

**THE GAME -** Sun Devil Football returns home following its bye week to take on Stanford on Thursday, October 18 in ASU's annual #MaroonMonsoon game. The game, scheduled for a 6 p.m. AZT kickoff (2 p.m. Colorado time), will be broadcast live on ESPN with Dave Flemming, Brock Huard and Laura Rutledge on the call. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on ESPN 620 AM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, joined by Jeff Van Raaphorst and Jeff Munn.

**ASU VS. STANFORD -** The Sun Devils are 17-14 all-time in the series against Stanford, though Stanford enters the contest as winners of five of the last six games in the series.

**PARKING ADVISORY-** Fans attending Sun Devil Football's Thursday night primetime showdown against Stanford Oct. 18 at 6 p.m. (MST) are asked to please be aware of the following parking advisories on game-day. Many of the gameday parking lots are shared with ASU faculty and students attending class, thus Sun Devil Athletics cannot guarantee parking in your designated lot.

Sun Devil Athletics encourages fans to arrive early, stay patient, account for traffic delays, and utilize the following information as they arrive to their parking lots on game day. We also encourage fans to utilize public transportation (light rail, bus, etc.) or the official rideshare partner of Sun Devil Athletics, Lyft, and take advantage of 20% off rides to the game with code ASUGAMEDAY. New Lyft users can also use promo code SUNDEVIL for \$5 off their first 4 rides as well.

- All designated game day parking lots will open at 1 p.m. for fans with season parking passes arriving to Sun Devil Stadium. Due to the weekday game, students will be utilizing game day parking lots for classes, which may affect parking availability.
- Sun Devil fans are asked to be courteous to their neighbors in the parking lots, and to not utilize more than one parking spot per parking pass for their tailgate setup due to the limited availability.
- Parking spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. Once at capacity, fans will be directed to other passholder lots.
- Overflow parking will be directed to the roof of the Packard & Stadium parking structures, Cornerstone lot (northeast corner of Rural Rd. & University Dr.), Karsten Golf Course parking lot and the dirt lot on Rio Salado east of Lot 8 (north of Karsten Golf Course).
- Stadium & Parking Structures:
- Both parking structures will be open to passholders at 1 p.m. on gameday. Parking spaces in the structures will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis until they reach capacity. The roof of these structures will be utilized for overflow from other gameday parking lots.

### AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- » Give ASU its 6th consecutive win at home, extending a streak that is currently tied for 17th nationally.
- » Give ASU its 30th win at home since the 2013 season, making ASU one of just 16 teams to accomplish the feat in the period.
- » Be just the second victory over the Cardinal since 2009.
- » Give ASU its second consecutive victory following a bye week (defeated Washington last season) after losing three straight previously.

No ASU running back has **lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 699 consecutive carries**, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 25 consecutive games. That includes 124 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only RBs on rushing plays and does not include receptions). The fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back. If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1038 carries over 37 games (since 2015).

Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of **127 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points**. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. ASU has not allowed more than 30 points in a game this year, one of just 12 teams in the nation to do so. The last time ASU had not given up 30+ points though 6 games was 2012. In the Pac-12 era (since 1978), only the '82, '86, '91, '97, '08, '09 and '12 saw ASU not give up 30 or more points at the midway point.

Eno Benjamin has forced **48 missed tackles this season** (39 rushing, 9 receiving) - leading all FBS players in the category and 6 more than the next closest player. He has posted a for a 114.5 elusive rating from Pro Football Focus, good for 10th nationally. Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 31.8 percent of the time - good for fourth nationally. 39.1 percent of Benjamin's rushes this season have resulted in a "win" for the Sun Devil offense, the 16th-highest total among FBS running backs. 32.8 percent of his rushes have resulted in a first down or touchdown, the 12th-highest percentage in the FBS.

N'Keal Harry **has a reception in all 31 games of his career** at Arizona State, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players. N'Keal Harry is now in 4th place in program history with 174 receptions, and just 14 shy of moving into the Top 3 in program history. Harry is currently 9th in school history with 2,282 career receiving yards, 5 yards shy of 8th. Harry has a 127.2 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for 11th nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets. Harry has forced 12 missed tackles this season, which is good for 11th-most among all FBS receivers.

