#### **UP NEXT**

The Sun Devil women's basketball team (11-16, 3-12 Pac-12) concludes its final Pac-12 road trip on Sunday (1 p.m. MST) when it plays at No. 3 Stanford (23-4, 12-3).

After Sunday's game, ASU will return home to host its final two regular season games vs. No. 12 UCLA (Feb. 29) and No. 7 USC (Mar. 2). The following week, the Sun Devils will begin postseason play at the Pac-12 Tournament which gets underway Wed., Mar. 6 at the MGM Grand Arena in Las Vegas.

#### **SETTING THE SCENE**

ASU had a brief respite from life on the road as it came into last weekend's home contests against the Washington schools having played seven of nine games away from home. After Sunday's game, ASU will have played nine of 13 games on the road. The sequence originally started the second weekend of January with the first of consecutive road trips to the Pacific Northwest for games first at the Oregon schools and the following weekend at the Washington schools.

All three of ASU's remaining games are rematches. In its first meeting vs. Stanford (Jan. 26), ASU had early success but ultimately was not able to sustain it in an 80-50 loss. Jalyn Brown (17 points) and Trayanna Crisp (16 points, game-high four steals) were ASU's main sources of offense as the duo combined for 33 points. Journey Thompson pulled down a career-high 13 rebounds, coming one board short of the single-game high by a Sun Devil this season (Kadidia Toure 14 vs. San Francisco on Nov. 13). Stanford shot 48 pct and was led by Kiki Iriafen (27 points, 14 rebounds) and Cameron Brink (20 points, 16 rebounds). ASU had only 10 turnovers, at the time, the 8th time 12 games it has had 11 or fewer turnovers.

ASU started its final regular season road trip with a 67-55 loss at Cal on Friday. For ASU, the game played out much like its loss at Washington State (Jan. 19) in which it outscored WSU 58-57 over the final 30 minutes after the Cougars jumped out to a 22-6 lead. In Friday's loss, the Sun Devils had a slow start getting outscored 26-13 in the first quarter only to edge the Bears 42-41 over the final 30 minutes. Brown (18 points) led ASU with her 22nd double-digit outing of the season, while Mallory Miller (11 points) and Toure (10 points, team-high eight rebounds) came off the bench to combine for 21 points. After Cal increased its lead to 30-16, the Sun Devils ripped off a 14-3 run to make it a one-possession game after Brown's layup with 3:55 remaining in the first half. Brown (seven points), Toure (five points) and Miller (four points) combined for 16 points for the Sun Devils, who shot 50 percent in the second quarter.

Cal was able to maintain a double-digit lead for most of the third quarter, until Thompson (jumper), Toure (two free throws) and Brown (jumper) scored six straight points to get ASU within eight late in the quarter. The Bears would douse any comeback fire the Sun Devils were looking to ignite by responding with an 11-2 run to take their largest lead, 65-48, midway through the fourth quarter.

#### **JALYN BROWN ASCENDING TO SUPERSTAR STATUS**

- As the season has progressed, Jalyn Brown has evolved into one of the top performers in the Pac-12. In league games, Brown is currently 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (20.3 ppg) & 6th in scoring in all games (17.5 ppg).
- Brown has scored in double figures 22x, including 20x in the last 21 games and the last 14 games in succession. During that 14-game stretch, she is leading the team in scoring (20.4 ppg), 3FGs per game (1.6) and free throws made (65), attempted (81) and FT percentage (80.2) and is 2nd in 3FG pct. (34.9), minutes (37.9 mpg) and assists (2.0 apg).
- In contest vs. No. 5 Colorado on Jan. 7, Brown scored 35 points, the most points by a Sun Devil in the 21st century.
- Added a second 30-point game, scoring 34 points (11-20 FGs, 4-5 3FGs, 8-8 FTs) in ASU's first Pac-12 win at Washington (Jan. 21).

#### **SERIES NOTES VS. STANFORD**

- Stanford has won the last 11 meetings including a pair of victories last season and last month's win in Tempe.
- ASU's last win over Stanford came on Jan. 7, 2018, a 73-66 triumph in Tempe.
- In the Pac-12 era, ASU's most successful stretch vs. the Cardinal came when it won four of five games in the 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons. Its 60-57 win at Stanford in Jan 2015 was its first over the Cardinal since 2006 and the first at Stanford since 1984. On Feb. 6, 2015, ASU became the first league school to sweep Stanford in the regular season since 1988 after defeating the Cardinal 53-52 in Tempe. ASU's 63-61 OT win at Stanford in February 2016 made it back-to-back wins at Maples Pavilion.

#### WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- As of Feb. 24, 2024, ASU is ranked in the top half of the Pac-12 in FT attempts per game (2nd/17.74), is 4th in offensive rebounds per game (11.7), fewest turnovers per game (13.1/28th in the nation) and turnover margin (+2.11), 5th in FTs made per game (12.1) and and 6th in turnovers forced per game (15.2) and steals per game (7.3).
- In terms of individual national rankings, Jaddan Simmons is ranked 10th in the nation in minutes per game (37.07), 57th in FTs made (102) and 71st in FT attempts (130). Jalyn Brown is 46th in the nation in minutes per game (35.24) and 68th in scoring (17.5 ppg).
- ASU has had 6 players lead/tie for team lead in scoring: Brown (13x),
   Crisp (6x), Simmons (5x), Kadidia Toure (4x), Treasure Hunt (1x) and



Journey Thompson (1). Brown's career-high 35 points vs. No. 5 Colorado (Jan. 7), is the highest single-game total by a Sun Devil this season.

- In the rebounding department, 9 players have led/tied for the team lead: Thompson (10x), Simmons (5x), Toure (4x), Maggie Besselink (4x), Brown (3x), Mallory Miller (3x), Sandra Magolico (2x), Isadora Souza (2x) and Hunt (1x). Toure's 14-rebound game vs. San Francisco (Nov. 13) represents the most rebounds by a Sun Devil this season.
- ASU has averaged only 12.0 turnovers (+2.5 turnover margin) in its last 21 games. It has had 11 or fewer turnovers 8x during that stretch
- In ASU's last 9 games, Trayanna Crisp has played 366:39 of a possible 370 minutes, including a career-high 50 mins in 2OT win over Washington (Feb. 16). Last weekend, Crisp led the team in scoring (18.5 ppg) and steals (2.0 spg) and played all 90 mins (includes double-OT game), in ASU's contests vs. UW (Feb. 16) and vs. WSU (Feb. 18).
- In ASU's last 4 games, Mallory Miller has averaged 7.8 ppg (3rd on the team), 6.0 rpg (leads team) and 1.5 bpg (leads team). She scored 7 points and grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds in 2OT win over UW (Feb. 16). She played a big role in getting the game to OT as she hit a jumper to get ASU within two and them stepped up again by hitting a pair of free throws with 15 seconds remaining to send the game to overtime. She notched her second double-figure scoring game at Cal (11 points). She scored a career-high 15 points at WSU (Jan. 19).
- Jaddan Simmons has 20 assists and 8 TOs in ASU's last 8 games.

#### **SEASON SUMMARY**

- ASU has had a pair of season-best three-game winning streaks in 2023-24. It started 3-0 after home wins over UTSA (70-55/Nov. 6), Montana State (75-62/Nov. 10) & San Francisco (77-69/Nov. 13). In the first half of its first three wins, ASU averaged 45.3 points & hit 49.5 pct of its shots. In the win vs. UTSA, ASU tied last season's highest point total in a half on its way to a 49-23 halftime lead. Against Montana State (Nov. 30), ASU scored 30 points in the first quarter, representing the third time it has scored 30 or more points in a quarter under head coach Natasha Adair.
- In its first loss at Grambling State (Nov. 16), ASU scored 32 points and shot 38 pct. in the first half while allowing the Tigers to score 45 points. Down by as many as 17, ASU tied the game at 67-67 before the Tigers hit game-winning 3-pointer in final seconds.
- ASU responded with a 72-40 win over Idaho State. The Bengals' final point total represented the fewest given up by ASU since a 49-40 win over VCU on November 27, 2020.
- After dropping an 84-42 decision to Texas in its first game at the Virgin Islands Paradise Jam (Nov. 23), ASU once again rebounded with a 3-game winning streak. Less than 24 hours after the setback to Texas, ASU had to face a South Florida squad (Nov. 24) that entered the game among the Top 50 teams in the nation in rebounding margin (+10.8). ASU rose to the challenge and outrebounded the Bulls 38-32 in its 66-49 win. In its 77-69 win over High Point (Nov. 25), ASU shot 50 percent for the game, the first time it shot 50 percent or higher since a win at San Diego on Dec. 18, 2021. Brown had her first 20-point game, while Hunt just missed a double-double with season highs in points (19) and rebounds (game-high 8 boards).
   ASU made it three straight wins after a 76-66 triumph over Pacific (Dec. 1). Simmons scored 17 of her career-high 26 points in the 2nd half, including 8 points in the final 94 seconds while Brown contrib-

