UP NEXT

The Sun Devil women's basketball team closes out its road trip to the state of Washington on Sunday (12 p.m. PST/1 p.m. MST) when it takes on the Washington Huskies.

The trip started Friday night in Pullman, Wash., where – for the second time in as many games – the Sun Devils were in position to come away with a quality road win before falling short in the final minutes. Despite a pair of stellar offensive performances from Jade Loville (13 of 21 points in the 1st half) and Jaddan Simmons (career-high 22 points/19 in the 2nd half), the Sun Devils lost at Washington State 65-58. Missed opportunities prevented ASU from capturing the win as it spent much of the fourth quarter either tied or within one possession of the Cougars.

The team's final road trip of the regular season has come on a week like no other while competing in a season like no other. ASU's makeup game at Cal (scheduled for Feb. 16) was supposed to be the second game of a sequence in which ASU would have been playing four road games in eight days. ASU's flight to Oakland on Tuesday was aborted (mechanical issues with its aircraft). While alternatives were explored to travel to the Bay Area and play the game, none were deemed to be in the best interest of the health and welfare of the student-athletes. Because ASU did not travel to California and play the game, the Pac-12 ruled ASU had to forfeit the game and take a loss in the conference standings.

The Sun Devils (12-10, 4-6 Pac-12), who were the last team in the Pac-12 to start conference play (Jan. 21), started the week having won three of its last four contests that were decided on the court after a 1-3 start. Included in its recent wins were consecutive wins over No. 19 Oregon (Feb. 6) and No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11). ASU came up just short of posting a second straight win over the Wildcats last Sunday in Tucson. With the scored tied at 57-57, Arizona scored five of the game's last six points to escape with an 62-58 win. ASU started rivalry weekend with an 81-77 win over Arizona (Feb. 11) in Tempe. Jade Loville (27 points), Taya Hanson (19 points) and Gilles (career-high 19 points) combined for 65 points in in the win. ASU operated at a high level of efficiency on a number of levels, shooting 91 percent (31-34) at the free throw line and 54.5 percent (6-11) from long range. Loville, who averaged 25.3 points during ASU's three-game winning streak, added a season-high eight rebounds.

Washington's record belies how competitive the Huskies (5-14, 0-11 Pac-12) have been throughout the season. In a conference in which every contest is a challenge for every team, Washington has proven to be a formidable opponent as the Huskies have come up short by an average of 6.6 points in seven of its 11 conference losses.