Kobe Williams has allowed just **29 yards after the catch this season** - the third-lowest among Pac-12 corners and good for the 21st-lowest total in the country. Williams has been targetted just 20 times this season (on 148 coverage snaps), the 21st-fewest in the nation and third fewest in the Pac-12. He has allowed just 101 yards total when targetted this season, the 17th-lowest total nationally. Terin Adams has been targetted just 13 times this season, second-fewest among Pac-12 corners that have played at least 80 pass coverage snaps this season.

ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in **8 of its last 11 games dating back to last year** (Demario Richard and Eno Benjamin each with 4). The last time that occurred was across the 1997 and 1998 campaigns, where ASU had 10 such performances over a 13-game span (last 6 of '97, 4 of 7 to open '98). Benjamin's 17 explosive runs this season (runs for over 15 yards) are second nationally. Benjamin is sixth among the nation's running backs with 23 catches this season, as are his 30 total targets. He has an offensive success score of 46.7 percent as a receiver, according to PFF (which measures plays that are considered a "win" by the offense), a total good for 10th nationally among running backs with at least 10 targets.

## #10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

1. Safety Demonte King has played every single defensive snap for the Sun Devils this season (452 total, included plays negated by penalties). That is the seventh-highest total among all defensive players in the Pac-12.
2. ASU has just two turnovers this season - good for the national lead in the category. The FBS record for fewest turnovers is 8 (accomplished several times)
3. Only 7 Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 250 defensive snaps this season. ASU has 3 of them (Merlin Robertson, Darien Butler, Aashari Crosswell). Robertson's 388 are 5th most among true freshmen in the FBS.
4. Kobe Williams has allowed just 29 yards after the catch this season - third among Pac-12 corners and good for the 17th-lowest total nationally.
5. No ASU running back has coughed up the ball on a rushing play on 699 consecutive carries (25 straight games without a fumble).
6. @eno\_benjamin5 forced or avoided 48 missed tackles on the season, easily leading the country in the category.
7. Kyle Williams is one of just 13 slot receivers nationally to not have a drop this season of players with 150+ routes and is 7th nationally with an 83.3 catch percentage among FBS slot receivers.
8. ASU has won 29 home games since 2013 (29-7), the 18th-highest total among FBS teams in that time span.
9. ASU has not allowed more than 30 points in a game this year, one of just 12 teams in the nation to do so. 8th time in Pac-12 era that has happened. Only '82, '86, '91 and '97 teams extended the streak to 7 games.
10. ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 8 of its last 11 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard/Eno Benjamin each with 4). Last time that occurred was across the '97 and '98 campaigns, where ASU had 10 such performances over a 13-game span.



## FOCUSING ON FOOTBALL

- » Among Pac-12 offensive players, regardless of position, N'Keal Harry is the 11th-highest graded player in the Pac-12 this season according to Pro Football Focus. His 79.6 score is good for 28th among all wide receivers in the country.
- » In the same token as above, Manny Wilkins is the 16th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 (77.7, fourth among quarterbacks) and the 30th-highest graded quarterback nationally.
- » Eno Benjamin remains the highest-graded running back in the league with a 75.8 overall score. His 82.8 grade as on rushing plays only is the 12th-highest grade among all FBS running backs.

## GOLD ZONE

- » ASU had its streak of 64 consecutive successful red zone scoring drives (excluding game-ending kneel-downs) come to a end during the second quarter against San Diego State - a streak that dated back to the first half of the team's contest at Washington in 2016.
- » However, ASU has still scored on 90.0 percent of its red zone trips (18-of-20) this season, good for 28th nationally.
- » ASU finished fifth nationally in converting on 96.23 percent of its red zone appearances last season (51-of-53). HOWEVER, the Devils took a knee in the red zone in the final seconds of the team's victories over fifth-ranked Washington and in the Territorial Cup contest against Arizona.
- » The Sun Devils scored on 43-of-47 trips to the red zone in 2016 (91.5 percent), a total that ranked 10th in the nation.
- » ASU is the only team in the country to be ranked in the Top 10 in red zone scoring in each of the past two seasons.

## DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU is currently 23rd nationally and first in the Pac-12 in averaging 7.7 tackles for loss per game (46 total) this season.
- » The Sun Devils are 21st in the nation and first in the Pac-12 in sacks per game, averaging 3.00 per game thus far (18 total).
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.

## DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » The Sun Devils have allowed just 21.2 points per game this season, good for 35th nationally and fourth in the Pac-12.
- » ASU has not allowed more than 30 points in a game this year, one of just 12 teams in the nation to do so in 2018.
- » The last time ASU had not given up 30 or more points at the midway point in the season was 2012. In the Pac-12 era (since 1978), only the 1982, 1986, 1991, 1997, 2008, 2009 and 2012 saw ASU not given up 30 or more points through six games. Of those seasons, ASU extended the streak to 7 games in only 1982, 1986, 1991 and 1997.
- » ASU has played 3 ranked teams in 6 games this year, making the scoring note that much more impressive. In the 7 others seasons that ASU did not allow 30 points through the midway point, only the 1986 season featured three ranked teams.
- » The Sun Devils did not allow a single point in the first quarter of games against non-conference opponents and haven't allowed one in four of six games this year. ASU has allowed just 3.5 points per first quarters this season, good for 23rd nationally. Last season, ASU allowed 6.7 first quarter points per game - the 82nd worst tally nationally.
- » ASU has given up just 10.3 points per second half this season, the 34th-best total nationally. The Devils gave up 14.9 second-half points per game in 2017 - the 92nd worst total in the FBS.

## HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 699 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 25 consecutive games. That includes 124 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions).
- » Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1038 carries over 37 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.
- » ASU has just two turnovers this season - in sole possession of the FBS lead in the category. ASU has outscored opponents 21-0 on points off turnovers on the year. The FBS single-season record for fewest turnovers in 8 (accomplished several times)
- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.

## HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins is currently seventh in program history with 7,045 career passing yards, good for fifth in Sun Devil football history. Wilkins will have a chance as moving into the Top 3 in ASU history (8,827 yards by Jake Plummer).
- » His 577 career completions are good for sixth in program history while his 43 career touchdown passes are 10th in program history.
- » Wilkins has 14 rushing touchdowns in his career, moving into a tie among all ASU quarterbacks for second in school history with Danny White (Mark Malone, 21). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins broke the school record for most consecutive pass attempts without an interception last season at 192 between the end of the 2016 season and the first half of last year, breaking Rudy Carpenter's previous school record of 149 from the end of 2005 to 2006. He has just one interception in 2018, tied for the 2nd-fewest in the country this season.
- » Wilkins has accounted for 57 career touchdowns (43 passing and 14 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 100.1 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 18th-best total among QBs with at least 200 dropbacks in the FBS.
- » The Sun Devil offense has scored a successful play (as graded by Pro Football Focus) on 39.7 percent of Wilkins' passing attempts this season - the 22nd-best total among all quarterbacks in the FBS with 350+ snaps.
- » Wilkins has a 132.4 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the second-best total in the country and nearly 40 points higher than the national average of 93.4.
- » Wilkins has just an 10.3 sack percentage that sits as the 19th-lowest total in the nation. His 66.2 NFL QB rating under pressure is 24th nationally.
- » Wilkins is 27th nationally in adjusted completion percentage (70.7 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.

## DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 31 games of his career at Arizona State, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players.
- » N'Keal Harry is now in 4th place in program history with 174 receptions, and just 14 shy of moving into the Top 3 in program history.
- » Harry is currently 9th in school history with 2,282 career receiving yards, 5 yards shy of 8th.
- » At 5.61 receptions for game in his career, Harry is second among the NCAA's active career leader in the category. His 73.6 career receiving yards per game are fourth among all active players.
- » With 18 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is tied for 9th in ASU school history in that category as well and needs just two more to move into eighth.



- » Harry has at least one touchdown reception in 8 of last 11 games. He has 10 touchdown receptions in those 11 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.
- » Harry has a 127.2 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for 11th nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.
- » Harry has forced 12 missed tackles this season, which is good for 11th-most among all FBS receivers.

### ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin has forced 48 missed tackles this season (39 rushing, 9 receiving) - leading all FBS players in the category and 6 more than the next closest player.
- » He has posted a for a 114.5 elusive rating from Pro Football Focus, good for 10th nationally.
- » Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 31.8 percent of the time - good for fourth nationally.

- » Benjamin's 17 explosive runs this season (runs for over 15 yards) are second nationally.
- » Benjamin has been equally impressive in the passing game, currently sixth among the nation's running backs with 23 catches this season, as are his 30 total targets.
- » He has an offensive success score of 46.7 percent as a receiver, according to PFF (which measures plays that are considered a "win" by the offense), a total good for 10th nationally among running backs with at least 10 targets..
- » 47.8 percent of his receptions have resulted in a first down or touchdown, good for 13th nationally among running backs with at least 10 targets.

### NEVER ENO-OUGH

- » Eno Benjamin set a single-game school rushing record with 312 yards against Oregon State, placing him eighth all-time on the Pac-12 conference single-game rushing list.
- » With his 47-yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter, Eno Benjamin set the school record for rushing yards in one half (185).
- » Benjamin's 312 yard performance was the most in the NCAA Division I FBS this season. Coming into the contest, Benjamin had only recorded 283 rushing yards this season and 425 rushing yards in his career.
- » His 339 all-purpose yards (312 RUSH, 27 REC), are the second-most in school history, falling just short of J.R. Redmond's 350 all-purpose yards in 1998 vs. USC (214 RUSH, 34 REC, 17 PR, 85, KOR).
- » Benjmain forced or avoided 20 missed tackles on carries last against Oregon State, tying the Pro Football Focus single-game record for most missed tackles forced on runs by a running back. He had 177 yards after contact in the contest, averaging 5.9 yards after contact per play.

### THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 13 solo tackles this season - tied for 10th among all FBS corners. Six of his tackles in run defense have constituted a "stop" for the defense and his 3.8 run-stop percentage is 17th nationally.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014. He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.
- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference - regardless of year.

### MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 608-328 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 67.5 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (102 of 151) while finding the end zone 78 times in that span (51.7 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 51.4 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (55 of 107) with 43 touchdowns (40.2 percent).

### A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 17 interception returns for touchdowns in the last seven seasons, good for third in the nation behind only Alabama (20) and Ohio State (17) in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 94 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 21 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (27), Alabama (26) and Boise State (25).

### NO FLY ZONE

- » Kobe Williams has allowed just 29 yards after the catch this season - the third-lowest among Pac-12 corners and good for the 21st-lowest total in the country
- » Williams has been targetted just 20 times this season (on 148 coverage snaps), the 21st-fewest in the nation and third fewest in the Pac-12. He has allowed just 101 yards total when targetted this season, the 17th-lowest total nationally.
- » Terin Adams has been targetted just 13 times this season, second-fewest among Pac-12 corners that have played at least 80 pass coverage snaps this season
- » Safety Demonte King has played every single defensive snap for the Sun Devils this season (452 total, included plays negated by penalties). That is the seventh-highest total among all defensive players in the Pac-12, though the six players ahead of him all have one extra game under their belts this season.

### KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » Jalen Bates is tied for 13th among 3-4 defensive ends with 8 QB pressures this season.
- » Renell Wren has scored a positive grade on 20.6 percent of his plays on running snaps, the seventh-highest percentage among Pac-12 interior linemen. Wren has the 11th-highest run defense score among Pac-12 interior defenders with a 77.8 grade from PFF.
- » Shannon Forman is currently 15th nationally among 3-4 defensive ends in Pro Football Focus' run-stop percentage, logging seven solo tackles in rush defense - all of which constituting as a "stop" - and a 8.2 run stop percentage.
- » Jalen Harvey has made 26 tackles within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage as a safety - the second-highest total among Pac-12 safeties.
- » ASU is tied for 5th nationally in allowing just 3 plays over 40 yards this season, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). ASU is also tied for 5th nationally in allowing just 1 play of over 50 yards on the year.
- » The Devils have given up just 9 plays over 30 yards, tied for 18th-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.