uted 20 points for the second straight game.

- The Sun Devils nearly came back from 14 down in the 4th quarter (got within 4 points 2x) before falling to Grand Canyon, 66-59 on Dec. 8. Simmons (20 points), Crisp (18 points) and Brown (16 points) scored all but 5 of ASU's points.
- ASU dropped consecutive games for the first time this season after falling to Arizona 91-52 in the Pac-12 opener for both teams.
- ASU got back on the winning track scoring a season high in an 80-76 win over Fresno State as part of the Jerry Colangelo Hall of Fame Series played at Footprint Series in Phoenix. Toure scored 12 of her career high-tying 22 points in the second half while Brown continued her streak of scoring in double figures in games she has started (eight) with 20 points. Crisp scored 12 points while Simmons and Thompson (career-high four steals) scored 10 points each. ASU shot 49 percent for the game, its second-highest mark of the season. Simmons, who went over 1,000 career points in the fourth quarter of the win, set a career high with eight assists and hit a pair of free throws with six seconds remaining to help clinch the win.
- The short-handed Sun Devils nearly came back from a double-digit deficit but in the end did not have enough to get over the hump in 65-55 loss to Santa Clara (Dec. 30). Crisp and (12 points), Simmons (11 points) and Toure (10 points) led the way for the Sun Devils (8-5), who were without key contributors Maggie Besselink and Treasure Hunt. The Sun Devils trailed by as many as 12 in the first half before transforming their defense into a riddle Santa Clara had no answers for during the latter stages of the first half and for the entire third quarter. The net result was a game tied at 44-44 entering the fourth quarter. Santa Clara outscored ASU 21-11 in the 4th Q.
- ASU came through with one of its best defensive efforts of the

season in holding Utah, one of the most prolific offenses in the country, more than 30 points below its scoring average. ASU was not able to do enough on the offensive end in 58-41 loss.

- Brown scored 35 points, the most by a Sun Devil in the 21st century in ASU's 81-68 loss to No. 5 Colorado on Jan. 7.
- The Sun Devils dropped both of their contests at the Oregon schools: 65-53 at Oregon and 92-55 at Oregon State. Brown led the team in scoring, averaging 15.5 ppg and knocking down 83 percent of her free throws (10-12) in the two games. Also providing major contributions was Thompson, who averaged 14.0 points and 4.5 rebounds, the second time this season Thompson scored in double figures in consecutive games.
- After falling at WSU 79-64 (Jan. 19), ASU captured its first Pac-12 win at UW, 73-65 on Jan. 21. Brown (34 points) posted her second 30-point game of the season.
- ASU came through with its best offensive performance in recent memory in a 76-71 win over Cal on Jan. Five players scored in double figures led by Jalyn Brown, who had a game-high 21 points to help ASU accumulate its season-high point total in conference play. ASU was remarkable throughout the game on the offensive end as it shot 54.8 pct, its highest FG pct. since shooting 56 pct vs. SIU on Nov. 24, 2018. It was its highest percentage in a Pac-12 game since

