TEMPE, Ariz. - The Sun Devil Football program signed 17 student-athletes on National Signing Day that will continue their athletic and academic endeavors at Arizona State University, as announced by head coach Herm Edwards and Recruiting Coordinator Antonio Pierce. The signing class consists of 14 freshmen student-athletes and three transfers. The Sun Devils have inked another class loaded with players that can make an instant imapct. Learn more about the class below.

ASU's Signing Class of 2021 Highlights:

- Eight members of Wednesday's announced Class of 2021 were recognized as four-star prospects by at least one major recruiting service, highlighted by consensus four-star prospects Isaiah Johnson, Jalin Conyers Ezra Oyetade, Lonyatta Alexander, and Travez Moore (Isaiah Johnson Consensus; Jalin Conyers Consense in 2020 class; Ezra Oyetade Consensus; Lonyotta Alexander Consensus; Travez Moore; Class of 2018 JUCO Consensus; Triston Miller 247 Sports; Jaydon Williams 247 Sports, Tommi Hill ESPN, 247 Sports)
- 12 of the prospects in the class rank within the Top-50 nationally at their position according to at least one major pubnlication:
- Seven recruits in the Sun Devils' class are ranked by at least one publication as a Top-500 overall prospect in the country
- Arizona State landed four of the Top-70 overall prospects from the state of California according to 24/7 Sports Composite rankings.
- The Sun Devils 2021 Class features players from 11 different states (New York, North Carolina, West Virginia, Louisiana, Washington, California, Florida, Texas, Pennsylvania, Arizona, Hawaii).
- The program signed the first prospects from West Virginia and New York in the internet-recruiting services era.
- 13 different Class of 2021 signees were ranked among the Top-50 overall prospects in their state.
- The average grade of the 13 freshman signees from this class is 87.32 according to 247 Sports, currently the sixth-highest mark in the Pac-12.
- Nine of the 17 signees will enroll early and arrive on campus in the Spring of 2021.
- Height and length are two charateristics the coaches have emphasized in the past few class, with nine of the signees listed at 6'4" or taller.

Lonyatta Alexander Freshman – Wide Receiver 6-2 | 185 | Pacifica, CA (Kennedy Catholic - WA)

Highly-productive wide receiver prospect who has a knack for getting open...Able to create separation from defenders with precise breaks and a quick change of direction...Reliable pass catcher with soft hands and the ability to make contested catches...Dangerous after the catch, becoming a dynamic playmaker with the ball in his hands...Prolific red zone threat that put up terrific numbers at Kennedy Catholic High School...Consensus four-star prospect according to all three major recruiting services...Rated by 247 Sports as the No. 240 overall prospect and the No. 33 wide receiver prospect in the country...247 Sports also listed him as the No. 7 overall prospect in the state of Washington... Ranked as the No. 59 wide receiver prospect nationally and the No. 9 player in Washington by Rivals...A member of the ESPN 300, who lists him as the No. 53 receiver prospect in the nation...Also tabbed by ESPN as the No. 8 overall prospect in the state...Three-year varsity standout who plans to play his senior season in the Spring...Finished his junior season with 67 catches for 1,328 yards and a mind-boggling 24 touchdowns in only 12 games...Helped lead Kennedy Catholic to a 9-0 regular season and a run to the Quarterfinals of the Washington 4A High School Football Playoffs...Averaged over 110 yards per game and nearly 20 yards per catch for an offense that posted over 48 points per game...Recorded an incredible 71 catches for 1,197 yards and 10 touchdowns in nine games during a brilliant sophomore season...Averaged 133 receiving yards and nearly eight catches per game...Became a household name after a breakout freshman season, hauling in 60 catches for 859 yards and 10 touchdowns in 10 games...Emerged as one of the top freshman in the entire state and continued to improve throughout his prep career.