SERIES NOTES VERSUS WASHINGTON

- •• ASU has dominated of late having won 24 of the last 32 meetings, including 22 of the last 28. Washington won the most recent contest 50-35 last February in Tempe
- ASU swept the season series in 2015-16, winning 68-61 in Seattle & 77-57 in Tempe. UW was victorious in both contests in 2016-17: 65-54 in Tempe & 70-57 in Seattle.
- In 2019, the teams had their contest canceled by a snowstorm in Seattle.
- In 2020, ASU won 67-50 in Seattle and 72-68 in Tempe. In the latter win, former Sun Devil Reili Richardson led ASU with 17 points and added six assists to become ASU's all-time leader in career assists.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- Through games played Feb. 18, ASU has an NCAA Net ranking of 39, one of seven Pac-12 teams in the Top 50 (Stanford 3, Oregon 10, Arizona 11, Utah 26, Colorado 32, Oregon State 50). Of those teams, ASU has wins over Colorado, Oregon State, Oregon and Arizona.
- ASU enters Sunday's game in ninth place in the Pac-12 (based on winning percentage). Only Cal (nine) has played fewer league games than ASU (10).
- As of Feb. 19, ASU is ranked among the top third in the Pac-12 in 3-pt FG pct. defense (2nd/29.6), offensive rebounds (4th/12.9 rpg) and rebounding defense (4th/32.86 rpg).
- During the Fall 2021 semester, ASU had a team GPA of 3.73.
- Jade Loville went over the 1,000-point mark in career scoring with a game-high 19 points at No. 2 Stanford (Jan. 28). <u>Loville currently leads the Pac-12 in scoring (19.0 ppg) in league games</u>. She averaged 25.5 points during ASU's recent three-game winning streak.
- In ASU's 3 wins over ranked teams No. 22 Colorado, No. 19 Oregon, No. 6 Arizona Taya Hanson averaged 15.5 ppg while shooting 43 pct from long range (6-14). In those same games, Mael Gilles nearly averaged a double-double (10.3 ppg/9.0 rpg).
- The team's active career leader in 3-pointers (138/3rd place on ASU's all-time list), Hanson needs 23 triples to tie Kylan Loney (161/2001-05) for 2nd place. The top spot is held by Katie Hempen (185/2014-16).
- Four players have led or tied for the team lead in scoring this season Loville (10x), Simmons (6x), Hanson (4x), Gilles (4x). *In ASU's last two games.*Simmons has averaged 19.0 points and while shooting 62 percent (13-21) from the floor.
- The Ls that could have been Ws: ASU was... outscored 12-5 in OT loss to Minnesota (Nov. 12)... within 7 points in the 4thQ at BYU (Nov. 17)... down by as many as 17, ASU got within 5 points in the 4thQ vs. Houston in Cancun (Nov. 25)... led by 7 in the 4thQ at Creighton (Dec. 12)... down by as many as 29, ASU got within 6 points 2x in the 4thQ vs. Utah (Jan. 23)... entered 4thQ at Oregon (Feb. 1) within 3 points of the Ducks... Was tied at No. 6 Arizona (57-57) with under 2 mins remaining, Arizona scored five of the game's last six points to escape with an 62-58 win... Spent much of 4thQ tied or within one possession at WSU (Feb. 18).
- Defensively, ASU has given up 55 or fewer points 10x. In its 57-52 OT win over Colorado (Jan. 21), ASU held CU nearly 18 points below its scoring average. CU's 52 points tied its lowest point total of the season. It needed the five additional minutes in OT to reach that as the Buffaloes had 46 points in regulation. ASU held Oregon more than 24 points below its average in 55-49 upset of the No. 19 Ducks (Feb. 6).



- ASU has allowed 13 or fewer points in a guarter 39x this season.
- ASU has allowed an average of only 57.4 ppg since the 2014-15 season (a span of 246 games). It has held the opposition to 50 or less points 73 times during that stretch (ASU is 69-4 in those contests).
- Including its 8-5 record this season, ASU is 81-18 (.818) in nonconference, regular season games since 2013.
- Two Sun Devils have started every game: Jaddan Simmons and Taya Hanson both returning starters from last season's squad.
- Transfers Jade Loville (Boise State) and Mael Gilles (graduate transfer from Rutgers) have started all 21 games they have played in.
- Maggie Besselink started first 7 games before getting injured. Jayde Van Hyfte, returning from surgery last year, has started last 15 games.