### RUIZ'S PIECES

- » Brandon Ruiz connected on all three of his field goal attempts (49, 24, 28), including the game-winning kick from 28 yards as time expired in ASU's 16-13 upset of then-No. 15 Michigan State to earn Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week Honors for the third time in his career.
- » Ruiz is 11th nationally with a 81.82 percent touchback percentage this season (27 of 33) while his 27 total touchbacks are 17th in the nation.
- » Ruiz has missed just one field goal on the season and is 6-for-7 for the campaign with the lone miss coming on a 53-yard attempt.

### DON'T SLEEP ON HIM

- » Michael Sleep-Dalton is tied for 18th in the nation this season with 13 punts downed inside



the 20 yard line.

- » He is currently 23rd nationally (fourth in Pac-12) in averaging 44.3 yards per punt, though he is 11th nationally with his 42.4 net yards per punt
- » Sleep-Dalton is 7th nationally among punters that have allowed 7 or more returns this season, allowing just 28 yards on punt returns this season on only 8 total punt returns.

## FRESHMEN SENSATIONS

---

- » Only 7 Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 250 defensive snaps this season. ASU has 3 of them (Merlin Robertson, Darien Butler, Aashari Crosswell).
- » Robertson's 388 snaps are 101 more than any other true freshman in the league and the fifth most among any Power Five true freshman in the country.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, there are just 19 3-4 outside linebackers to not miss a tackle on a running play this season that play at least 50 percent of their team's snaps - with Merlin Robertson being one of those.
- » Darien Butler leads Pac-12 inside linebackers with 9 quarterback pressures this season.

## IN THE TRENCHES

---

- » ASU went consecutive games without allowing a sack for the first time since 2005 (LSU and Northwestern).
- » The Devils now have 3 such games this year (UTSA,UW,OSU). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack.
- » Cohl Cabral is one of just 27 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year.
- » Cabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 11.2 percent of his rushing snaps this season - the 17th-best percentage among FBS centers in the country.
- » Steve Miller has allowed just 5 QB pressures this season - the 10th-lowest total among Pac-12 guards in 2018.
- » Eno Benjamin is 26th nationally in averaging 1.9 yards before contact per rushing play this season, a testament to the offensive line in front of him.

## GOLD RUSH

---

- » ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 8 of its last 11 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard and Eno Benjamin each with 4).
- » The last time that occurred was across the 1997 and 1998 campaigns, where ASU had 10 such performances over a 13-game span (last 6 of '97, 4 of 7 to open '98).
- » ASU has 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » ASU currently has the 27th-highest graded rushing attack of 2018, according to Pro Football Focus.

## KEEPING MOMENTUM

---

- » Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 127 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 71 of those games (55.9 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won as least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.
- » The Sun Devils are 29-7 at home since 2013 with the 29 wins representing the 18th most in the FBS in that time frame. ASU has won 5 straight at home, tied for the 17th-longest active home winning streak in the FBS.

#### General

The Sun Devil Athletics media relations staff understands the importance of assisting the media in providing coverage of the institution, its athletics programs, administrators, coaches and student-athletes. We pride ourselves in being able to disseminate information as widely, uniformly and fairly as possible using normally accepted media standards. To this end, the best attempt will be made to fill reasonable requests by recognized media outlets. Members of the media are encouraged to work with the Sun Devil Football media relations staff to assist in that endeavor. It is not permissible for media members to contact any athletics department administrator, associate, coach or student-athlete directly without working through the media relations department.

#### Practice Policies

Due to the nature of Arizona State game dates this season, practices schedules each week will vary dependent upon that week's game. The ASU media relations office will provide a practice schedule prior to each game week for the media.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4. At the conclusion of Period 3, a member of the media relations staff will escort the media out of practice. The typical viewing period will last approximately 35-40 minutes.

No member of the media may shoot any portion of practice that includes team activities (anything 11-on-11) or that includes any play-calling signals and/or audio. Members of the media may only photograph and shoot individual or positions groups working separate of a team setting.

