SUN DEVIL LACROSSE PREVIEW

Arizona State Lacrosse (5-5, 1-1) continues Pac-12 Conference play on the road against No. 20 Stanford (6-3, 2-0) on Saturday, March 30. The game is slated for 1 p.m. MST, and can be viewed on Pac-12 Network. ASU will take on their fifth ranked opponent this season, and are in search of their first ranked win of the season.

Program History:

The two programs have met 13 times, with the Cardinal coming out on top in 12 of the 13 contests. The lone Sun Devil win came on April 8, 2022 at home when ASU took down then-No.22 Stanford 18-11. A trio of Sun Devils scored five goals in the win.

Sun Devil Outlook:

ASU continued Pac-12 play against No. 17 USC at home last weekend, and fell 7-16. Sophomore attacker Lydia Oldknow recorded her sixth hat trick of the season in the loss, and also moved into the program's top-10 career scorers with 43 goals. She joins teammate Mina Scott who sits sixth on the list with 71 goals. The Sun Devils conclude the season with four road games in the final six contests— which starts against Stanford this weekend.

ASU has not earned a win over a ranked team since its last defeat over USC on May 5 2022, when No. 23 ASU upset No. 16 USC.

Scouting the Opponent:

The Cardinal post an undefeated 4-0 record at home and are averaging 18 goals when playing on their home turf. Stanford has won six of their last seven matchups after dropping the first two games of the season to No. 16 Virginia and unranked Yale. The most recent win came last week when the Cardinal downed the Oregon Ducks 18-8 in California.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS:

- Senior attacker Mina Scott is 6th all-time in goals with 71, and 6th all-time with 87 points. No other active player is in the top-10 for all time goals or assists.
- With five wins in ten starts this season, Vahle is just one win shy of breaking the tie with Berkeley Bonneau for a program-best 21 wins.
- Zoe Mazur's 85 draw controls have her on the single-season leaderboard, sitting at second all-time behind Kaylor Buckner's 111 draw controls which came in 2023.
- Lydia Oldknow's 41 goals are 10th on the program's all-time career scoring list.

TEAM NOTABLES:

- ASU earned their first road win of the season against SDSU on March 17. The Sun Devils outscored the Aztecs 10-2 in the second half to secure the 17-9 win.
- The Sun Devils have the 18th-best clearing percentage in the NCAA at 91.6%.
- ASU has held opponents to a 83.2% clear percentage allowing 139 clears in 167 attempts.
- The Sun Devils' 3-0 start to the season was the first time in program history, but was halted after a loss to Stony Brook in the team's first road game.

PLAYER NOTABLES:

- Zoe Mazur's 8.50 draw controls per game are the seventh-best individual mark in the NCAA and second best in the Pac-12.
- Attackers Mina Scott (30) and Lydia Oldknow (31) each have 30+ points on the season.
- in the Pac-12 opener against SDSU, junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle hit the 400 career save mark and was the second active goalie in the Pac-12 with 400 career saves.
- Oldknow has six hat tricks this season, which leads the team.
- Graduate attacker Shannon Urey is two points away from 200 in her career. 178 points came during her time at Mercer University.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

- Katie Vahle earned the first weekly award for ASU this season after being named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the week on 3/19.

Sun Devil Athletics hired Taryn VanThof as the new Lacrosse Head Coach, Vice President of University Athletics Ray Anderson announced on July 5, 2022

VanThof comes to Arizona State after an extremely successful six-year stint as the Assistant Coach at national power Florida. There she served as the Offensive Coordinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator for the Gators.

“Thank you to Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson and Senior Associate AD/SWA Christina Wombacher for this opportunity to lead the Sun Devil Lacrosse program,” VanThof remarked. “I could not be more thrilled to coach at this extraordinary university.”

Under the direction of VanThof and Head Coach Amanda O’Leary, Florida has emerged as one of the nation’s premiere programs over the past six years. In 2022, the Gators made their fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament, earning a bid every year of VanThof’s tenure. She arrives in Tempe coming off two straight appearances in the NCAA Quarterfinal Round (Elite Eight) with Florida.

She capped her playing career in the ultimate fashion, captaining the 2018 team to the NCAA Championship, the first in program history. Warden was named the Most Outstanding Player of the National Championship Game after delivering a four-goal performance in the 16-15 win over Boston College.

"I am honored and humbled to be named assistant coach at Arizona State University," Haley Warden remarked. "I would like to thank Coach VanThof and Sr. Associate AD/SWA Christina Wombacher for this amazing opportunity."