PLAYER NOTES

- Jade Loville: Has scored 20 or more points 7x this year and currently leads ASU in scoring (16.8 ppg/3rd in Pac-12), 3-pointers (33), FG pct (45.5/13th in Pac-12) and 3-point FG pct. (45.2/3rd in Pac-12) and is 2nd in FTs made (60) and attempted (79). On Dec. 18, Loville became the fourth Sun Devil to score 30 or more points since 2000, as the 2021 All-Mountain West honoree dropped 34 points (most in the Pac-12 as of Feb. 11) in ASU's win over San Diego (Dec. 18). She repeated the feat by accounting for 19 of her game-high 33 points (tied for 2nd-highest total in the Pac-12 this season) in the second half of ASU's win over Oregon State (Feb. 4). Loville scored an opponent game-high 27 points in ASU's upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11). DNP for precautionary reasons in ASU's contest vs. Colorado (Jan. 21).
- <u>Jaddan Simmons:</u> Leads ASU in assists (3.0 apg/12th in Pac-12) and FTs made (64) and attempted (89) and is 2nd steals (1.73 spg/t9th in the Pac-12). Averaged 11.5 ppg in two games vs. Arizona including team-high 16 points at Arizona (Feb. 13). *Has averaged 19.0 points and while shooting 62 percent (13-21) from the floor.*
- <u>Taya Hanson:</u> Is 2nd on the team in 3FGs (27), tied 2nd in blocks (0.6 bpg), 3rd in assists (2.3 apg) & steals (1.3 spg) and 4th in rebounds (3.4 rpg). Hanson scored 17 points in ASU's win over No. 22 Colorado (Jan. 21) and in its win over OSU (Feb. 4). She tied her career high in rebounds (7) in the win over Colorado and again in ASU's upset of No. 19 Oregon (Feb. 6). Hanson, who has made all 25 of her FTs in Pac-12 play, scored a season-high 19 points in upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11).
- Mael Gilles: Currently paces the team in rebs (7.62 rpg/4th in the Pac-12), offensive rebs (2.48 rpg/7th in Pac-12), steals (1.89 spg/6th in Pac-12) and blocks (1.29 bpg/8th in Pac-12) and is 2nd in scoring (10.0 ppg), and assists (2.5 apg). Gilles has four double-doubles and has just missed the feat three other times. She has scored in double figures 9x including career-high 19 points (10-of-10 FTs) in upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11) and has grabbed 10 or more rebs 6x. Followed that with 15-point performance (6-10 FGs) in the rematch in in Tucson (Feb. 13). DNP for precautionary reasons in ASU's contest vs. Lipscomb (Dec. 30).
- <u>Jayde Van Hyfte:</u> The only Sun Devil on last season's roster to start every game in 2019-20, made her 2021-22 debut in the season's eighth game after not having played since the 2020-21 season opener. She has started every game she has played in ASU's last 15 games and is shooting 63.6 pct (21-33 FGs) from the floor... With ASU up by one point, took a charge in the final seconds of ASU's 81-77 win upset of No. 6 Arizona (Feb. 11).
- Maggie Besselink: After starting the first seven games, missed ASU's next six games due to injury. • <u>Meg Newman:</u> One of the most sought-after players in the country and ranked as the No. 33 overall player in the nation and No. 6 at her position by ESPN.com, Newman suffered a season-ending injury during preseason training.