Viewing periods are always subject to the discretion of the Sun Devil Football coaching staff and may change suddenly. Following that open viewing period, the members of the media will be escorted out of the facility and reconvene at the Student-Athlete Facility on the north end of Sun Devil Stadium for post-practice interviews. Under no circumstances will Periscope technology be permitted.

#### Interview Policies

All interviews will be conducted post-practice at the new Student-Athlete Facility, located at the north end of Sun Devil Stadium. Due to high demand, several players and members of the coaching staff might only be available on a limited basis each week. A full availability schedule will be provided to the media each week.

All interviews must be arranged through the Media Relations office. Under no circumstances are members of the media allowed to contact a student-athlete or member of the coaching staff without first contacting a member of the Media Relations staff. All coaches and student-athletes have been encouraged to check in with the Media Relations staff and not indulge any interview requests that have not been arranged through the proper channels. Every possible attempt will be made to accommodate all media requests.

Following home contests, Arizona State will bring several student-athletes to the media room at the new Student-Athlete Facility in the North End Zone for a post-game press conference. Head Coach Herm Edwards will follow

the student-athletes.

Please note that there is a new NCAA rule in effect that states that every NCAA athletic team must take one day off per week from all team-related activities, including practice, weight training, conditioning, meetings, interviews, etc. This means that one day per week (typically Monday for Sun Devil football), no Sun Devil student-athlete may conduct an interview. As this is an NCAA rule and will be monitored by compliance personnel, there can be no exceptions made.

#### Weekly Press Conferences

Head coach Herm Edwards will host his weekly press conferences each Monday prior to game week. The press conference is tentatively scheduled for 12 p.m. (Noon) Arizona Time each week.

#### Photography/Videography

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4 and those wishing to document practice via photograph or video will be able to do so during this time, so long as said documentation does not record play-calling signals. On-camera interviews will be conducted at the end of each practice.

For home games, a photographer work area has been established inside the Carson Student-Athlete Center (first floor). Internet access to transmit files is available in the photography workroom. Credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times.

#### Weekly Media Teleconference

The Pac-12 Football Coaches Weekly Media Teleconference Call will take place each Tuesday during the season. Coach Graham is scheduled to speak at 12:05 PT/1:05 MT each Tuesday. The teleconferences will be recorded and available at Pac-12.com that same afternoon of the call. ### ON THE AIR

Hear the hometown call with broadcaster Tim Healey and color analyst Jeff Van Raaphorst as well as sideline reporter Jordan Simone providing all the action for Sun Devil Football this season. The hometown broadcasts are boosted by Bonneville's powerful sports/talk lineup of Arizona Sports 98.7 FM, ESPN Phoenix 620 AM and 92.3 KTAR News FM. This week's game broadcast will be broadcast on ESPN 620 AM.

The Pac-12 will again provide access to Armed Forces Network for carriage of Pac-12 football games in 2017 for the benefit of the men and women in the military.

### LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION

ASU will host a primetime contest on ESPN for the third time this season, with ASU posting a 1-1 record on the national broadcast this season. Dave Flemming will be on the call, alongside analyst Brock Huard and sideline reporter Laura Rutledge.

### Saleaumua, Dixon Among Finalists for Polynesian Football Hall of Fame Class

HONOLULU – Arizona State football alums Dan Saleaumua and David Dixon were named as two of the 12 Finalists that will be on the ballot for induction into the Polynesian Football Hall of Fame Class of 2019.

An Honorable Mention All-American in 1985, Saleaumua was twice a Second-Team All-Pac-10 pick. Beyond ASU, he had a 12-year NFL career including All-Pro honors in 1990 and a Pro Bowl selection for the Kansas City Chiefs in 1995. He played in 125 games over eight seasons in Kansas City. He finished his career with 35.5 sacks and 18 fumble recoveries - 17 of which came with the Chiefs, a franchise record that still stands. He also spent time with the Detroit Lions and Seattle Seahawks.

David Dixon, a member of the Sun Devils' offensive line for the 1990 and '91 seasons, played 11 professional seasons in the National Football League, and was just the second player of Maori descent to ever play professional football.