Austin Barry Freshman – Offensive Line 6-5 | 270 | Riverside, CA (John W. North)

Physically-imposing offensive lineman who has been dominant at the line of scrimmage at the high school level...

Versatile prospect with the ability to play tackle or guard...A valuable weapon in the run game, relying on his strength and power to pave the way for the ball carrier...Continues to progress drastically as a pass blocker, showing improved quickness and agility allowing him to better handle speed rushers...Rarely gets knocked off from his base, using his long reach to his advantage, delivering the first punch at the point of attack...Possesses the athleticism to be utilized as a pulling blocker out in space...Multi-sport athlete, competing as a member of the John W. North High School Track & Field team...Owns 51-7.5 shot put PR and 137-4 discus PR... Consensus three-star prospect according to all three major recruiting services...Listed as the No. 72 offensive tackle prospect nationally and the No. 67 overall prospect in California in the 247 Sports compositing rankings... Tabbed by Rivals as the No. 72 offensive tackle prospect in the country and the No. 54 overall prospect in the state...ESPN rated him as the No. 64 offensive tackle prospect in the nation and the No. 60 overall prospect in California...Helped lead John W. North to a 10-2 record and a CIF Southern Section Division 10 quarterfinal appearance as a junior...Starting tackle for the Huskies the past two seasons, providing a steady force up front...A key reason why his team has averaged over 175 yards rushing per game over the past two seasons, including over 183 yards in 2019.

Armon Bethea Freshman – Offensive Line 6-5 | 309 | Brooklyn, NY (Erasmus Hall)

Giant offensive line prospect with massive potential...Plays with an edge and mentality necessary for the role...Versatile athlete with the ability to play guard or tackle...Dominant force at the line of scrimmage, imposing his will on opponents...Finishes his blocks to ensure extra yardage and wearing down the defense...Transformed his body over the past year, making him one of the fastest-rising recruits of the class...Has shown improved mobility and footwork thanks to the changes...Invited to the All-American Bowl as one of the top players in the class, where he committed to Arizona State on a national broadcast...Consensus Top-5 overall prospect in the state of New York according to all major recruiting services...Ranked as the No. 60 offensive guard prospect and the No. 5 overall prospect in New York in 247 Sports composite rankings...Tabbed as a three-star prospect by Rivals, who ranks him as the No. 4 prospect in New York...ESPN lists him as a three-star and the No. 3 overall prospect in the state...Was primarily used at left guard as a junior...Led Erasmus Hall High School to the New York Public Schools Athletic League City Conference

Championship...First prospect that has signed with Arizona State out of New York since at least 2000.

Finn Collins Freshman – Quarterback 6-3 | 185 | Tarzana, CA (Bishop Alemany)

Prolific quarterback prospect who enjoyed a terrific junior season operating one of the top offenses in California High School football...Accurate passer with excellent anticipation and timing on his throws...Ability to place the ball in a spot that allows the receiver to make a play after the catch...Tall frame and high football I.Q. allow him to quickly and clearly read defenses and make good decisions...Consensus three-star prospect according to all three major recruiting services...Rated as the No. 18 pro-style quarterback nationally according to Rivals and the No. 35 overall prospect in the competitive state of California...Currently the No. 29 pro-style quarterback prospect in the country and the No. 62 overall prospect in the state according to 247 Sports composite rankings...ESPN tabbed him as the No. 31 pocket passer in the nation and the No. 48 prospect in the state...becomes the third highly-rated quarterback prospect from California to commit to the Sun Devils under Herm Edwards, a group highlighted by current starting quarterback Jayden Daniels...put up terrific numbers at San Joaquin Memorial, leading the Panthers to a 12-2 record and a run to the Division I-A CIF State Football semifinals...completed 198 of 318 passes (62%) for 3,576 yards and 39 touchdowns compared to only six interceptions in a brilliant junior season...threw at least one touchdown in all 14 games, connecting on multiple scores in 12 games...the Panthers averaged 39.1 points per game and 458 yards per game with Collins as the signal caller...comes from the same high school that produced two-year starting sophomore left guard and Freshman All-American Dohonvan West.