SEASON SUMMARY

- The first month of the season was punctuated by a challenging schedule for a team not only getting used to playing with one another, but also adjusting to the personnel it did not have due to injuries. Freshman post Meg Newman one of the nation's most sought after players and ranked No. 6 at her position by ESPN.com was lost for the season after suffering a knee injury during preseason practices. In addition, Isadora Sousa, another exciting newcomer, missed most of preseason workouts due to injury.
- ASU opened the 2021-22 season splitting its first two contests, defeating Northern Colorado 71-41 (Nov. 9) before falling to Minnesota 66-59 in OT (Nov. 12). Loville (16.5 ppg) & Hanson (12.0 ppg) both averaged double figures in scoring in the two games. Gilles averaged 7.0 ppg, 5.0 rebs, 4.0 blocks and 3.0 steals. Besselink had a career-high 15 rebounds vs. Minnesota.
- Despite a strong defensive effort, ASU was not able to overcome shooting 30 percent in a 55-44 loss at BYU (Nov. 17).
- Coming off a 13 pct (3-24) outing from long range at BYU, ASU came within one 3-pointer of tying the single-game school record after hitting 13 in an 82-53 win over Marist (Nov. 21). Ten of its triples came during a first half in which it shot a blistering 59 pct from beyond the arc.
- ASU went 1-2 at the Cancun Challenge played on Thanksgiving weekend. ASU started the tourney with setbacks against Houston (68-60) & No. 6 Baylor 62-52. In both contests, the Sun Devils fought back to get within single digits after trailing by double-figures. In the final of the three games it played in three days, ASU defeated Fordham 58-43. The Sun Devils entered the game with a record of 2-4. The win over the Rams started a sequence in which the Sun Devils went 7-1 over their next eight games.
- ASU swept its home tournament, the ASU Classic, defeating UTSA (68-44) & Harvard (91-54) to extend its winning streak to three games. Loville (13.0 ppg), Gilles (11.0 ppg, 8.5 rpg, 4.0 apg, 2.5 spg) and Basallo (10.0 ppg, 3.0 apg) were ASU's top contributors. Gabriela Bosquez (career-high nine points) and Imogen Greenslade (career-high 11 rebounds) both had strong outings against Harvard.
- Despite a (then) career-high 18 points from Gilles, ASU had its three-game winning streak snapped at Creighton, 69-62 (Dec. 12). ASU shot 47 pct for the game, its third straight contest shooting 45 pct or higher. ASU doubled up Creighton in scoring (24-12) in the third quarter to take a five-point lead going the final frame. Creighton outscored ASU 28-16 over the last 10 minutes the most points scored by an ASU opponent in a quarter this season to come back and claim the win.
- On Dec. 18, Loville became the 4th Sun Devil WBB player to score 30 or more points since 2000, as the 2021 All-Mountain West honoree dropped 34 points (most in the Pac-12 as of Feb. 19) in ASU's 79-60 win over San Diego.
- ASU was originally scheduled to open Pac-12 play with contests at UCLA (Dec. 31) & at USC (Jan. 2). On Dec. 24, it was announced the first half of ASU's road trip to Los Angeles had been postponed. ASU announced on Dec. 28 it reached an agreement to play Lipscomb on Dec. 30 in Tempe (ASU won 70-54). On Dec. 29, it was announced the second half of ASU's trip to the City of Angles would not be happening, either. ASU also had its next four contests vs. UW and WSU, at UO and OSU postponed.
- Coming off an unplanned period of just over three weeks without playing a game, ASU started Pac-12 play the final Pac-12 team to start league play with a 57-52 overtime upset of No. 22 Colorado (Jan. 21). It followed that with a 72-63 loss at home to Utah, a game in which ASU nearly came up with what would have been the second-largest comeback in NCAA Division I history. Trailing by 29 points with two minutes remaining in the second quarter, ASU fought back to get within six points with just over two minutes remaining.
- Playing for only the fourth time in 37 days, the Sun Devils fell at No. 2 and defending national champion Stanford 78-40 on Jan. 28. ASU was not able to play the second game it had scheduled while in the Bay Area after its game at Cal (Jan. 30) had to be postponed.
- In its first opportunity to make up one of its seven postponements, ASU came up on the wrong end of a 72-58 decision at No. 19 Oregon (Feb. 1). Gilles came through with one of her best all-around games of the season with team highs in points (15), rebounds (7) and assists (career high-tying 5 assists). Trailing by three points entering the fourth quarter, ASU was outscored 23-12 in the final 10 minutes.
- ASU entered its contest vs. third-place Oregon State (Feb. 4) having lost its last three games. The Sun Devils would respond to the challenge as Loville scored 19 of her game-high 33 points in the second half and Hanson knocked down 6 consecutive free throws with 17 seconds remaining to



help ASU defeat the Beavers 67-57. ASU then evened the score with Oregon, upsetting the No. 19 Ducks 55-49 (Feb. 6). Loville scored 12 of her 16 points in the 2nd half and Basallo chipped in 7 of her 10 points in the 3rd quarter.

- ASU split its two games vs. No. 6 Arizona, winning 81-77 in Tempe (Feb. 11) and coming just short of pulling off the sweep, falling 62-58 in Tucson (Feb. 13). Loville (27 points, season high 8 rebounds), Hanson (season-high 19 points) and Gilles (career-high 19 points/10 rebounds) combined for 65 points in ASU's win in Tempe (Feb. 11). With the scored tied at 57-57 in the second game, Arizona scored five of the game's last six points to escape with an 62-58 win. Loville (17.5 ppg), Gilles (17.0 ppg) and Simmons (11.5 ppg), who led ASU with 16 points in the rematch, all averaged double figures in the two games.
- ASU's makeup game at Cal (scheduled for Feb. 16) was supposed to be the second game of a sequence in which ASU would have been playing 4 road games in 8 days. ASU's flight to Oakland on Feb. 15 was aborted (mechanical issues with its aircraft.) While alternatives were explored to travel to the Bay Area and play the game, none were deemed to be in the best interest of the health and welfare of the student-athletes. Because ASU did not travel to California and play the game, the Pac-12 ruled ASU had to forfeit the game and take a loss in the conference standings.
- Despite a pair of stellar offensive performances from Jade Loville (13 of 21 points in the 1st half) and Jaddan Simmons (career-high 22 points/19 in the 2nd half), ASU lost at Washington State 65-58 (Feb. 18). Missed opportunities prevented ASU from capturing the win as it spent much of the 4th quarter either tied or within one possession of the Cougars.

