#### **Sand Devil Update**

The Sand Devils went 2-2 at the Pac-12 North Invitational that they hosted at Grand Canyon Beach Stadium. Arizona State upset No. 11 Cal and picked up a second win against Washington, both victories by the same 3-2 margin.

#### Opponent Outlook Boise State (5-8)

- The Broncos went 1-3 last weekend at a tournament in Fort Worth, Texas. The lone win came against Houston Baptist.
- ASU and Boise State met earlier this season with the Broncos coming away with the 3-2 win. In the all-time series, it is tied at 3-3.

#### Utah (2-18)

- The Utes have struggled this season, currently on an 11-game losing streak. The two wins on the schedule were against The Master's University and Southeastern Louisiana.
- In the short history between the Sun Devils and Utes, ASU is undefeated against Utah and has won the two matchups.

#### **Record Breakers**

Three Sand Devils are in the top ten for individual wins. Fifth-year senior Katelyn Carballo broke the record for individual career wins in the win over the Huskies. She now has 64 career wins.

Senior Samantha Plaster hit 50 wins in her career at the Pac-12 South Invitational. She is currently in fifth in the record book with 53. Fellow senior Cierra Flood is not far behind with 46 total wins in seventh place.

#### **New Faces**

Three freshmen made the lineup in the first day of competition. Taryn Ames and Kate Fitzgerald teamed up in the No. 5 spot, winning both of their matches. Lila Bordis teamed up with junior Maddy Salazar at No. 4, going 1-1.

#### In the Rankings

The Sand Devils started the season at No. 20 in the preseason AVCA Coaches Poll, which is where the team ended in 2020. The team has been ranked for three weeks of the season. ASU was ranked as high as No. 19 in 2020.

#### Left Is Right

The Sand Devils have three players on the roster who play left handed: Katelyn Carballo, Maddy Salazar and Emily Anderson.

#### **Last Season**

While last season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Sand Devils managed to keep some of the momentum from their 2019 record-breaking season. Before the season was cut short, the team was ranked in the AVCA top 20 for three different weeks. In Brad Keenan's fourth season as the head coach, the team did not lose to an unranked team, continuing a trend from the 2019 season. With a 4-6 record, the team recorded two sweeps against Boise State and Utah.

#### 2021 Schedule Outlook

Arizona State will spend the majority of the season on the road, though three tournaments are in the state of Arizona. The 2021 schedule features six teams ranked in the AVCA Coaches Poll, including 2019 NCAA National Champion UCLA. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Sun Devils are unable to compete at their usual home at the PERA Club. For the home match against Arizona on April 21, the location is to be determined.

#### **Sister Sister**

Bailey and Emily Anderson are sisters from Las Vegas, Nevada. Bailey is a redshirt sophomore and Emily is a sophomore. They are the second pair of sisters to play on the same team for ASU beach volleyball. Cassidy and Kylie Pickrell were also teammates in 2016.