Jalin Conyers Redshirt Freshman – Tight End 6-4 | 220 | Gruver, TX (Gruver/Oklahoma)

Coveted tight-end transfer prospect joining the Sun Devils with four seasons to play after redshirting one season at Oklahoma...Listed as a tight end, but has the athleticism and ball skills of a wide receiver, making him a matchup nightmare... An excellent fit in Offensive Coordinator Zak Hill's scheme, which features the tight end as a receiving threat...Continues to add weight and strength to his frame, improving his effectiveness as a blocker...Consensus four-star prospect and Top-10 tight end recruit nationally coming out of High School...Invited to the All-American Bowl along with his fellow top prospects from the 2020 class...247 Sports ranked him as the No. 72 overall prospect and No. 4 tight end prospect in the country...Also tabbed him as the No. 12 overall prospect in the loaded state of Texas...A member of the Rivals 250 as the No 250 overall prospect and No. 8 tight end according to the publication...Slotted as the No. 2 tight end in the nation by ESPN...2019 Best of the Panhandle Male Athlete of the Year... Was one of the state's best two-sport athletes, leading Gruver High School to the State Championship in football and basketball.

Eddie Czaplicki Freshman – Kicker/Punter 6-1 | 185 | Charlotte, NC (Providence)

Premiere kicking and punting prospect featuring a big-time leg...Possesses tremendous range and is extremely accurate with his kicks...Known for flipping the field with his punts and is a special team's weapon with his ability to pin opponents deep...Versatile prospect who can fill many roles for the Sun Devils...Five-star kicker and punter prospect according to Prokicker.com...Kohl's Football ranked him as the No. 3 kicker and No. 9 punter prospect nationally, one of only three in the 2021 class to be in the Top-10 of both categories... Kohl's evaluated his legs as one of the quickest in the class... Gets the ball out quickly and smoothly when he punts...Excellent coordination which makes him a candidate to be a hold-er...Tabbed as a three-star prospect and the No. 11 kicker in the class by 247 Sports...Made 8-of-9 field goals as a sophomore and nailed all 25 of his extra points...Made four kicks of 40 or more yards, including two from 47 yards...Averaged over 40 net yards per punt, pinning the opponent inside the 20 five times...Launched a season-best punt of 68 yards, one of three 50+-yards punts on the year.

Eric Gentry Freshman – Linebacker 6-6 | 220 | Philadelphia, PA (Saint John Neumann Goretti)

Long and athletic linebacker prospect who has earned the nickname "The Freak" on the Philadelphia prep football scene... Possess the versatility to impact the game in many ways with his unique height and the continued development of his strength...Difficult matchup as a pass rusher on the edge with his reach and quickness...Playing at tight end allowed him to improve in coverage and work on his hands...Consensus three-star prospect according to all three major recruiting services...Tabbed as the No. 24 wide defensive end prospect in the country and the No. 15 overall prospect in the state of Pennsylvania by 247 Sports...Rated as an athlete by Rivals and slotted as the No. 26 overall prospect in Pennsylvania... ESPN ranked him as the No 24 overall prospect in the state and the No. 106 defensive end prospect in the nation...occupies the No. 27 spot on Penn Live's Top-50 High School football prospects list...key part of a Neumann-Goretti defense that allowed only 9.3 points per game and shut out four opponents...the Saints finished the regular season undefeated (11-0) before losing to Pope John Paul II in the PA Class AAA State Playoffs.