WELCOME TO TEMPE

ASU added a quartet of talented and experienced transfers in the offseason who head coach Charli Turner Thorne feels has the potential to have a major impact this season. Three of the four transferred in April with 2020 Mountain West Conference Newcomer of the Year Ayzhiana Basallo being the first to officially join the program. Basallo, a 5-5 guard who will have two years of eligibility, arrived at ASU from San Jose State where she earned her degree in communication earlier this year. In her only full season at San Jose State – did not play in 2018-19 due to NCAA transfer rules and SJSU's 2020-21 season was canceled after only four games due to COVID-19 – Basallo earned the Mountain West Conference's Newcomer of the Year award for a season in which she averaged a team-high 18.5 points per game while shooting 44.7 pct from the field, 45.4 pct from beyond the arc (school single-season record) and 92.5 pct at the free throw line (school single-season record).

Jade Loville, a 5-10 wing who earned All-Mountain West honors last season, joined ASU from Boise State. In 2020-21, Loville, who has two years of eligibility, scored in double figures 19 times last season, setting the school's single-game scoring record with 40 points at UNLV on Feb. 10, 2021. She scored 20 or more points nine times and was named the Mountain West Player of the Week after averaging 26.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game in a two-game sweep of San Jose State (Dec. 31 and Jan. 2).

A 6-1 forward who originally came up through Canada's youth national teams Mael Gilles is using her fifth year of eligibility to play for ASU after spending the last four seasons with Rutgers (started 55 of 101 career games). Last season, Gilles averaged 8.1 points and 4.3 rebounds in helping Rutgers earn its highest seed in the NCAA Tournament since 2012. A starter in all 18 games she played in last season, Gilles notched six double-figure scoring efforts, including a season-high 16 points on two occasions.

In early June, ASU welcomed Isadora Sousa, a six-foot guard who played the last two seasons at Chipola College in Marianna, Fla. A native of Sao Paulo, Brazil, Sousa has twice been named an NJCCA All-American – third team in 2020 and second team in 2021 – by World Exposure Report. She is coming off a campaign in which she earned FCSAA/NJCAA VIII All-State, All-Panhandle Conference first-team and FCSAA/NJCAA VIII All-Tournament Team honors in helping lead Chipola to its seventh FCSAA Championship and an appearance in the NJCAA Tournament semifinals.

One of the biggest challenges ASU faced last season was overcoming its youth/inexperience as out of 120 possible starts, 95 were made by freshmen (62) or upperclassmen who were first-year starters (33). In addition to the talent they brought, just as important is the experience as Gilles (56/104), Loville (87/23) and Basallo (60/33) brought a combined 224 games of NCAA D1 playing experience, including 139 starts.

YVONNE SANCHEZ JOINS CHARLI TURNER THORNE'S COACHING STAFF

Last April Yvonne Sanchez – a coach with more than 30 years of experience both as an assistant and head coach – joined Charli Turner Thorne's staff as assistant coach at ASU. Sanchez came to Tempe from the University of Michigan where she spent the last three seasons as assistant coach. While in Ann Arbor, the Wolverines won nearly 70 percent of their games and earned a pair of bids to the NCAA Tournament (Michigan would likely have also been a 2020 NCAA Tournament participant had the postseason not been canceled due to the pandemic). In 2021, the Wolverines earned their highest NCAA Tournament seed ever (No. 6) and reached the Sweet 16 for the first time in program history with wins over No. 11 seed Florida Gulf Coast and No. 3 seed Tennessee. Michigan fell just short of its first Elite Eight after being edged by No. 2 seed Baylor in overtime, 78-75.