- a 55.6-percent effort vs. Arizona on February 16, 2018. On top of those feats, ASU set a school record for 3-point FG pct (minimum of 10 attempts) as it hit 80 pct (8-10) of its attempts.
- In a game in which the final score belied the closeness of the game, ASU came up short at Arizona, 63-52 on Feb. 4. Crisp (15 points, five rebounds) led the Sun Devils, who were looking to win back-to-back road games in league play for the first time since January of 2020. Any hope the Sun Devils had of squaring this year's edition of the Territorial Cup Series was extinguished less than four minutes into the final period as the Wildcats added on to the fourpoint spurt at the end of the third quarter by scoring the first nine points of the final one to extend out to a 54-41 lead. The Wildcats were never threatened after what ended up being an 18-2 run that put ASU into a 59-43 hole with under four minutes remaining. • ASU ended its run of nine games on the road with contests at No. 9 USC and No. 10 UCLA. At USC, after trailing by as many as 19 points, ASU whittled USC's lead down to 10 after Toure's jumper with 17 seconds left in the first half. The Sun Devils got even closer, trimming USC's lead to single digits after Crisp's 3-pointer in the opening moments of the third quarter made the count 38-31. As fast as the Sun Devils got back into game, they lost their grasp of it just as quickly as the Trojans - in fewer than three minutes - reclaimed a firm grip of the contest by outscoring ASU 10-2 to take a commanding lead once again, 50-33, with 6:14 remaining. The Sun Devils would cut the lead to 11 once more but were not able to get any closer... At UCLA, after getting outscored 17-10 in the first quarter, the Sun Devils put together their best sequence of the game as they outscored UCLA 7-2 over the first six-plus minutes of the second quarter to pull within two points, 19-17. If there was a negative during the successful stretch it was the Sun Devils not being able to score more points while the Bruins were struggling with their offense. ASU's inability to do more damage on the scoreboard was magnified when the Bruins finally found their footing and closed the half with a 9-2 run to take a 28-19 lead at the half. UCLA's success carried over into the third quarter as they opened the second half

with a 17-6 run to more than double their halftime lead, 45-25 with

5:48 remaining in the third quarter.

Although the Sun Devil women's basketball team's overall health is a 180-degree difference from last season, the squad was dealt a tremendous blow when Natasha Adair announced Oct. 4, 2023, that senior guard Tyi Skinner would miss the 2023-24 season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who last season earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, quickly established herself as one of top scorers in the Pac-12 and one of the most exciting players in the nation to watch in her first season in Tempe.

In 2022-23, Skinner scored 20 or more points 15 times, including a career-high 29 points on two occasions. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner went on to average 19.3 points per game, the most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89 season. She concluded her first campaign in the Maroon and Gold among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), free throws made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG percentage (34.7/6th) and free throw percentage (78.1/8th).

- Led Wolsey-Wessington to a 22-3 record an appearance in the state semifinals (its first appearance in the state tournament) and the state's top seed in 2023.
- As a junior, teamed with sister Hanna to help Aberdeen Christian to a 21-5 record & a berth in the Class B girls basketball tournament.
- Has played in 23 contests and is averaging 13.2 minutes per game.
- In ASU's last 4 games, Miller has averaged 7.8 ppg (3rd on the team), 6.0 rpg (leads team) and 1.5 bpg (leads team). She scored 7 points and grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds in 2OT win over UW (Feb. 16). She played a big role in getting the game to OT as she hit a jumper to get ASU within two and them stepped up again by hitting a pair of free throws with 15 seconds remaining to send the game to overtime.
- Miller notched her second double-figure scoring game at Cal (11 points). She scored a career-high 15 points at WSU (Jan. 19).
- Tied for team lead in rebs (7) vs. Idaho State (Nov. 19).
- Scored career-high 15 points, pulled down 8 rebounds and played 30 minutes at WSU (Jan. 21).

#### #25 • Adison Novosel • G • 5-11 • Jr. • Richfield, Ohio

- Has played in 18 games (8.9 mins per game) for ASU this season.
- All six of her 3-pointers came in 5-game stretch.
- Logged a season-high 30 minutes and knocked down season-high 3 triples vs. No. 15 Utah (Jan. 5).
- Transferred to ASU in 2023 after playing first two seasons at Saint Francis University where she appeared in 35 contests (25 starts).
- After appearing in seven games off the bench as a freshman, started 25 of 28 games in 2022-23.
- As a sophomore, led Saint Francis with 29 triples and posted career highs in points (12) and 3-pointers (4) vs. Central Connecticut State (Jan. 28).