Isaia Glass Freshman - Offensive Line 6-5 | 250 | San Tan Valley, AZ (Queen Creek)

Intriguing offensive line prospect who is just scratching the surface of his potential...Has worked extremely hard in the weight room to add weight to his frame, developing into one of the strongest lineman in the state...Unique athleticism and mobility for the position, making him aprime candidate for a lead blocker on screens and pulling in the run game...Takes pride in doing the dirty work, playing with an edge and demeanor that makes him a nightmare for opposing defensive lineman...Utilizes a long reach and proper hand placement to control the defensive lineman without holding...Made a transition from tight end to tackle, solidifying the starting left tackle spot for Queen Creek...Multi-sport athlete, competing for the Queen Creek basketball and track & field team...Consensus three-star prospect according to all three major recruiting services...Soared in the recruiting rankings after a dominant senior season...Named to the Max Preps Arizona High School Football All-State First Team...Tabbed by 247 Sports as the No. 60 offensive tackle prospect nationally and the No. 13 overall prospect in Arizona...ESPN ranked him as the No. 98 offensive tackle prospect in the country and the No. 13 overall prospect in the state...Three-star prospect according to Rivals...Played defensive line for the Bulldogs during his first two varsity seasons, compiling 85 tackles in his career...Son of Paul Glass, who played defensive line at Arizona State from 2000-01.

Tommi Hill Freshman – Defensive Back 6-0 | 190 | Orlando, FL (Edgewater)

Elite athlete that turned down several prominent programs to come to Arizona State...Excels in many facets of the game for Edgewater High School in Florida...Shutdown cornerback with a unique combination of size and athleticism that allow him to matchup with any type of receiver...Sticks to fast receivers and can make up ground while the ball is in the air thanks to his track speed...Competed in the 100 and 200 meter in high school...Physical at the line of scrimmage and terrific ball skills thanks to his work at wide receiver...A member of the ESPN 300, coming in as the No. 196 overall prospect in the nation and a four-star...Tabbed as the No. 12 cornerback prospect in the country and the No. 30 player in Florida by ESPN...Four-star prospect according to 247 Sports, who ranks him as the No. 235 overall prospect nationally, the No. 12 athlete, and the No. 31 overall prospect in the state of Florida...Rivals rated him as the No. 14 athlete in the country and the No. 60 overall prospect in the state...Three-year member of the varsity team, combining to go 33-6 during his time at Edgewater...A key part of the Eagles run to the Class 7A 2020 FHSAA Football State Championship game, facing off against St. Thomas Aquinas on 12/19...Opposing quarterbacks rarely threw to his side of the field during his high school career...Still managed to make a positive impact on the game, thriving on offense and special teams...Compiled 85 catches for 1,586 yards and 14 touchdowns in 24 games over the past two seasons...Credited with 22 tackles, four interceptions, eight pass breakups, and two tackles for loss on defense from 2019-20.

Isaiah Johnson Freshman – Defensive Back 6-1 | 180 | Blue Springs, WV (St. Bernard)

Elite defensive back prospect with a unique combination of size and speed that made him one of the most widely-pursued athletes in the class...Capable of matching up with any type of receiver thanks to a long frame and excellent quickness...Ball-hawking defender who relentlessly pursues the ball when it is in the air...Physical player in run support and at the line of scrimmage, allowing him to re-route receivers...One of three members of the class to be invited to the 2021 All-American Bowl, joined by Ezra Oyetade and Armon Bethea...Consensus four-star prospect and Top-20 overall prospect in California according to all three major recruiting services...Arizona State has now landed a Top-20 prospect from California in each of his first four recruiting classes...Listed as the No. 139 overall prospect and the No. 9 cornerback prospect nationally in 247 Sports Composite Rankings...Tabbed by Rivals as the No. 157 overall prospect and the No. 14 cornerback prospect in the country...One of three members of the class in the ESPN 300, coming in at No. 182 overall...ESPN also rated him as the No. 11 cornerback prospect in the country...The 19th-highest rated recruit for the program since 2000 according to 247 Sports...Played both sides of the ball for three seasons at Bluefield High School, with the Beavers making the State Championship game each season...2019 Max Preps West Virginia All-State First Team Selection as a defensive back...The first Arizona State signee from West Virginia since at least 2000.