Sanchez was on staff at the University of New Mexico from 2000-2016, spending the last five seasons of her tenure as head coach. She amassed 77 victories as head coach and was named the 2014-15 Mountain West Coach of the Year after winning a school-record 14 conference games. In her first season as head coach, the Lobos reached the Mountain West Conference championship game. She would duplicate the feat in 2015 when the Lobos went 21-13. During her time as an assistant coach (2000-08) and associate head coach (2008-11), the Lobos won two Mountain West regular-season titles and five conference tournament crowns and made seven NCAA Tournament appearances. New Mexico won 239 games from 2000-2011, highlighted by the program's only NCAA Sweet 16 appearance, in 2003.

NEWS FROM SIGNING DAY

On Nov. 10, 2021, Charli Turner Thorne announced local superstar Trayanna Crisp, rated a four-star and Top 100 student-athlete by ESPN.com, signed a national letter of intent to study and play basketball at Arizona State.

A five-foot-eight combo guard who is rated No. 20 in the nation at her position by ESPN.com, Crisp will continue to play in front of the hometown fans that witnessed her win state championships as a freshman and sophomore while playing for Goodyear Millennium High School. A first-team all-region selection, most recently Crisp averaged 14.2 points, 5.2 rebounds and 4.2 assists in helping lead PHH Prep to the Grind Session girls basketball world championship. As a sophomore, Crisp, who has returned to Millennium for her senior season, was recognized as the 5A offensive player of the year for per-game contributions of 14.8 points, 3.6 steals, 3.0 assists 4.2 rebounds while shooting 49 percent from the field.

Crisp's impact with Millennium was as sudden as it was superb as she contributed 9.7 points, 2.6 assists and 2.4 steals per game as a freshman in helping Millennium win the first of consecutive state titles.



HEAD COACH CHARLI TURNER THORNE



- The winningest coach in ASU women's basketball history and No. 2 in the Pac-12 in career wins (488), Charli Turner Thorne is at the helm of an Arizona State program that has qualified for postseason all but one year since 2001, including a school record six consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (2014-19), two Elite Eight appearances and three Sweet 16 finishes. ASU's 14 NCAA Tournament appearances under Turner Thorne are 11 more than what ASU had in the 15 years prior to her arrival in Tempe. Has also earned a pair of gold medals with USA Basketball.
- The 2021-22 season will be the 25th at ASU for Turner Thorne who has 528 career in 28 seasons as a head coach (includes 40 wins in three seasons at Northern Arizona).
- In 2020-21, Turner Thorne led the Sun Devils to a berth in the Postseason WNIT, their 20th postseason trip in the last 21 seasons in which a postseason competition has been held. It was also the program's seventh consecutive postseason appearance in which a postseason competition was held (six consecutive NCAA Tournaments 2014-19, 2021 WNIT). With its 66-64 OT win over No. 9 Arizona on Feb. 28, ASU has five wins over Top 10 teams over the last three seasons.
- After finishing with a 20-11 record in 2019-20, ASU extended its school record for consecutive 20-win seasons (seven) and finished No. 25 in the AP poll. The Sun Devils were preparing to make their school record seventh straight trip to the NCAA Tournament before the cancellation of the season was announced on March 12, 2020 due to the coronavirus pandemic. ASU became the first unranked team to defeat consecutive Top-5 opponents when it knocked off then-No. 2 Oregon (72-66 on Jan. 10) and then-No. 3 Oregon State (54-47 on Jan. 12).
- In 2018-19, Turner Thorne led ASU to a school record sixth consecutive NCAA appearance and 20-win season. The Sun Devils captured a pair of wins in the 2019 NCAA Tournament and advanced to the Sweet 16.

• In 2017-18, ASU matched the school record for consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (five) and consecutive 20-win seasons (five). ASU won 22 games and made it to the second round of the NCAA Tournament while posting four Top 25 wins, including a 57-51 upset of No. 10 Oregon State in the quarterfinals of the Pac-12 Tournament.

