Devil receiving an honorable mention.

#### In the Rankings

ASU was ranked No. 21 in the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA) preseason poll. The Sun Devils' highest ranking in 2019 was No. 13 in week two. They were in the top 20 in seven weeks of the regular season and in the top 25 all season.

#### Returners

The Sun Devils return seven gymnasts who have played key roles for ASU in past seasons. The team is led by junior Leonard-Baker, who has earned All-America honors in each of her two seasons in Tempe. She has been a staple in the all-around for Arizona State in the last two years. Other returners who have made key contributions are Morgan Wilson, Jessica Ginn Morgan Hart and Ashley Szafranski. Jasmine Gutierrez and Graycee Zaugg have also made appearances in lineups during their time here.

Three returners have earned 9.900s or better during their time at ASU. Hart scored a 9.900 on bars last year, Szafranski has earned 9.900s on bars and beam in her career and Wilson won a vault title with one of her two 9.900s in 2019. Leonard-Baker has the most 9.900s or better, earning 12 between bars and floor just last season. She also won 12 event titles last year, seven on bars and five on floor.

#### **Newcomers**

Arizona State has seven new faces on the team: six freshmen and a transfer sophomore. The Sun Devils will rely on some key underclassmen to show up big for the team in 2020. At the Maroon and Gold Scrimmage in early December, freshmen Juliette Boyer, Hannah Scharf and Gracie Reeves all competed in the all-around, with Boyer taking second behind Leonard-Baker.

#### **Home Promotions**

In 2020, the Gym Devils' home schedule is packed with promotions. For the home opener against Oklahoma, it is the Cystic Fibrosis awareness and alumni meet. On January 17, ASU will host a Beauty and the Beast meet with ASU wrestling. After the Salute to Service meet against Cal, the Sun Devils will have a Bring the Heat and camper reunion meet against UCLA. Arizona State's meet against Washington is the academic achievement meet, with a kids clinic following the competition. Finally, March. 8's meet against Pittsburgh is senior day as well as the princess-themeed meet.

Vice President for University Athletics and Athletics Director Ray Anderson named Jay Santos the head women's gymnastics coach on May 27, 2016.

Jay Santos led the Gym Devils to a another successful season in 2019, the first since 2014 to have a winning record (11-10) in the regular season. The team was ranked in the top-25 on Road to Nationals all year and earned four wins over top-25 teams throughout the season. They scored a 196.000 or better six times and had a team RQS (Regional Qualifying Score) of 196.320 at the end of the year. To start off the postseason, the Sun Devils took fifth at the Pac-12 Gymnastics Championships, the best team finish since 2006. The team qualified for their second-straight trip to NCAA Regionals. Cairo Leonard-Baker qualified for nationals as an individual on bars, earning Second Team All-America honors.

Santos has led ASU to arguably one of the most substantial turnarounds in recent collegiate gymnastics history. In his first season as head coach in 2017, Santos quickly elevated the program. The Gym Devils scored 195 in four separate meets, the first time that has happened since the 2014 season. Santos' 2018 squad improved 18 spots from their 2017 national finish of 41, capping the season ranked at No. 23 nationally (highest finish since 2007). Ranking in the top-20 of the national standings for 12 consecutive weeks, Arizona State made its first team NCAA regional appearance since 2014 while sending individual all-around qualifier and regular season All-American Cairo Leonard-Baker to nationals. Courtesy of his efforts at the helm of the program, Santos was named the 2018 Pac-12 Coach of the Year.

Santos coached Eastern Michigan to the 2016 Mid-American Conference Championship, the program's first-ever NCAA Regional appearance, and finished the season ranked 17th in the nation – the highest national ranking in the history of the program. He earned NCAA Central Regional Head Coach of the Year honors.

Prior to leading Eastern Michigan, Santos coached at the University of Illinois-Champaign where he served as assistant coach, then associate head coach in his four-year tenure. At Illinois, Santos coached the team to three NCAA Championship appearances in 2011, 2013, and 2014, finishing 11th in the nation each year. Santos also coached eight Illini gymnasts to All-American honors.