Triston Miller Redshirt Sophomore - Offensive Line 6-5 | 290 | Charlotte, NC (Charlotte Country Day/North Carolina)

Key transfer offensive lineman from North Carolina who is eligible immediately with three years left to play...Versatile athlete that can play anywhere along the offensive line and fit into any blocking scheme...Tremendous size and strength make him a force in the run game...Possesses excellent quickness for someone with him frame, making him an excellent candidate to pull as a lead blocker...Improved his footwork and technique tremendously during his time in Chapel Hill, making him a contender for immediately playing time in Tempe...Long arms and reach allow him to register the first punch at the point of attack and utilizes his power...Redshirted during his first season at North Carolina and was a valuable member of the scout team...Highly-touted recruit coming out of High School...Ranked by 247 Sports as the No. 181 overall prospect and the No. 17 offensive tackle prospect in the entire 2019 class...Also tabbed as the No. 7 overall prospect in North Carolina...First Team All-State selection by the Associated Press and received Third Team All-State honors from the Charlotte Observer following his senior year in 2019... Earned Charlotte Independent School Athletic Association Second Team All-Conference honors as well...Led Charlotte Country Day High School to the 2019 NCISAA Division II state title....Blocked for an offense that averaged 187.2 yards per game on the ground...Claimed Second Team All-State honors as a junior...Named to the First Team CISAA All-Conference in 2018.

Travez Moore Graduate Transfer - Defensive Lineman 6-4 | 250 | Bastrop, LA (Bastrop/Copiah Lincoln CC/LSU)

Graduate transfer from LSU who will be immediately eligible at Arizona State...Brings experience to the defensive line group with a chance to make a quick impact...Pass rush specialist with an extremely quick first step...Difficult for tackles to handle because of his quickness and explosive burst off the ball ...Added muscle and strength to allow him to hold up in the run game...Transferred to LSU from Copiah Lincoln Community College...Appeared in eight games in three seasons with the Tigers, collecting seven tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks... Considered one of the top overall JUCO recruits in his class, rated as the top weakside defensive end prospect in all of junior college in 2017...Consensus four-star prospect by all JUCO recruiting sites ... Ranked No. 1 weakside defensive end by 247 Sports ... Tabbed as the No. 1 junior college weakside defensive end and the No. 6 overall prospect on ESPN's JC 50...Played at Bastrop High School, where he was a consensus three star prospect...247 Sports rated him as the

No. 34 weakside defensive end prospect in the country and the No. 29 overall prospect in Louisiana...Slotted as the No. 42 outside linebacker prospect nationally and the No. 28 overall prospect in the state by Rivals...Considered the No. 48 outside linebacker prospect by ESPN.

Ezra Oyetade Freshman – Offensive Line 6-3 | 285 | Garland, TX (Lakeview Centennial)

Considered one of the top center prospects in the class and one of the best center prospects to ever sign with the program...Extremely athletic and mobile with the versatility to play in many schemes...Delivers accurate and consistent snaps while still getting blocking his assignment...High I.Q. player with the ability to call protections and lead the offensive line...A strong presences in the run game, finishing blocks and getting to the second level...Utilizes his leverage and lower body to drive back larger defenders...One of three members of the class to be invited to the 2021 All-American Bowl, joined by Isaiah Johnson and Armon Bethea... Selected to the Polynesian Bowl, an All-Star game featuring the best high school players of Polynesian heritage and other ancestries...Consensus four-star prospect and Top-7 center prospect according to all major recruiting services...A member of the Rivals 250 as the No. 178 overall prospect and the No. 3 center prospect nationally...Tabbed as the No. 2 center in the nation and the No. 271 overall prospect by 247 Sports... Ranked as the No. 88 player in Sports Illustrated's Postseason SI99 Football Prospect Rankings...Highest-rated center prospect to sign with the Sun Devils out of high school in the internet-recruiting services era.