- In 2018 the Sun Devils also matched the school record with eight student-athletes named to the Pac-12's All-Academic Teams. ASU's No. 5 finish (3.672) on the WBCA's 2017 Academic Honor Roll represented the second time in three seasons the Sun Devils were among the top 10 programs in the country after placing seventh (3.558) for the 2014-15 academic year.
- Between 1996-97 (Turner Thorne's first season at ASU) and 2018-19, the Sun Devils led the Pac-12 in the number of first-team All-Academic conference awards (22) and the combined number of first- and second-team All-Academic conference awards (46). Note: As of 2019-20 the Pac-12 no longer distinguishes first- and second-team honorees in academics.
- Despite injuries to key personnel and a young backcourt, Turner Thorne led ASU to its fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance (12th during ASU tenure) and fourth-consecutive 20-win season (12th during ASU tenure) in 2017. The Sun Devils made it to the second round of NCAAs where they came up just short of upsetting eventual national champion South Carolina as the Sun Devils took a lead going into the final minute of the game.
- Was named the 2016 Pac-12 Coach of the Year (coaches and media), the second time she has been recognized with the honor (2001), after leading the Sun Devils to their second regular season Pac-12 championship. ASU would go on to earn its highest NCAA Tournament seed (No. 2) in program history. In 2016 ASU also tied the program records for most conference wins (16) and consecutive wins (15) and set the program record for most road wins (11).
- In 2014-15 Turner Thorne led ASU to 29 wins (second-highest total in school history), a second-place finish in the Pac-12 and a berth in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The 2014-15 Sun Devils posted the best overall start (18-1) and conference start (7-0) in school history and reached 20 wins faster than any other squad (22 games).
- In 2013-14, ASU recorded its 10th 20-win season (23) and its ninth NCAA Tournament berth since 2000-01. The Sun Devils advanced to the second round of the Tournament, the seventh time under Turner Thorne the Sun Devils have been among the final 32 teams or better.
- In 2011 led ASU to its sixth NCAA Tournament appearance in seven years and a third-place finish in the Pac-10, ASU's ninth top-3 conference finish in 11 seasons.
- In 2009 guided ASU to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament for the second time in three seasons. ASU's final 26-9 record in 2008-09 included a school record 15-game winning streak (tied by 2016-17 team).
- In 2006-07 guided the Sun Devils to a school record 31 wins,

including a school record 16 Pac-10 wins, and led them to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history. ASU concluded the 2006-07 season ranked No. 8 in the final USA Today/ESPN coaches poll and No. 10 in the final Associated Press poll, their highest FINAL rankings in each of the respective polls in school history.

- In 2005-06 led ASU to a 25-7 record. During the season led ASU to its first Top 10 ranking in 22 years.
- In 2004-05 directed ASU to a 24-10 overall record and its first NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearance in 22 years.
- Led her 2001-02 team to a 25-9 record, which at the time had tied the single-season school record for most wins.
- Guided ASU to a share of the Pac-10 title in 2001 and the inaugural Pac-10 Tournament title in 2002, the first league championships in school history.
- Started her head coaching career at Northern Arizona where she spent three seasons (40-40 record from 1992/93 1995/96) and led NAU to consecutive winning seasons in 1994-95 and 1995-96, the first coach in school history to accomplish the feat.
- · As a player, lettered four years at Stanford where she played three years under Tara VanDerveer.
- During the summer of 2009 Turner Thorne served as the head coach of the USA Women's World University Games Team which went undefeated (7-0) and captured the gold medal at the 2009 World University Games in Belgrade, Serbia. It was Turner Thorne's second time working with USA Basketball. In the summer of 2007 Turner Thorne served as an assistant coach on USA Basketball's U21 World Championship Team which won the gold medal at the FIBA U21 World Championship in Moscow, Russia.
- Is a past president of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) Executive Committee.
- · Graduated from Stanford in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and later earned her master's degree in education from Washington in 1990.
- Turner Thorne and her husband, Will, have three sons Conor (23), Liam (20) and Quinn (18).