Santos was assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Iowa State from 2006-10, and also spent time as an assistant at Ohio State. Santos also spent eight years coaching at Somersault Gymnastics Center in Stoughton, Mass., serving as the women's team director and head coach for his last four years. Santos served as a nationally-rated men's gymnastics judge from 1997-2001, working numerous college dual meets as well as Junior Olympic state and regional championships.

Santos earned a bachelor's degree in Business Administration in Operations Management from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst in 1995, and was a member of the Minutemen's gymnastics team from 1990-95. At Amherst, he was a three-time co-captain and founding member of the department's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC).

Santos' wife, Jessica Santos, serves as the Sun Devil gymnastics program's associate head coach. They have two sons, Mason and Cooper.



Jessica Santos was named associate head coach for Sun Devil Gymnastics on May 27, 2016, joining her husband Jay Santos, who was named head coach of the Sun Devil Gymnastics program on the same day.

Since joining the team, Jessica Santos has helped bring Arizona State to new heights. In 2019, the team earned the first winning record (11-10) in the regular season since 2014. The team was ranked in the top-25 on Road to Nationals all year and earned four wins over top-25 teams throughout the season. In 2018, the team improved 18 spots from their 2017 national finish of 41, finishing the season at No. 23 nationally (highest finish since 2007). All-American Cairo Leonard-Baker has qualified for nationals in each of her two seasons. In 2017, they had the best season since 2014, capping it off by scoring the best Pac-12 team total since 2004.

Santos helped coach Eastern Michigan to the 2016 Mid-American Conference Championship, the program's first-ever NCAA Regional appearance, and finished the season ranked 17th in the nation – the highest national ranking in the history of the program.

Prior to her time at Eastern Michigan, Santos served as a volunteer assistant at the University of Illinois-Champaign for three seasons. There, Santos helped the Fighting Illini to their first back-to-back NCAA Championships appearances in program history. Santos was also an assistant at Iowa State from 2009-11, where the Cyclones' saw the team's highest national ranking since 2007 at No. 13. At Pittsburgh, where Santos coached as an assistant from 2006-09, she was named the 2007 NCAA Northeast Regional Co-Assistant Coach of the year. She also served as the co-recruiting coordinator for the Panthers.

Jessica earned both her bachelor's and master's degrees in Athletic Coaching Education at West Virginia University in 2005 and 2007, respectively. She competed for the Mountaineers from 2001-05 and was the last gymnast at WVU to score a perfect 10.0 in competition. Jessica then served as the Mountaineers' volunteer assistant coach during the 2006 season. A member of the National Association of Women's Gymnastics Judges, Jessica has been a Certified Level 10 judge since 2007.

After two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach, Peel made the jump to be the full-time assistant coach for the Gym Devils starting in the 2020 season.

Peel compiled a prolific career as a gymnast at the University of Utah. She competed as a member of the Red Rocks program from 2006-09, helping to pace the squad to three-consecutive second-place national finishes. She most notably won the 2006 NCAA uneven bar title as a freshman. She also received second-team All-America honors on vault at the 2006 NCAA Championships. One of the best to don the Utah red and white, Peel finished her career as a 12-time All-American and a five-time NCAA regional champion.

Following her gymnastics career, Peel worked as a stunt double in a number of renowned TV series and blockbuster movies. She recently made headlines as a stunt double on "Game of Thrones" and has made appearances in numerous episodes from 2016-19. Peel has accumulated 75 total credits in her professional acting career, according to IMDB.

In working in the industry, Peel has garnered extensive experience in coordinating and conducting choreography for prominent productions. She also has experience performing as an acrobat, having appeared in renowned shows such as Le Reve and Cirque Du Soleil's Viva Elvis in Las Vegas.

Peel is from Seattle, Washington, and she currently resides in Scottsdale with her husband John.