#### #30 • Morasha Wiggins • G • 6-0 • Jr. • Kalamazoo, Mich.

- Transferred to ASU after playing her freshman season (2021-22) at North Carolina.
- Ranked 18th in the ESPNW Class of 2021 rankings, Wiggins was expected to be an impact player for ASU before suffering a preseason injury that forced her to miss the entire 2022-23 campaign. At the time of her 2023-24 injury, was averaging 12.6 minutes per game and was shooting 50 percent from the floor (6-12 FGs).
- Played in 6 games in 2023-24 before prematurely having her season end due to knee injury.
- Played 23 minutes and scored 8 points and hit all 4 FTs in her Sun Devil debut vs. San Francisco (Nov. 13).

#### #44 • Isadora Sousa • G • 6-0 • Grad. • Sao Paulo, Brazil

- Has played in 46 games (22 starts) in her 3 seasons with ASU.
- Has worked hard to come back from injury each of her three seasons and has proven to be an effective performer when on the floor.
- Has started 14 of 15 games she has played this season and has connected on 50 percent of 3FGs (14-28).
- Came up big in ASU's 2OT win over UW (Feb. 16), scoring 14 of her career high 16 points in the 2nd half (6 points) and OT (8 points).
- Scored all 12 points of her points via the long ball (4-4 3FGs) in ASU's win over Cal (Jan. 28).
- Scored 10 points and had career-high steals (3) vs. No. 5 Colorado (Jan. 7).
- In 2022-23, had the second-highest field goal percentage on the team, shooting 44.8%.
- Missed first 10 games due to injury before playing vs. Arizona (Dec. 17). Did not play vs. Fresno State (Dec. 20) but started ASU's game vs. Santa Clara (Dec. 30) and scored 7 points and had 3 rebounds in 19 minutes.

#### **RECAPPING THE 2022-23 SEASON**

Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe. The accomplishments included...

- Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03.
- Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3). Only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season.
- Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. After trailing the Bruins by as many as 19 points in the third quarter, the Sun Devils staged a furious rally to take a two-point lead in regulation before falling in overtime. The win would have been ASU's biggest comeback in school history.
- In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points). The victory was also No. 175 of Adair's career.
- Individually, Sun Devil guards Jaddan Simmons (Pac-12 All-Defense honorable mention) and Tyi Skinner (All-Pac-12 honorable mention) comprised one of the most talented backcourts in the country. Both players earned Pac-12 honors as voted on by the league's head coaches. Skinner, who finished second in the Pac-12 and 27th in the nation in scoring (19.2 ppg), was also named to the media's 15-member All-Pac-12 team.



# **HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR**



- •On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- •Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- •In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- •In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament; After trailing the Bruins by as many as 19 points in the third quarter, the Sun Devils staged a furious rally to take a two-point lead in

regulation before falling in overtime. The win would have been ASU's biggest comeback in school history; In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points). The victory was also No. 175 of Adair's career; Individually, Sun Devil guards Jaddan Simmons (Pac-12 All-Defense honorable mention) and Tyi Skinner (All-Pac-12 honorable mention) comprised one of the most talented backcourts in the country; Both players earned Pac-12 honors as voted on by the league's head coaches. Skinner, who finished second in the Pac-12 and 27th in the nation in scoring (19.2 ppg), was also named to the media's 15-member All-Pac-12 team.

- •In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- •Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All- Conference honors.
- •In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- •Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win Hoyas program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished the 2016-17 campaign with 17 wins, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- •In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- •While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All- Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- •Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the program to consecutive postseason appearances.





# **HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR**

- •In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.
- •In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.
- While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.
- •Adair previously spent 14 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with eight years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor five WNBA draft picks and several players who went on to play professionally overseas.
- A founding member of the Black Coaches United, Adair has been recognized by the organization, as well as Advancement of Blacks in Sports (ABIS), as one of the top women's basketball coaches in the country. Adair prides herself on being known as a game-changer as it



relates to social justice and creating a safe space for athletes to find and use their voice; where she was a guest on ESPNW's "Around the Rim" with LaChina Robinson and Delaware's UD Winning Women in Athletics: Trailblazers and Changemakers Webinar Series.

- •Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990- 92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994.
- Coach Adair has two children, a son Aaron M. Adair (26), graduated magna cum laude from Johnson C. Smith University. A four-year member of the university's President's Council for his academic achievement, he also earned four letters playing for the men's basketball team. Daughter Allyssa M. Adair (18) is a freshman at Texas State University and a middle blocker on the volleyball team.