RJ Regan Freshman – Defensive Back 6-0 | 170 | Orange, CA (Orange Lutheran)

Lockdown defensive back prospect who can eliminate the opponent's top playmaker...Wrecks an offensive game plan with his ability to shut down half of the field...Thrives in both man-to-man and zone coverage thanks to his instincts and diverse skill set...Tracks the ball in the air extremely well and has the hands to come down with interceptions in traffic...Utilizes his hands and footwork at the line of scrimmage to gain a positioning advantage and prevent the receiver from running the route...Went head-to-head with some of the top receivers in the country on the California High School footballs scene...Consensus three-star prospect according to all three major recruiting services... Ranked the No. 45 cornerback prospect in the country and No. 36 overall prospect in California by Rivals...Tabbed by ESPN as the No. 45 cornerback prospect and the No. 51 overall prospect in California...Listed as the No. 47 cornerback prospect nationally and the No. 46 overall prospect in the state in the 247 Sports composite rankings... Early enrollee who will miss his senior season of high school football...Left his mark at Orange Lutheran thanks to a standout junior season, finishing with 43 tackles, 20 pass deflections, and three interceptions in 11 games...Added a tackle for loss and fumble recovery as an All-Trinity Football League performer...Gained the attention of schools after a breakout sophomore campaign in which he made 42 tackles, broke up nine passes, and made an interception in his first varsity season.

Gharin Stansbury Freshman – Defensive Line 6-5 | 230 | Centerville, LA (Franklin Senior)

Extremely talented defensive lineman prospect who was widely-pursued by several prominent programs...Continues to put on weight and strength as he transitions to the defensive end position from linebacker...Has not lost a step despite a bulkier frame, maintaining his quickness and burst off the edge...Possesses a nose for the football and great instincts thanks to a high football I.Q...Can beat with speed or power, featuring a wide variety of pass rushing moves...Played on the offensive line, giving him an understanding of how to beat certain techniques and protections...Consensus three-star prospect according to all three major recruiting services...Considered the No. 40 weakside defensive end prospect nationally and the No. 20 overall prospect in Louisiana by 247 Sports... Rivals rated him as the No. 23 overall prospect in the state...Ranked by ESPN as the No. 88 defensive end prospect in the nation and the No. 27 overall prospect in Louisiana...No. 75 in the Sporting News' Preseason Top-100 football

prospects in Louisiana...Put up insanely productive numbers during a breakout senior season in which he helped Franklin Senior pitch two shutouts...Recruitment took off thanks to a brilliant final prep campaign...Proved to be one of the best linebackers in the state as a junior, finishing with 89 tackles, 12 tackles for loss, and ten sacks...Impacted the game in many facets in 2019, forcing four fumbles and knocking down four passes...Played in four games as a sophomore on Varsity, collecting 22 tackles, four tackles for loss, and one sack which forced a fumble.

Sione Veikoso Freshman – Offensive Line 6-7 | 290 | Kailua, HI (Kailua)

Physically-mature offensive lineman who recently went on a mission in Brazil for over a year...Grew several inches while abroad, making him more versatile and increasing his potential...Uses a large frame to impose his will on defenders, creating running lanes and protecting the quarterback...Very agile for his height, with the ability to move around and block in space...Originally part of the 2018 class out of High School before going on his mission... Three-star prospect according to 247 Sports, who rated him as the No. 60 offensive tackle prospect in the country and the No. 10 prospect in Hawaii for the 2018 class...Looks to continue the recent success of Sun Devil offensive lineman from Hawaii, with redshirt freshman Ben Scott starting at right tackle this season.

Jaydon Williams Freshman - Linebacker 6-1 | 200 | Dallas, TX (South Oak Cliff)

Special athlete at the linebacker position with excellent closing speed and terrific pursuit in the open field...
